Hornsby averaged 23.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists in two games last week, while hitting 17of-25 field goals ( =68.0 percent) and 10-of-14 three-point attempts (=71.4). He opened his week with 21 points, five rebounds, four assists and two steals against Lenoir-Rhyne on Dec. 12, and followed that performance with a career-high 26 points at No. 7 Ohio State on Dec. 15. Hornsby was 6-of-8 from beyond the arc against the Buckeyes and added five boards.

#### **FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

Through the first six weeks of the 2012-13 season, several underclassmen continue to find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman MICHAEL KESSENS is averaging a Conference-best 10.7 rebounds. Radford sophomore JAVONTE GREEN is the Big South's top field goal shooter at 55.8 percent and leading stealer with 2.60 per game. Campbell sophomore TREY FREEMAN is handing out a League-high 6.40 assists and is tops in assist-to-turnover ratio, while Kessens leads the Conference in both offensive rebounds (4.00) and defensive boards (6.70) per game. Lastly, UNC Asheville sophomore KEITH HORNSBY is first in the League with a 52.6 three-point percentage, based on a minimum of 2.0 made per game.

#### **GOING GREEN**

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls. Greenwood is now tied for 21st all-time with 403 career helpers and needs eight to move past Winthrop's **REGGIE MIDDLETON** (410 from 2008-12) for the 20th spot. Greenwood is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

#### REBOUNDING LESSONS FROM KESSENS

Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is looking to become just the second frosh in Big South history to average double-figure rebounds in a season. The first was Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** in 2008-09, who averaged 10.30 that year. If Kessens can maintain his top spot, he would be just the second freshman to lead the Big South in rebounding. Big South Hall of Famer and former Campbell standout **JOE SPINKS** was the first with his average of 9.4 rebounds in 1990-91.

#### SEXTON JOINS BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** became the 115th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone against The Citadel on Dec. 4. Coastal Carolina senior **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 68 points away from 1,000 in his career. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

#### STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is the seventh player in Big South history with 1,600 career points and 700 rebounds after eclipsing the 1,600 career point mark vs. Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye is four blocked shots away from 100 in his career, and is looking to become just the fourth player in League annals with 1,600 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocks.

#### **BOARD REPORT**

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** became the 24th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 15 at Virginia Tech. He is now 13th all-time with 763 and is 21 away from moving past Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (783 from 2008-10) for 12th-place. Okoye is also 37 caroms away from becoming the 11th player in League history with 800 career rebounds. He is the second VMI player with at least 700 career rebounds in the Big South, as former Keydet and current Charlotte Bobcat **REGGIE WILLIAMS** grabbed 820 boards from 2004-08.

#### **GREEN MACHINE**

Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is averaging 3.00 steals in his last six games and a League-leading 2.60 steals overall, the highest average in the Big South since the 2008-09 campaign when VMI's **CHA-VIS HOLMES** led the Conference with 3.4. Meanwhile, Green is currently the Big South's leading field goal shooter at 55.8 percent, and could become the Conference's second player to lead the League in both steals and field goal percentage. The first (and only) to do so was Charleston Southern's **HEDER AMBROISE** in 1987-88. That season, he was tops with a 63.3 field goal clip and 2.1 steals per game.

#### TREASURE ISLAND

Charleston Southern scored 101 points in each of its past two games, first against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 1 and then three days later against The Citadel on Dec. 4. It was the first time the Buccaneers tallied back-to-back 100-point games since 1987-88 when they did it against Maryland-Eastern Shore (102) and Claflin (101).

#### **CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He is now one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 636 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 102.

#### **STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (243) and Big South victories (144). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 272-300 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 243-249.

#### SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is five wins away from 150 in his career as a collegiate head coach, while Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** needs nine victories for 100 at CSU.

