Newsome averaged 24.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 61.3 percent from the field in helping the Runnin' Bulldogs to two Big South wins last week -- including an overtime win at South Division leader Charleston Southern. Newsome posted his first double-double of the season with 22 points and 10 rebounds against the Buccaneers. He followed with 26 points, five rebounds and four assists against Longwood, and for the week, Newsome was 19-of-31 from the field (=61.3 percent), 2-of-4 from long range (=50.0) and 8-of-10 from the line (=80.0).

He tallied 22 points on 10-of-12 shooting at High Point with five rebounds and a blocked shot. Kessens then scored 21 points on 8-of-11 from the field and 5-of-6 from the line at Gardner-Webb. **STAN'S THE ONLY MAN**

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is the first player in Big South history with at least 1,800 career points (1,887), 800 career rebounds (853) and 100 career blocked shots (100) after reaching the century mark in rejections Jan. 30 at Radford. Okoye, who is 13 points shy of becoming the 10th player in League annals with 1,900 points, also needs 47 rebounds to join High Point's **ARIZONA REID** as the only players with 1,900 career points and 900 rebounds. Reid had 2,069 points and 1,013 rebounds in his career from 2004-08.

**LEADING MINUTE MAN**

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** is on record as the Big South's all-time leader for career minutes played with 4,204 after breaking the mark this past Saturday at High Point. He surpassed the previous record of 4,178 that was established by Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (2005-09). Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 37.13 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category.

**PIRATES COVE**

Charleston Southern has won five-straight Big South road games dating back to last season, one shy of tying the school record for most consecutive Conference road wins. The 1986-87 Bucs won its first six League road games that season. CSU's four Big South road victories this season matches last year's total. The last time the Buccaneers won five Conference games away from home was in 1995-96 (5-2).

**LITTLE BIG MAN**

Charleston Southern 5-8 sophomore guard **SAAH NIMLEY** has recorded back-to-back 20-point, 10-rebound games for the Buccaneers. He tallied a 20-point, 10-assist game earlier this season against The Citadel on Dec. 4, and is the first Big South player since VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 to post a 20-point/10-rebound and 20-point/10-assist game in the same season. Meanwhile, in Big South games this year, Nimley is averaging 18.0 points (3rd in the Big South), 7.3 rebounds (7th) and 6.75 assists (1st), plus 1.63 steals.

**MOUNTAIN RETREAT**

The longest active home win streak in League contests belongs to UNC Asheville at nine. In fact, UNC Asheville is 23-3 (=88.5 percent) since moving into Kimmel Arena in 2011-12, including 12-1 in regular-season Big South games. Following Asheville with the longest active home Big South win streak is High Point (eight) and Coastal Carolina (five).

**U-2**

The Big South Conference will have its second regular-season appearance on ESPNU this Friday, as the network will televise the UNC Asheville at VMI game live from Cameron Hall at 7:00pm. **JIM BARBAR** (play-by-play) and **MALCOLM HUCKABY** (analyst) have the call from Lexington, Va. The network televised its first-ever regular-season Big South game on Jan. 19 when the Keydets played at Coastal Carolina.

**BIG SOUTH'S "BB&T GAME OF THE WEEK" CONTINUES THIS WEEK ON ESPN3**

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this Saturday with Liberty at Gardner-Webb airing live beginning at 7:00pm. **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from Paul Porter Arena in Boiling Springs, N.C. For the first time, ESPN3 is carrying a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games are scheduled Feb. 23 due to BracketBusters).

**BIG BROWN**

High Point redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** is third in the Big South with 17.6 points per game and tied for second with 10 20-point contests. He is the fifth-highest scoring freshman in the nation, and his per game clip is the highest for a Big South frosh since **SETH CURRY** averaged 20.2 points for Liberty in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Brown's League ranking is the highest for a freshman since Curry finished second among the Conference's scoring leaders in '08-09.

