## **SAAH NIMLEY • G** Soph. • Charleston Southern Lawrenceville, Ga.

Nimley averaged 24.5 points, 9.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists in leading the Buccaneers to two Big South road wins last week. The 5-8 guard opened his week with a career-high 26 points in CSU's win at Presbyterian College, including 19 in the second half. He also grabbed nine boards and had three assists in the victory. At Liberty this past Saturday, Nimley posted 23 points, 10 rebounds and five assists while going 6-of-12 from three-point range as the Bucs won at the Vines Center for the first time since 2006. For the week, Nimley was 11-of-22 from beyond the arc (=50.0 percent), 10-of-15 from the line ( =66.7) and averaged 1.5 steals.

## WILL WEEKS • F Fr. • UNC Asheville Charlotte, N.C.

Weeks averaged 16.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in the Bulldogs' two wins last week. He recorded 12 points, six rebounds and three steals against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 23, and followed with a teamhigh 21 points on 7-of-10 from the field and 7-of-10 from the charity stripe against High Point this past Saturday. Weeks also collected eight rebounds and three assists vs. the Panthers. For the week, he was 10-of-16 from the floor ( =62.5) and 13-of-18 and from the line (=72.2).

#### 7-UP

Charleston Southern's 7-0 Big South start is its best since opening the 1986-87 League season 10-0 and marks the program's second-ever 7-0 opening. It is the third-straight season that a Big South member has opened League play at least 7-0 (12th all-time), and the Buccaneers are the fourth League member with at least two 7-0 starts to the Conference season.

### THE IMPORTANCE OF A GOOD START

Charleston Southern is the League's last undefeated team in Big South play at 7-0. Prior to this season, a total of 11 teams started the Big South season 7-0 since 1985-86, and each of those squads went on to win or share the regular-season crown. In addition, seven teams that opened 7-0 have won the Conference Tournament title -- the last being UNC Asheville in 2011-12, while another three finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

### **PIRATES COVE**

Charleston Southern has won five-straight Big South road games dating back to last season, one shy of tying the school record for most consecutive Conference road wins. The 1986-87 Bucs won its first six League road games that season. CSU's four Big South road victories this season matches last year's total. The last time the Buccaneers won five Conference games away from home was in 1995-96 (5-2).

#### PERFECTO MUNDO

Presbyterian College went a perfect 16-of-16 from the free throw line this past Saturday at Longwood, the third time a Big South member has recorded a 100.0 free throw percentage in a game when making at least 16 from the charity stripe -- and the second time in a Conference game. UNC Asheville holds the all-time mark of 24-of-24 against High Point on Feb. 18, 2000, while Liberty was a perfect 18-of-18 from the line against Hampton on Dec. 17, 2011.

### BIG SOUTH'S "BB&T GAME OF THE WEEK" CONTINUES THIS WEEK ON ESPN3 AND MASN

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this Saturday with Presbyterian at High Point airing live beginning at 7:00pm. **MIKE HOGEWOOD** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the Millis Center in High Point, N.C. Meanwhile, the first of two Big South games on MASN is this weekend, as the network will carry the Liberty at Winthrop game live at 7:00pm. **FRED CUNNINGHAM** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) have the call from the Winthrop Coliseum. For the first time, ESPN3 will carry a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games are scheduled Feb. 23 due to Bracket-Busters). In addition, ESPNU will broadcast the second of two regular-season Big South games on Friday, Feb. 8 with UNC Asheville at VMI.

#### STAN'S THE MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI became the third player in Big South history with 1,800 career points and 800 career rebounds when he reached the scoring milestone on Jan. 16 against Campbell. With 1,864 points and 838 boards, Okoye joins former Keydet **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (2,556 points, 820 rebounds) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (2,069, 1,013) in the 1800-800 club. Meanwhile, Okoye is one blocked shot away from 100 in his career, and would become the first player in League annals with 1,800 points, 800 rebounds and 100 blocks. He is also 136 points away from becoming the eighth player with 2,000 career points.

### LITTLE BIG MAN

Charleston Southern 5-8 sophomore guard **SAAH NIMLEY** recorded a 20-point, 10-assist game earlier this season against The Citadel on Dec. 4, and added a 20-point, 10-rebound effort this past Saturday at Liberty. He is the first Big South player since VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 to post a 20-point/10-rebound and 20-point/10-assist game in the same season. Meanwhile, in Big South games this year, Nimley is averaging 16.7 points, 6.9 rebounds and 7.14 assists (in addition to 1.71 steals).

