Raffa had a tremendous game in Coastal's debut in The HTC Center. He tallied 27 points, eight rebounds and two steals and hit a pair of clutch three-pointers in the 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He single-handedly recorded a 5-0 run to open up the second half and retake the lead from the Zips. With under three minutes to play in the game, Raffa hit a three-pointer to make it a two possession game. In overtime, Raffa once again delivered from deep to extend the Coastal lead to four, then nailed a three with 1:06 to play to push the Chanticleer advantage to five. Raffa added a free throw with two seconds left in overtime to give CCU the final margin.

Brown posted game-highs of 28 points, eight rebounds, five steals and three blocks in his collegiate debut to lead High Point to an 81-73 win over UNC Greensboro last Friday. He shot 12-for-22 from the floor and had nearly identical stats in the first and second halves. After UNCG took a 9-8 lead, Brown hit a jumper and the Panthers led the rest of the game. Brown's one-handed alley-oop dunk was featured as ESPN SportsCenter's No. 1 play on Saturday morning.

### CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He is now one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 634 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 100.

### WELCOME MAT

The Big South's newest head coach -- Winthrop's **PAT KELSEY**, picked up his first win as a collegiate head coach in his first game at the helm of the Eagles with Winthrop's 80-48 home victory over St. Andrews Presbyterian on Nov. 10.

### BUILDING HOME EQUITY

The Big South went 6-0 in its home games this past weekend, which included the opening of Coastal Carolina's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center. The Chanticleers needed overtime to defeat Akron, 74-70. Campbell, Gardner-Webb, High Point, UNC Asheville and Winthrop were the Conference's other winners at home during the season-opening weekend.

### GOING GREEN

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** needs 29 assists to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists. He would be the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

### STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (241) and Big South victories (144). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 270-293 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 241-243.

### STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI became the ninth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 600 rebounds when he surpassed 1,500 points against Army on Nov. 11. Okoye is 25th in the Conference record books with 687 rebounds, and is 13 away from becoming the 24th member of the League's 700-rebound club. Once that occurs, Okoye will be just eighth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 700 career rebounds. Okoye also needs 10 blocked shots for 100 in his career, and is looking to become just the fourth player in League annals with 1,500 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocks.

### BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is 48 points away from 1,000 in his career, while **ANTHONY RAFFA** is 57 points away from 1,000 points at Coastal Carolina. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

### BIG MAN BACK ON CAMPUS

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior center **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** returned to the court after missing all of 2011-12 with an injury. Cunningham averaged 11.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.5 blocks in his first two games back. He had nine rebounds against both Western Carolina and UNC Wilmington and blocked six shots against the Seahawks. Cunningham is four rejections away from 100 in his career, which would make him the 29th player in League history with 100 career blocks.

### A BIGGER BIG SOUTH IN 2012-13

The Big South Conference has an all-time high 12 member institutions in 2012-13 with the addition of Longwood University as a full member. The expansion allowed the Conference to create two six-team divisions in men's basketball for the first time in League history. The North Division is comprised of **Campbell, High Point, Liberty, Longwood, Radford** and **VMI**, while the South Division consists of **Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, UNC Asheville** and **Winthrop**. Each team will play a 16-game Conference season with 10 intra-division contests and six crossover games. In addition, the format for the Conference Tournament now includes all 12 programs, with the top two teams in each division receiving byes into the quarterfinals.

### HEIR APPARENTS?

With the graduation of UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM**, Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the departed Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After two games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is averaging 16.0 points and Nimley is at 15.5 per game. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

### LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** enters the 2012-13 season needing 25 rebounds to become the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds. Law will likely surpass 700 career boards by seasons end.

### MID-MAJOR MANIA

The Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 seven consecutive seasons, and had two programs receive votes in this year's preseason poll -- UNC Asheville and Charleston Southern. This week, Campbell and Coastal Carolina received votes. Below is a look at this year's rankings among the Big South members:

### BIG BURRUS

Liberty senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is looking to join the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members. Burrus has tallied 104 rejections in his career -- tied for 27th in League annals, and has 452 career rebounds to his credit. He would become just the second Liberty player on the list, joining Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

### BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty's **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,736 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 501. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

## NORTH DIVISION

## CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

The Camels defeated Division III Averett, 74-55, in Friday's opener behind 31 points from **DARREN WHITE**, who made 11-of-18 from the floor and 9-of-12 from the line. **DARIAN HOOKER** added 15 points in his CU debut, while **Trey Freeman** chipped in 10 with 5 assists and 0 turnovers ... CU improved to 6-4 in season openers under 10th-year head coach **ROBBIE LAING** and won its fifth lid-lifter in the last six seasons ... The Camels also ran their win streak to seven in home openers, including all five at Gore Arena, which opened in November 2008 ... The Camels stand 41-16 (=71.9) all-time at Gore Arena.

## HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point opened the season with a win over UNC Greensboro in the teams' first meeting since 2003-04. High Point is now 7-1 all-time vs. the Spartans ... HPU head coach **SCOTT CHERRY** has a 4-0 record in season openers ... High Point's newcomers accounted for 75 of the team's 81 points (93 percent) and 23 of 41 rebounds (56.1 percent) against UNC Greensboro. Redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** (28 points, eight rebounds) and graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** (15 points, seven rebounds) led the way ... Battling foul trouble throughout the game, Chaney posted his 15 points and seven rebounds in just 16 minutes of play ... **JAIUS SIMMS** had a career-high seven assists vs. UNC Greensboro.

## LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty is 31-9 all-time in home openers, including 18-4 all-time when playing its first game of the season in the Vines Center. The Flames have won seven straight home openers. The last time Liberty dropped a home opener was on Nov. 19, 2004, when the Flames fell to New Hampshire, 59-58 ... The Flames' 18 miscues in the season opener at Richmond were the most since the 2010-11 season (19 at Coastal Carolina, Feb. 3, 2011) ... The Flames are also looking to bounce back from their third-lowest scoring total during **DALE LAYER**'s coaching tenure. Liberty's 42 points at Richmond was the lowest point total since the Flames posted 41 against Old Dominion (Nov. 19, 2009) during Layer's first season as head coach.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

New Big South member Longwood dropped its season-opening game on the road at Marshall, 81-47. The Lancers trailed just 18-12 with 6:12 left in the first half before the Thundering Herd closed the period with a 17-8 run to lead 35-20 at halftime. Marshall continued its momentum to start the second half and outscored Longwood 25-4 to lead 60-24 with 13:11 remaining ... Freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** led the Lancers with 11 points in his collegiate debut, including 7-of-10 free throws, adding five rebounds, two steals and one block before fouling out with 1:59 on the clock ... **JEYLANI DUBLIN** added career highs of 10 points and eight rebounds off the bench ... The Lancers played without two projected starters, **FRANK HOLLOWAY** and freshman **NIK BROWN**, each out with injuries suffered late last week.

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford has won nine-straight home openers and is 34-4 all-time in home openers ... The Highlanders were led by **R.J. PRICE**'s 16 points at Wake Forest, while freshman **KION BROWN** added 14 off the bench ... **BLAKE SMITH** recorded a team-high three steals against the Demon Deacons, increasing his career total to 154.

## VMI KEYDETS

Senior **STAN OKOYE** scored a career-high 31 points and pulled down eight rebounds while going 12-of-21 from the field against Army in Sunday's consolation game of the All-Military Classic. It marked the second time Okoye has reached the 30-point plateau after dropping in 30 against Presbyterian College on Dec. 4, 2010 ... For the tourney, Okoye averaged 22.3 points and 7.0 rebounds ... Freshman **PHILLIP ANGLADE** pulled down 11 rebounds in Sunday's consolation game against Army for VMI's best board output over the two-day tourney. Anglade finished with 13 rebounds overall for the weekend, including 10 on the offensive glass ... Sophomore **BRIAN BROWN** poured in a career-high 22 points in the season opener against The Citadel, hitting 7-of-14 three-point goals. Brown's previous season-high was 15 points at Gardner-Webb last year on February 11, 2011 ... VMI will face Virginia Tech Thursday for the first time since the 2009-10 season. The Keydets have met the Hokies 129 times on the hardwood, the most of any opponent in program history ... VMI opens the season with four games over a six-day stretch.

## SOUTH DIVISION

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

Charleston Southern started 0-2 with a pair of road losses against perennial NCAA Tournament programs. CSU fell 68-58 on Friday night at Charlotte, losing by 10 despite shooting below 30 percent as a team. The Bucs dropped their Sunday contest less than 48 hours later at No. 11/12 Arizona, 82-73 ... The Bucs hung tough with Charlotte, but struggled to make shots. The 49ers broke the game open with a 14-0 run in the second half. Despite good looks, the Bucs connected on only 8-of-34 three-point attempts. Sophomore **SAAH NIMLEY** had 20 points in the game ... Against the Wildcats, **ARLON HARPER** scored a team-high 20 in the nine-point loss.

## COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants opened The HTC Center with a thrilling 74-70 overtime victory over Akron ... Coastal had five players make their Coastal debut in the win over Akron, led by freshman **MICHEL ENANGA**, who had nine points and seven rebounds while starting the game ...
