Hillsinger batted .438 (7-16) last week with six runs scored, nine RBI and two home runs in helping the Highlanders win four games, including a three-game sweep of UNC Asheville. He started his week with a three-run homer in the top of the first inning at James Madison, giving Radford an early lead in the eventual win. He knocked in another run later in the game to make the score 5-3. In the series opener against UNC Asheville, Hillsinger knocked in three runs in his first four at-bats, including a leadoff homer in the fourth. He plated two runs in the second game and finished the week with a .500 on-base percentage and an .812 slugging percentage.
