Harper averaged 16.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in helping the Runnin' Bulldogs to two key Big South road wins last week. Harper, who was averaging just 9.1 points in his last seven games entering the week, tallied 16 points and nine rebounds at UNC Asheville on Feb. 13. He pulled down seven of his eight offensive rebounds in the second half to help GWU to a 16-1 advantage in second-chance points in the period, while his two free throws with 3.8 seconds left gave the Runnin' Bulldogs a three-point lead. Harper then scored 17 points and had five rebounds in Saturday's win at Coastal Carolina. He made a career-high 13-of-16 free throws in finishing as the team's leading scorer

HIGH POINT CLINCHES SHARE OF NORTH DIVISION CROWN, FIRST ROUND BYE

High Point has clinched at least a share of the Big South's North Division as well as a first round bye in the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship. The Panthers are 10-3 in Conference games and need one victory for the outright Division title. It is High Point's first-ever Big South regular-season men's basketball crown.

15-FOOTERS

UNC Asheville has won at least 15 games in six consecutive seasons, tied for the second-longest streak in Big South history. It is also their 15th 15-win season since the Conference was formed, which ranks as the second-most in League history. Meanwhile, High Point has recorded its first 15-win season since the 2009-10 season and its sixth overall as Big South members. Gardner-Webb has also reached 15 wins in a season for the first time since joining the Conference in 2008-09 and its 16 wins are the most since winning 16 in 2007-08.

TEN-TAMOUNT

High Point has notched its first 10-win Big South season since 2009-10 and fourth overall. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville needs one more Big South victory for its sixth consecutive 10-win Conference season. The Bulldogs' current streak is already the second-longest in League annals, as the record is nine by Winthrop from 1999-08. Once Asheville wins its 10th Big South game of the year, it would be its ninth season with at least 10 Conference victories and the second-most in Conference history. Winthrop holds that record as well with 10 overall 10-win Big South seasons. Charleston Southern is one Big South win away from its second-straight 10-win League season.

STAN'S THE ONLY MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is the first player in Big South history with at least 1,900 career points (1,987), 800 career rebounds (894) and 100 career blocked shots (100). Okoye needs six rebounds to join High Point's **ARIZONA REID** as the only players with 1,900 career points and 900 rebounds. Reid had 2,069 points and 1,013 rebounds in his career from 2004-08.

LEADING MINUTE MAN

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** is on record as the Big South's all-time leader for career minutes played with 4,356 after breaking the mark of 4,178 on Feb. 2 at High Point. He surpassed the record that was first established by Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (2005-09). Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 37.26 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category.

BAUCOM'S BALLERS

With VMI's **STAN OKOYE** ranking eighth all-time in League history with 1,987 points, Keydet head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** owns the distinction of coaching four of the Big South's all-time Top 10 scorers. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (2004-08) is the Conference's career leader with 2,556 points, and **CHAVIS HOL-MES** (2005-09) is sixth with 2,065. Okoye is eighth and **KEITH GABRIEL** (2008-12) is 10th with 1,925 career markers. In fact, VMI has the most representatives in the Top 10. High Point is second with two of the League's all-time Top 10 scorers.

BIG SOUTH'S "BB&T GAME OF THE WEEK" ON ESPN3 RESUMES MARCH 2

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 resumes next Saturday with the UNC Asheville at Winthrop regular-season finale airing live beginning at 4:00pm. MATT HOGUE (play-by-play) and NATE ROSS (analyst) will call the action from the Winthrop Coliseum in Rock Hill, S.C. For the first time, ESPN3 carried a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games are scheduled Feb. 23 due to BracketBusters).

