## CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### JEREMY SEXTON • G Sr. • Charleston Southern Chattanooga, Tenn.

Sexton averaged 24.5 points, 4.0 steals and 3.5 rebounds in leading the Buccaneers to two victories last week. He opened his week with 15 points and a career-high six steals to help rally CSU past UNC Asheville on Jan. 16. Sexton scored 10 points and recorded three steals after the Bulldogs took a 12-point lead in the second half. On Saturday against High Point, Sexton was near perfect with a career-best 34 points on 12-of-13 shooting from the field -- including 8-of-9 from threepoint range. He also grabbed five rebounds and had two steals against the Panthers. For the week, Sexton was 19-of-25 from the field ( =76.0 percent) and 9-of-14 from beyond the arc (=64.3).

## THE CRONS BRAND Freshman of the **W**eek

JEROME HILL • F Fr. • Gardner-Webb Adel, Ga.

Hill, who entered the week averaging 4.5 points and 3.2 rebounds, tallied 10.5 points per game and 7.0 boards last week for the Runnin' Bulldogs. He scored a careerhigh 15 points in GWU's win over Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16 in which he lifted the 'Dogs to a 66-65 win with two put-backs in the final 14.3 seconds. Hill added six points and eight rebounds -- including a careerhigh six offensive boards, in Saturday's one point loss to Radford. For the week, Hill shot 87.5 percent from the field, 70.0 percent from the free throw line and averaged 2.0 steals in the two games.

#### **GIMME FIVE**

Charleston Southern's 5-0 Big South start is its best since opening the 1986-87 League season 10-0 and marks its third-ever 5-0 opening (1985-86). It is the eighth-straight season that a Big South member has opened League play at least 5-0 (10 total in that span), and the Buccaneers are the seventh different team since 2005-06 to begin 5-0.

#### THE IMPORTANCE OF A GOOD START

Charleston Southern is the League's last undefeated team in Big South play at 5-0. Prior to this season, a total of 25 teams started the Big South season 5-0 since 1985-86, and 21 of those squads won or shared the regular-season crown. In addition, nine teams that opened 5-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being UNC Asheville in 2011-12, while another six finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

#### BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS WEEK

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this Saturday with Campbell at Coastal Carolina airing live beginning at 7:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from The HTC Center in Conway, S.C. For the first time, ESPN3 will carry a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games are scheduled Feb. 23 due to BracketBusters). In addition, ESPNU will broadcast the second of two regular-season Big South games on Friday, Feb. 8 with UNC Asheville at VMI.

#### STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI became the third player in Big South history with 1,800 career points and 800 career rebounds when he reached the scoring milestone on Jan. 16 against Campbell. With 1,830 points and 827 boards, Okoye joins former Keydet **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (2,556 points, 820 rebounds) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (2,069, 1,013) in the 1800-800 club. Meanwhile, Okoye is one blocked shot away from 100 in his career, and would become the first player in League annals with 1,800 points, 800 rebounds and 100 blocks. He is also 170 points away from becoming the eighth player with 2,000 career points.

#### HE'S SEXTON AND HE KNOWS IT

Charleston Southern senior guard **JEREMY SEXTON** set a Big South single-game record for highest three-point percentage in a Conference game after going 8-of-9 (=88.9 percent) from beyond the arc this past Saturday against High Point. The record, based on a minimum 7 made 3FG, was previously 77.8 percent. In fact, Charleston Southern now has four of the top five individual single-game three-point field goal percentage in a Big South game following Sexton's performance.

#### **MOUNTAIN RETREAT**

The longest active home win streak in League contests belongs to UNC Asheville at seven. In fact, UNC Asheville is 21-3 (=87.5 percent) since moving into Kimmel Arena in 2011-12, including 10-1 in regular-season Big South games. Following Asheville with the longest active home Big South win streak is Charleston Southern and High Point (five each), Campbell, Coastal Carolina and VMI (three each), and Radford (two).

#### **FIVE AND DIME STORE**

Five players have combined for nine 10-assist games this season, with Charleston Southern's **SAAH NIMLEY** leading the way with three followed by Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** and Presbyterian College's **ERIC WASHINGTON** with two each. Last season, eight Big South players combined for 16 games with at least 10 assists, but just two players had more than one 10-assist performance. The last time the Big South had at least three players with two-plus games with 10 helpers was in 2007-08 (four players).

