Olesczuk, who entered the week hitting .189, batted .571 (8-14) with three runs scored, six RBI, two doubles and a home run to lead the Eagles to a 3-1 week. He collected three multi-hit games and drove in a run in all four contests. Olesczuk opened his week with a 3-3 day and two RBI in a win over Furman, and followed that with two hits and a double in Winthrop's Big South series opener against Gardner-Webb. He added three hits, two RBI and a home run in the series finale. For the week, Olesczuk posted a .588 on-base percentage and a .929 slugging percentage, plus a sacrifice fly, stolen base, walk and hit-by-pitch.
