Okoye averaged 26.0 points, 11.5 rebounds, 3.5 steals, 3.5 assists and 2.0 blocks in leading the Keydets to two wins last week. He opened his week with 22 points, seven rebounds, four steals and three assists in VMI's 76-71 road win at Old Dominion -- the Keydets' first win over the Monarchs since 1978 -- and scored the go-ahead basket with 3:29 remaining. Against Elon on Saturday, he tallied 30 points and 16 rebounds in leading VMI to the nine-point victory. He grabbed 11 rebounds in the second half and a total of 15 defensive rebounds in the game. For the week, Okoye was 19-of-37 from the field (=51.4 percent) and was 12-of-18 at the line (=66.7).

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

Through the first three weeks of the 2012-13 season, several underclassmen find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is averaging a Conference-best 10.8 rebounds and a League-high 61.2 percent from the floor. Campbell sophomore **TREY FREEMAN** is handing out a League-high 6.29 assists, while Charleston Southern freshman **MALCOLM BERNARD** leads the Big South with a perfect free throw clip (10-of-10). Lastly, Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is averaging a League-best 2.71 steals per game.

RAFFA JOINS BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **ANTHONY RAFFA** became the 115th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone against Johnson & Wales on Nov. 20. Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is 22 points away from 1,000 in his career. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is now the seventh player in Big South history with 1,600 career points and 700 rebounds after eclipsing the 1,600 career point mark vs. Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye, who needs 55 points to crack the Big South's all-time Top 20 scorers, is five blocked shots away from 100 in his career, and is looking to become just the fourth player in League annals with 1,600 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocks.

BOARD REPORT

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** became the 24th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 15 at Virginia Tech. He is now tied with Big South Hall of Famer **TONY DUNKIN** for 15th all-time with 725. Okoye is 75 caroms away from becoming the 11th player in League history with 800 career rebounds. He is the second VMI player with at least 700 career rebounds in the Big South, as former Keydet and current Charlotte Bobcat **REGGIE WILLIAMS** grabbed 820 boards from 2004-08.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He is now one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 635 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 101.

GOING GREEN

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** needs 14 assists to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists. He would be the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (241) and Big South victories (144). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 270-298 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 241-247.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is six wins away from 150 in his career as a collegiate head coach, while Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** needs 11 victories for 100 at CSU.

HEIR APPARENTS?

With the graduation of UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM**, Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the departed Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After five games into their sophomore seasons, Nimley is averaging 11.6 points and Harper is at 11.4 per game. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

TAKE COVER

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON**, who was hampered by injuries most of last season, is averaging 15.5 points, 6.3 rebounds, a League-high 3.0 blocks per game and is making 52.9 percent from the field. In his last four games, Covington has scored 20 points three times, has blocked 16 shots (4.0 average) and has two double-figure rebound games. In 2011-12, Covington was limited to 24 games and 362 minutes. He scored 121 points a season ago (5.0 average) with 64 rebounds (2.7) and 16 blocks. Meanwhile, Covington is 10 blocked shots away from joining the Big South's 100-blocked shot club.

GOTTA HAVE HART

Gardner-Webb senior **KEVIN HARTLEY** has been a defensive mainstay for the Runnin' Bulldogs through the first eight games of the season. He leads the squad with 6.6 rebounds to rank 11th in the Big South, and his 2.38 steals per game is fifth in the Conference. Hartley also ranks seventh in the League with 4.5 defensive rebounds a game. He has four games with at least three steals this season and is just 14 takeaways from matching his season steal total from 2011-12 (33 in 32 games).

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,773 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 538. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

MINUTE MAN

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** has played 3,582 minutes in his career, and is 597 away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader. He is 418 away from logging 4,000, which would make him the seventh player on record with that total. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 38.7 minutes played per game this year is slightly below his previous high of 38.9 as a sophomore in 2010-11. The Big South's all-time minutes played leader is Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH**, who played 4,178 minutes from 2005-09.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** needs 15 rebounds to become the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds. With a career 7.1 per game average, Law will likely surpass 700 career boards by seasons end.

