TREASURE ISLAND

Charleston Southern scored 101 points in each of its past two games, first against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 1 and then three days later against The Citadel on Dec. 4. It was the first time the Buccaneers tallied back-to-back 100-point games since 1987-88 when they did it against Maryland-Eastern Shore (102) and Claflin (101).

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

Through the first five weeks of the 2012-13 season, several underclassmen continue to find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is averaging a Conference-best 11.4 rebounds and leads the Big South with a 58.0 field goal percentage. Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is the Big South's top stealer with 2.60 per game. Campbell sophomore **TREY FREEMAN** is handing out a League-high 6.33 assists, while Kessens leads the Conference in both offensive rebounds (4.38) and defensive boards (7.00) per game.

REBOUNDING LESSONS FROM KESSENS

Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is looking to become just the second frosh in Big South history to average double-figure rebounds in a season. The first was Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** in 2008-09, who averaged 10.30 that year. Kessen's average of 11.38 rebounds per game is currently the third-highest clip in a season, and if he can maintain his top spot, he would be just the second freshman to lead the Big South in rebounding. Big South Hall of Famer and former Campbell standout **JOE SPINKS** was the first with his average of 9.4 rebounds in 1990-91.

SEXTON JOINS BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** became the 115th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone against The Citadel on Dec. 4. Coastal Carolina senior **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 77 points away from 1,000 in his career. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is now the seventh player in Big South history with 1,600 career points and 700 rebounds after eclipsing the 1,600 career point mark vs. Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye is four blocked shots away from 100 in his career, and is looking to become just the fourth player in League annals with 1,600 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocks.

BOARD REPORT

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** became the 24th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 15 at Virginia Tech. He is now 13th all-time with 763 and is 21 away from moving past Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (783 from 2008-10) for 12th-place. Okoye is also 37 caroms away from becoming the 11th player in League history with 800 career rebounds. He is the second VMI player with at least 700 career rebounds in the Big South, as former Keydet and current Charlotte Bobcat **REGGIE WILLIAMS** grabbed 820 boards from 2004-08.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is averaging 3.00 steals in his last six games and a League-leading 2.60 steals overall, the highest average in the Big South since the 2008-09 campaign when VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** led the Conference with 3.4. Meanwhile, Green is currently the Big South's second-leading field goal shooter at 55.8 percent, and could become the Conference's second player to lead the League in both steals and field goal percentage. The first (and only) to do so was Charleston Southern's **EDER AMBROISE** in 1987-88. That season, he was tops with a 63.3 field goal clip and 2.1 steals per game.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He is now one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 635 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 101.

GOING GREEN

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** needs five assists to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career helpers. He would be the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (242) and Big South victories (144). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 271-298 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 242-247.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is five wins away from 150 in his career as a collegiate head coach, while Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** needs nine victories for 100 at CSU.

HEIR APPARENTS?

With the graduation of UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM**, Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have begun to replace the departed Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After eight games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is at 16.3 per game and Nimley is averaging 14.3 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game eight times in their young career (three times this season -- all consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 7-1 in those games. The duo have surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those eight outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

TAKE COVER

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON** is one blocked shot away from becoming the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections. Covington, who was hampered by injuries most of last season, is averaging 14.4 points, 6.2 rebounds, a League-high 2.60 blocks per game and is making 54.9 percent from the field. He has two 20-point, 10-rebound games this year among his three double-doubles. Through 10 games this season, Covington has logged 250 minutes with 144 points, 62 rebounds and 26 blocked shots. In 2011-12, Covington was limited to 362 minutes in his 24 appearances. He scored 121 points a season ago (5.0 average) with 64 rebounds (2.7) and 16 blocks.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,805 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 570 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

MINUTE-BY-MINUTE

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** has played 3,652 minutes in his career, and is 527 away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader. He is 348 away from logging 4,000, which would make him the seventh player on record with that total. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 37.75 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category. The Big South's all-time minutes played leader is Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH**, who played 4,178 minutes from 2005-09.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest. He is 41st all-time with 605 and needs 10 to move past Radford's **DON BURGESS** (614 from 1990-94) for 40th-place. With a career 7.1 per game average, Law will likely surpass 700 career boards by seasons end.

AGONY OF DEFEAT

The Big South has suffered a total of 29 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games is 5.24 points. UNC Asheville has suffered five of its six losses by eight points-or-less -- including the last three losses by an average of 3.0 points. Radford is next with four losses by single-digits. The North Division teams have lost a combined 16 games under 10 points (5.63 average) while the South Division squads have dropped 13 games by single-digits by an average of 4.77 points.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Just two players have scored in double figures in every game thus far -- UNC Asheville's **JEREMY ATKINSON** (8) and Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** (7). Atkinson owns the longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 16 games, dating back to last season, just ahead of White's 13-game streak.

MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

CUNNINGHAM HARDWARE

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the 29th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 29 against USC Upstate. Cunningham stands at 101 blocks and with 411 career rebounds, and is on his way to joining the Big South 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members.

FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is 16th all-time in Big South history with 625 career field goals. He reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye needs four to surpass Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** (628 from 1990-95) for 15th-place and is 22 buckets away from entering the Big South's career Top 10. Meanwhile, Okoye is 66 points shy of becoming the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 15 in both scoring and rebounding. The other two are VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 8th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

BIG SOUTH TAKES DOWN MEMBER FROM BIG EAST

For the second consecutive season, a Big South member has defeated a member from the Big East Conference on the hardwood. Gardner-Webb knocked off its first Big East team on Nov. 15, as the Runnin' Bulldogs downed DePaul on its home court. GWU led from start to finish in the 71-59 victory. Last season, Presbyterian College had the Big South's win over a Big East member with its 56-54 win at Cincinnati. The Big South has now defeated a Big East program five out of the last nine seasons.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

After a week-long break for final exams, Campbell returns to action Wednesday night at Gore Arena vs. NAIA member Rio Grande. The Camels are 11-0 all-time vs. non-Division I schools under the guidance of 10th-year head coach **ROBBIE LAING** ... The Big South's leading scorer (11th in the nation) **DARREN WHITE** has missed the last two games with an injured hand ... Campbell suffered a 61-58 loss to NEC power Robert Morris last Tuesday in its only game of the week. Without White in the lineup, **MARVELLE HARRIS** scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the season (3rd of his career). The Camels shot 52% from the floor and finished with a 34-24 edge on the glass, but surrendered 22 points off 20 turnovers.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

Redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** notched his first collegiate double-double with 27 points and 10 rebounds at Wake Forest last Wednesday. He also had an alley-oop dunk that was featured as ESPN SportsCenter's No. 3 play. He's the second Panther ever to be on ESPN SportsCenter's Top 10 Plays twice in the same season, following **SHAY SHINE** in 2009-10 ... Brown was ranked the No. 21 freshman in the nation in an ESPN.com Insider article on Dec. 6 ... **JAIRUS SIMMS** is averaging 4.3 assists, the highest total for any Panther since **DAVID SINGLETON** averaged 4.8 in 2008-09. Simms has a Big South-best 2.6 assist-to-turnover ratio ... High Point is averaging 5.5 blocks per game this season. Since moving up to Division I in 1999-00, HPU's highest block average was 4.4 in 2008-09. The Panthers averaged 2.8 last year. Brown is leading the team with 2.4 blocks per game ... High Point hosts Western Michigan on Sunday to complete the teams' in-season home-and-home series. It's the first non-Conference home-and-home for High Point since playing both Savannah State and Longwood twice each in 2007-08.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty defeated Southern Virginia on Dec. 4 to end an eight-game losing skid. Prior to the victory, the Flames had started the season 0-8 for the first time in school history ... Liberty was also 0-3 inside the Vines Center for the first time in the facility's history. Before the win, Liberty had not started 0-3 at home since the 1988-89 season, its first year in Division I ... After posting a season-high 25 points against Georgia State, leading scorer **DAVON MARSHALL** went scoreless against Southern Virginia, but had a season-high eight assists. **ANDREW SMITH** had a career-high 10 points in the contest, while **SOMMY OGUKWE** chipped in a career-high seven points and nine rebounds.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood was idle last week for semester exams ... The Lancers play two games this week, beginning on Monday night at nationally-ranked Georgetown. The game will be televised on MASN/ESPN3 ... Freshman standout **MICHAEL KESSENS** leads the Big South in field goal percentage (58.0), rebounding (11.4), offensive rebounds (4.4), defensive rebounds (7.0) and double-doubles (5); ranks third in blocks (2.1), seventh in free throw percentage (77.4), 14th in steals (1.6) and tied for 15th in scoring (13.0) ... Four different Lancers have scored at least 20 points in a game this season, and a fifth player has a 19-point game.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford is off this week for final exams ... The Highlanders are one win away from matching all of last season's victory total (6).

VMI KEYDETS

Freshman guard **TIM MARSHALL** matched a career-high 11 points against Wright State Saturday night. Marshall had hit the 11-point mark two weeks before against West Virginia on Nov. 28 ... **STAN OKOYE** had his nine-game double-figures streak stopped Saturday night at Wright State. Okoye, who entered the game averaging 20.7 points, was held to seven points by the Raiders, his fewest since a 7-point game against Asheville in the 2012 Big South Championship game ... The Keydets set or equaled 18 team or individual season highs in the 102-61 win against Virginia University of Lynchburg last Monday night ... VMI will not play for a two-week period as its next game is scheduled for Dec. 22 at George Washington. VMI has just four games in the month of December this season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

Charleston Southern improved to 3-5 on the year with a 101-73 win over The Citadel last Tuesday night. The game was the Bucs' final game before a two-week break for exams. GWU held Tech to 29.2 percent shooting for the game (14-48). It marked the fifth time this season that Gardner-Webb has held an opponent to less than 20 field goals in a game ... Freshman forward **JEROME HILL** was credited with an eye-popping five (5) drawn charges against Tennessee Tech ... **TASHAN NEWSOME** averaged a strong 18.3 points per game in three games last week, including a season-high 27 against the Golden Eagles. He had 18 in a win over UVA-Wise on Monday and a team-high 10 in a loss at Wofford on Wednesday ... GWU will break for exams before hosting The Citadel on Saturday at 7:00 pm.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

KHALID MUTAKABBIR needs 318 points, 98 three-pointers, 93 assists and eight more games started to move into PC's Division I career record books in each of those categories. With 39 minutes played at Furman, he moved to the top of the total career minutes at PC ... **JOSHUA CLYBURN** became the third PC player to score more than 20 points in a game this season. **JORDAN DOWNING** posted 25 at Clemson, while Mutakabbir added 20 against Toccoa Falls. Clyburn and Downing's 20+ points were career firsts.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville ended its six-game losing streak with an 85-51 victory over Montreat Saturday afternoon. **JEREMY ATKINSON** had 22 points, seven rebounds and six assists in the victory, and was 10-of-11 from the free throw line. **TRENT MEYER** made a career-best six 3-pointers in the win, including a perfect 5-for-5 from long range in the second half. Meyer also collected a career-best eight rebounds. **SAM HUGHES** came off the bench to score a career-high 12 rebounds plus collect five rebounds ... Asheville out-rebounded the smaller Cavaliers on Saturday, 54-27. The Bulldogs had eight different players grab at least five rebounds in the victory ...