#### **HEIR APPARENTS**

With the graduation of UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of MATT DICKEY and J.P. PRIMM, Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of SAAH NIMLEY and ARLON HARPER have replaced the departed Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After eight games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is at 16.3 per game and Nimley is averaging 14.3 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

#### WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game eight times in their young career (three times this season -- all consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 7-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those eight outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

#### **TAKE COVER**

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON** is one blocked shot away from becoming the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections. Covington, who was hampered by injuries most of last season, is averaging 14.4 points, 6.2 rebounds, a League-high 2.60 blocks per game and is making 54.9 percent from the field in 2012-13. He has two 20-point, 10-rebound games this year among his three double-doubles. Through 10 games this season, Covington has logged 250 minutes with 144 points, 62 rebounds and 26 blocked shots. In 2011-12, Covington was limited to 362 minutes in his 24 appearances. He scored 121 points a season ago (5.0 average) with 64 rebounds (2.7) and 16 blocks.

#### **BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,812 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 577 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

## MINUTE-BY-MINUTE

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** has played 3,731 minutes in his career, and is 448 away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader. He is 269 away from logging 4,000, which would make him the seventh player on record with that total. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 38.10 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category. The Big South's all-time minutes played leader is Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH**, who played 4,178 minutes from 2005-09.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest. He is 41st all-time with 607 and needs eight to move past Radford's **DON BURGESS** (614 from 1990-94) for 40th-place.

#### AGONY OF DEFEAT

The Big South has suffered a total of 33 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games is 5.27 points. UNC Asheville has suffered five of its seven losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. Radford, Campbell and Liberty are next with four losses by single-digits. The North Division teams have lost a combined 19 games under 10 points (5.53 average) while the South Division squads have dropped 14 games by single-digits by an average of 4.93 points.

#### DOUBLE TROUBLE

Just two players have scored in double figures in every game thus far -- UNC Asheville's JEREMY ATKINSON (10) and Campbell's DARREN WHITE (7). Atkinson owns the longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 18 games, dating back to last season, ahead of White's 13-game streak.

#### **CUNNINGHAM HARDWARE**

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior D.J. CUNNINGHAM became the 29th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 29 against USC Upstate. Cunningham stands at 108 blocks (26th all-time) and with 423 career rebounds, he is on his way to joining the Big South 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members.

#### FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior STAN OKOYE is 16th all-time in Big South history with 625 career field goals. He reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24. Okove needs four to surpass Winthrop's LaSHAWN COULTER (628 from 1990-95) for 15th-place and is 22 buckets away from entering the Big South's career Top 10. Meanwhile, Okoye is 66 points shy of becoming the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 15 in both scoring and rebounding. The other two are VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS (1st - scoring, 8th - rebounding) and High Point's ARIZONA REID (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

#### **BIG SOUTH TAKES DOWN MEMBER FROM BIG EAST**

For the second consecutive season, a Big South member has defeated a member from the Big East Conference on the hardwood. Gardner-Webb knocked off its first Big East team on Nov. 15, as the Runnin' Bulldogs downed DePaul on its home court. GWU led from start to finish in the 71-59 victory. Last season, Presbyterian College had the Big South's win over a Big East member with its 56-54 win at Cincinnati. The Big South has now defeated a Big East program five out of the last nine seasons.

#### **MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS**

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a threeyear agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

## BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

#### **MID-MAJOR MANIA**

The Big South has had a member ranked in the Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 seven consecutive seasons, and has had five programs receive votes in this year's weekly ranking. Below is a look at this year's rankings among the Big South members:

#### **NORTH DIVISION**

#### CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell heads to the Pacific Northwest for a pair of games this week. The Camels face No. 14/14 Gonzaga Wednesday before meeting Seattle University Saturday at KeyArena (former home of the Seattle SuperSonics) ... Campbell is 0-10 all-time vs. nationally-ranked teams as a Division I member ... Leading scorer **DARREN WHITE** has missed the last 3 games with a hand injury ... The West Coast trip is a homecoming for sophomore guard **ANDREW RYAN**, who hails from Lynden, Wash., which is 95 miles north of Seattle and 5 miles south of the U.S.-Canada border ... Over the last 4 games, **MARVELLE HARRIS** is averaging 12.8 points and 10.5 rebounds per outing, while shooting 71 percent (22-31) from the floor and 70 percent (7-10) from the line ... During his 37-game career, **TREY FREEMAN** has missed more than one free throw in a game just 6 times (and just once this year). He is shooting 80.8% from the line (85.9% for his career) ... **LEEK LEEK** came off the bench vs. Rio Grande and scored a season-high 16 points on 6-9 shooting (3-3 threes) in 21 minutes.

