FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

Through the first four weeks of the 2012-13 season, several underclassmen find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is averaging a Conference-best 11.4 rebounds. Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is the Big South's top shooter at 61.5 percent and is also tops with 3.13 steals per game. Campbell sophomore **TREY FREEMAN** is handing out a League-high 6.38 assists, while Kessens leads the Conference in both offensive rebounds (4.38) and defensive boards (7.00) per game.

REBOUNDING LESSONS FROM KESSENS

Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is looking to become just the second frosh in Big South history to average double-figure rebounds in a season. The first was Gardner-Webb's **JOSHUA HENLEY** in 2008-09, who averaged 10.30 that year. Kessen's average of 11.38 rebounds per game is currently the third-highest clip in a season, and if he can maintain his top spot, He would be just the second freshman to lead the Big South in rebounding. Big South Hall of Famer and former Campbell standout **JOE SPINKS** was the first with his average of 9.4 rebounds in 1990-91.

RAFFA JOINS BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **ANTHONY RAFFA** became the 115th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone against Johnson & Wales on Nov. 20. Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is 12 points away from 1,000 in his career. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is now the seventh player in Big South history with 1,600 career points and 700 rebounds after eclipsing the 1,600 career point mark vs. Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye, who needs 12 points to crack the Big South's all-time Top 20 scorers, is four blocked shots away from 100 in his career, and is looking to become just the fourth player in League annals with 1,600 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocks.

BOARD REPORT

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** became the 24th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 15 at Virginia Tech. He is now 15th all-time with 744, two away from moving into 14th-place. Okoye is 56 caroms away from becoming the 11th player in League history with 800 career rebounds. He is the second VMI player with at least 700 career rebounds in the Big South, as former Keydet and current Charlotte Bobcat **REGGIE WILLIAMS** grabbed 820 boards from 2004-08.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is averaging 4.25 steals in his last four games and a League-leading 3.13 steals overall, the highest average in the Big South since the 2008-09 campaign when VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** led the Conference with 3.4. The League has had a player average at least 3.00 steals per game six times in Big South history. Meanwhile, Green is currently the Big South's top field goal shooter at 61.5 percent, and will attempt to become the Conference's second player to lead the League in both steals and field goal percentage. The first (and only) to do so was Charleston Southern's **HEDER AMBROISE** in 1987-88. That season, he was tops with a 63.3 field goal clip and 2.1 steals per game.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. He is now one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis is ninth among all active coaches with 635 Division I wins and is 35th all-time in Division I victories. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 101.

GOING GREEN

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** needs nine assists to become the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career helpers. He would be the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (241) and Big South victories (144). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 270-298 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 241-247.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is six wins away from 150 in his career as a collegiate head coach, while Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** needs 10 victories for 100 at CSU.

HEIR APPARENTS?

With the graduation of UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM**, Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are ready to replace the departed Bulldogs as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After seven games into their sophomore seasons, Harper is at 14.3 per game and Nimley is averaging 13.4 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game seven times in their young career (twice this season), and the Buccaneers are 6-1 in those games. The duo have surpassed 20 points in the same contest in three of those seven outings, and CSU is 2-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

TAKE COVER

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON**, who was hampered by injuries most of last season, is averaging 13.6 points, 6.3 rebounds, a League-high 2.75 blocks per game and is making 50.0 percent from the field. In a four-game span Nov. 13-24, Covington scored 20 points three times, blocked 16 shots (4.0 average) and had two double-figure rebound games. Through eight games this season, Covington has logged 208 minutes with 109 points, 50 rebounds and 22 blocked shots. In 2011-12, Covington was limited to 24 games and 362 minutes. He scored 121 points a season ago (5.0 average) with 64 rebounds (2.7) and 16 blocks. Meanwhile, Covington is six blocked shots away from joining the Big South's 100-blocked shot club.

HART OF THE MATTER

Gardner-Webb senior **KEVIN HARTLEY** has been a defensive mainstay for the Runnin' Bulldogs through the first eight games of the season. He leads the squad with 6.6 rebounds to rank 12th in the Big South, and his 2.38 steals per game is fourth in the Conference. Hartley also ranks ninth in the League with 4.5 defensive rebounds a game. He has four games with at least three steals this season and is just 14 takeaways from matching his season steal total from 2011-12 (33 in 32 games).

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,791 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 556 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

MINUTE-BY-MINUTE

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** has played 3,613 minutes in his career, and is 566 away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader. He is 387 away from logging 4,000, which would make him the seventh player on record with that total. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 37.6 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category. The Big South's all-time minutes played leader is Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH**, who played 4,178 minutes from 2005-09.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** needs two rebounds to become the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds. With a career 7.1 per game average, Law will likely surpass 700 career boards by seasons end.

MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

CUNNINGHAM HARDWARE

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the 29th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 29 against USC Upstate. Cunningham stands at 101 blocks and with 411 career rebounds, is on his way to joining the Big South 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 16 members.

