#### STAN OKOYE • F Sr. • VMI Raleigh, N.C.

Okoye averaged 22.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in leading the Keydets to two Big South wins last week. He posted 20 points, 10 rebounds, three assists, one block and one steal in VMI's victory over Liberty on Jan. 9. Okoye then tallied 25 points, 13 boards and three assists in the Keydets' win over Winthrop to give VMI its first 3-0 Big South start since 2008-09. For the week, Okoye was 15-of-34 from the field and 11-of-14 from the free throw line.

Weeks scored a career-high 27 points -- his first career 20-point game, and set a UNC Asheville single-game record for field goal percentage last Wednesday, as he was 11-of-12 ( =91.7 percent) from the field at Gardner-Webb. He also recorded eight rebounds in the contest. In Asheville's home win over Radford on Saturday, Weeks contributed seven points, three rebounds and three steals. Weeks finished the two games 12-of-15 from the floor (=80.0 percent) with 10 free throws and averaged 5.5 rebounds.

#### 3-0 STARTS

For the second consecutive season and third time overall, at least three Big South teams have started Conference play 3-0 in the same season. Preseason favorites Campbell (North Division) and Charleston Southern (South Division) are each 3-0 for the second-straight year, while VMI is 3-0 for the first time since 2008-09 and second time overall as Big South members. The last time Campbell started 4-0 in the Big South was in 1993-94; the Bucs' last 4-0 start was in 1986-87 (10-0); VMI started 6-0 in 2008-09.

#### WHAT DOES A 3-0 START MEAN EXACTLY?

Starting 3-0 in League action has proven to be a key indicator of a successful Conference season. The last time VMI started 3-0 in 2008-09, the Keydets reached the title game of the Big South Championship. Charleston Southern's 3-0 start last season earmarked the Buccaneers into the Conference Semifinals for the first time since 2005-06. Campbell earned a first round bye in last year's Big South Tournament after starting 3-0 in its first season back in the Big South. Of the Conference's 27 previous League champions, 11 started the Big South season 3-0 while 22 claimed the regular-season crown.

#### **DIVIDE AND CONQUER**

After 12 crossover divisional games, the North Division squads are a combined 7-5 against the South Division, including 3-1 on the road. Campbell, High Point and VMI are 2-0 against South teams, while Charleston Southern and UNC Asheville are 2-0 against North opponents.

#### **U-2**

The Big South Conference will have its first regular-season appearance on ESPNU this Saturday, as the network will televise the VMI at Coastal Carolina game live from The HTC Center at 11:00am. **ADAM AMIN** (play-by-play) and former Chanticleer women's basketball standout **BROOKE WEISBROD** (analyst) have the call from Conway, S.C. It will be the first of two regular-season Big South games on ESPNU this season, with UNC Asheville at VMI on Feb. 8 being the second.

#### BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS WEEK

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this Saturday with Winthrop at Campbell airing live beginning at 1:00pm. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from Gore Arena in Buies Creek, N.C. For the first time, ESPN3 will carry a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games are scheduled Feb. 23 due to BracketBusters).

### GREENWOOD JOINS BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina senior **KIERRE GREENWOOD** became the third Big South player this season and 116th in League history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 9 against Presbyterian. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers:

#### STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is three points away from becoming just the fourth player in Big South history with 1,800 career points and 800 rebounds. He became the 11th player with 800 rebounds when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday against Winthrop, and is currently 11th all-time with 810. Okoye is two blocked shots away from 100 in his career, and would become the first player in League annals with 1,800 points, 800 rebounds and 100 blocks. He is also 203 points away from becoming the eighth player with 2,000 career points.

#### **MOUNTAIN RETREAT**

The longest active home win streak in League contests belongs to UNC Asheville at six, and the Bulldogs will go for number seven this Saturday against Longwood. In fact, UNC Asheville is 20-3 (=87.0 percent) since moving into Kimmel Arena in 2011-12, including 9-1 in regular-season Big South games.