#### **BIG SOUTH'S ACTIVE 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Coastal Carolina senior **KIERRE GREENWOOD** became the third Big South player this season and 116th in League history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 9 against Presbyterian. He is one of five active players with 1,000 points, while Coastal Carolina is the lone Big South squad with two active 1,000 point scorers this season. #### A GAME OF MARGINS

Following the first 30 Conference games of the season, the home teams are 21-9 (=70.0 percent) -- the highest home winning percentage since before the 2002-03 campaign. Of the 30 games this season, 15 have been decided by double figures by an average of 14.67 points, while the 15 games decided by less than 10 points have been by an average of 5.73. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season thus far is 10.20 points.

#### TRIPLE THREAT

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is nine three-pointers shy of 200 in his career, which would make him the 31st player in Big South history with that total. He would be the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining **JAMARCO WARREN** (337 from 2007-11), **BRETT LARRICK** (234 from 1993-97) and **CHRIS MOORE** (206 from 2004-08).

#### **DOWNTOWN DOWNING**

In his last nine games, Presbyterian College redshirt-sophomore **JORDAN DOWNING** is 29-of-50 from three-point range (=58.0 percent) to bring his season total up to 44-of-101 for a League-leading 43.6 clip. The Davidson transfer was just 15-of-51 from beyond the arc (=29.4) after his first 10 games with the Blue Hose.

#### **STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (249) and Big South victories (147). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 278-303 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 249-252.

#### SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** collected his 150th career win as a collegiate head coach with the Keydets' 76-57 win over Campbell on Jan. 16. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADE-BAUGH** needs two victories for 100 at CSU.

#### FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 675 career field goals and needs 25 to become the sixth player in League annals with 700. Okoye, who reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24, is closing in on 400 career made free throws, as he is 15 away from that milestone. That would make him the 13th player with 400 freebies.

#### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 17 games, dating back to last season. PC's **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** had his streak of 16 consecutive games in double figures snapped Jan. 16 at Winthrop. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is the next closest to White with 14 consecutive games in double digits.

#### **GOING GREEN**

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 16th all-time in Big South history with 440 career assists, and needs eight helpers to move past Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** (447 from 1991-94) for 15th. Greenwood, who became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls, is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest. He is 39th all-time with 628 and needs three to move past Campbell's **SANDERS JACKSON** (630 from 1985-89) for 38th-place.

#### TOPPING OF THE CHARTS

UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** is the national leader in free throw percentage with a 96.6 success rate as he has made 57-of-59 attempts this season. Hornsby is challenging the Big South single-season free throw record of 92.5 percent that was established by Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** in 1993-94. If Hornsby can continue his standing, he would become the first Big South player in history to lead the NCAA in free throw shooting.

#### **CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 107. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 641 Division I wins and is tied for 34th all-time in Division I victories. #### MINUTE-BY-MINUTE

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** became the seventh player on record in Big South history to play at least 4,000 career minutes when he eclipsed the mark during the Jan. 16 Winthrop game. Now with 4,048 in his career, he is 131 away from breaking the all-time mark of 4,178 minutes played established by Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** from 2005-09. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 36.74 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category.

#### **HEIR APPARENTS**

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After 16 games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is at 15.4 per game and Nimley is averaging 14.3 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

#### WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game nine times in their young career (four times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 8-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those nine outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

#### DJC-I

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** has recorded 43 of his 54 blocked shots this season in his last 12 games, an average of 3.58 in that span. He has at least four rejections in five of those contests as well, including a career-high seven against Radford on Jan. 12. The 29th player in Big South history to record 100 career blocked shots, Cunningham now stands 17th in the Conference record books with 141. Meanwhile, with 468 career rebounds, he is on his way to joining the Big South 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members.

#### DJC-II

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON** became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections when he surpassed the milestone with five blocked shots at George Washington on Dec. 22. He is currently tied for 23rd all-time with 122 career rejections and is one away from his second 50-block season. Covington is averaging career-highs this season with 13.4 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.88 blocked shots.

#### **FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

Several underclassmen continue to find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman MICHAEL KESSENS is averaging a Conference-best 9.5 rebounds and has a League-leading eight double-doubles. Radford sophomore R.J. PRICE is the Big South's leader for most three-pointers made per game with 2.88. Campbell sophomore TREY FREEMAN is handing out a League-high 6.00 assists and is tops in assist-to-turnover ratio, while High Point redshirt-freshman JOHN BROWN leads the Conference in 20-point games (tied with 9), offensive rebounds (3.65) and is second in steals (2.24) -- just behind Radford sophomore JAVONTE GREEN (2.37 spg) in that category. Lastly, UNC Asheville sophomore KEITH HORNSBY is first in the League and nation in free throw percentage (96.6).