BIG BURRUS

Injured Liberty senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is also looking to join the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club once he gets healthy and rejoins the lineup. Burrus has tallied 104 rejections in his career -- tied for 27th in League annals, and has 452 career rebounds to his credit. He would become just the second Liberty player on the list, joining Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is 17th all-time in Big South history with 616 career field goals. He reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24. Okoye needs six to surpass Campbell's **HENRY WILSON** (621 from 1985-89) for 16th-place and is 31 buckets away from entering the Big South's career Top 10. Meanwhile, Okoye is 90 points shy of becoming the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 15 in both scoring and rebounding. The other two are VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 8th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

BIG SOUTH TAKES DOWN MEMBER FROM BIG EAST

For the second consecutive season, a Big South member has defeated a member from the Big East Conference on the hardwood. Gardner-Webb knocked off its first Big East team on Nov. 15, as the Runnin' Bulldogs downed DePaul on its home court. GWU led from start to finish in the 71-59 victory. Last season, Presbyterian College had the Big South's win over a Big East member with its 56-54 win at Cincinnati. The Big South has now defeated a Big East program five out of the last nine seasons.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE EIGHTH APPEARANCE IN ESPN'S BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in ESPN's BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

A BIGGER BIG SOUTH IN 2012-13

The Big South Conference has an all-time high 12 member institutions in 2012-13 with the addition of Longwood University as a full member. The expansion allowed the Conference to create two six-team divisions in men's basketball for the first time in League history. The North Division is comprised of **Campbell, High Point, Liberty, Longwood, Radford** and **VMI**, while the South Division consists of **Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, UNC Asheville** and **Winthrop**. Each team will play a 16-game Conference season with 10 intra-division contests and six crossover games. In addition, the format for the Conference Tournament now includes all 12 programs, with the top two teams in each division receiving byes into the quarterfinals.

Campbell improved to 3-1 at home this year and ended a 4-game losing streak with a 91-78 victory over Newberry. **TREY FREEMAN** (21), **DARIAN HOOKER** (18), **RECO McCARTER** (17) and **D.J. MASON** (12) all hit season scoring highs for the Camels, who played without **DARREN WHITE** (21.9 ppg), who was nursing a hand injury ... Campbell set Gore Arena records for free throws made (36) and attempted (44) in the game that also set a building mark for most combined fouls (64) ... The Camels host NEC power Robert Morris Tuesday before taking a week-long break from competition for final exams.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point's one-point loss at Western Michigan was its closest loss since an 82-81 loss to Appalachian State in an ESPN BracketBuster game on Feb. 19, 2011 ... The 63-point win over Johnson & Wales was HPU's largest margin of victory since a 70-point victory (93-23) over Warren Wilson on Nov. 19, 2007 ... High Point had very balanced scoring in both games last week: against Western Michigan, four players scored in double-figures and, against Johnson & Wales, six scored in double-figures ... High Point had several defensive marks against Johnson & Wales: most steals (17) since 16 vs. UNC Asheville on Dec. 4, 2010; first time with 10 blocks since 10 vs. Gardner-Webb on Jan. 10, 2009; first time forcing more than 25 turnovers (27) since getting 26 vs. Winthrop on Feb. 15, 2011.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty starts the season 0-8 for the first time in program history ... The Flames are also 0-3 in the Vines Center for the first time ... The last time Liberty started 0-3 at home was the 1988-89 season, its first year in Division I. That year the Flames played their games in the Schilling Center ... Against Georgia State, **DAVON MARSHALL** led all scorers with a game-high 25 points, marking the first 20-point game by a Flame this season and the most tallies since a 26-point effort by **EVAN GORDON** at Coastal Carolina on Feb 3, 2011. Marshall's six three-pointers were also the most since Gordon posted the same number in Liberty's 2010-11 season opener against Virginia Interterm (Nov. 12, 2010) ... Despite the defeat, Liberty finished the contest with 12 three-pointers, the most since knocking down 15 in a 95-80 victory at Charleston Southern during the 2008-09 season ... **TOMASZ GIELO** returned to the court on Thursday against Morgan State after missing six games. He finished with 11 points in 18 minutes.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

Freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** posted his fifth double-double with 18 points and a career-high and game-high 17 rebounds against Central Penn ... **TRISTAN CAREY** and **DAVID ROBINSON** each added 17 points against CPC, and freshman **NIK BROWN** had 12 points and a career-high and game-high six assists ... **FRANK HOLLOWAY** contributed eight points and seven rebounds in 22 minutes off the bench while making his Longwood debut after missing the first six games with an injury ... Robinson was the only Lancer to reach double-figure scoring against Dartmouth, finishing with a career-high and game-high 21 points ... Longwood has made at least one three-point field goal in 308 consecutive games, dating back to Nov. 26, 2002.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

The Highlanders have won three-straight games for the first time since the 2009-10 season ... Radford is one victory away from matching its season total for all of last season.