BIG SOUTH TAKES DOWN MEMBER FROM BIG EAST

For the second consecutive season, a Big South member has defeated a member from the Big East Conference on the hardwood. Gardner-Webb knocked off its first Big East team on Nov. 15, as the Runnin' Bulldogs downed DePaul on its home court. GWU led from start to finish in the 71-59 victory. Last season, Presbyterian College had the Big South's win over a Big East member with its 56-54 win at Cincinnati. The Big South has now defeated a Big East program five out of the last nine seasons.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

NORTH DIVISION

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

After traveling 6,834 round trip air miles on a 4-games-in-8-days road trip, Campbell returns home to Gore Arena for its next three contests. The Camels host Division II Newberry Thursday in their only game of the week ... Campbell fell to 0-10 all-time against nationally-ranked teams with a 91-72 loss at No. 20/22 Cincinnati, Nov. 20 ... **TREY FREEMAN** scored a season-high 17 points at Cincinnati and is averaging a League-leading 6.3 assists per game ... **DARREN WHITE**, who averaged 21.0 points in two games against BCS conference foes Iowa State and Cincinnati, was named to the Global Sports Classic All-Tournament Team ... **MARVELLE HARRIS** scored a season-high 12 points (5-6 FG) to go along with eight rebounds against Northern Arizona.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

Freshman guard **ADAM WEARY** led the team in scoring for the first time with 12 points at Indiana State on Sunday. With 10.6 points per game, he is one of three Panthers averaging double figures behind redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** (18.2) and **ALLAN CHANEY** (15.0) ... Brown has scored at least 20 points three times and scored in double figures four times in his first five collegiate games ... Chaney posted two double-doubles in a row in a loss to William & Mary on Nov. 17 (22 points, 10 rebounds) and a win over St. Andrews (14 points, 10 rebounds) ... Indiana State hit 10-of-15 (66.7 percent) three-pointers on Sunday, the highest three-point shooting percentage for an HPU opponent since Charleston Southern hit 11-of-16 (68.8 percent) on Jan. 2, 2012 ... **JAIUS SIMMS** leads the Big South with a 3.29 assist-to-turnover ratio. He had a career-high nine assists with one turnover against St. Andrews ... Thursday's game at Western Michigan will be High Point's first-ever contest against a current member of the Mid-American Conference.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty's 0-6 start to the season is its second in program history and the first since the 1977-78 campaign, when the Flames began the year 0-7 ... **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** broke out of his scoring slump with a season-high 15 points against Southern Miss ... After scoring 12 points in each of his first four games, **DAVON MARSHALL** got over the hump with a season-high 15 points against Sam Houston State on Nov. 20 ... With the absence of past players **ANTWAN BURRUS**, **TOMASZ GIELO** and **JOEL VANDER POL**, **JR CORONADO** is accounting for more than 26 percent of the Flames' rebounding, averaging 7.8 boards per game.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

JEYLANI DUYBLIN led Longwood at nationally-ranked Creighton with career highs and game highs of 19 points and eight rebounds, while junior **TRISTAN CAREY** finished with 14 points and four steals ... Against Florida A&M, Carey led Longwood with his career-high tying 30 points, making 11-17 shots, including 7-9 three-point field goals and adding eight rebounds. The seven three-pointers tied the school's Division I record shared by three others. Freshman **NIK BROWN** added career highs of 21 points, making 9-10 free throws, and six assists. Classmate **MICHAEL KESSENS** finished with a double-double of 14 points and a career-high and game-high 16 rebounds, and Dublin contributed his first career double-double of 11 points and a career-high 11 rebounds in the win ... Kessens led Longwood against Cornell with his career-high and game-high 20 points, adding a game-high 14 rebounds for his fourth double-double this season ... Carey was named to the Continental Tire/Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team for his efforts in the four-game event. He averaged 18.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists, adding nine steals and three blocks.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford recorded its first back-to-back wins since winning the opening two games of the 2011-12 season vs. Delaware and Shenandoah ... **R.J. PRICE** made a career-high six three-pointers in the win over Brevard.