#### REBOUNDING LESSONS FROM KESSENS

Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is looking to become just the second frosh in Big South history to lead the Conference in rebounding. The first was Big South Hall of Famer and former Campbell standout **JOE SPINKS**, who averaged a League-high 9.4 rebounds in 1990-91. Meanwhile, Kessens could also become just the second freshman to average double-figure rebounds in a season as well should he increase his rebounding total. The first was Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** in 2008-09, who averaged 10.30 that year.

#### **BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,939 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 704 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** was recognized by *CBSSports.com* as the outlet's Midseason Comeback Player of the Year on Jan. 10. #### WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

#### MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

#### AGONY OF DEFEAT

The Big South suffered a total of 43 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games was 5.56 points. UNC Asheville suffered six of its eight non-Conference losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams lost a combined 24 non-League games under 10 points (5.67 average) while the South Division squads dropped 19 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.42 points.

#### **MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS**

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

#### BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

#### **BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

#### TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below

#### TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

- (A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- (B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;
- (C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- (D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- (F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would considered, and so forth until the tie is broken:
- (G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;
- (I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.
- (J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

#### **NORTH DIVISION**

#### **CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS**

Campbell has won six of its last seven games and is one victory under the .500 mark for the first time since Nov. 20 ... The Camels stand 6-3 on the year at Gore Arena and have won the last three on their home floor. CU's three home losses have come by a total of 9 points ... Saturday's attendance of 2,518 for the Winthrop game was the 10th-highest for a men's basketball game since Gore Arena opened in 2008-09 ... DARIUS LEONARD has scored in double figures five times in his last six games and is scoring at an 11.6 clip against Big South foes ... The Camels have won three of their four games since leading scorer DARREN WHITE (21.8 ppg) was sidelined with a knee injury ... Campbell tops the Big South with a 45.6 team field goal percentage overall as well as 47.3 percent in Conference play ... TREY FREEMAN matched his season-high of 24 points in the Winthrop game. He has scored in double-digits in each of CU's first five Big South contests ... ANDREW RYAN hit a season high 12 points vs. Winthrop.

#### HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point's double-overtime win over Liberty last Wednesday was HPU's first since a 70-69 win over Winthrop on Feb. 15, 2011. The Panthers played in four overtime games last season, going 2-2 ... Both ALLAN CHANEY and JOHN BROWN posted double-doubles in the win over Liberty. It was the first time since a Jan. 15, 2011 loss to VMI that two HPU players had double-doubles in the same game (COREY LAW, DU'VAUGHN MAXWELL) ... Chaney posted back-to-back 20+ point games for the first time in his career and led High Point in scoring in both games last week. He shot 16-of-17 from the free throw line and is now shooting 89.4 percent on the season, which ranks 19th in the nation ... Freshman ADAM WEARY posted career-highs of 19 points and three 3-pointers at Charleston Southern on Saturday.

#### LIBERTY FLAMES

Against High Point, **TAVARES SPEAKS** posted a career-high 20 points ... Liberty's double overtime tilt against the Panthers was its first since Feb. 4, 2009, when the Flames fell at Gardner-Webb, 95-90 ... The HPU contest also marked Liberty's first overtime game of the 2012-13 season and first since Jan. 14, 2012 against Winthrop ... **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** surpassed 700 points for his Liberty career this past Saturday and now has 704 tallies.

#### LONGWOOD LANCERS

**TRISTAN CAREY** led the Lancers at Radford last week with 23 points, making 5-of-10 three-pointers with five rebounds and three steals, while freshman **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** added career highs of 12 points and 10 assists, the latter a gamehigh, for his first collegiate double-double ... **DAVID ROBINSON** scored a game-high 20 points at Asheville, including 4-of-6 three-pointers while **MICHAEL KESSENS** added 16 points and a game-high 11 rebounds for his eighth double-double. Woodhouse had a career-high and game-high 11 assists -- giving him 21 assists in two games last week.

#### RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford won back-to-back Big South games for the first time since the 2009-10 season, and the Highlanders are over .500 in Big South games for the first time since that same year ... **R.J. PRICE** scored a career-high 30 points vs. Longwood last week and had the game-winning 3-pointer at Gardner-Webb on Saturday. He is the first Highlander in three seasons to reach the 30-point plateau in a game.

