Carey averaged 31.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 steals in two games last week. He opened his week with career-highs of 40 points and 12 rebounds in the Lancers' 102-101 win over Liberty on Feb. 19. Carey was 8-of-15 from three-point range and 12-of-22 overall from the field against the Flames. On Saturday at Tennessee-Martin, he scored a game-high 23 points with four three-pointers, three assists, one steal and one block. For the week, Carey was 21-of-40 from the field ( =52.5), 12-of-25 from three-point range ( =48.0) and 9-of-12 from the charity stripe ( =75.0).

### HIGH POINT CLINCHES NORTH DIVISION CROWN

High Point is the outright North Division champion and the No. 1 North Seed in the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship. The Panthers earn a bye into the quarterfinals, which is bestowed upon the top two teams in each division. High Point is 11-3 in Conference games -- tied for its best mark in Big South play, and captures its first-ever Big South regular-season men's basketball crown.

### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN CLINCHES SHARE OF SOUTH DIVISION TITLE, FIRST ROUND BYE

Charleston Southern has clinched at least a share of the South Division title as well as a first round bye in the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championships. The Buccaneers are 11-3 in Conference games and needs one victory for the outright crown. Even if CSU ends in a three-way tie with UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb for the division championship at 11-5, the Bucs would finish second in the multi-team tie in that scenario and therefore receives the bye.

### BIG SOUTH'S "BB&T GAME OF THE WEEK" ON ESPN3 CONCLUDES MARCH 2

The Big South "BB&T Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 concludes this Saturday with the UNC Asheville at Winthrop regular-season finale airing live beginning at 4:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the Winthrop Coliseum in Rock Hill, S.C. For the first time, ESPN3 carried a Big South match-up every Saturday of the Conference season (no League games were scheduled Feb. 23 due to the Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters).

### 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** became the eighth player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Feb. 19 against High Point, and is on pace to finish as the League's No. 5 all-time scorer. Okoye is the third Keydet on the Big South's 2,000-point list, which is detailed below:

### 15-FOOTERS

UNC Asheville has won at least 15 games in six consecutive seasons, tied for the second-longest streak in Big South history. It is also their 15th 15-win season since the Conference was formed, which ranks as the second-most in League history. Meanwhile, High Point has recorded its first 15-win season since the 2009-10 season and its sixth overall as Big South members. Gardner-Webb has also reached 15 wins in a season for the first time since joining the Conference in 2008-09 and its 18 wins are the most since winning 18 in 2004-05. Lastly, Charleston Southern has recorded its third consecutive 15-win season, the longest streak for the Bucs since 1994-97.

### TEN-TAMOUNT

High Point has notched its first 10-win Big South season since 2009-10 and fourth overall, while Charleston Southern has its second-straight 10-win Conference campaign and fourth overall as well. It is the first time the Bucs have posted back-to-back 10-win Big South seasons in school history. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville needs one more Big South victory for its sixth consecutive 10-win Conference season. The Bulldogs' current streak is already the second-longest in League annals, as the record is nine by Winthrop from 1999-08. Once Asheville wins its 10th Big South game of the year, it would be its ninth season with at least 10 Conference victories and the second-most in the record books. Winthrop holds that record as well with 10 overall 10-win Big South seasons.

### STAN'S THE ONLY MAN

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is the first player in Big South history with 2,000 career points (2,037), 900 career rebounds (912) and 100 career blocked shots (100). Okoye is the second player in League annals with 2,000 points and 900 boards, joining High Point's **ARIZONA REID**. Reid had 2,069 points and 1,013 rebounds in his career from 2004-08.

### DIVIDE AND CONQUER

The South Division "won" the first season of the Big South's crossover divisional games in men's basketball, as the South teams finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division. The host teams won a combined 22 games, with the South Division squads finishing 13-5 at home while going 9-9 on North Division home courts. The teams will crossover once again in the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship, beginning in the first round. ### LEADING MINUTE MAN

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** is on record as the Big South's all-time leader for career minutes played with 4,428 after breaking the mark of 4,178 on Feb. 2 at High Point. He surpassed the record that was first established by Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (2005-09). Mutakabbir has averaged 1,117 minutes played per season, and his average of 37.17 minutes played per game this year leads the Conference -- which would mark his fourth-straight year leading the League in the category.

### BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-freshman **JOHN BROWN** is fourth in the Big South with 17.0 points per game and is tied for the second-most 20-point contests with 12. He is the fifth-highest scoring freshman in the nation, and his per game clip is the highest for a Big South frosh since **SETH CURRY** averaged 20.2 points for Liberty in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Brown's League ranking is the highest for a freshman since Curry finished second among the Conference's scoring leaders in '08-09.

### STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (255) and Big South victories (153). Now in his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 284-307 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 255-256.

### BAUCOM'S BALLERS

With VMI's **STAN OKOYE** ranking seventh all-time in League history with 2,037 points, Keydet head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** owns the distinction of coaching four of the Big South's all-time Top 10 scorers. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (2004-08) is the Conference's career leader with 2,556 points, and **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2005-09) is sixth with 2,065. Okoye is seventh and **KEITH GABRIEL** (2008-12) is 10th with 1,925 career markers. In fact, VMI has the most representatives in the Top 10. High Point is second with two of the League's all-time Top 10 scorers.

### HOME EQUITY

The longest active home win streak in League contests belongs to High Point at nine. The Panthers moved to the top of the list after UNC Asheville's streak of 10 consecutive home Big South wins ended Feb. 13 against Gardner-Webb. Following High Point with the longest active home Big South win streak is Gardner-Webb at three wins.

### WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 12 times in their young career (seven times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 11-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 12 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

### A GAME OF MARGINS

After 84 Conference games this season, the home teams are 53-31 (=63.1 percent) -- the highest home winning percentage since the 2007-08 campaign when home teams won 66.1 percent of the League match-ups. Of the 84 games this season, 43 have been decided by double figures by an average of 15.98 points, while the 41 games decided by less than 10 points have been by an average of 4.88. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season entering the final week is 10.56 points.

**MORE ON COACHING WINS...**

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** needs one victory to tie the all-time coaching win record at the Institute of 116 wins, currently held by **BART BELLAIRS**. On Jan. 16, Baucom collected his 150th career win as a collegiate head coach with the Keydets' 76-57 win over Campbell. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** became the 11th head coach in League history with 100 wins at a Conference member as he reached the milestone with the Buccaneers' 79-75 win at Liberty on Jan. 26.

**FIELD (GOAL) GENERAL**

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is fifth all-time in Big South history with 755 career field goals, and is 21 away from moving into fourth-place, which is currently occupied by Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** (775 from 1989-93). Okoye surpassed 400 career made free throws Feb. 13 to become the 13th player with 400 freebies. He is now just the third player in Big South history with 700 career field goals and 400 career free throws (414).

**TRIPLE THREAT**

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** eclipsed 200 career three-point field goals Feb. 16 at UNC Asheville, becoming the 31st player in Big South history to achieve the milestone. With 203 career treys, he is the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining **JAMARCO WARREN** (337 from 2007-11), **BRETT LARRICK** (234 from 1993-97) and **CHRIS MOORE** (206 from 2004-08).

**GOING GREEN**

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** is 13th all-time in Big South history with 472 career assists after surpassing Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN** (469 from 1995-00) and High Point's **MIKE JEFFERSON** (470 from 2005-08) last week. Greenwood, who became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he eclipsed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls, is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

**LITTLE BIG MAN**

Charleston Southern 5-8 sophomore guard **SAAH NIMLEY** recorded back-to-back 20-point, 10-rebound games for the Buccaneers Jan. 26-30, and posted his third such effort Feb. 13 at Winthrop with 24 points and 10 boards. He tallied a 20-point, 10-assist game earlier this season against The Citadel on Dec. 4, and is the first Big South player since VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 to post a 20-point/10-rebound and 20-point/10-assist game in the same season. Meanwhile, in Big South games this year, Nimley is averaging 17.2 points (4th in the Big South), 6.6 rebounds (8th) and 5.85 assists (4th).