#### A GAME OF MARGINS

Following the first 18 Conference games of the season, the visiting teams are 8-10 ( =44.4 percent). Last season, the visiting teams won 40.4 percent of the Big South schedule. Of the 18 games this season, 11 have been decided by double figures by an average of 14.27 points, while the seven games decided by less than 10 points have been by an average of 7.14. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season thus far is 11.50 points.

#### CBSSPORTS.COM HONORS HIGH POINT'S ALLAN CHANEY

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** was recognized by *CBSSports.com* as the outlet's Midseason Comeback Player of the Year on Jan. 10. Chaney overcame a heart ailment and is averaging 13.4 points and 7.9 rebounds this season for the Panthers.

#### TRIPLE THREAT

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is 18 three-pointers shy of 200 in his career, which would make him the 31st player in Big South history with that total. He would be the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining **JAMARCO WARREN** (337 from 2007-11), **BRETT LARRICK** (234 from 1993-97) and **CHRIS MOORE** (2006 from 2004-08).

#### **CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 106. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 640 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories.

#### STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (248) and Big South victories (146). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 277-302 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldoos' leader is 248-251.

#### SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is one win away from 150 in his career as a collegiate head coach, while Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** needs four victories for 100 at CSU.

#### FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 665 career field goals and needs 35 to become the sixth player in League annals with 700. Okoye, who reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24, is now the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 12 in both scoring and rebounding, as he is 12th with 1,797 career points and 11th with 810 rebounds. He joins VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 8th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

#### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 17 games, dating back to last season. PC's **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** is next with 16 consecutive games in double figures.

#### CAMPBELL'S FREEMAN NAMED A COUSY AWARD CANDIDATE

Campbell sophomore point guard **TREY FREEMAN** was named among the initial candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Dec. 20. The Watch List will be narrowed down to 20 in January, the final 10 in February and the final five in March. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be announced at the Final Four in April.

#### **GOING GREEN**

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 16th all-time in Big South history with 432 career assists, and needs 16 helpers to move past Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** (447 from 1991-94) for 15th. Greenwood, who became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls, is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

#### **CUNNINGHAM HARDWARE**

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** has recorded 38 of his 49 blocked shots this season in his last 10 games, an average of 3.80 in that span. He has at least four rejections in five of those contests as well, including a career-high seven against Radford this past Saturday. The 29th player in Big South history to record 100 career blocked shots, Cunningham now stands 19th in the Conference record books with 136. Meanwhile, with 459 career rebounds, he is on his way to joining the Big South 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members.

#### **BIG BROWN**

In his last eight games, High Point redshirt-freshman forward **JOHN BROWN** is averaging 20.3 points, 7.8 rebounds, 2.6 steals and 1.1 blocked shots. In addition, he has grabbed 34 of his 62 total rebounds in this span on the offensive side. Brown has recorded six of his League-leading nine 20-point games during this same timeframe.

#### DOWNTOWN DOWNING

In his last seven games, Presbyterian College redshirt-sophomore **JORDAN DOWNING** is 23-of-41 from three-point range (=56.1 percent) to bring his season total up to 38-of-92 for a 41.3 clip. The Davidson transfer was just 15-of-51 from beyond the arc (=29.4) after his first 10 games with the Blue Hose.

#### HEIR APPARENTS

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of SAAH NIMLEY and ARLON HARPER have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of MATT DICKEY and J.P. PRIMM as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After 14 games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is at 15.6 per game and Nimley is averaging 14.9 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

#### WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards SAAH NIMLEY and ARLON HARPER have scored 15 points in the same game nine times in their young career (four times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 8-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those nine outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

#### **TAKE COVER**

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON** became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections when he surpassed the milestone with five blocked shots at George Washington on Dec. 22. Covington, who was hampered by injuries most of last season, is averaging 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, 2.87 blocks per game and is making a League-leading 54.7 percent from the field in 2012-13. He has two 20-point, 10-rebound games this year among his three double-doubles. Through 15 games this season, Covington has logged 399 minutes with 207 points, 94 rebounds and 43 blocked shots. In 2011-12, Covington was limited to 362 minutes in his 24 appearances. He scored 121 points a season ago (5.0 average) with 64 rebounds (2.7) and 16 blocks.