## GARDNER-WEBB SNAPS 11-GAME BIG SOUTH ROAD LOSING STREAK

Gardner-Webb snapped its 11-game Big South road losing streak with its 63-49 win at VMI this past Saturday. It was the Runnin' Bulldogs' first Conference road victory since Dec. 31, 2011, a 61-55 win at Radford in their first Big South road game of the 2011-12 campaign. GWU's futility streak was the longest in the Big South since Radford's 15-game slide in away League games from 2010-12.

### **MOUNTAIN RETREAT**

The longest active home win streak in League contests belongs to UNC Asheville at nine. In fact, UNC Asheville is 23-3 (=88.5 percent) since moving into Kimmel Arena in 2011-12, including 12-1 in regular-season Big South games. Following Asheville with the longest active home Big South win streak is High Point (six), Charleston Southern (five), Campbell and Coastal Carolina (four each) and Radford (three).

#### **DIVIDE AND CONQUER**

After 24 crossover divisional games, the South Division leads the head-to-head meetings, 14-10. The host teams have won a combined 13 games, with the South Division squads 7-4 at home while going 7-6 on North Division home courts. #### A GAME OF MARGINS

Following the first 42 Conference games of the season, the home teams are 29-13 (=69.0 percent) -- the highest home winning percentage since before the 2002-03 campaign. Of the 42 games this season, 22 have been decided by double figures by an average of 15.64 points, while the 20 games decided by less than 10 points have been by an average of 5.45. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season thus far is 10.79 points.

#### TRIPLE THREAT

Charleston Southern senior JEREMY SEXTON is five three-pointers shy of 200 in his career, which would make him the 31st player in Big South history with that total. He would be the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining JAMARCO WARREN (337 from 2007-11), BRETT LARRICK (234 from 1993-97) and CHRIS MOORE (206 from 2004-08).

### **STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach EDDIE BIEDENBACH is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (251) and Big South victories (149). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 280-303 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 251-252.

## SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach BARCLAY RADEBAUGH became the 11th head coach in League history with 100 wins at a Conference member as he reached the milestone with the Buccaneers' 79-75 win at Liberty this past Saturday. On Jan. 16, VMI head coach DUGGAR BAUCOM collected his 150th career win as a collegiate head coach with the Keydets' 76-57 win over Campbell.

#### FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior STAN OKOYE is sixth all-time in Big South history with 688 career field goals and needs 12 to become the sixth player in League annals with 700. Okove, who reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24, is closing in on 400 career made free throws, as he is 10 away from that milestone. That would make him the 13th player with 400 freebies, and just the sixth with 600 career field goals and 400 career free throws.

## **GOING GREEN**

Coastal Carolina senior guard KIERRE GREENWOOD is 16th all-time in Big South history with 445 career assists, and needs three helpers to move past Liberty's MATT HILDEBRAND (447 from 1991-94) for 15th. Greenwood, who became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls, is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining ROBERT DOWDELL (561 from 1987-91) and ALVIN GREEN (411 from 2000-05).

## **BIG SOUTH'S ACTIVE 1,000-POINT CLUB**

#### **TOPPING THE CHARTS**

UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** is second in the nation in free throw percentage with a 94.0 success rate as he has made 63-of-67 attempts this season. His school-record streak of 45 consecutive free throws came to end this past Saturday against High Point. Hornsby is challenging the Big South single-season free throw record of 92.5 percent that was established by Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** in 1993-94. Hornsby also has a chance to become the first Big South player in history to lead the NCAA in free throw shooting.

#### **CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 108. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 642 Division I wins and is 34th all-time in Division I victories. ## MINUTE-BY-MINUTE

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** is 53 minutes away from becoming the Big South's all-time leader on record for most career minutes played. The seventh player in Big South history to play at least 4,000 career minutes, his total of 4,125 is approaching the League mark of 4,178 minutes played that was established by Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** from 2005-09. Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 36.90 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category.

## HEIR APPARENTS

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After 18 games into their sophomore seasons, Nimley is at 15.4 per game and Harper is averaging 14.8 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

## WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 10 times in their young career (five times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 9-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 10 outlings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

### DJC-I

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** is 14 rebounds away from becoming the 68th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds. Once he reaches the rebounding benchmark, he will become the 17th player in League annals with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots. Meanwhile, Cunningham has recorded 48 of his career-high 59 blocked shots this season in his last 14 games, an average of 3.43 in that span. He has at least four rejections in five of those contests as well, including a career-high seven against Radford on Jan. 12. The 29th player in Big South history to record 100 career blocked shots, Cunningham now stands 15th in the Conference record books with 146.