HOME EQUITY

The longest active home win streak in League contests belongs to High Point at nine. The Panthers moved to the top of the list after UNC Asheville's streak of 10 consecutive home Big South wins ended Feb. 13 against Gardner-Webb. Following High Point with the longest active home Big South win streak is Gardner-Webb at two wins.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** is fourth in the Big South with 16.6 points per game and third with 10 20-point contests. He is the seventh-highest scoring freshman in the nation, and his per game clip is the highest for a Big South frosh since **SETH CURRY** averaged 20.2 points for Liberty in **2008-09**. Meanwhile, Brown's League ranking is the highest for a freshman since Curry finished second among the Conference's scoring leaders in '08-09.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (255) and Big South victories (153). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 284-305 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 255-254.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 12 times in their young career (seven times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 11-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 12 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

DIVIDE AND CONQUER

With one crossover divisional game remaining — VMI at Charleston Southern on Thursday, Feb. 21 — the South Division leads the head-to-head meetings, 21-14 (=60.0 percent) after 35 games. The host teams have won a combined 21 games, with the South Division squads 12-5 at home while going 9-9 on North Division home courts. A GAME OF MARGINS

After 77 Conference games this season, the home teams are 48-29 (=62.3 percent) -- the highest home winning percentage since the 2007-08 campaign when home teams won 66.1 percent of the League match-ups. Of the 77 games this season, 39 have been decided by double figures by an average of 15.95 points, while the 38 games decided by less than 10 points have been by an average of 5.05. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season thus far is 10.57 points.

MORE ON COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** needs one victory to tie the all-time coaching win record at the Institute of 116 wins, currently held by **BART BELLAIRS**. On Jan. 16, Baucom collected his 150th career win as a collegiate head coach with the Keydets' 76-57 win over Campbell. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** became the 11th head coach in League history with 100 wins at a Conference member as he reached the milestone with the Buccaneers' 79-75 win at Liberty on Jan. 26.

FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is fifth all-time in Big South history with 736 career field goals, and is 34 away from moving into fourth-place. Okoye surpassed 400 career made free throws last week to become the 13th player with 400 freebies. He is now just the third player in Big South history with 700 career field goals and 400 career free throws (408).

TRIPLE THREAT

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** eclipsed 200 career three-point field goals this past Saturday at UNC Asheville, becoming the 31st player in Big South history to achieve the milestone. With 201 career treys, he is the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining **JAMARCO WARREN** (337 from 2007-11), **BRETT LARRICK** (234 from 1993-97) and **CHRIS MOORE** (206 from 2004-08).

2.000-POINT ODYSSEY

VMI senior **STAN OKOY**E is 13 points away from becoming the eighth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points. He would be the third Keydet on the list, which is detailed below:

LITTLE BIG MAN

Charleston Southern 5-8 sophomore guard **SAAH NIMLEY** recorded back-to-back 20-point, 10-rebound games for the Buccaneers Jan. 26-30, and posted his third such effort Feb. 13 at Winthrop with 24 points and 10 boards. He tallied a 20-point, 10-assist game earlier this season against The Citadel on **Dec. 4**, and is the first Big South player since VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 to post a 20-point/10-rebound and 20-point/10-assist game in the same season. Meanwhile, in Big South games this year, Nimley is averaging 17.8 points (3rd in the Big South), 6.9 rebounds (8th) and 5.92 assists (4th).

BIG SOUTH'S ACTIVE 1,000-POINT CLUB

Three Big South players have surpassed 1,000 career points this year, and the Conference has five active 1,000-point scorers on the court this season -- with Coastal Carolina the lone member with two active 1,000 point scorers. UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** is ninth all-time in Big South history with 165 career blocked shots and needs two to move into eighth. He is also tied for 63rd in Big South history with 530 career rebounds, and is just one of 18 players in League annals with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots. Meanwhile, Cunningham has recorded 67 of his career-high 78 blocked shots this season in his last 20 games, an average of 3.35 in that span.

DJC-II

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON** is tied for 16th in Big South history with 145 career blocked shots and is 19 away from reaching the League's Top 10 in the category. Covington's 72 blocks are a career-high, and he is averaging personal-bests of 14.4 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.00 blocked shots this year.