**GARDNER-WEBB TURNS 11-GAME BIG SOUTH ROAD LOSING STREAK INTO WINNING STREAK**

Gardner-Webb, which snapped its 11-game Big South road losing streak with a 63-49 win at VMI on Jan. 26, has won two consecutive Conference road games after the Runnin' Bulldogs defeated South Division leader Charleston Southern on Jan. 30 in overtime, 74-73. Gardner-Webb enters this week looking to win three-straight Big South road games since joining the League in 2008-09.

**TRIPLE THREAT**

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is three 3-pointers shy of 200 in his career, which would make him the 31st player in Big South history with that total. He would be the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining **JAMARCO WARREN** (337 from 2007-11), **BRETT LARRICK** (234 from 1993-97) and **CHRIS MOORE** (206 from 2004-08).

## DIVIDE AND CONQUER

The final weekend of crossover divisional games is this weekend for 10 of the 12 squads (VMI-Charleston Southern is Feb. 21). After 29 crossover divisional games, the South Division continues to lead the head-to-head meetings, 18-11 (=62.1 percent). The host teams have won a combined 17 games, with the South Division squads 10-4 at home while going 8-7 on North Division home courts. ## A GAME OF MARGINS

Following the first 53 Conference games of the season, the home teams are 36-17 (=67.9 percent) -- the highest home winning percentage since before the 2002-03 campaign. Of the 53 games this season, 30 have been decided by double figures by an average of 15.33 points, while the 23 games decided by less than 10 points have been by an average of 4.96. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season thus far is 10.83 points.

## STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (253) and Big South victories (151). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 282-303 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 253-252.

## SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS...

Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** became the 11th head coach in League history with 100 wins at a Conference member as he reached the milestone with the Buccaneers' 79-75 win at Liberty on Jan. 26. On Jan. 16, VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** collected his 150th career win as a collegiate head coach with the Keydets' 76-57 win over Campbell.

## FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 698 career field goals and needs two to become the sixth player in League annals with 700. Okoye, who reached the 600-plateau in the Keydets' win over Elon on Nov. 24, is closing in on 400 career made free throws, as he is eight away from that milestone. That would make him the 13th player with 400 freebies, and just the sixth with 600 career field goals and 400 career free throws.

## BIG SOUTH'S ACTIVE 1,000-POINT CLUB

Three Big South players have surpassed 1,000 career points this year, and the Conference has five active 1,000-point scorers on the court this season -- with Coastal Carolina the lone member with two active 1,000 point scorers. ## 7-UP

Charleston Southern's 7-0 Big South start was its best since opening the 1986-87 League season 10-0 and marked the program's second-ever 7-0 opening. It is the third-straight season that a Big South member opened League play at least 7-0 (12th all-time), and the Buccaneers are the fourth League member with at least two 7-0 starts to the Conference season.

## WILL PAST HISTORY REPEAT FOR THE BUCCANEERS?

Charleston Southern was the League's last undefeated team in Big South play with its 7-0 start. Prior to this season, a total of 11 teams started the Big South season 7-0 since 1985-86, and each of those squads went on to win or share the regular-season crown. In addition, seven teams that opened 7-0 have won the Conference Tournament title -- the last being UNC Asheville in 2011-12, while another three finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

**DJC-I**

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the 68th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at Campbell. At the same time, he became the 18th player in League annals with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots. Meanwhile, Cunningham has recorded 53 of his career-high 64 blocked shots this season in his last 16 games, an average of 3.31 in that span. The 29th player in Big South history to record 100 career blocked shots, Cunningham now stands 15th in the Conference record books with 151.

**DJC-II**

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON**, who became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career rejections when he surpassed the milestone with five blocked shots at George Washington on Dec. 22, is currently 20th all-time with 130 career rejections. Covington's 57 blocks this season ties his career-high he first set as a freshman in 2010-11. He is also averaging personal-bests of 12.9 points, 7.0 rebounds and 2.85 blocked shots this year.

