### CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**JEREMY ATKINSON • F**  
**Sr. • UNC Asheville**  
**Elm City, N.C.**

Atkinson averaged 20.0 points, 7.7 rebounds, 4.3 offensive rebounds and 3.3 assists in leading the Bulldogs to three wins. He scored 21 points and grabbed nine rebounds in Asheville's win at North-eastern on Dec. 18, and followed with a career-high 31 points with nine boards in the Bulldogs' victory at St. John's on Dec. 21. Against the Red Storm, Atkinson scored 23 second half points and knocked down a personal-best three triples in leading the 17-point comeback victory. In the three games, he was 21-of-41 from the field (=51.2 percent), 5-of-9 from beyond the arc (=55.6) and 13-of-15 from the free throw line (=86.7).

Brown averaged 22.7 points, 10.8 rebounds and 2.0 steals in three games. He had 20 points and 10 rebounds against Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 21 before tallying 23 points and a career-high 16 rebounds at Chattanooga on Dec. 28. Brown added 25 points and six boards the next day against Austin Peay en route to receiving All-Tournament team honors at the Dr. Pepper Classic. In the three-game span, he was 24-of-52 from the floor (=46.2 percent) and 20-of-28 from the charity stripe (=71.4).

**WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...**

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

**CAMPBELL'S FREEMAN NAMED A COUSY AWARD CANDIDATE**

Campbell sophomore point guard **TREY FREEMAN** was named among the initial candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Dec. 20. The Watch List will be narrowed down to 20 in January, the final 10 in February and the final five in March. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be announced at the Final Four in April.

**TIS THE SEASON... CONFERENCE SEASON!!**

The Big South Conference season begins this weekend with six games on the slate, as the Conference begins a new Wednesday-Saturday playing format, as well as divisional play for the first time in League history. **DIVIDE AND CONQUER**

As mentioned above, the Big South has divisional play this season for the first time in League history. This weekend's Conference openers will also have the first crossover contests between the North and South Division teams. The first intra-division games will occur on Wednesday, Jan. 9.

**MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS**

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

**BIG SOUTH'S NEW ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK TIPS OFF THIS WEEK**

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 tips off this Saturday with Charleston Southern at Radford airing live beginning at 4:00pm. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the Dedmon Center in Radford, Va. For the first time, ESPN3 will carry a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games are scheduled Feb. 23 due to BracketBusters), while ESPNU will televise two regular-season Big South games for the first time as well (Jan. 19 and Feb. 8).

**CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He is now one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 638 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 104.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (246) and Big South victories (144). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 275-300 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 246-249.

**SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...**

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is five wins away from 150 in his career as a collegiate head coach, while Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** needs seven victories for 100 at CSU.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 15 games, dating back to last season.

**STAN'S THE MAN**

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is the seventh player in Big South history with 1,600 career points and 700 rebounds after eclipsing the 1,600 career point mark vs. Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye is four blocked shots away from 100 in his career, and is looking to become just the fourth player in League annals with 1,600 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocks.

**FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

As Conference season begins this weekend, several underclassmen continue to find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is averaging a Conference-best 9.9 rebounds and has a League-leading six double-doubles. Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is the Big South's top field goal shooter at 52.7 percent and leading stealer with 2.31 per game. Campbell sophomore **TREY FREEMAN** is handing out a League-high 5.92 assists and is tops in assist-to-turnover ratio, while High Point redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** leads the Conference in 20-point games (8) and offensive rebounds (4.08). Lastly, UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** is first in the League with a 47.5 three-point percentage, based on a minimum of 2.0 made per game.

**REBOUNDING LESSONS FROM KESSENS**

Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is looking to become just the second frosh in Big South history to lead the Conference in rebounding. The first was Big South Hall of Famer and former Campbell standout **JOE SPINKS**, who averaged a League-high 9.4 rebounds in 1990-91. Meanwhile, Kessens could also become just the second freshman to average double-figure rebounds in a season as well. The first was Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** in 2008-09, who averaged 10.30 that year.