VMI KEYDETS

VMI recorded its first win over Old Dominion since Jan. 25, 1978 ... **STAN OKOYE**'s is now tied with **WILL BYNUM** '77 for 10th on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,606 points ... **D.J. COVINGTON** averaged 16.5 points and 6.5 rebounds and shot 57.9 percent from the floor in the two VMI wins last week. He blocked seven shots against Old Dominion ... Through six games, VMI has had at least one 20-point scorer in all contests played this year and multiple 20-point scorers in three games ... With the home win over Elon, VMI extended its home win streak over non-Conference opponents to 27.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

The Bucs fell to 1-4 to open the year after an 0-2 week ... CSU led ETSU by 20 on Tuesday night, before a falling in the final five seconds by two points ... The Bucs hung tough with unbeaten Alabama and trailed by six with five minutes left before the Tide pulled away late ... CSU opens a three-game homestand on Wednesday night against College of Charleston. The Bucs have 25 days between roads trips to Alabama and a return trip to ETSU on Dec. 18 ... Charleston Southern was out-rebounded for the first time this season in the loss to ETSU. The Bucs bounced back to out-rebound the Tide, 37-36, and had a 15-14 advantage on the offensive boards ... **SAAH NIMLEY** leads the Bucs in scoring at 11.6 points per game, followed by **ARLON HARPER** at 11.4. **MATHIANG MUO** is also averaging 10.6 per game. **PAUL Gombwer** is leading the Bucs with 8.2 rebounds per game.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants picked up a 96-40 home win over Johnson & Wales last week before falling to Florida International, 87-77 ... **ANTHONY RAFFA** became the 17th player in CCU history to score 1,000 points in his career with 15 points against Johnson & Wales. He reached the milestone with his 14th point in the game. Raffa followed the historic performance up with a career-high 34 points in the loss to Florida International. He has now led the Chants in scoring in all five games this season, and it is the longest such streak of his career ... **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 102 points away from 1,000 in his career and would become the 18th player in CCU history to reach the milestone ... The Chants have out-rebounded every opponent this season by an average of just under 10 boards a game. Freshman **MICHEL ENANGA** is leading the way on the glass with 8.8 boards per contest, followed by **EL HADJI NDIEGUENE**'s 7.0 boards per game ... Coastal hits the road this week with a game at Boston University on Wednesday. The Terriers will return the trip next Wednesday with a game in Conway.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

After playing a grueling schedule that included eight games in the season's first 16 days, Gardner-Webb will have an eight-day break before returning to action on Dec. 3 at home against UVA-Wise. That will begin a string of three games in five days that also includes a road game at Wofford (Dec. 5) and a home date with Tennessee Tech (Dec. 8) ... Gardner-Webb has held a halftime lead in five of its eight games so far ... GWU has ranked near the top of the Big South's scoring and field goal percentage defensive leaders all season, but Sunday's performance at a red-hot Illinois team was likely its most impressive to date. The Illini came into the game averaging 83 ppg and led the nation with 69 made three-point baskets. Gardner-Webb held Illinois 20 points below its scoring average, forced the Illini into 18 turnovers and limited the three-point production to a season-low seven makes ... **TASHAN NEWSOME**, who missed the previous seven days with a back injury, saw limited action against Austin Peay and played 24 minutes vs. Illinois.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

KHALID MUTAKABBIR is 353 points away from becoming the first PC player in Division I history to go surpass 1,500. He is just 99 from taking over the top career assists spot as well ... Despite the 0-3 record last week, two players averaged double-figures with Mutakabbir leading the scoring effort against Wisconsin and Cornell with 14 and 17 points, and **JOSH CLYBURN**'s 14 points led the team against Florida A&M. Mutakabbir averaged 14.7 ppg, while Clyburn averaged 10.0 ppg in the three games.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

The Bulldogs have lost five straight but four of the losses have come to BCS schools, and four have been by eight points or less ... UNC Asheville lost by two points at No. 15 N.C. State, 82-80, Nov. 23. Asheville got a career-high 28 points from **JEREMY ATKINSON** and career-high 23 points from **KEITH HORNSBY**, but fell just short of a stunning upset. The Bulldogs led for most of the game before the Wolfpack rallied late ... Asheville plays just once this week as it begins a three-game homestand on Thursday night when it hosts USC Upstate at Kimmel Arena.

WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop evened its record to 2-2 on the year with an impressive defensive effort against Lenoir-Rhyne on Nov. 20. The Eagles were tied at 17-17 at halftime but held the Bears to 23 percent shooting and 18 points in the second half. The Eagles held the Bears to just 35 total points, which is the lowest point total allowed at home since the 2007-08 squad held Limestone to just 34 points ... **GIDEON GAMBLE** and **DERRICK HENRY** finished with 12 and 11 points, respectively, against Lenoir-Rhyne. It was the first game of the year that Henry didn't lead the team in scoring ... Henry has scored in double-figures in all four games and is averaging 18.8 points per game.