**TOPPING THE CHARTS**

UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** is second in the nation in free throw percentage with a 93.2 success rate as he has made 68-of-73 attempts this season -- just 0.8 percentage points off the national leader. His school-record streak of 45 consecutive free throws came to end Jan. 26 against High Point. Hornsby is challenging the Big South single-season free throw record of 92.5 percent that was established by Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** in 1993-94. Hornsby also has a chance to become the first Big South player in history to lead the NCAA in free throw shooting.

**GOING GREEN**

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 15th all-time in Big South history with 450 career assists, and needs 20 helpers to move past Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN** (469 from 1995-00) for 14th. Greenwood, who became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls, is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

**CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESEL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 109. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 643 Division I wins and is 34th all-time in Division I victories. **HEIR APPARENTS**

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After 19 games into their sophomore seasons, Nimley is at 16.1 per game and Harper is averaging 14.6 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

**WINNING COMBINATION**

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 10 times in their young career (five times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 9-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 10 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

**HEAD OF THE CLASS**

Campbell senior **DARREN WHITE** was selected to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District 3 Team last week, and now moves onto the national ballot for Academic All-America. It is the second-straight year and the seventh time in the last eight seasons that the Big South has had an Academic All-District honoree. The last time the Conference had a CoSIDA Academic All-American was in 2008-09 (Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN**).

**PASS HAPPY**

Presbyterian College sophomore **ERIC WASHINGTON**, High Point senior **JAIROS SIMMS** and Longwood guard **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** all have more assists than field goal attempts this season. Washington has 99 assists compared to 82 field goal attempts, while Simms has the largest margin -- 70 assists compared to 43 shots. Woodhouse has handed out 95 assists while taking just 77 attempts from the floor. Of the three, Woodhouse has six games this season in which he has attempted more field goals than assists. Washington has four such games, while Simms has done it just three times.

**GRAB AND GO**

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the Big South's scoring leader with 20.4 points and rebounding leader with 9.1 points. If he can maintain his top ranking in both categories, he would be the first player since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10 and just the fifth in League history to lead the Big South in scoring and rebounding. Meanwhile, Okoye is looking to become the fourth different player in the Conference record books to average at least 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in the same season.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT**

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** is 34th all-time with 651 rebounds and needs 12 to move past Charleston Southern's **JEFF DANIELS** (660 from 1993-97) for 33rd-place. Law, who became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest, is 24 rebounds shy of entering the Conference's Top 30 rebounders.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 1,998 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 763 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

**LENDING A HELPING HAND**

Presbyterian College sophomore guard **ERIC WASHINGTON** is averaging 8.2 assists in his last five games, and 6.60 on the season. He has played in just 15 of PC's 23 games this season (=65.2 percent) and does not meet the League or NCAA minimum (75 percent of games played) to be ranked among the overall statistical leaders. Washington's 99 assists this season include seven games with eight, including three with 10, and his 6.56 assist average in Conference games ranks third in the League.

**CLIMBING THE CHAIN OF COMMAND**

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 11 in both scoring and rebounding, as he is 11th with 1,887 career points and 6th with 853 rebounds. He joins VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 8th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

**DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK**

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Conference at 18 games. Campbell's **DARREN WHITE**, who has missed the last eight games with an injury, is at 17 consecutive games scoring in double figures. Gardner-Webb's **TASHAN NEWSOME** is the next closest with 15.

**FIVE AND DIME STORE**

Five players have combined for 10 10-assist games this season, with Charleston Southern's **SAAH NIMLEY** and Presbyterian College's **ERIC WASHINGTON** leading the way with three each, followed by Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** with two. Last season, eight Big South players combined for 16 games with at least 10 assists, but just two players had more than one 10-assist performance. The last time the Big South had at least three players with two-plus games with 10 helpers was in 2007-08 (four players).

