In the series opener, he had four hits in his first four at-bats, scored three times and stole two bases to help the Highlanders to an early 7-1 lead. Kemp knocked in the first run for the Highlanders on a double in the second inning. In the second game, he had three hits, including a two-run homer in the 10th inning to give Radford the go-ahead runs, although the Highlanders lost in the bottom half of the frame. In the series finale, Kemp again knocked in the first run of the game to give the Highlanders the lead for good. He finished with two RBI and a run scored.

Coastal Carolina remains in first-place in the Big South with its .750 winning percentage (9-3 record). The Chants have won all four Conference series this season ... Coastal Carolina has 13 losses this season, six by way of extra innings ... **TUCKER FRAWLEY** threw out 3-of-4 runners attempting to steal last week. Radford picked up its third Big South series win in four tries this past weekend, taking two of three from Winthrop. The Highlanders have won nine of the last 11 regular season games from the Eagles. **JEFF KEMP** and **MATT HILLSINGER** each had eight hits in the series -- Kemp had four hits in the first game and Hillsinger had five in the second ... Kemp has hit in 11-straight games, and has a career-high 45 RBI in 39 games ... The Keydets won the series against the Camels thanks in large part to **JACOB MORLEY**, who hit a home run in each game of the series, including the game-winner in the nightcap of Friday's doubleheader and the walk-off in Saturday's game. 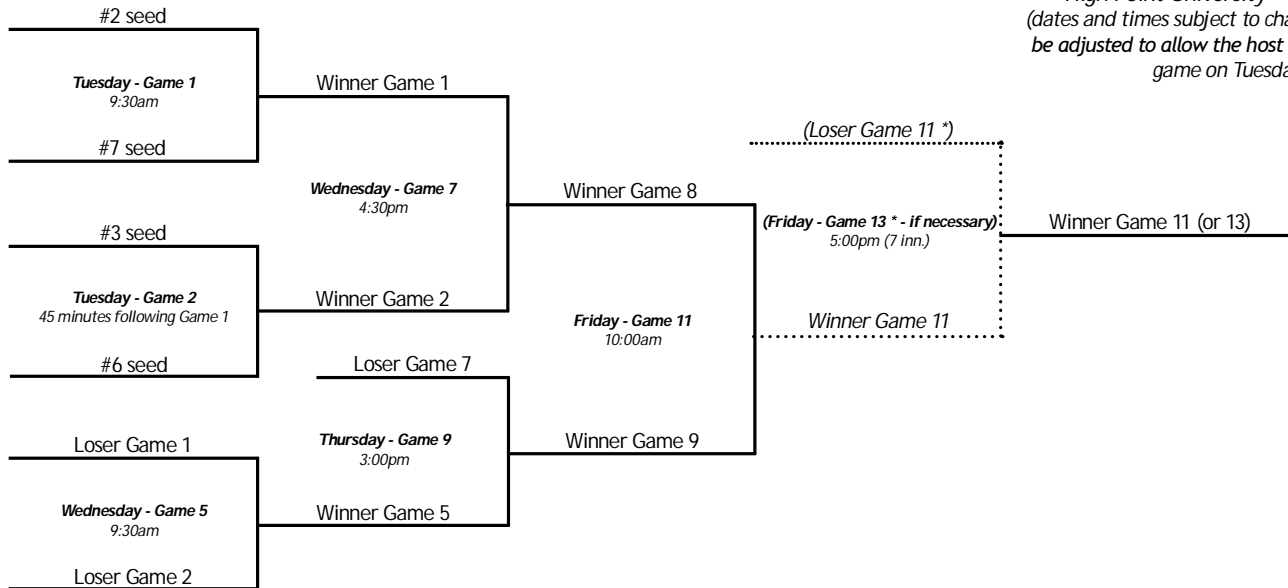

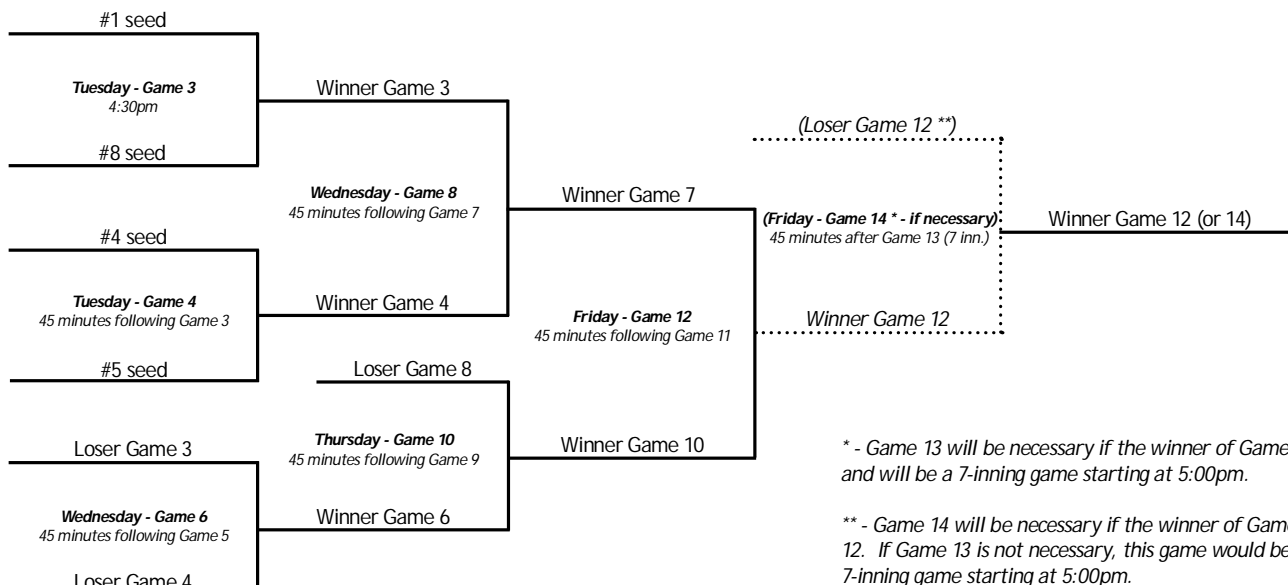