#### MINUTE-BY-MINUTE

Presbyterian College senior KHALID MUTAKABBIR has played 3,973 minutes in his career, and is 206 away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader. He is 27 away from logging 4,000, which would make him the seventh player on record with that total. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 36.65 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category. The Big South's all-time minutes played leader is Liberty's ANTHONY SMITH, who played 4,178 minutes from 2005-09.

#### **FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

Several underclassmen continue to find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman MICHAEL KESSENS is averaging a Conference-best 9.5 rebounds and has a League-leading seven double-doubles. Radford sophomore R.J. PRICE is the Big South's leader for most three-pointers made per game with 2.87. Campbell sophomore TREY FREEMAN is handing out a League-high 6.24 assists and is tops in assist-to-turnover ratio, while High Point redshirt-freshman JOHN BROWN leads the Conference in 20-point games (9), offensive rebounds (3.60) and steals (2.40). Lastly, UNC Asheville sophomore KEITH HORNSBY is first in the League in free throw percentage (95.7).

#### REBOUNDING LESSONS FROM KESSENS

Longwood freshman MICHAEL KESSENS is looking to become just the second frosh in Big South history to lead the Conference in rebounding. The first was Big South Hall of Famer and former Campbell standout JOE SPINKS, who averaged a League-high 9.4 rebounds in 1990-91. Meanwhile, Kessens could also become just the second freshman to average double-figure rebounds in a season as well. The first was Gardner-Webb's JOSHUA HENLEY in 2008-09, who averaged 10.30 that year.

#### **BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior JOHN CALEB SANDERS and his brother and former teammate JESSE have combined to score 1,914 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 679 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

#### WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

#### MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

#### **AGONY OF DEFEAT**

The Big South suffered a total of 43 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games was 5.56 points. UNC Asheville suffered six of its eight non-Conference losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams lost a combined 24 non-League games under 10 points (5.67 average) while the South Division squads dropped 19 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.42 points.

#### WHERE THEY RANK?

As mentioned previously, UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 248 career victories. VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is seventh in League history with 112 career wins, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is 10th with 106 career victories. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is four wins away from becoming the 11th Big South head coach with 100 overall wins.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest. He is 40th all-time with 623 and needs five to move past Augusta's **KEENAN MANN** (627 from 1988-91) for 39th-place.

#### **MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS**

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

#### BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

#### **BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

#### TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament.

Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below

#### TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

- (A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- (B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;
- (C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- (D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- (F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;
- (G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;
- (I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.
- (J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

#### **NORTH DIVISION**

#### CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell has won its last five games, the team's longest win streak since opening the 2011-12 season with 5-straight victories ... After losing its first four road games of the season, CU has won its last three ... **DARIUS LEONARD** is averaging 13.7 points, 7.3 rebounds and shooting 63% from the floor in Big South games ... **MARVELLE HARRIS** moved into 10th place on Campbell's Division I rebounding list this past Saturday, as he has 462 career boards ... **TREY FREEMAN** scored 17 of his team-leading 19 points in the 2nd half of Wednesday's win at Longwood. He matched his career highs with 10 assists and 4 steals, while grabbing a season-best 7 rebounds. Freeman current ranks 21st in the nation with 6.2 assists.

#### HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point started 2-1 in Big South play for the fifth time in 14 seasons in the League, and the third time in head coach SCOTT CHERRY's four seasons ... Redshirt-freshman JOHN BROWN is the nation's No. 2 freshman scorer at 18.4 points per game. He ranks behind only UNLV's ANTHONY BENNETT (19.6 ppg) ... Brown's 22 points at Radford on Wednesday marked his ninth 20-plus point game of the season. He is on pace to become just the second freshman to lead HPU in scoring in the Division I era ... Freshman ADAM WEARY scored in double-digits for the ninth time this season in HPU's win over Gardner-Webb on Saturday. Weary shot 75 percent (6-for-8) from the field, his best shooting percentage of the season.