TOPPING THE CHARTS

UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** remains second in the nation in free throw percentage with a 93.8 success rate as he has made 91-of-97 attempts this season -- just 1.2 percentage points off the national leader. His school-record streak of 45 consecutive free throws came to end Jan. 26 against High Point, and had a streak of 24 end this past Saturday against Charleston Southern. Hornsby is challenging the Big South single-season free throw record of 92.5 percent that was established by Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** in 1993-94. Hornsby also has a chance to become the first Big South player in history to lead the NCAA in free throw shooting.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 111. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 645 Division I wins and is 34th all-time in Division I victories. HEIR APPARENTS

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. After 23 games into their sophomore seasons, Nimley is at 16.3 per game and Harper is averaging 15.0 points. Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

PASS HAPPY

Presbyterian College sophomore **ERIC WASHINGTON**, High Point senior **JAIRUS SIMMS** and Longwood guard **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** all have more assists than field goal attempts this season. Washington has 126 assists compared to 114 field goal attempts, while Simms has the largest margin -- 77 assists compared to 49 shots. Woodhouse has handed out 126 assists while taking just 101 attempts from the floor.

GRAB AND GO

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the Big South's scoring leader with 21.1 points and rebounding leader with 9.3 points. If he can maintain his top ranking in both categories, he would be the first player since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10 and just the fifth in League history to lead the Big South in scoring and rebounding. Meanwhile, Okoye is looking to become the fourth different player in the Conference record books to average at least 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in the same season.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** is 34th all-time with 658 rebounds and needs three to move past Charleston Southern's **JEFF DANIELS** (660 from 1993-97) for 33rd-place. Law, who became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest, is 19 rebounds shy of entering the Conference's Top 30 rebounders.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,085 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 10 in both scoring and rebounding, as he is eighth with 1,987 career points and 5th with 894 rebounds. He joins VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 9th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

DIME-ONDS IN THE ROUGH

Six players have combined for 13 10-assist games this season, with Charleston Southern's **SAAH NIM-LEY**, Presbyterian College's **ERIC WASHINGTON** and Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leading the way with three each. Last season, eight Big South players combined for 16 games with at least 10 assists, but just two players had more than one 10-assist performance. The last time the Big South had three players with at least three games with 10 helpers was before the 2004-05 season.

DOWNTOWN DOWNING

Presbyterian College redshirt-sophomore **JORDAN DOWNING** is leading the Big South with a 43.9 overall three-point field goal percentage (61-of-139), based on a minimum 2.0 3FG made per game. In a nine-game stretch from Dec. 18-Jan. 19, Downing was 29-of-50 from long distance (=58.0 percent) to bring his season percentage at the time to a League-leading 43.6 clip. The Davidson transfer was just 15-of-51 from beyond the arc (=29.4) after his first 10 games with the Blue Hose.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

WILL PAST HISTORY REPEAT FOR THE BUCCANEERS?

Charleston Southern was the League's last undefeated team in Big South play with its 7-0 start. Prior to this season, a total of 11 teams started the Big South season 7-0 since 1985-86, and each of those squads went on to win or share the regular-season crown. In addition, seven teams that opened 7-0 have won the Conference Tournament title -- the last being UNC Asheville in 2011-12, while another three finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

- (A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- (B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;
- (C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- (D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- (F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would considered, and so forth until the tie is broken:
- (G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;
- (H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;
- (I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.
- (J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

Charleston Southern senior quard **JEREMY SEXTON** set a Big South single-game record for highest three-point percentage in a Conference game after going 8-of-9 (=88.9 percent) from beyond the arc Jan. 19 against High Point. The record, based on a minimum 7 made 3FG, was previously 77.8 percent. In fact, Charleston Southern now has four of the top five individual single-game three-point field goal percentage in a Big South game following Sexton's performance.

PERFECTO MUNDO

Presbyterian College went a perfect 16-of-16 from the free throw line Jan. 26 at Longwood, the third time a Big South member has recorded a 100.0 free throw percentage in a game when making at least 16 from the charity stripe -- and the second time in a Conference game. UNC Asheville holds the alltime mark of 24-of-24 against High Point on Feb. 18, 2000, while Liberty was a perfect 18-of-18 from the line against Hampton on Dec. 17, 2011.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

Campbell senior DARREN WHITE was selected to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District 3 Team Jan. 31, and now moves onto the national ballot for Academic All-America. It is the second-straight year and the seventh time in the last eight seasons that the Big South has had an Academic All-District honoree. The last time the Conference had a CoSIDA Academic All-American was in 2008-09 (Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN**).

