Campbell took two of three games over UNC Asheville this past weekend to move to 8-4 in Conference play. The series win over the Bulldogs was the seventh three-game series win of the season for CU, the most since 2005 ... The Fighting Camels have won five of their last six games, rebounding from its longest losing streak of the season (three) ... Campbell hosts nationally-ranked N.C. State on Tuesday. CU is 4-6 against nationally-ranked opponents under head coach **GREG GOFF**, and last faced a ranked N.C. State club in 2008. Coastal completed its first Big South sweep of the season with its three wins over VMI this past weekend. The Chants are now 27-4 all-time against VMI and have won each of the last 16 meetings ... In 35 games, Coastal Carolina has used 16 *DIFFERENT* defensive alignments (including the DH) and 25 *DIFFERENT* batting lineups ... **TUCKER FRAWLEY** was added to the Johnny Bench Watch List and batted .333 last week, going 3-for-4 in games one and two of the VMI series. Behind the plate, he has thrown out 15 of 29 base runners this season (51.7 percent) ... **DANIEL BOWMAN** became CCU's all-time RBI leader last week and ranks 5th on Big South career list with 187.
