Jackson, who entered last week batting .196, went 12-20 at the plate (=.600 average) with six runs scored, seven RBI, five doubles and two triples in helping the Runnin' Bulldogs win four of six games. In GWU's upset of No. 4 North Carolina, Jackson was 2-4 with a walk, and followed that performance by going 4-4 with three runs scored, two triples and a double in the series-opening win over Alabama State. Jackson finished the week with four multi-hit games, two multi-RBI efforts and an extra-base hit in five of six appearances. He posted a 1.050 slugging percentage and .667 on-base percentage.