CAMPBELL'S FREEMAN NAMED A COUSY AWARD CANDIDATE

Campbell sophomore point guard TREY FREEMAN was named among the initial candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Dec. 20. The Watch List was narrowed to 20 on January 10, and the final 12 were named on February 7. The final five will be revealed in March, with the winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award to be announced at the Final Four in April.

CBSSPORTS.COM HONORS HIGH POINT'S ALLAN CHANEY

High Point graduate student ALLAN CHANEY was recognized by CBSSports.com as the outlet's Midseason Comeback Player of the Year on Jan. 10. Chaney overcame a heart ailment and is averaging 14.3 points and 7.9 rebounds this season for the Panthers. He also ranks third in the Big South in free throw shooting (85.) and fourth in field goal percentage (51.3).

WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

AGONY OF DEFEAT

The Big South suffered a total of 43 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games was 5.56 points. UNC Asheville suffered six of its eight non-Conference losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams lost a combined 24 non-League games under 10 points (5.67 average) while the South Division squads dropped 19 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.42 points.

MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a threeyear agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

NORTH DIVISION

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell ended a 6-game losing streak with Saturday's 87-78 victory over VMI. The Camel bench outscored the Keydet reserves, 60-18, sparked by career-high performances from **ANDREW RYAN** (27 points) and **ANTWON OLIVER** (17). **RECO McCARTER** added a career-best 10 rebounds, plus his top scoring outing (14) in Big South play off the bench ... **TREY FREEMAN** dealt a career-high 14 assists against VMI, second-most in CU history behind **DAN POGUE**'s school record 16 ... In Wednesday's 82-80 loss to Liberty, Freeman scored 18 of his team-leading 22 points in the 2nd half, and also handed out 8 assists, while **DARIUS LEONARD** tallied a career-high 17 points.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point clinched a share of the Big South North Division with its win over Liberty on Saturday. It will be High Point's first championship (regular season or tournament) in men's basketball ... HPU's 10-3 start matches 2006-07 for the program's best record through 13 Big South games. HPU went 11-3 that season, the 11 wins being an all-time high for the Panthers ... High Point was the first Big South team to 10 League wins for the first time since joining the Conference in 1999-00 ... The Panthers have won six games in a row for the first time since Jan. 6-22, 2007. That was part of an eight-game winning streak.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty has alternated wins and losses in its last eight games, beginning with its 74-47 win over Longwood on Jan. 22 ... In Liberty's win at Campbell, **TAVARES SPEAKS** posted a career-high 28 point ... **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** concluded Liberty's game against High Point with a game-high 23 points. Sanders leads the Flames with five 20-point games this season ... Sanders is now 25th all-time on Liberty's career scoring list with 850 points ... **DAVON MARSHALL** (68) needs six more three-pointers to surpass **MATT HILDEBRAND** (73) for the fifth-most three-point field goals by a Flame in a single season ... In its last eight games, Liberty is shooting 80.6 percent from the foul line, making 145-of-180 free throw attempts.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood won its first Conference home game this past Saturday, leading from start to finish while defeating Radford, 76-61 in Willett Hall. TRISTAN CAREY scored a career- and game-high 31 points, adding a game-high 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the season and fourth of his career. Freshman LUCAS WOODHOUSE tied his career-highs with 12 points and a game-high 11 assists for his second double-double ... Longwood plays its final home game on Feb. 19 against Liberty, a game to be televised on MASN and ESPN3, before returning to the road at Tennessee-Martin on Feb. 23 in the 2013 Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

JAVONTE GREEN recorded his 8th double-double this season with 20 points and a career-high 16 rebounds vs. VMI on Feb. 13. That followed a 23-point, 13-rebound performance at Liberty and a 27-point, 13-rebound game vs. Presbyterian. He now has 15 career double-doubles ... **RASHUN DAVIS** had a career-high 18 points at VMI last week ... The Highlanders have raised their free throw shooting percentage 30 points from .618 to .648 on the year ... Radford is 5-0 this season when holding opponents under 60 points.