VMI KEYDETS

VMI had its string of 27 consecutive home wins against non-Conference competition snapped Saturday after Morgan State rallied to edge the Keydets 81-80 on a buzzer beater in overtime. VMI had not dropped a game at Cameron Hall against such competition since a 71-69 loss to Army on Dec. 1, 2007 ... **STAN OKOYE** has scored in double figures in all eight games this season and posted his second double-double of the year with 29 points and 11 rebounds against Morgan State ... Freshman guard **TIM MARSHALL** scored a career-high 11 points and hit three 3-pointers in Wednesday's loss at West Virginia ... **RODNEY GLASGOW** has averaged 6.5 assists over his last two games ... VMI set a season-high in free throws made and attempted with 17 out of 26 against Morgan State ... Former VMI head coach **GARY McPHERSON** (1966-69) who later became West Virginia's head coach through the 1973-74 season, was honored in a pregame ceremony before VMI's game at West Virginia Nov. 28 in WVU Coliseum. McPherson currently resides in Morgantown and is a senior director of development at the university. Two of McPherson's players from VMI's Class of 1968, guard **JOHN KEMPER** and center **STEVE POWERS**, presented Coach McPherson with a framed team photo of the 1967-68 VMI basketball squad.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

The Bucs dropped a 72-67 heartbreaker to College of Charleston last Wednesday night in front of a sold out crowd in the Buc Dome. CSU cut a 14-point deficit to one in the final minutes on a three by **ARLON HARPER**, but CofC made its free throws down the stretch to keep the rally at bay. Harper and **SAAH NIMLEY** each had 20 points ... CSU bounced back with a 101-69 win over Barber-Scotia on Saturday. The Bucs jumped to a 19-5 lead, with Harper finishing with a game-high 23 and **JOE WILLIAMS** added a season-high 15 points. The Bucs out-rebounded the overmatched Sabers, 39-29 ... Harper's scoring average has climbed to 14.3 points per game after averaging 21.5 points last week ... CSU hosts The Citadel on Tuesday night before taking a two-week break for exams, returning to action Dec. 18 at ETSU.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chanticleers fell on the road last week at Boston University. **ANTHONY RAFFA** continues to lead the Big South in scoring with 23 points per game and ranks fourth in the NCAA. Freshman **MICHEL ENANGA** leads the team in rebounding with 7.5 ... The Chants have out-rebounded every opponent this season by an average of 8.1 boards per game ... Coastal welcomes in Boston U. to Conway this Thursday and it will mark the first time the Chants have played back-to-back games against the same non-Conference opponent in program history. Coastal played home and home with UNC Wilmington during the 2007-08 season but had a game against Canisius sandwiched between the two games.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb was off last week and returns to action Monday night, Dec. 3 against Virginia-Wise. The game begins a string of three games in five days ... GWU has held a halftime lead in five of its eight games thus far ... The Runnin' Bulldogs lead the Big South in scoring defense at 59.1 points allowed per game.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The Presbyterian College men's basketball team shot a school Division I record 64.6 percent from the field last week against Toccoa Falls, converting a record 42 baskets en route to a 97-38 victory. The 56 total rebounds was also a record and the 97 points ranks third ... Two players pulled down double-digit rebounds in a single game for the first time in PC's Division I history with **AUSTIN ANDERSON** and **WILLIAM TRUSS** both recording 11 rebounds against Toccoa Falls.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville lost another close game last Thursday, as the Bulldogs fell to USC Upstate at home by two points, 73-71, despite having a 16-point lead in the second half. Asheville has lost six-straight, with five of the losses by seven points or less. The last two losses have been by just two points each ... Asheville had a nice game from **TRENT MEYER** against the Spartans, as he scored a career-high 23 points -- his second 20-point game in his last three contests ... **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** picked up his first double-double of the year with 10 points and 11 rebounds. He blocked three shots to reach 101 for his career and into seventh-place on Asheville's career list ... **KEITH HORNSBY** just missed a double-double against USC Upstate with eight points and a career-high nine assists.

WINTHROP EAGLES

The Eagles are off to a 2-4 start after dropping two road games this past week at Wofford College and James Madison. The Eagles trailed by 20 points in the second half of both games but rallied both times. Winthrop has yet to be involved in a game decided by less than 10 points this season ... **ANDRE SMITH** had a breakout game on Saturday in the loss at JMU as he scored a career-high 26 points on 8-for-13 shooting. He was 4-for-6 from three and 6-for-7 at the foul line and also finished with a team-high five rebounds. Smith is now second on the team in scoring at 10.8 ppg ... **DERRICK HENRY** leads the team with 16.5 ppg, but failed to score in double-figures for the first time all season with nine points at JMU. It was also the first game in which Henry did not attempt at least five free throws in a game ... WU is hosting its third non-Division I opponent this season on Tuesday when it takes on Brevard College. The Eagles have won 30-straight games against non-Division I opponents. Current Winthrop assistant coach **MARK PROSSER** was the head coach of Brevard in 2011-12 ... Following the Brevard game, the Eagles will have 10 days between contests as they will be back in action on Dec. 15 at Ohio to start a three-game road swing that includes Ohio State and Auburn.