**DOWNTOWN DOWNING**

In a nine-game stretch from Dec. 18-Jan. 19, Presbyterian College redshirt-sophomore **JORDAN DOWNING** was 29-of-50 from three-point range (=58.0 percent) to bring his season percentage to a League-leading 43.6 clip at the time. The Davidson transfer was just 15-of-51 from beyond the arc (=29.4) after his first 10 games with the Blue Hose. Downing is currently 55-of-124 from three-point range this season and ranks first with a 44.4 overall percentage, based on a minimum 2.0 3FG made per game.

**MID-MAJOR MANIA**

The Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 seven consecutive seasons, and has had five programs receive votes in this year's weekly ranking. Below is a look at this year's rankings among the Big South members:

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

**TOURNAMENT SEEDING**

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

**TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE**

(A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;

(B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;

(C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;

(D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;

(F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;

(G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;

(I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

(J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

**BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS TO BE UNVEILED FEB. 4**

ESPN will formerly announce the 2013 Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters pairings on Monday evening, Feb. 4, beginning at 6:30pm with a Selection Show on ESPNU to announce the TV match-ups. Following the program, the non-TV games will be released. The Big South Conference is participating in the event for the eighth consecutive season, with a League-record 12 teams among the field of 122. All of the Big South's men's basketball programs are participating in the same year for the second time, and the Conference is tied for the most members competing of the 15 Leagues involved this season. Six Big South teams will host a game while the remaining six members will play on the road. The Conference is 12-23 all-time in the BracketBusters, including a League-best four wins in 2012. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances five times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2), 2009 (ESPN2), 2011 (ESPN2) and 2012 (ESPN2).

**HE'S SEXTON AND HE KNOWS IT**

Charleston Southern senior guard **JEREMY SEXTON** set a Big South single-game record for highest three-point percentage in a Conference game after going 8-of-9 ( =88.9 percent) from beyond the arc Jan. 19 against High Point. The record, based on a minimum 7 made 3FG, was previously 77.8 percent. In fact, Charleston Southern now has four of the top five individual single-game three-point field goal percentage in a Big South game following Sexton's performance.

**PERFECTO MUNDO**

Presbyterian College went a perfect 16-of-16 from the free throw line Jan. 26 at Longwood, the third time a Big South member has recorded a 100.0 free throw percentage in a game when making at least 16 from the charity stripe -- and the second time in a Conference game. UNC Asheville holds the all-time mark of 24-of-24 against High Point on Feb. 18, 2000, while Liberty was a perfect 18-of-18 from the line against Hampton on Dec. 17, 2011.

**CAMPBELL'S FREEMAN NAMED A COUSY AWARD CANDIDATE**

Campbell sophomore point guard **TREY FREEMAN** was named among the initial candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Dec. 20. The Watch List was narrowed to 20 on January 10, with the final 10 being selected in February and the final five in March. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be announced at the Final Four in April.

**CBSSPORTS.COM HONORS HIGH POINT'S ALLAN CHANEY**

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** was recognized by *CBSSports.com* as the outlet's Midseason Comeback Player of the Year on Jan. 10. Chaney overcame a heart ailment and is averaging 14.4 points and 7.7 rebounds this season for the Panthers. He also ranks second in the Big South in both field goal percentage (52.5) and free throw shooting (87.8).

**WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...**

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

**MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS**

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

**AGONY OF DEFEAT**

The Big South suffered a total of 43 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games was 5.56 points. UNC Asheville suffered six of its eight non-Conference losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams lost a combined 24 non-League games under 10 points (5.67 average) while the South Division squads dropped 19 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.42 points.

**MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS**

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

## CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell has suffered consecutive defeats for the first time since a 4-game losing streak in December ... **DARIAN HOOKER** matched his career-high with 18 points Saturday against Asheville. Over the last four games, Hooker is scoring at a 15.8 ppg clip, while shooting 52.5% from the field, 42% from 3-point range (8-19) and 81% (13-16) from the line ... **LEEK LEEK** matched his season high point total in League play with 14 at Liberty ... Campbell hosts High Point Wednesday before closing out play against the South Division Saturday at Charleston Southern ... CU stands 4-4 with leading scorer **DARREN WHITE** sidelined by a knee injury.

## HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point has matched its second-best Big South start through nine games at 6-3. HPU also started 6-3 in 2003-04. The only time HPU started better was a 7-2 mark in 2006-07 ... The Panthers are 7-3 in their last 10 games, their best stretch since going 7-3 from Jan. 8-Feb. 6, 2008 ... **ALLAN CHANEY** posted his fourth double-double of the season with 21 points and 12 rebounds against Presbyterian on Saturday ... Freshman guard **ADAM WEARY** has scored in double digits three times in a row and in six of his last seven games.

## LIBERTY FLAMES

Against Campbell, **TAVARES SPEAKS** (22), **DAVON MARSHALL** (22) and **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** (21) marked the first time the Flames had three 20-point scorers in a game in nearly five years. The last time three Liberty players accomplished the feat was on Feb. 14, 2009 at Charleston Southern ... Marshall is also the first Liberty player to record back-to-back 20-point performances since **JESSE SANDERS** did so during the 2010-11 season ... Despite the Flames coming into the Winthrop contest leading the Big South in three-point percentage, the Eagles' defense held Liberty to a season-low 15.0 percent (3-of-20) from downtown ... The Flames finished the Winthrop game with its best free throw percentage of the season, hitting 15-of-16 shots (93.8 percent). Liberty's seven turnovers were also its fewest this season ... **TAVARES SPEAKS** has posted double-digit scoring figures in the last 12 games.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood dropped two League road games at High Point, 88-60, and Gardner-Webb, 76-65 ... Freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** led the Lancers at HPU with a career-high 22 points, while junior **T.T. CAREY** added 15 points and classmate **DAVID ROB-INSON** finished with 10 points ... Kessens followed with 21 points at GWU, while **JEYLANI DUBLIN** added 14 points and Carey finished with 13 points ... Freshman **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** is averaging 7.8 assists in his last six games, and 6.7 assists in the nine Conference games.

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

The Highlanders lead the Big South in turnover margin (+2.61) and forces more turnovers per game than any other team in the Big South (16.6) ... **JAVONTE GREEN** recorded his fifth double-double this season with 13 points and 13 rebounds vs. Longwood. He now has 12 career double-doubles ... **JALEN CARETHERS** set career-highs in both rebounds (8) and blocked shots (4) at Coastal Carolina ... **LUCAS DYER** scored a career-high 8 points at Coastal Carolina ... **BLAKE SMITH** currently ranks fourth in career steals at RU with 181. He is just two steals from tying for third all-time ... The Highlanders have used four different starting lineups this season. **BLAKE SMITH** and Green have started every game this season. The current probable starting lineup of Price, Smith, Green, **KYLE NOREEN** and **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has started 14 games this season and been used in each of the last nine games.

## VMI KEYDETS

**STAN OKOYE** scored VMI's final 16 points, including 13 in the final 1:11, and converted the go-ahead put-back with 3.4 seconds remaining to lead the Keydets to a 70-69 come-from-behind win at Radford last Wednesday night. Okoye also posted his seventh double-double of the year as he finished with 15 rebounds, one off his season high of 16 rebounds pulled down against Elon Nov. 24 ... VMI's win at Radford marked just the second time in 12 games this year that VMI has rallied to win a contest after trailing with 5:00 to go in regulation. It also was the first time this year VMI had won a game that was tied at the half ... VMI used a different starting lineup for the first time this season when freshman forward **PHILLIP ANGLADE** was inserted for senior forward **NICK GORE** at Radford. The starting lineup employed for VMI's first 19 games was the longest stretch of a single starting line-up combination used by the Keydets since the mid-70's ... VMI has won three games on the road this year. The Keydets won just one of 15 road contests last season.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

Charleston Southern had its third-longest winning streak in school history come to an end with a 74-73 home loss to Gardner-Webb in overtime last Wednesday. The Bucs trailed 64-54 with 90 seconds left, only to rally and force overtime on a fadeaway three-pointer by **MATHIANG MUO** with two seconds left. GWU would win in overtime on a three-point play with 30 seconds remaining ... **SAAH NIMLEY** set his scoring career high for the second time in a week with 27 points against the Runnin' Bulldogs. Nimley helped rally the Bucs from a 10-point deficit in the final 90 seconds and grabbed 10 rebounds as well.

## COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants pushed their home win streak to seven games inside The HTC Center with a 62-52 victory over Radford ... CCU had its road losing streak extended to four games with a 61-48 loss at Winthrop last Wednesday ... Senior **ANTHONY RAFFA** led the way last week with 16 points at Winthrop and 22 in the win over RU ... Coastal hosts Charleston Southern on Wednesday. The Chants are unbeaten at home in Conference play while the Bucs are unbeaten on the road in Big South action.

## GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb has won three games in a row for the first time this season after topping Charleston Southern and Longwood ... The Runnin' Bulldogs improved to 10-3 in the all-time series with Charleston Southern and is now 1-1 this season in overtime games ... Three of Gardner-Webb previous five games have been decided by one point (2-1 record) ... Of Gardner-Webb's 13 wins this season, 10 have come by at least 10 points (UNC Asheville, Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern have not) ... Reserve point guard **JARVIS DAVIS** came off the bench last week to average 13.5 points and shoot 57.1 percent from the floor in two wins. Davis is a transfer from UCF ... Gardner-Webb's 13 wins this season are the most under third-year head coach **CHRIS HOLTMANN**.

## PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The Blue Hose are seventh in the nation in free throw percentage at 76.6, which is pacing as the second-highest single-season average in Big South history ... **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** has connected on his last 22 consecutive free throws ... The loss against UNC Asheville marked the first time in PC's Division I history the team lost despite shooting more than 60 percent from the floor. The Blue Hose, who shot 62.2% against Asheville, are 4-1 since 2007. It also marked the first time this season PC has fallen after shooting over 50% from the field. Since 2007, the Blue Hose are 26-15 ... Through nine Big South games, Mutakabbir is averaging 17.9 points, compared to his 15.9 a game overall. **JORDAN DOWNING** is averaging just over two points more in League play, 15.8 - 13.7 ... During the stretch, Mutakabbir has posted three 20-point games in the last three of four games, and had double-digit points in all but one. Downing has scored in double-figures in all nine games and had a career-high 26 against Winthrop.

## UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville picked up two big road wins last week to raise its record to 13-10. The Bulldogs edged PC, 77-74 and then knocked off Campbell on Saturday, 78-61 ... **JEREMY ATKINSON** led the Bulldogs with 22 points in each game ... **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** had a big week as well with a double-double at PC with 18 points and 10 rebounds. He then tallied 17 points with six rebounds at Campbell ... The Bulldogs have now won 13 of their last 16 Big South Conference games on the road, including Tournament play ... The Bulldogs' game at VMI Friday night is a rematch of the 2012 Big South Conference championship game.

## WINTHROP EAGLES

The Eagles had their first 2-0 week in Big South play this season, picking up a win over South Division foe Coastal Carolina and North Division foe Liberty ... The Eagles were solid defensively in the two games, holding Coastal to 48 points and combining to hold its two opponents to 52 points per game. Opponents shot 36 percent from the field and just 27 percent behind the arc ... The Coastal victory marked just the third time all season Winthrop won after trailing at the half. The win over Liberty was the fourth straight, which is the longest current win streak over any Big South team ... Junior **JOAB JEROME** had a career-high 18 points against Liberty and averaged 13.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists on the week while shooting 47 percent ... The two wins inched the Eagles closer to 300 wins all-time at the Winthrop Coliseum as they are now at 298. Winthrop has four more chances to reach the 300-win plateau this season.