#### DJC-I

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON**, who became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections when he surpassed the milestone with five blocked shots at George Washington on Dec. 22, is currently 21st all-time with 126 career rejections. Covington is in the midst of the second 50-block season of his career, and he is averaging personal-bests of 13.3 points, 6.6 rebounds and 2.79 blocked shots this year.

#### LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW**, who became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest, is 36th all-time with 643 and needs five to move past Coastal Carolina's **SAM McLAURIN** (647 from 2008-12) for 35th-place.

### **FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

Several underclassmen continue to find themselves among the League leaders in various categories. Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is averaging a Conference-best 9.2 rebounds and has a League-leading eight double-doubles. Radford sophomore **R.J. PRICE** is the Big South's leader for most three-pointers made per game with 2.95. Teammate and sophomore **JAVONTE GREEN** is tops in steals with 2.29, while Campbell sophomore **TREY FREEMAN** is handing out a League-high 5.86 assists. High Point redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** leads the Conference with 3.47 offensive rebounds. Lastly, UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** is first in the League in free throw percentage (94.0).

### REBOUNDING LESSONS FROM KESSENS

Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** is looking to become just the second frosh in Big South history to lead the Conference in rebounding. The first was Big South Hall of Famer and former Campbell standout **JOE SPINKS**, who averaged a Leaque-high 9.4 rebounds in 1990-91.

### **BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,968 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. ## DOUBLE TROUBLE

Campbell's **DARREN WHITE** owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 17 games, dating back to last season. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is the next closest to White with 16 consecutive games in double digits, followed by Gardner-Webb's **TASHAN NEWSOME** (13).

#### HE'S SEXTON AND HE KNOWS IT

Charleston Southern senior guard **JEREMY SEXTON** set a Big South single-game record for highest three-point percentage in a Conference game after going 8-of-9 (=88.9 percent) from beyond the arc Jan. 19 against High Point. The record, based on a minimum 7 made 3FG, was previously 77.8 percent. In fact, Charleston Southern now has four of the top five individual single-game three-point field goal percentage in a Big South game following Sexton's performance.

### **FIVE AND DIME STORE**

Five players have combined for 10 10-assist games this season, with Charleston Southern's **SAAH NIM-LEY** and Presbyterian College's **ERIC WASHINGTON** leading the way with three each, followed by Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** with two. Last season, eight Big South players combined for 16 games with at least 10 assists, but just two players had more than one 10-assist performance. The last time the Big South had at least three players with two-plus games with 10 helpers was in 2007-08 (four players).

## **DOWNTOWN DOWNING**

In a nine-game stretch from Dec. 18-Jan. 19, Presbyterian College redshirt-sophomore **JORDAN DOWNING** was 29-of-50 from three-point range ( =58.0 percent) to bring his season percentage to a League-leading 43.6 clip at the time. The Davidson transfer was just 15-of-51 from beyond the arc ( =29.4) after his first 10 games with the Blue Hose. Downing is currently 47-of-111 from three-point range this season and ranks second with a 42.3 overall percentage.

#### **MID-MAJOR MANIA**

## **BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

#### TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament.

Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below

#### TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

- (A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- (B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;
- (C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- (D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- (F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would considered, and so forth until the tie is broken:
- (G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;
- (I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.
- (J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

#### BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS TO BE UNVEILED FEB. 4

ESPN will formerly announce the 2013 Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters pairings on Monday evening, Feb. 4, beginning at 6:30pm with a Selection Show on ESPNU to announce the TV match-ups. Following the program, the non-TV games will be released. The Big South Conference is participating in the event for the eighth consecutive season, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times in the past six years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPNU), 2011 (ESPNU) and 2012 (ESPN3).

## WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

#### MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

#### AGONY OF DEFEAT

The Big South suffered a total of 43 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games was 5.56 points. UNC Asheville suffered six of its eight non-Conference losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams lost a combined 24 non-League games under 10 points (5.67 average) while the South Division squads dropped 19 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.42 points.