#### **VMI KEYDETS**

VMI had its five-game win streak snapped with a 72-49 loss to Coastal Carolina Saturday. It was VMI's longest winning streak since the 2010-11 season when VMI started 5-0 on the campaign. The 4-0 Big South Conference start was VMI's best since 2008-09 when the Keydets reeled off a 6-0 start ... VMI is 7-1 at home this season and have won 20 of their last 23 at Cameron Hall over the last two years ... **STAN OKOYE** is 95 points out of fourth-place on the school's all-time scoring charts ... Okoye moved past REGGIE WILLIAMS (2005-08) in career rebounding at VMI and is in fourth with 827 boards ... VMI held Campbell to 10-of-30 shooting in the second half (33.3%) last Wednesday, which was the second-best half defensively against a Division I opponent this year ... VMI has used the same starting lineup --Okoye, RODNEY GLASGOW, BRIAN BROWN, D.J. COVINGTON, NICK GORE -- in all 17 games this season. That marks the first time since 2008-09 that the Keydets had used the same starting lineup for more than 12 games to start the year and it also makes VMI the only team in the Big South to have a single starting lineup this season ... VMI went three consecutive games during its win streak posting less than 10 turnovers. It was the first time VMI had done that since Jan. 26-Feb. 2, 2010 ... VMI's 49 points at Coastal Carolina was just the fourth time in **DUGGAR BAUCOM**'s eight years that the Keydets were held below 50 points in a game.

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

The Bucs continued their red-hot two months with a 2-0 week, picking up home wins over UNC Asheville, 74-68, on Wednesday night, and knocking off High Point, 83-75 on Saturday night. As a team, CSU went 13-of-25 from three-point range after making 11 in the previous two contests combined ... The Bucs rallied from a 12-point second half deficit to defeat UNC Asheville on Wednesday night. **SAAH NIMLEY** had a career-high 11 rebounds as CSU put together an 11-3 run in the final five minutes to surge to the win ... The Bucs are off to their best start in Big South play under **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** at 5-0 ... CSU is now 10-2 at the Buc Dome in Big South games the last two seasons.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chanticleers went 1-1 last week after falling on a last second shot at Gardner-Webb and winning 72-49 at home over VMI on ESPNU ... Coastal was led by **AN-THONY RAFFA**, who averaged 23.0 points per game along with 3.5 rebounds. He shot 58.1 percent from the field and 40.0 percent from 3-point range ... **EL HADJI NDIEGUENE** averaged 7.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in the two games as well ... Coastal trailed almost the entire game at GWU but took the lead in the final minute before a late tip-in by the Runnin' Bulldogs gave GWU the one-point victory ... CCU's defense showed up at home against VMI as the Chants held the Keydets well below their 80+ points per game average and held them to their lowest point output since 2008 ... The Chants return to action this week as they travel to UNC Asheville on Wednesday and host Campbell on Saturday for an ESPN3 broadcast.

#### GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb went 1-1 in two buzzer-beating games at home last week. The Runnin' Bulldogs defeated Coastal Carolina on a last-second lay-in from **JEROME HILL** and dropped a game to Radford on a 3-pointer as time expired ... GWU missed an improbable 20 of its first 21 field goal attempts in the first half vs. Radford, and finished at just 8.9 percent for the half (2-of-23) -- its lowest field goal shooting percentage of the season for 20 minutes ... **KEVIN HARTLEY** has made a sizzling 18 of his last 25 three-point attempts (72 percent), and is shooting at an even 50 percent on the season.

#### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The Blue Hose earned their first Conference win of the season with the 68-60 decision against Liberty. Not only did KHALID MUTAKABBIR record a career-high 26 points in the win, JOSHUA CLYBURN posted his first career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds. He has now hit 45-straight free throws, a school record and the longest streak of its kind in the country. Hornsby now leads the nation in free throw percentage at 96.6 (57-of-59) ... **JEREMY AT-KINSON** enjoyed his third double-double of the year in a victory over Longwood with 17 points and 11 rebounds. The victory was Asheville's 10th-straight against a Big South Conference opponent at home ... The Bulldogs stay at home this week with key games against Coastal Carolina on Wednesday night and High Point on Saturday in Kimmel Arena.

#### WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop avoided its first 0-4 start in League play since 1997-98 with a win over PC on Wednesday. The Eagles were led by GIDEON GAMBLE's 12 points as he scored in double-figures for the fourth-straight game, having led the team in scoring all four times. In the next game, he was held to just three points in the loss at Campbell. Despite that, Gamble is averaging 11.6 points and 4.6 rebounds while shooting 43 percent from the field and 59 percent from three (10-for-17) in five League games ... CHRISTIAN FARMER returned from injury last week after missing five games. He scored eight points in 11 minutes at Campbell in his second game back ... Winthrop has now lost its last five road games in Conference play and six of the last seven ... JOAB JEROME tied his career-best 16 points at Campbell and has 23 of his team-high 40 assists in the last five games (4.6 average).