#### LIBERTY FLAMES

TOMASZ GIELO finished with a career-high night in points for the second straight game, pacing the Flames with 19 tallies in the win over Coastal Carolina. The Flames now lead the all-time series with Coastal, 27-23, and have won the last two meetings ... The Liberty defense held CCU leading scorer ANTHONY RAFFA to eight points after the senior went scoreless in the first half. Liberty concluded the night with its third-highest field goal percentage of the season, shooting 47.6 percent (20-of-42) from the field. Defensively, the Flames held Coastal Carolina to 29.2 percent shooting (19-of-65). Liberty also held the Chanticleers to 10.0 percent (2-of-20) from three-point range ... JOHN CALEB SANDERS needs 21 points to reach 700 for his Liberty career.

#### LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood dropped two Big South Conference home games last week, falling 83-73 to North Division favorite Campbell on Jan. 9, and 75-62 to South Division favorite Charleston Southern on Jan. 12 ... **TRISTAN CAREY** scored a game-high 23 points against the Fighting Camels, while **JEYLANI DUBLIN** had 12 points and freshman **KARL ZIEGLER** finished with a career-high 11 points off the bench ... Freshman **NIK BROWN** scored 18 points with four assists against the Buccaneers, while Carey had 16 points, a game-high nine rebounds and three steals, freshman **MICHAEL KES-SENS** finished with 14 points and a game-high nine rebounds ... The Lancers will play their next three League games on the road, including two this week, beginning at North Division and in-state rival Radford on Jan. 16, followed by a trip to South Division opponent UNC Asheville on Jan. 19.

#### RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

**R.J. PRICE** leads the Big South in 3FG made per game at 2.87 ... **BLAKE SMITH** set a season-high with 15 points vs. High Point ... **YA YA ANDERSON** tied a career-high with four rebounds vs. High Point ... Smith is now 17 steals away from breaking the career record at Radford, which is 192. He is 24 away from becoming the 16th player in Big South history with 200 career steals.

#### VMI KEYDETS

VMI has won four straight for its longest win streak of the year and moved over the .500 mark for the first time this season ... VMI is 6-1 at home with the lone setback being an 81-80 loss to Morgan State on Dec. 1 ... VMI held Winthrop to 22 second half points this past Saturday, the lowest point total in either half by a VMI opponent this year ... STAN OKOYE is averaging 28 points and 10.3 rebounds after three Conference games. Okoye passed CHAVIS HOLMES (2006-09) for fifth-place on VMI's all-time scoring list and also moved past RON CARTER (1975-78) for fifth-place on the Institute's all-time rebound list ... RODNEY GLASGOW dished out 11 assists and committed just three turnovers in VMI's two games last week ... In the last three games, VMI is averaging just 8.7 turnovers ... Freshman DORIAN ALBRITTON scored a career-high 14 points and knocked down four 3-pointers against Winthrop this past Saturday ... With four blocks in each of the last two games, D.J. COVINGTON has 116 career rejections and is now third on school's all-time list.

#### **SOUTH DIVISION**

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

CSU pulled away from Winthrop in a 75-63 home win on Wednesday and forced 20 turnovers in a 75-62 win at Longwood on Saturday. The two wins improve the Bucs to 7-1 since Dec. 1 ... Charleston Southern is one of the nation's top three-point shooting teams, as the Bucs are sixth nationally with 9.3 three-point field goals per game ... SAAH NIMLEY is averaging 7.6 assists per game over the last seven games. He had 21 points to go with eight rebounds and eight assists at Longwood. Nimley has two double-doubles and seven 20-point games this season ... ARLON HARPER's streak of double-figure scoring games stands at nine after he poured in 18 points in Saturday's win at Longwood. He has reached double figures in 12 of 14 games this season ... The Bucs are 4-0 with MATHIANG MUO back in the lineup after missing most of December. Muo had 19 points and six rebounds in the Winthrop win.

