Green averaged 25.0 points, 13.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.5 steals in two games last week. He opened his week with 23 points and tied his career-high with 13 boards at Liberty. Green then tallied 27 points and grabbed 13 rebounds in Saturday's win over Presbyterian College. He handed out a career-best five assists against the Blue Hose and also recorded three steals.

STAN OKOYE • F Sr. • VMI Raleigh, N.C.

Okoye averaged 30.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in two games last week. He scored a team-high 27 points on 12-of-20 from the field in a victory at Longwood, which included 3-of-6 from long range. Okoye followed that game with 34 points and 16 rebounds against UNC Asheville on Friday night for his eighth double-double of the year. For the week, Okoye was 25-of-47 from the field (= 53.2) and 7-of-17 from three-point range (= 41.2).

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

MICHEL ENANGA • G/F Fr. • Coastal Carolina Yaounde, Cameroon

Enanga averaged 11.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in two games off the bench for the Chanticleers. He notched a double-double with 12 points and 10 boards, and added a pair of steals in Coastal's win over Charleston Southern. Enanga then had 10 points and five rebounds at High Point. For the week, he was 8-of-13 from the floor (= 61.5), 3-of-3 from three-point range and 3-of-4 from the line (= 75.0).

15-FOOTER

UNC Asheville has now won at least 15 games in six consecutive seasons, tied for the second-longest streak in Big South history. It is also their 15th 15-win season since the Conference was formed, which ranks as the second-most in League history.

TEN-TAMOUNT

UNC Asheville needs one more Big South victory for its sixth consecutive 10-win Conference season. The Bulldogs' current streak is already the second-longest in League annals, as the record is nine by Winthrop from 1999-08. Once Asheville wins its 10th Big South game of the year, it would be its ninth season with at least 10 Conference victories and the second-most in Conference history. Winthrop holds that record as well with 10 overall 10-win Big South seasons.

STAN'S THE ONLY MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is the first player in Big South history with at least 1,900 career points (1,948), 800 career rebounds (876) and 100 career blocked shots (100) after reaching the century mark in rejections Jan. 30 at Radford. Okoye needs 24 rebounds to join High Point's **ARIZONA REID** as the only players with 1,900 career points and 900 rebounds. Reid had 2,069 points and 1,013 rebounds in his career from 2004-08.

LEADING MINUTE MAN

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** is on record as the Big South's all-time leader for career minutes played with 4,283 after breaking the mark of 4,178 on Feb. 2 at High Point. He surpassed the record that was first established by Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (2005-09). Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 37.32 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category.

BAUCOM'S BALLERS

With VMI's **STAN OKOYE** ninth all-time in League history with 1,948 points, Keydet head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** now owns the distinction of coaching four of the Big South's all-time Top 10 scorers. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (2004-08) is the Conference's career leader with 2,556 points, and **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2005-09) is sixth with 2,065. Okoye is ninth and **KEITH GABRIEL** (2008-12) is 10th with 1,925 career markers. In fact, VMI has the most representatives in the Top 10. High Point is second with two of the League's all-time Top 10 scorers.

BIG SOUTH'S "BB&T GAME OF THE WEEK" CONTINUES THIS WEEK ON ESPN3 AND MASN

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this Saturday with Charleston Southern at UNC Asheville airing live beginning at 2:00pm. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from Kimmel Arena in Asheville, N.C. Meanwhile, the second of two Big South games on MASN is this weekend, as the network will carry the VMI at Campbell game live at 2:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) have the call from Gore Arena in Buies Creek, N.C. For the first time, ESPN3 is carrying a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games are scheduled Feb. 23 due to BracketBusters).

MOUNTAIN RETREAT

The longest active home win streak in League contests belongs to UNC Asheville at 10. In fact, the Bulldogs are 24-3 (=88.9 percent) since moving into Kimmel Arena in 2011-12, including 13-1 in regular-season Big South games. Following Asheville with the longest active home Big South win streak is High Point (nine) and Coastal Carolina (six).

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** is fourth in the Big South with 17.1 points per game and third with 10 20-point contests. He is the sixth-highest scoring freshman in the nation, and his per game clip is the highest for a Big South frosh since **SETH CURRY** averaged 20.2 points for Liberty in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Brown's League ranking is the highest for a freshman since Curry finished second among the Conference's scoring leaders in '08-09.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 11 times in their young career (six times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 10-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 11 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (255) and Big South victories (153). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 284-303 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 255-252.