## **MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS**

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

## **NORTH DIVISION**

### **CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS**

After getting off to a 3-9 start, CU has won seven of its last nine games to move to 10-11 overall (5-2 Big South) ... The Camels are 7-3 at home and have won four-straight. Their three home losses have been by a combined 9 points ... Following Tuesday's game at Liberty, Campbell will play four of its next five at home ... MARVELLE HARRIS has moved into 7th place on CU's all-time blocked shots list (100) and is 8th all time with 487 rebounds (Division I era, since '77-78) ... DARIAN HOOKER averaged 15 points on 58.8% shooting last week ... LEEK LEEK scored 14 points at Coastal Carolina, his highest output against a Big South team this season ... Despite shooting just 37.5% from the field at Coastal Carolina, Campbell continues to lead the Big South Conference in team field goal percentage (45.4) ... ANDREW RYAN is averaging 9.6 points (double figures 3 times), while shooting 52.9% from the field, 6-14 threes and 85.7% from the line in his last five games.

### HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point recorded its first win over VMI since March 1, 2008. The Panthers tallied 24 assists in the game, the most against a Division I opponent since getting 25 in that March 1, 2008 game against the Keydets. The Panthers also recorded 25 assists in a 100-50 win over Montreat on Nov. 28, 2008 ... HPU's 96 points against VMI were the most by the Panthers since a 98-60 win over Campbell on Feb. 22, 2012 ... COREY LAW scored in double-digits in points in back-to-back games for the first time this season and averaged 7.5 rebounds last week. He shot 83.3 percent (10-for-12) from the floor ... Redshirt-freshman JOHN BROWN has scored in double-digits in 18 of 19 games this season. With 17.5 points per game, he's the No. 3 freshman scorer in the country.

#### LIBERTY FLAMES

Against Charleston Southern, **DAVON MARSHALL** led Liberty with 23 points, hitting 7-of-12 shots from three-point land. Marshall's seven three-pointers are the most since **KYLE OHMAN** knocked down seven in a 103-88 victory over VMI in the 2008 Big South Tournament. Marshall is now one of five players in school history tied for second for three-pointers made in a game ... **TAVARES SPEAKS** continues to provide consistent production for the Flames' offense, posting double digit scoring figures in 10 straight contests (13.5 ppg during the span) ... Liberty's loss to the Buccaneers snapped a five-game home winning streak against Charleston Southern ... Against Longwood last week, the Flames finished with their third-best shooting percentage of the season, hitting 28-of-53 shots (52.8 percent) from the field.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood dropped two games last week, falling 74-47 at Liberty before an 82-71 home setback to Presbyterian ... The Lancers continue seeking their first Conference win (0-7), and have dropped 11-straight decisions overall ... Freshman KARL ZIEGLER led Longwood at Liberty with a career-high 12 points, including 8-of-8 free throws, while TRISTAN CAREY added 10 points ... DAVID ROBINSON and freshman MICHAEL KESSENS led the Lancers against the Blue Hose with their respective 16 points each, with Robinson tying his career-high with three steals, while JEYLANI DUBLIN had 13 points. Carey finished with a game-high four steals ... Longwood is back on the road this week, its fourth and fifth road games in their last six overall.

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

**R.J. PRICE** has hit a game-winning shot in each of RU's last two wins, which have both come by a single point. He has moved into 10th all-time on the RU career made 3-point field goals list with 118 ... Radford is now 2-0 this season in games decided by 3 points or fewer (both are 1-point victories) ... RU overcame a halftime deficit for the first time this season in the Winthrop victory. The Highlanders were 0-10 prior to that and 1-25 in the last two seasons ... **BLAKE SMITH** currently ranks fourth in career steals at RU with 179, while **JAVONTE GREEN** is 8th in RU history with 151 offensive boards ... **Green scored 20 of Radford's 27 first-half points in the Winthrop victory.** He finished the day with 26 ... **RASHUN DAVIS** had 10 points off the bench against the Eagles after a career-high eight assists vs. Campbell.

#### VMI KEYDETS

After a season-long five game winning streak, VMI has dropped its last three games -- which is the team's longest skid of the year. During the dry spell, the Keydets have been held under the 50-point threshold twice and are shooting just 37% from the floor, 30% from 3-point range and 36% from the free throw line ... D.J. COVING-TON turned in his fourth double-double of the year with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Gardner-Webb, his first since Dec. 3 ... Freshman TIM MARSHALL scored in double figures in two games last week with 11 points at High Point and 14 points against Gardner-Webb. It was the first time Marshall had scored double figures in Conference games and he averaged 12.5 points and shot 50% (7-of-14) from three-point range ... The team's 1-of-4 free throws against Gardner-Webb were the lowest in both categories in the DUGGAR BAUCOM coaching era.