#### **COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS**

The Chanticleers went 1-1 last week with a home win over Presbyterian and a loss on the road at Liberty ... CCU is just 1-5 on the road and a strong 6-2 at home ... **KIERRE GREENWOOD** led the team last week with 19.0 points per game while eclipsing the 1,000-point mark for his career ... **EL HADJI NDIEGUENE** averaged 11.0 rebounds per game last week along with 7.5 points ... **ANTHONY RAFFA** continues to lead the team this season with 18.1 points per game but averaged just 10.0 points last week. The Chants struggled from the floor, making just 33.6 percent of their shots from the field.

#### GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb allowed more than 70 points just once in its first 14 games of the season -- 76 at then-No. 11 North Carolina in the season opener. The Runnin' Bulldogs have seen each of the last three opponents reach at least 70 points, with both UNC Asheville and High Point doing so in regulation ... High Point became the first team all season to top 50-percent shooting against the Runnin' Bulldogs ... TASHAN NEWSOME is the League's second-leading scorer in Big South games (19.3) ... GWU snapped an eight-game losing streak to UNC Asheville on Jan. 9 with its 78-71 win. GWU led by as many as 20 points in that game ... Gardner-Webb has forged a 21-10 mark in Paul Porter Arena since CHRIS HOLTMANN's arrival on campus. GWU is 15-5 in its last 20 home games, including a 6-1 mark so far this season.

#### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The last four meetings with Winthrop have been decided by a combined 10 points (2.5 average), with the teams going 2-2 ... Despite its won-loss record, PC has a higher field goal percentage than its opponents. PC owns a 45.1 FG% (third in the League), compared to 44.5 for its competition ... ERIC WASHINGTON is averaging 5.9 assists per game. If that holds up he will shatter PC's Division I season record of 3.5 set by PIERRE MILLER in 2010-11. Washington already has the career assist mark with 3.7, and needs just eight assists to take the season record ... KHALID MUTAKABBIR is averaging 16.0 ppg in Big South play compared to 14.8 overall, while JORDAN DOWNING is averaging 14.7 ppg in the League, compared to 12.7 overall ... Mutakabbir needs just 172 points to move atop PC's Division I career record books in that category. He is also first in career minutes and games started with 107.

#### **UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS**

Against Gardner-Webb, last Wednesday, the Bulldogs set two school records. **WILL WEEKS** went 11-of-12 (=91.7 percent) from the field as he scored a career-high 27 points. It was the best individual field goal percentage in a game. **KEITH HORNS-BY** hit four-straight free throws to run his consecutive streak to 29, setting a school record for consecutive free throws. Hornsby is second nationally in free throw percentage at 95.7 (45-of-47) ... In the Radford win, **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** blocked a career-high seven shots and is 10th nationally with 3.06 blocks per game ... As a team, Asheville has 94 blocks on the season to lead the Big South. The Bulldogs already have more blocks than they did all of last season (88).


#### WINTHROP EAGLES

The Eagles are 0-3 in the Big South for the first time since opening the 1997-98 League season 0-5. Winthrop opened the 2012-13 Conference slate against opponents that are a combined 8-1 in League play ... Winthrop will look for its first Big South win Wednesday at home against PC ... GIDEON GAMBLE has been the most consistent offense for the team during the last six games as he's been in double-figures in five contests and had nine in the other. He scored 16 points at VMI on Saturday, which is a career-high in a Big South game. He's averaging 14.3 points and 5.0 rebounds while shooting 46 percent from the field and 64 percent behind the arc (7-for-11) in three League games ... The Eagles are in the midst of a four-game losing streak, and have allowed 71.2 points and 46 percent from the field during the skid.
