White averaged 23.7 points, 8.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals in three games last week. He opened his week with a double-double with 15 points and 12 rebounds against Northwestern State, and added five assists. White then scored a career-high 36 points on 15-of-19 shooting to lead the Camels past Appalachian State. He scored 28 points in the second half and added four rebounds in the contest. White led Campbell with 20 points Sunday at Iowa State and contributed six boards against the Cyclones. For the week, he was 28-of-58 from the field (=48.3 percent) and 14-of-16 from the free throw line (=87.5).

### BIG SOUTH TAKES DOWN MEMBER FROM BIG EAST

For the second consecutive season, a Big South member has defeated a member from the Big East Conference on the hardwood. Gardner-Webb knocked off its first Big East team last week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs downed DePaul on its home court on Nov. 15. GWU led from start to finish in the 71-59 victory. Last season, Presbyterian College had the Big South's win over a Big East member with its 56-54 win at Cincinnati. The Big South has now defeated a Big East program five out of the last nine seasons.

### BOARD REPORT

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** became the 24th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 15 at Virginia Tech. He is now tied for 22nd all-time with 702 in his career, and needs five to move into 19th on the Conference's career list. Okoye is the second VMI player with 700 career rebounds in the Big South, as former Keydet and current Charlotte Bobcat **REGGIE WILLIAMS** grabbed 820 boards from 2004-08.

### CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He is now one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 634 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 100.

### GOING GREEN

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** needs 23 assists to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists. He would be the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

### STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (241) and Big South victories (144). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 270-297 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 241-246.

### STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is now the eighth player in Big South history with 1,500 career points and 700 rebounds after eclipsing 700 career boards at Virginia Tech on Nov. 15. He is on his way to becoming the seventh player with 1,600 points and 700 rebounds as well. Okoye also needs nine blocked shots for 100 in his career, and is looking to become just the fourth player in League annals with 1,500 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocks.

### BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **ANTHONY RAFFA** is 14 points away from 1,000 in his Coastal Carolina career, which would make him the 114th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points. Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is 32 points away from 1,000 in his career. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

### HEIR APPARENTS?

With the graduation of UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM**, Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the departed Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After three games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is averaging 13.0 points and Nimley is at 12.7 per game. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

### WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game five times in their young career, and the Buccaneers are 5-0 in those games.

**FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

Through the first two weeks of the 2012-13 season, several underclassmen find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is averaging a Conference-best 10.3 rebounds, while Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is the top field goal shooter at 60.4 percent. Campbell sophomore **TREY FREEMAN** is handing out a League-high 6.25 assists, while Charleston Southern freshman **MALCOLM BERNARD** leads the Big South with a perfect free throw clip (10-of-10). Lastly, High Point freshman **JOHN BROWN**'s 2.67 blocked shots per game leads the League.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,750 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 515. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

**MINUTE MAN**

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** has played 3,466 minutes in his career, and is 713 away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader. He is 534 away from logging 4,000, which would make him the seventh player on record with that total. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 38.7 minutes played per game this year is slightly below his previous high of 38.9 as a sophomore in 2010-11. The Big South's all-time minutes played leader is Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH**, who played 4,178 minutes from 2005-09.

**BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

**A BIGGER BIG SOUTH IN 2012-13**

The Big South Conference has an all-time high 12 member institutions in 2012-13 with the addition of Longwood University as a full member. The expansion allowed the Conference to create two six-team divisions in men's basketball for the first time in League history. The North Division is comprised of **Campbell, High Point, Liberty, Longwood, Radford** and **VMI**, while the South Division consists of **Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, UNC Asheville** and **Winthrop**. Each team will play a 16-game Conference season with 10 intra-division contests and six crossover games. In addition, the format for the Conference Tournament now includes all 12 programs, with the top two teams in each division receiving byes into the quarterfinals.

**MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS**

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

**BIG BURRUS**

Liberty senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is looking to join the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members. Burrus has tallied 104 rejections in his career -- tied for 27th in League annals, and has 452 career rebounds to his credit. He would become just the second Liberty player on the list, joining Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT**

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** entered the 2012-13 season needing 25 rebounds to become the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds. With a career 7.1 per game average, Law will likely surpass 700 career boards by seasons end.

## NORTH DIVISION

## CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

**DARREN WHITE's** 36 points against Appalachian State was the third-highest single-game total in Campbell's Division I era (since '77-78). It also was a Gore Arena record. He had 28 points in the 2nd half alone (12-of-15 FG) and added 7 rebounds ... **ANDREW RYAN** has played 94 minutes this season without a turnover and leads the League in assists (12) to turnover (0) ratio (1.000). **TREY FREEMAN** is second to Ryan in A-T-O ratio (3.57) and tops the circuit with 6.25 assists per game ... **DAR- IAN HOOKER** has scored in double digits in all four games, including a season-high 17 vs. Appalachian State ... The Camels play at No. 20/22 Cincinnati this week, marking the first time the team has faced a Big East Conference member since 1980 (Providence).

## HIGH POINT PANTHERS

HPU's 22-point win over Appalachian State was the team's largest margin of victory in a road win since High Point joined NCAA Division I in 1999-00. The previous best was 21 in a 70-49 win over Savannah State on Feb. 6, 2007 ... HPU started 2-0 for the first time since 2002-03. High Point's 2-1 start against Division I opponents is its best since 2005-06, when HPU also went 2-1 ... **ALLAN CHANEY** went 8-for-8 from the free-throw line against William & Mary on Saturday, making him the 12th player in HPU's Division I era to shoot 100 percent when attempting at least eight free throws ... Through three games, HPU is averaging 4.7 blocks. Last season HPU averaged 2.8 blocks. The Panthers have averaged more than four blocks per game twice in its Division I era: 2008-09 (4.4) and 2009-10 (4.2).

## LIBERTY FLAMES

**CASEY ROBERTS** is providing the Flames with fire power off the bench. Against Georgetown, he led Liberty with 13 points. Prior to that performance, he posted 11 tallies against William & Mary ... Last season, Liberty averaged nearly four three-point field goals per game. This year, the Flames are knocking down just under seven treys per contest. **DAVON MARSHALL** is pacing the Flames from the perimeter with eight three-pointers ... At Georgetown, **JR CORONADO** finished with a game-high 13 rebounds ... Liberty's 10 three-point field goals against Georgetown were the most since posting the same total at Coastal Carolina on Jan. 8, 2011.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood dropped two games last week, including a 78-66 setback at home to defending MEAC Tournament Champion Norfolk State on Nov. 15, before a 112-63 road loss at Arkansas on Nov. 18 ... Against the Spartans, freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** with game highs of 17 points and 15 rebounds for his first career double-double. **TRISTAN CAREY** had 13 points, seven rebounds and five assists, while **DAVID ROBINSON** and freshman **NIK BROWN** each contributed 10 points, with Brown adding five assists ... Kessens posted his second consecutive double-double of 17 points and a game-high 11 rebounds at Arkansas, adding three steals and two blocks.

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

RU won its 10th-straight home opener with its victory over Cincinnati Christian ... **JAVONTE GREEN** scored a career-high 28 points at Eastern Kentucky and was named to the Comfort Suites Invitational All-Tournament team. Green averaged 17.0 points, 7.8 rebounds, 2.8 steals and shot 60.0 percent (27-of-45) in four games last week.

## VMI KEYDETS

**D.J. COVINGTON** averaged 21.5 points and 6.5 rebounds with four blocks in two games last week. He also shot 52.9 percent from the floor and was 7-of-9 in free throws ... Against Central Penn, Covington picked up his first double-double since January 16, 2012 (at Winthrop) with 20 points and 13 rebounds. Covington's 20 points, 17 of which came in the second half, matched his then-career high set in February 2011. The junior forward also tied his career-high with 13 rebounds, five of which came on the offensive glass, and also blocked five shots ...