**GOING GREEN**

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls. Greenwood is now 18th all-time with 421 career helpers and needs nine to move past UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** (429 from 2008-12) for 17th. Greenwood is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

**GREENWOOD ON CUSP OF BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Coastal Carolina senior **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 20 points away from becoming the fourth Big South player this season and 116th in League history with 1,000 career points. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

**BOARD REPORT**

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** is 27 rebounds away from becoming the 11th player in Big South history with 800 career rebounds. He became the 24th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 15 at Virginia Tech. He is now 13th all-time with 773 and is 11 away from moving past Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (783 from 2008-10) for 12th-place. Okoye is the second VMI player with at least 700 career rebounds in the Big South, as former Keydet and current Charlotte Bobcat **REGGIE WILLIAMS** grabbed 820 boards from 2004-08.

**GREEN MACHINE**

Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is averaging a League-leading 2.31 steals per game, and could be the second Highlander in three seasons to lead the Big South in steals (teammate **BLAKE SMITH** was the last with 2.4 in 2010-11). Meanwhile, Green is currently the Big South's leading field goal shooter at 52.7 percent, and could become the Conference's second player to lead the League in both steals and field goal percentage. The first (and only) to do so was Charleston Southern's **HEDER AMBROISE** in 1987-88. That season, he was tops with a 63.3 field goal clip and 2.1 steals per game.

**AGONY OF DEFEAT**

The Big South has suffered a total of 40 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games is 5.50 points. UNC Asheville has suffered a League-high five of its seven losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams have lost a combined 23 non-League games under 10 points (5.74 average) while the South Division squads have dropped 17 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.18 points.

**CUNNINGHAM HARDWARE**

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** has recorded 21 of his 32 blocked shots this season in his last six games, an average of 3.5. He has at least three rejections in five of those contests as well. During his current streak, he became the 29th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 29 against USC Upstate. Cunningham now stands at 119 blocks (23rd all-time) and with 440 career rebounds, he is on his way to joining the Big South 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members.

**HEIR APPARENTS**

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After 11 games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is at 16.2 per game and Nimley is averaging 14.6 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

**WINNING COMBINATION**

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game eight times in their young career (three times this season -- all consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 7-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those eight outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

**TAKE COVER**

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON** became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections when he surpassed the milestone with five blocked shots at George Washington on Dec. 22. Covington, who was hampered by injuries most of last season, is averaging 14.4 points, 6.2 rebounds, a League-high 2.82 blocks per game and is making 52.3 percent from the field in 2012-13. He has two 20-point, 10-rebound games this year among his three double-doubles. Through 11 games this season, Covington has logged 281 minutes with 150 points, 67 rebounds and 31 blocked shots. In 2011-12, Covington was limited to 362 minutes in his 24 appearances. He scored 121 points a season ago (5.0 average) with 64 rebounds (2.7) and 16 blocks.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,868 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 633 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

**MINUTE-BY-MINUTE**

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** has played 3,872 minutes in his career, and is 307 away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader. He is 128 away from logging 4,000, which would make him the seventh player on record with that total. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 37.29 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category. The Big South's all-time minutes played leader is Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH**, who played 4,178 minutes from 2005-09.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT**

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest. He is 40th all-time with 617 and needs 11 to move past Augusta's **KEENAN MANN** (627 from 1988-91) for 39th-place.

**FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL**

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is 15th all-time in Big South history with 630 career field goals. He reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye needs three to surpass Big South Hall of Famer and former Liberty star **PETER ALUMA** (632 from 1994-97) for 15th-place and is 17 buckets away from entering the Big South's career Top 10. Meanwhile, Okoye is 47 points shy of becoming the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 15 in both scoring and rebounding. The other two are VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 8th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

**WHERE THEY RANK?**

As mentioned previously, UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 246 career victories. VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is tied for seventh in League history with 108 career wins, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is 10th with 104 career victories. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is seven wins away from becoming the 11th Big South head coach with 100 overall wins.

**MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS**

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

**BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT**

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

**MID-MAJOR MANIA**

The Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 seven consecutive seasons, and has had five programs receive votes in this year's weekly ranking. Below is a look at this year's rankings among the Big South members:

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

**TOURNAMENT SEEDING**

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

**TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE**

(A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;

(B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;

(C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;

(D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;

(F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;

(G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;

(I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

(J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

## NORTH DIVISION

## CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell had a full, healthy roster for the first time all season Dec. 29 against UNC Wilmington, which resulted in a 72-60 victory. In the 98th meeting between the schools, **DARREN WHITE** scored 32 points (23 in the 2nd half) and **TREY FREEMAN** added 18 as the Camels won for the third time in their last five contests vs. the Seahawks. In the second half, White (23) and Freeman (12) combined for 35 of Campbell's 41 points, including the final 25 ... White produced his third 30-plus point outing of the year (tied for 3rd all-time among CU leaders in the Division I era) ... Campbell returns to action Jan. 2 at Conference USA member East Carolina. The Camels and Pirates have split the last four games in the series with each team winning on its home floor ... CU stands 4-3 at home this year, with the three losses coming by a total of 9 points.

## HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point snapped a four-game losing streak with a win over Austin Peay in the consolation game of the Dr. Pepper Classic on Dec. 29. The four losses came by an average of 6.3 points and the Panthers were within five points in the last five minutes of each of those games ... Redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** has scored at least 20 points in his last five games and had three double-doubles in that span. He averaged 23.0 points and 9.8 rebounds in those games. He grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds against Chattanooga on Dec. 28 ... Brown was featured on ESPN SportsCenter's Top 10 for the third time this season with his fast break, alley-oop dunk against Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 21. It ranked No. 4 ... Guard **DEVANTE WALLACE** returned from injury to play his first two games of the season in the Dr. Pepper Classic. He averaged 10.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists and hit three three-pointers against Chattanooga ... High Point is shooting 76.3 percent from the free throw line, which is tied for 10th in the nation.

## LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty picked up its first victory over a Division I opponent this season with its 63-62 win at Western Carolina. In the game, **TOMASZ GIELO** grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds, while **JOEL VANDER POL** swatted away a career-high four shots ... Liberty's point total against Union College (104) was its highest of the season, marking the first time the Flames have reached the century mark since defeating VMI, 100-82, on Jan. 20, 2011 ... Against Union College, **JR CORONADO** posted a career-high 14 points and 16 rebounds, while **DAVON MARSHALL** had a career-high nine assists. **ANDREW SMITH** had a career-high 14 points, Vander Pol had a season-high 12 points and career-high 11 rebounds, and **CHAD DONLEY** had a career-high 10 points ... Against Milligan, **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** posted a career-high 24 points to surpass the 600-point mark for his career ... **ANTWAN BURRUS** will apply for a medical redshirt this season.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood played three road games in five days just ahead of the Christmas holiday, falling at Canisius, 82-54, on Dec. 17; falling at Seton Hall, 79-61, on Dec. 19; and falling at VCU, 93-56, on Dec. 21 ... **JEYLANI DUBLIN** led the Lancers at Canisius with 12 points and a game-high 10 rebounds for his second double-double this year, while freshman **NIK BROWN** had 11 points and four assists. Dublin led Longwood with 13 points at Seton Hall, adding seven rebounds, while **DAVID ROBINSON** had 10 points. Robinson led the Lancers with 18 points at VCU, making 3-7 three-pointers. **TRISTAN CAREY** had 17 points, making 3-6 three-pointers, adding seven rebounds and four steals, and Dublin finished with 10 points ... The Lancers will play their first-ever Big South Conference contest on Saturday, Jan. 5, welcoming Coastal Carolina to Willett Hall in Farmville for a 2:00pm tip-off. It's the first of three-straight League home games.

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

The Highlanders' six wins this season matches their victory total for all of last year ... Senior **BLAKE SMITH** needs 28 steals for 200 in his career and would need to average 1.47 in his final 19 games to reach the milestone.

## VMI KEYDETS

Freshman **TIM MARSHALL** scored a career-high 14 points in VMI's 76-67 loss at George Washington Dec. 22. He hit 4-of-5 three-pointers against the Colonials and helped VMI to a season best 42.9% (9-of-21) beyond the arc. Marshall has averaged 12.5 points over his last 2 games ... After a quiet first half where he was scoreless against George Washington, **STAN OKOYE** bounced back to finish with 19 points and 10 rebounds ... **D.J. COVINGTON** had five blocks at George Washington and became just the fifth player in VMI history with 100 career rejections ... VMI resumes action Jan. 2 at home against Shenandoah after playing just one game overall in the previous 24 days. VMI hasn't played a home game since Dec. 3.