**BIG SOUTH'S ACTIVE 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Three Big South players surpassed 1,000 career points this year, and the Conference has five active 1,000-point scorers on the court this season -- with Coastal Carolina the lone member with two active 1,000 point scorers. **THE D.J.'S**

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** leads the Big South with 81 blocked shots, while VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is a close second with 79 rejections. Cunningham's total is the eighth-most in a Big South single-season, while Covington's swats are the 10th-highest single-season output.

**DJC-I**

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** is eighth all-time in Big South history with 168 career blocked shots. He is also 59th in Big South history with 545 career rebounds, and is just one of 18 players in League annals with 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots. Meanwhile, Cunningham has recorded 70 of his career-high 81 blocked shots this season in his last 22 games, an average of 3.18 in that span.

**DJC-II**

VMI junior **D.J. COVINGTON** is 16th in Big South history with 152 career blocked shots and is 12 away from reaching the League's Top 10 in the category. Covington's 79 blocks are a career-high, and he is averaging personal-bests of 14.7 points, 7.3 rebounds and 2.93 blocked shots this year.

## TOPPING THE CHARTS

UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** remains second in the nation in free throw percentage with a 93.8 success rate as he has made 91-of-97 attempts this season -- just 1.5 percentage points off the national leader. His school-record streak of 45 consecutive free throws came to end Jan. 26 against High Point, and had a streak of 24 end Feb. 16 against Charleston Southern. Hornsby is challenging the Big South single-season free throw record of 92.5 percent that was established by Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** in 1993-94. Hornsby also has a chance to become the first Big South player in history to lead the NCAA in free throw shooting.

## CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESEL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 112. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 646 Division I wins and is 34th all-time in Division I victories. ## 7-UP

Charleston Southern's 7-0 Big South start was its best since opening the 1986-87 League season 10-0 and marked the program's second-ever 7-0 opening. It is the third-straight season that a Big South member opened League play at least 7-0 (12th all-time), and the Buccaneers are the fourth League member with at least two 7-0 starts to the Conference season.

## HEIR APPARENTS

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have replaced UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** as the Big South's top guard tandem. As freshmen last season, Nimley scored 420 points (13.5 points per game), while Harper tallied 389 markers (12.5 per game). By comparison, Dickey scored 338 points (10.9 average) and Primm had 280 (9.0 a game) as freshmen in 2008-09. Nearing the completion of their sophomore seasons, Nimley is at 16.0 per game (24 games) and Harper is averaging 14.8 points (26 contests). Primm averaged 12.5 points as a sophomore in 2009-10, while Dickey scored 11.5 that season.

## PASS HAPPY

Presbyterian College sophomore **ERIC WASHINGTON**, High Point senior **JAIRUS SIMMS** and Longwood guard **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** all have more assists than field goal attempts this season. Washington has 135 assists compared to 129 field goal attempts, while Simms has the largest margin -- 85 assists compared to 51 shots. Woodhouse has handed out 147 assists while taking just 114 attempts from the floor.

## GRAB AND GO

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the Big South's scoring leader with 20.6 points and rebounding leader with 8.9 boards. If he can maintain his top ranking in both categories, he would be the first player since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10 and just the fifth in League history to lead the Big South in scoring and rebounding. Meanwhile, Okoye is looking to become the fourth different player in the Conference record books to average at least 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in the same season.

## LAW ENFORCEMENT

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW** is 33rd all-time with 662 rebounds and needs five to move past Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (666 from 2006-10) for 32nd-place. Law, who became the 41st player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 5 at Wake Forest, is 13 rebounds shy of entering the Conference's Top 30 rebounders.

Longwood freshman guard **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** has recorded five games with at least 10 assists, the most in the Big South since last season when Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** had eight. Woodhouse's season total of 147 helpers is the most by a Big South freshman since **CHRIS GAYNOR** handed out 152 in his freshman year at Winthrop in 2004-05. Woodhouse needs three assists to become the fourth freshman in League history with at least 150 in a season. He is the top assist man in Conference games with 7.21 per contest.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,123 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. **WHERE THEY RANK?**

As mentioned previously, UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 255 career victories. VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is tied for sixth in League history with 115 career wins, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is eighth with 112 career victories. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is three wins away from moving into the Top 10.