DIVIDE AND CONQUER

With one crossover divisional game remaining -- VMI at Charleston Southern on Feb. 21 -- the South Division continues to lead the head-to-head meetings, 21-14 (=60.0 percent) after 35 games. The host teams have won a combined 21 games, with the South Division squads 12-5 at home while going 9-9 on North Division home courts. Here is a look at each team's crossover record in Big South games, in current standings order:

A GAME OF MARGINS

Following the first 65 Conference games of the season, the home teams are 44-21 (=67.7 percent) -- the highest home winning percentage since before the 2002-03 campaign. Of the 65 games this season, 37 have been decided by double figures by an average of 15.62 points, while the 28 games decided by less than 10 points have been by an average of 4.89. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season thus far is 11.00 points.

MORE ON COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** needs one victory to tie the all-time coaching win record at the Institute of 116 wins, currently held by **BART BELLAIRS**. On Jan. 16, Baucom collected his 150th career win as a collegiate head coach with the Keydets' 76-57 win over Campbell. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** became the 11th head coach in League history with 100 wins at a Conference member as he reached the milestone with the Buccaneers' 79-75 win at Liberty on Jan. 26.

FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is fifth all-time in Big South history with 723 career field goals, and is 52 away from moving into fourth-place. Okoye is closing in on 400 career made free throws, as he is four away from that milestone. That would make him the 13th player with 400 freebies, and just the third with 700 career field goals and 400 career free throws.

TRIPLE THREAT

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is one 3-pointer shy of 200 in his career, which would make him the 31st player in Big South history with that total. He would be the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining **JAMARCO WARREN** (337 from 2007-11), **BRETT LARRICK** (234 from 1993-97) and **CHRIS MOORE** (206 from 2004-08).

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is 52 points away from becoming the eighth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points. He would be the third Keydet on the list, which is detailed below:

DJC-I

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the 68th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 2 at Campbell. At the same time, he became the 18th player in League annals with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots. Meanwhile, Cunningham has recorded 59 of his career-high 70 blocked shots this season in his last 18 games, an average of 3.28 in that span. The 29th player in Big South history to record 100 career blocked shots, Cunningham now stands 12th in the Conference record books with 157.

DJC-II

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON**, who became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections when he surpassed the milestone with five blocked shots at George Washington on Dec. 22, is currently tied for 18th all-time with 140 career rejections. Covington's 67 blocks are a career-high, and he is averaging personal-bests of 13.5 points, 7.4 rebounds and 3.05 blocked shots this year.

TOPPING THE CHARTS

UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** remains second in the nation in free throw percentage with a 94.5 success rate as he has made 86-of-91 attempts this season -- just 0.1 percentage points off the national leader. His school-record streak of 45 consecutive free throws came to end Jan. 26 against High Point, and he is currently in the midst of a streak of 19 in-a-row. Hornsby is challenging the Big South single-season free throw record of 92.5 percent that was established by Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** in 1993-94. Hornsby also has a chance to become the first Big South player in history to lead the NCAA in free throw shooting.

GOING GREEN

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 15th all-time in Big South history with 459 career assists, and needs 11 helpers to move past Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN** (469 from 1995-00) for 14th. Greenwood, who became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls, is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESEL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 110. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 644 Division I wins and is 34th all-time in Division I victories. HEIR APPARENTS

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After 21 games into their sophomore seasons, Nimley is at 15.8 per game and Harper is averaging 15.0 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

Campbell senior **DARREN WHITE** was selected to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District 3 Team Jan. 31, and now moves onto the national ballot for Academic All-America. It is the second-straight year and the seventh time in the last eight seasons that the Big South has had an Academic All-District honoree. The last time the Conference had a CoSIDA Academic All-American was in 2008-09 (Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN**).

LITTLE BIG MAN

Charleston Southern 5-8 sophomore guard **SAAH NIMLEY** recorded back-to-back 20-point, 10-rebound games for the Buccaneers Jan. 26-30. He tallied a 20-point, 10-assist game earlier this season against The Citadel on Dec. 4, and is the first Big South player since VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 to post a 20-point/10-rebound and 20-point/10-assist game in the same season. Meanwhile, in Big South games this year, Nimley is averaging 17.1 points (5th in the Big South), 6.6 rebounds (10th) and 6.10 assists (3rd).

DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 20 games. Gardner-Webb's **TASHAN NEWSOME** and Campbell's **DARREN WHITE**, who has missed the last eight games with an injury, are both at 17 consecutive games scoring in double figures.

PASS HAPPY

Presbyterian College sophomore **ERIC WASHINGTON**, High Point senior **JAIKUS SIMMS** and Longwood guard **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** all have more assists than field goal attempts this season. Washington has 111 assists compared to 99 field goal attempts, while Simms has the largest margin -- 74 assists compared to 45 shots. Woodhouse has handed out 108 assists while taking just 88 attempts from the floor.