## **SOUTH DIVISION**

## **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS**

The Bucs have won eight-straight games, CSU's longest winning streak since nine-straight in 1994-95 ... Charleston Southern is 11-1 since Dec. 1 ... **SAAH NIMLEY** had a career-high 26 points and the Bucs hit 15-of-30 three-pointers in their win at Presbyterian last week ... The Bucs fought off Liberty for a 79-75 win Saturday night in Lynchburg, Va. Nimley had 23 points and **ARLON HARPER** added 19 as CSU won for the first time in the Vines Center since 2006 ... The Bucs continue to lead the nation in three-pointers made per game with 9.6.

### COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chanticleers extended their home win streak to six games with a win over Campbell last week and also continued to struggle on the road with their seventh road setback of the season at UNC Asheville ... ANTHONY RAFFA shined in both contests last week, scoring 27 at Asheville and scoring 20 in the win over Campbell -- both team-highs ... KIERRE GREENWOOD looked to be back to 100 percent against Campbell after suffering from flu-like symptoms for three-straight games. He scored 18 points while grabbing five rebounds against the Camels ... The Chants have now won six-straight home games, including all three Conference games, by an average of 22.5 points per game while holding opponents to just 50.0 points per contest ... CCU now has three players averaging double-figures (Raffa, Greenwood and WARREN GILLIS).

#### GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb has held three Division I foes to less than 50 points this season ... The 49 points allowed to VMI marked the Keydets' lowest scoring output at home since 2005 ... GWU has held three teams this season more than 25 points below their season scoring average ... **KEVIN HARTLEY** has made 23 of his last 34 shots from beyond the arc (67.6 percent). Hartley posted his second double-double of the season at VMI with 10 points and 13 rebounds.

### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The combination of **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** and **JORDAN DOWNING** have proved to be a key for the Blue Hose offense in Conference play. Through seven Big South games, Mutakabbir is averaging 18.1 points, compared to his 15.8 overall clip. Downing is averaging just over two points more in League play (15.6 to 13.4) ... Mutakabbir has posted two 20-point games in two of the last three games. Downing has scored in double-figures in all seven games and had a career-high 26 against Winthrop ... **ERIC WASHINGTON** is averaging 6.2 assists per game ... If that holds up he will shatter PC's Division I season record of 3.5 set by **PIERRE MILLER** in 2010-11. Washington has recorded a double-double in two of the last three games, with 10 assists and 11 points against Liberty and 10 assists and 10 points against Longwood ... The Blue Hose are 10th in the nation in free throw percentage (76.1).

#### **UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS**

UNC Asheville went 2-0 last week with two home wins. Asheville edged Coastal Carolina, 63-60 on Wednesday and then knocked off High Point, 69-58 ... The Bulldogs have now won six-straight home games and 11-straight games against Big South opponents at home dating back to last year ... **JEREMY ATKINSON** hit the longest shot in the history of Kimmel Arena when he banked in a 65-footer at the end of the first half against High Point ... Asheville is above .500 (11-10) for the first time since being 1-0 at the start of the year. After starting the year 1-6, the Bulldogs are 10-4 ... **KEITH HORNSBY**'s streak of 45-straight free throws came to an end against High Point as he missed his first two. He made two straight later in the game to begin a new streak ... Asheville is 30-4 in its last 34 games against Big South opponents.


#### WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop suffered a 1-point loss at Radford on Saturday as it dropped its first game all season when leading into the final minute of the game. It was the second one-point game of the season for Winthrop (50-49 win at Ohio) ... Winthrop is just 2-6 in its last eight games decided by a point. It was also just the second time the Eagles have lost this year when leading at the half ... Winthrop's last two losses at Radford have been by a total of three points ... Winthrop drained nine threes in the loss at Radford, the most triples in a League game since Feb. 4, 2012 at VMI (9-for-22). Not including VMI, it was the first time Winthrop hit nine threes in regular-season Big South game since Dec. 5, 2009 vs. High Point in an 82-68 victory ... Winthrop fell to 1-13 all-time against Radford when scoring 50-59 points against the Highlanders ... The Eagles have won 296 games at the Winthrop Coliseum and will look for an opportunity to reach the 300-win mark this season, as six of their final 10 games are at home.