#### HIGH POINT PANTHERS

Graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY**'s 18 second-half points against Western Michigan were the most by any Panther this season. He scored in double-digits for the seventh time and scored 20 for the second time this season. He has gotten nine or 10 rebounds in five games as well ... Chaney went 6-for-7 on free throws Sunday and is 27-for-29 (93.1 percent) on the season ... **JOHN BROWN** has scored in double digits in eight of nine games this year and has scored at least 20 five times ... Sunday marked the first time this season High Point had two 20-point scorers ... Freshman forward **LORENZO CUGINI** scored all eight of his points in the second half against Western Michigan, going 3-for-3 from the floor and 2-for-2 from three-point range in that period. High Point had 13 steals and forced 26 turnovers vs. Western Michigan -- most against any Division I opponent this season.

#### LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty starts the season 1-9 for the fifth time in program history. The last time was during the 1998-99 campaign, in which the Flames finished that year with a 4-23 record ... After leading Howard by eight at halftime, the Flames went scoreless from the field for eight-plus minutes, falling to the Bison, 60-53 this past Saturday ... Liberty had a season-high six blocks in the contest, including three by **JR CORONADO**. He is the first Flame to record three blocks in a game this season ... Liberty's nine three-pointers against the Bison were its third-highest single-game total this year. The Flames also earned posted their largest rebound margin, winning the battle on the glass, 40-35. Liberty's 40 rebounds were a season-high.

#### LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood returned to action after a break for semester exams with two games last week, falling on the road at No. 15/21 Georgetown before an 86-74 home win past Southern Virginia ... **JEYLANI DUBLIN** had 11 points and six rebounds at GU, while freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** contributed 10 points and five rebounds ... **TRISTAN CAREY** scored a game-high 25 points against SVU, followed by Kessens with 16 points and a game-high 11 rebounds, freshman **NIK BROWN** with 12 points and freshman **KARL ZIEGLER** had 10 points off the bench ... For the first time this season, the Lancers out-rebounded consecutive opponents with a plus-10 margin against the nationally-ranked Hoyas (36-26) and a plus-15 margin against SVU (43-28) ... Longwood is in the midst of a seven-day, three-game road trip this week to play non-Conference contests at Canisius (Dec. 17), at Seton Hall (Dec. 19) and at VCU (Dec. 21). The Lancers are traveling via charter bus this week and will accumulate more than 1,300 miles and more than 24 hours of "bustime" between Dec. 15-21.

With 39 minutes played at Furman, he moved to the top of the total career minutes at PC ... Mutakabbir was just two points shy of his career-high with 23 points against North Greenville on Dec. 12. He was one of four players in double-figures in the win ... Against North Greenville, RYAN McTAVISH pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds while RYAN HARGRAVE added a career-best 16 points in just his second game of the season after sitting out the first seven games with an injury ... WILLIAM TRUSS scored 15 points against Jacksonville State, just two shy of his career-high ... Asheville trailed at halftime to the 6-1 Bears before rallying for the victory ... **KEITH HORNSBY** scored 21 points against Lenoir-Rhyne and then tallied a career-high 26 points at Ohio State on Saturday. Hornsby shot the ball very well during the week as he went 17-of-25 from the field, 10-of-14 from the 3-point line and 3-of-4 from the free throw line ... Freshman forward **WILL WEEKS** scored a career-best 14 points at Ohio State on Saturday ... The Bulldogs are in the middle of three-game road trip as they'll play at Northeastern on Tuesday and St. John's on Friday.

#### WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop pulled off a 50-49 win at Ohio this past Saturday in a gutsy performance led by sophomore **DERRICK HENRY**'s 14 points while **ANDRE SMITH** and **JOAB JEROME** added 10 points ... Henry was just 5-for-14 from the field and 2-for-5 at the foul line, but hit the biggest shot with 3 seconds remaining when he knocked down a free throw for a 1-point advantage in leading the team to its first NCAA Division I win of the season. It was also the team's first non-Conference road win in exactly a year as they last won an away game on Dec. 15, 2011 at Jacksonville ...