GRAB AND GO

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the Big South's scoring leader with 21.3 points and rebounding leader with 9.3 points. If he can maintain his top ranking in both categories, he would be the first player since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10 and just the fifth in League history to lead the Big South in scoring and rebounding. Meanwhile, Okoye is looking to become the fourth different player in the Conference record books to average at least 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in the same season.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** is 34th all-time with 657 rebounds and needs four to move past Charleston Southern's **JEFF DANIELS** (660 from 1993-97) for 33rd-place. Law, who became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest, is 20 rebounds shy of entering the Conference's Top 30 rebounders.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,044 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 809 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Presbyterian College sophomore guard **ERIC WASHINGTON** is averaging 7.57 assists in his last seven games, and 6.53 on the season. He has played in just 17 of PC's 25 games this season (=68.0 percent) and does not meet the League or NCAA minimum (75 percent of games played) to be ranked among the overall statistical leaders. Washington's 111 assists this season include seven games with eight, including three with 10, and his 6.45 assist average in Conference games ranks second in the League.

CLIMBING THE CHAIN OF COMMAND

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 10 in both scoring and rebounding, as he is ninth with 1,948 career points and 5th with 876 rebounds. He joins VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 8th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

FIVE AND DIME STORE

Six players have combined for 11 10-assist games this season, with Charleston Southern's **SAAH NIMLEY** and Presbyterian College's **ERIC WASHINGTON** leading the way with three each, followed by Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** with two. Last season, eight Big South players combined for 16 games with at least 10 assists, but just two players had more than one 10-assist performance. The last time the Big South had at least three players with two-plus games with 10 helpers was in 2007-08 (four players).

DOWNTOWN DOWNING

Presbyterian College redshirt-sophomore **JORDAN DOWNING** is leading the Big South with a 45.5 overall three-point field goal percentage (61-of-134), based on a minimum 2.0 3FG made per game. In a nine-game stretch from Dec. 18-Jan. 19, Downing was 29-of-50 from long distance (=58.0 percent) to bring his season percentage to a League-leading 43.6 clip at the time. The Davidson transfer was just 15-of-51 from beyond the arc (=29.4) after his first 10 games with the Blue Hose.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

The Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 seven consecutive seasons, and has had five programs receive votes in this year's weekly ranking. Below is a look at this year's rankings among the Big South members:

7-UP

Charleston Southern's 7-0 Big South start was its best since opening the 1986-87 League season 10-0 and marked the program's second-ever 7-0 opening. It is the third-straight season that a Big South member opened League play at least 7-0 (12th all-time), and the Buccaneers are the fourth League member with at least two 7-0 starts to the Conference season.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

- (A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- (B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;
- (C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- (D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- (F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;
- (G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;
- (I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.
- (J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

WILL PAST HISTORY REPEAT FOR THE BUCCANEERS?

Charleston Southern was the League's last undefeated team in Big South play with its 7-0 start. Prior to this season, a total of 11 teams started the Big South season 7-0 since 1985-86, and each of those squads went on to win or share the regular-season crown. In addition, seven teams that opened 7-0 have won the Conference Tournament title -- the last being UNC Asheville in 2011-12, while another three finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

HE'S SEXTON AND HE KNOWS IT

Charleston Southern senior guard **JEREMY SEXTON** set a Big South single-game record for highest three-point percentage in a Conference game after going 8-of-9 (=88.9 percent) from beyond the arc Jan. 19 against High Point. The record, based on a minimum 7 made 3FG, was previously 77.8 percent. In fact, Charleston Southern now has four of the top five individual single-game three-point field goal percentage in a Big South game following Sexton's performance.

PERFECTO MUNDO

Presbyterian College went a perfect 16-of-16 from the free throw line Jan. 26 at Longwood, the third time a Big South member has recorded a 100.0 free throw percentage in a game when making at least 16 from the charity stripe -- and the second time in a Conference game. UNC Asheville holds the all-time mark of 24-of-24 against High Point on Feb. 18, 2000, while Liberty was a perfect 18-of-18 from the line against Hampton on Dec. 17, 2011.

CAMPBELL'S FREEMAN NAMED A COUSY AWARD CANDIDATE

Campbell sophomore point guard **TREY FREEMAN** was named among the initial candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Dec. 20. The Watch List was narrowed to 20 on January 10, and the final 12 were named on February 7. The final five will be revealed in March, with the winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award to be announced at the Final Four in April.

CBSSPORTS.COM HONORS HIGH POINT'S ALLAN CHANEY

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** was recognized by *CBSSports.com* as the outlet's Midseason Comeback Player of the Year on Jan. 10. Chaney overcame a heart ailment and is averaging 14.5 points and 7.6 rebounds this season for the Panthers. He also ranks third in the Big South in both field goal percentage (52.0) and free throw shooting (85.6).

WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

AGONY OF DEFEAT

The Big South suffered a total of 43 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games was 5.56 points. UNC Asheville suffered six of its eight non-Conference losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams lost a combined 24 non-League games under 10 points (5.67 average) while the South Division squads dropped 19 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.42 points.

MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

Big South assists leader **TREY FREEMAN**'s 143 assist this year are 9th most in Campbell's Division I era (since '77-78).

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point has gone 9-3 in its last 12 games, the Panthers' best 12-game stretch since going 9-3 from Jan. 13 - Feb. 17, 2007. The last time High Point won at least 10 games in a 13-game stretch was also in 2006-07 ... The Panthers have won four games in a row for the first time since Jan. 29 - Feb. 7, 2011 ... High Point's 8-3 Big South record is its second-best ever through 11 games. HPU started 9-2 in 2006-07 en route to an 11-3 Conference record ... **COREY LAW** has been named to the 2013 State Farm Dark Horse Dunker competition. One of 16 contestants who are voted in on facebook.com/collegeslam will get to compete in the Slam Dunk Championship during the Final Four in Atlanta ... **DERRELL EDWARDS** posted career highs of 15 points and four three-pointers in High Point's win over Coastal Carolina on Saturday.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Against Gardner-Webb, **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** paced the Flames with a career-high 27 points, scoring 25 in the second half. Sanders' scoring performance put him over the 800-point mark for his Liberty career. His 25 points in the second half is the most points by a Flame in a single half since **SETH CURRY** did so in his lone season at Liberty. Curry scored 25 points in the second half of a 75-70 win on Dec. 22, 2008 over Northern Colorado in Las Vegas ... **TAVARES SPEAKS** posted seven points against Gardner-Webb on Saturday, snapping a 13-game double digit scoring streak ... Liberty's loss to the Runnin' Bulldogs snapped a six-game winning streak against Gardner-Webb.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood won its first-ever Big South men's basketball game on Feb. 9, defeating Winthrop, 62-56, on the road in Rock Hill. **MICHAEL KESSENS** led the Lancers with a team-high 15 points, adding five rebounds. **JEYLANI DUBLIN** and **DAVID ROBINSON** each had 13 points, with Robinson making 3-3 three-pointers and adding five rebounds. The 56 points allowed were the fewest by an opponent this season, as were the 20 made field goals, and the 48 field goal attempts were the second fewest allowed this year. Longwood played just six players in the contest against the Eagles ... Kessens is averaging 17.0 points in his last five games, making 36-of-59 field goals (61%) ... **TRISTAN CAREY** has scored in double-figures in his last 10 games, averaging 15.0 points and 2.5 steals. The Runnin' Bulldogs improved to 9-2 in Paul Porter Arena this season, and are 11-2 overall on home and neutral courts in 2012-13 ... GWU pulled down an impressive 17 offensive rebounds vs. Liberty, but scored just nine second-chance points ... GWU has led by at least 10 points in all but one of its home games this season.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

KHALID MUTAKABBIR connected on 27 straight free throws, dating back to the second half of the Liberty game Jan. 19, before a miss at the 15:05 mark in the second half against Radford on Feb. 19 ... The win over Gardner-Webb marked the first time this season the Blue Hose trailed at the 15-minute, 10-minute and 5-minute marks of the second half. It also marked the first time this season **ERIC WASHINGTON** led the team in scoring (13 points). It was just the second time in his career he has done so ... Washington has recorded two double-doubles so far this season, with 10 assists and 11 points against Liberty and 10 assists and 10 points against Longwood ... Mutakabbir needs just 42 points to move into PC's Division I career record books in the category. He is first in games started with 114.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville has won seven straight games after knocking off Winthrop and VMI last week. The Bulldogs rallied from an 11-point first-half deficit against the Eagles on Wednesday to record a 69-56 victory. **KEITH HORNSBY** and **JEREMY ATKINSON** combined for 41 points in the win ... Asheville won for the sixth straight year at VMI on Friday as the Bulldogs won a nationally-televised game against the Keydets, 90-79. Atkinson and Hornsby led the way with 24 points each, while freshman **WILL WEEKS** added 19 points -- 16 in the second half ... Atkinson has scored in double figures in 24 of 25 games this season and 32 of the last 33 games dating back to last year ... The Bulldogs are 14-3 on the road in their last 17 Big South Conference road games, and 25-4 in League games over the last two seasons.

WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop was 0-2 last week despite holding leads in the second half of both games ... The Eagles loss at UNC Asheville was the second straight road game in which the team held a double-digit lead and ended up losing ... In the loss to Longwood on Saturday, the Lancers shot 61 percent from the floor in the second half.