VMI KEYDETS

D.J. COVINGTON scored a career-high 31 points and grabbed a career-tying 15 rebounds at Campbell Saturday. For the week, he averaged 23.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, shot 69 percent from the floor and had five blocks and six steals over the two games. He has posted double-doubles in two of the last three games and now has six on the season ... Freshman guard **TIM MARSHALL** tied a season-high with 18 points against Campbell ... **STAN OKOYE** was held under double figures scoring for just the second time this season when he tallied 9 points at Campbell. It marked the fewest points for Okoye in a game this season since the Wright State game when he scored seven points ... **JOE CARR** made his first start of the season against Campbell when he was inserted for **RODNEY GLASGOW**, who was slowed by an injury and was limited to just five minutes against the Camels. It was just the third different starting lineup combo used by the Keydets this year ... VMI will play its next four games over an eight-day stretch beginning with a home game against High Point Tuesday night. The Keydets have dropped three straight at home after beginning the year 7-1.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

The Bucs are within a half game of High Point for first overall in League play and have a half-game lead in the South Division ... Charleston Southern dropped its first game last week at Winthrop, 70-65, on Wednesday. The Bucs started the game just 1-of-24 from three-point range before rallying to cut the lead to three in the final minute ... The late rally built momentum heading into Saturday's showdown at UNC Asheville, as the Bucs finished strong in a 73-65 win over the Bulldogs. CSU put together a 21-6 run over the final 10 minutes as six different Bucs scored down the stretch to give the Bucs the season sweep ... SAAH NIMLEY and ARLON HARPER combined for 35 points, 14 rebounds and 13 assists at UNC Asheville ... The Bucs play three times in five days this week, beginning with Conference home games against Presbyterian on Tuesday and VMI on Thursday.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants picked up their second road win of the season last week but saw their eight-game home winning streak come to an end. Coastal defeated Presbyterian, 60-53 on Wednesday before falling at home to Gardner-Webb, 70-63 ... The Chants were led by senior **ANTHONY RAFFA** who averaged 17.5 points per game while knocking down nine 3-pointers ... Freshman **BADOU DIAGNE** led the post players with 8.5 rebounds per game along with 6.0 points ... Coastal currently sits in fourth in the South Division with three Conference games to play. The Chants are two games back from second-place UNC Asheville and host the Bulldogs on Tuesday.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb has won three games in a row for the second time this season, and is also on a hot streak with six wins in its last seven ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have their most wins since going 16-16 in 2007-08 ... Gardner-Webb is a combined 11-2 in home and neutral site games this season (9-2 at home, 2-0 neutral) ... GWU has made 24 free throws in two of its last three games, and 67 free throws overall in its last three games -- three more than its opponents have attempted during that stretch ... GWU swept the regular season series over UNC Asheville for the first time since joining the Big South Conference, and swept Coastal Carolina for the first time since 2008-09.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The Blue Hose are fifth in the nation in free throw percentage (77.0) ... ERIC WASHINGTON is averaging 6.6 assists per game. If that holds up he will shatter PC's Division I season record of 3.5 set by PIERRE MILLER in 2010-11. Washington already has the career assists mark with 4.3 ... Through 13 Big South games, KHALID MUTAKABBIR is averaging 16.1 points, compared to his 15.3 a game overall. JORDAN DOWNING is averaging just under two points more in league play, 14.3 compared to 13.2 ... Mutakabbir needs just 11 points to move into PC's Division I career record books in the category and 12 points to become the first player in PC's Division I history to reach 1,500 career points.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville had its first-ever losing streak at Kimmel Arena as the Bulldogs dropped two League games at home this past week to Gardner-Webb and Charleston Southern ... The Bulldogs' two-game losing streak in League play is the first since dropping three in a row early in the 2010-11 Big South season ... JEREMY ATKINSON scored in double figures in both games last week and has scored in double figures in 34 of the last 35 games ... KEITH HORNSBY had his streak of 24 straight free throws end against CSU ... TRENT MEYER scored a career-high 27 points against Charleston Southern and knocked down seven treys in the contest ... Asheville has been out-rebounded in three straight games ... The Bulldogs have won three-straight Big South road games but will get a very tough test Tuesday night at Coastal Carolina.


WINTHROP EAGLES