**LENDING A HELPING HAND**

Presbyterian College sophomore guard **ERIC WASHINGTON** is averaging 7.00 assists in his last 11 games, and 6.43 on the season. He has played in 21 of PC's 29 games this season (=72.4 percent) and does not meet the League or NCAA minimum (75 percent of games played) to be ranked among the overall statistical leaders. Washington's 135 assists this season include seven games with eight, including three with 10, and his 6.50 assist average in Conference games ranks second in the League.

**CLIMBING THE CHAIN OF COMMAND**

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** is the third player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 10 in both scoring and rebounding, as he is seventh with 2,037 career points and 5th with 912 rebounds. He joins VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (1st - scoring, 9th - rebounding) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (5th - scoring, 2nd - rebounding).

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play for the first time in 2012-13, the Conference will utilize a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference has developed a new tiebreaker for this new divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, if necessary.

**TOURNAMENT SEEDING**

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

**TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE**

(A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;

(B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;

(C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;

(D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;

(F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;

(G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;

(I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

(J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

## THE NEW 40

Longwood junior guard **TRISTAN CAREY** scored a school Division I record 40 points vs. Liberty on Feb. 19 with a school Division I record eight three-pointers in the contest. It is the highest single-game scoring output in the Big South this season, and almost a year to the day since the Conference's previous 40 point game -- Feb. 22, 2012. That night, **NICK BARBOUR** poured in 44 points at home against Campbell.

## TURN OF THE CENTURY

Longwood defeated Liberty 102-101 on Feb. 19, marking the first Big South game since Jan. 2, 2010 that both squads scored 100 points in the same contest. Liberty was involved in that game as well, as the Flames defeated VMI, 110-102. The combined 203 points for Longwood-Liberty were the most combined points in a Big South game since Feb. 13, 2010 when UNC Asheville (114) and VMI (97) combined for 211. Meanwhile, Liberty scored 100 points in a Big South game for the fifth time, but it was the Flames' first loss when reaching the century mark in points.

## BUCCANEERS GRAB A REPEAT OF BIG SOUTH HISTORY, LOOKING FOR THE SECOND PHASE

Charleston Southern's clinching of at least a share of the South Division title marks the 12th time in League history that a team that started at least 7-0 in Big South games went on to win or share the regular-season crown. Meanwhile, CSU is looking to join seven teams that opened 7-0 that eventually won the Conference Tournament title -- the last being UNC Asheville in 2011-12. Another three finished as Big South Tournament runner-up.

## HEAD OF THE CLASS

Campbell senior **DARREN WHITE** was selected to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-America Team as a Third-Team selection. He is the Big South's first CoSIDA Academic All-American since Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN** in 2008-09, and the eighth such honoree in League history.

## DIME-ONDS IN THE ROUGH

Eight players have combined for 17 10-assist games this season, with Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leading the way with five games. Last season, eight Big South players combined for 16 games with at least 10 assists, but just two players had more than one 10-assist performance. The last time the Big South had three players with at least three games with 10 helpers was before the 2004-05 season. The last time the Conference had 17 individual 10-assist games was in 2007-08.

## DOWNTOWN DOWNING

Presbyterian College redshirt-sophomore **JORDAN DOWNING** is leading the Big South with a 43.9 overall three-point field goal percentage (61-of-139), based on a minimum 2.0 3FG made per game. In a nine-game stretch from Dec. 18-Jan. 19, Downing was 29-of-50 from long distance ( =58.0 percent) to bring his season percentage at the time to a League-leading 43.6 clip. The Davidson transfer was just 15-of-51 from beyond the arc ( =29.4) after his first 10 games with the Blue Hose.

## MID-MAJOR MANIA

The Big South has had a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 seven consecutive seasons, and has had six programs receive votes in this year's weekly ranking. Below is a look at this year's rankings among the Big South members:

## FEBRUARY'S FINEST

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** is the Big South's leading scorer in the month of February this season, as he is averaging 21.4 points in seven games this month. Longwood's **TRISTAN CAREY** (20.7) and UNC Asheville's **JEREMY ATKINSON** (20.4) are also averaging 20 points in February games. Radford's **JAVONTE GREEN** is hauling in a League-best 9.1 rebounds in February, while Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** is averaging 8.29 assists this month. Asheville's **TRENT MEYER** is tops with 2.86 steals. VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is the League's top shooter thus far in the month of February, as he is making 61.7 percent of his field goals (58-of-94), while Atkinson and Liberty's **DAVON MARSHALL** are both 90.0 percent free throw shooters (Atkinson - 90.7, Marshall - 90.0).