## SOUTH DIVISION

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

Charleston Southern ended 2012 on a high note, winning two of its last three games, including avenging an earlier loss to East Tennessee State as well as a win against Virginia Intermont, while falling on the road to Wichita State ... After falling to ETSU earlier in the season at home, Charleston Southern outscored the Buccaneers, 34-6 over the final 14 minutes of the first half en route to a 72-51 win in Brooke Gymnasium on Dec. 18. **ARLON HARPER** scored 25 points in the victory, adding six rebounds and four steals, while **JEREMY SEXTON** knocked down five three-pointers. ... **SAAH NIMLEY** scored a season-high 21 points at Wichita State, but the Shockers rallied from a six-point deficit in building a double-digit lead in the win ... Charleston Southern dominated visiting Virginia Intermont as six players scored double-digits in the 105-59 victory over the Cobras. **CEDRICK BOWEN** matched a career-high with 17 points and eight rebounds, while Nimley recorded his second-straight 20-point game and added eight assists in the victory.

## COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chanticleers closed out the 2012 portion of their season with a 5-6 record. It is the first time since the 2008-09 campaign that the Chants have closed out the first half of the year with a losing record ... Coastal posted its biggest win of the season on Dec. 19 with a dominating 69-46 victory over Clemson inside The HTC Center ... **ANTHONY RAFFA** leads the Chants into Conference play averaging 18.9 points per game but **KIERRE GREENWOOD** has led Coastal in the last two games and is averaging 12.9 ppg. Greenwood posted a career-high 21 points in the Chants' most recent victory over Greensboro College ... Greenwood now sits just 20 points away from becoming the 18th player in CCU history to reach the 1,000-point milestone ... Coastal travels to Longwood this weekend for the first time since 1984.

## GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb is off to its best start since going 8-6 to start the 2004-05 season. GWU went on to post an 18-12 record and the Atlantic Sun Conference regular-season championship that season ... The eight wins for Gardner-Webb are the most before Christmas since the Runnin' Bulldogs started the 1999-00 season with a 14-0 pre-Christmas record in their final season at the Division II level ... Each of Gardner-Webb's eight wins so far this season have been by at least 10 points ... The 14 days between games for Gardner-Webb is the longest in-season stretch for the Runnin' Bulldogs since moving up to NCAA Division I.

## PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

**KHALID MUTAKABBIR** needs 220 points, 88 three-pointers, 77 assists and one more game started to move into PC's Division I career record books in each of those categories. With 39 minutes played at Furman Dec. 9, he moved to the top of the total career minutes at PC ... The Blue Hose have faced a total of 12 nationally ranked opponents since moving to Division I, including games this season against No. 13 Creighton and No. 24 Wisconsin ... PC is 1-11 against ranked opponents in its Division I era -- the win was a 56-54 decision over No. 20 Cincinnati in 2011.

## UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville heads into 2013 with a three-game winning streak. The Bulldogs picked up two key road non-Conference wins over Christmas as they defeated Northeastern, 79-73 and stunned St. John's, 72-65. Asheville made it three wins in a row with a 95-66 victory over Bluefield on Sunday ... **JON NWANNUNU** set two career-highs in the winning streak. He tallied a career-high 16 points at Northeastern and then pumped in 22 points with a career-best 11 rebounds vs. Bluefield ... Asheville starts a three-game road trip at Charlotte on Jan. 2 and then opens Big South Conference play at Liberty on Saturday. The Bulldogs are 15-1 in Big South lid-lifters under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**.

## WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop has won four of its last five games with the only loss coming at No. 7 Ohio State and two of the last three wins coming on the road at Ohio and Auburn ... Winthrop's win over Auburn was just the third-ever by the Eagles against an SEC school ... Winthrop played the Buckeyes tight and even led at the 14:31 mark of the second half. The Eagles out rebounded Ohio State, the first opponent to do so this season. Winthrop also connected on a season-high 10 threes against Ohio State and it was the first time a Winthrop team hit 10 or more threes in a game in 89 contests ... The road stretch of winning at Ohio, the close loss at OSU and the win at Auburn is arguably the most successful non-Conference road swing in Winthrop's history ... **JOAB JEROME**'s emergence played a big role in the recent success. In the last five games, he is averaging a team-best 11.2 points and 6.2 rebounds while shooting 57 percent.