## HE'S SEXTON AND HE KNOWS IT

Charleston Southern senior guard **JEREMY SEXTON** set a Big South single-game record for highest three-point percentage in a Conference game after going 8-of-9 ( =88.9 percent) from beyond the arc Jan. 19 against High Point. The record, based on a minimum 7 made 3FG, was previously 77.8 percent. In fact, Charleston Southern now has four of the top five individual single-game three-point field goal percentage in a Big South game following Sexton's performance.

## PERFECTO MUNDO

Presbyterian College went a perfect 16-of-16 from the free throw line Jan. 26 at Longwood, the third time a Big South member has recorded a 100.0 free throw percentage in a game when making at least 16 from the charity stripe -- and the second time in a Conference game. UNC Asheville holds the all-time mark of 24-of-24 against High Point on Feb. 18, 2000, while Liberty was a perfect 18-of-18 from the line against Hampton on Dec. 17, 2011.

## CAMPBELL'S FREEMAN NAMED A COUSY AWARD CANDIDATE

Campbell sophomore point guard **TREY FREEMAN** was named among the initial candidates for the 2013 Bob Cousy Award, as announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Dec. 20. The Watch List was narrowed to 20 on January 10, and the final 12 were named on February 7. The final five will be revealed in March, with the winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award to be announced at the Final Four in April.

## CBSSPORTS.COM HONORS HIGH POINT'S ALLAN CHANEY

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** was recognized by *CBSSports.com* as the outlet's Midseason Comeback Player of the Year on Jan. 10. Chaney overcame a heart ailment and is averaging 14.2 points and 7.8 rebounds this season for the Panthers. He also ranks third in the Big South in both free throw shooting (84.8) and field goal percentage (52.0).

## AGONY OF DEFEAT

The Big South suffered a total of 48 non-Conference losses this season by single digits, and the average margin of defeat in those games was 5.60 points. UNC Asheville suffered seven of its nine non-Conference losses by eight points-or-less -- including three-straight by an average of 3.0 points. The North Division teams lost a combined 27 non-League games under 10 points (5.81 average) while the South Division squads dropped 21 out-of-Conference games by single-digits by an average of 5.33 points.

## WHILE WE WERE AWAY ON BREAK...

The week of Dec. 17-23 was a memorable one for the Big South. In a four-day span from Dec. 19-22, the Conference collected wins over members from the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC. Coastal Carolina opened the victory parade with a 69-46 win over Clemson -- the Chanticleers' second consecutive win over the Tigers. UNC Asheville followed with a 72-65 victory at St. John's on Dec. 21 -- the Bulldogs rallied from 17 points down for the win. Winthrop concluded the run with a 74-67 win at Auburn on Dec. 22.

## MORE ON THE BIG SOUTH'S LATEST BIG WINS

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, and the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has now collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

## MYRTLE BEACH MADNESS

The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held at Coastal Carolina University's new on-campus arena, The HTC Center, in the first year of a three-year agreement to host the Conference's marquee event. It will be a combined tournament for the seventh time in League history and the first same site event since 2002 when the Conference staged its basketball postseason in Roanoke, Va. The combined tournament will feature all Big South men's and women's basketball teams -- 23 in total.

## CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell improved to 3-0 in overtime games last week when the Camels won a 72-66 decision at Radford. **ANDREW RYAN** scored 9 of his 20 points in the OT period, while **TREY FREEMAN** finished with a team-leading 21 points for CU, which swept the season series from the Highlanders and moved into 2nd place in the league standings ... In Saturday's BracketBusters game against Savannah State, **RECO McCARTER** hit career highs with 21 points and 12 rebounds, but the Camels dropped a 69-63 decision ... Freeman has moved into a tie for 4th-place on Campbell's single-season assists list (172) with **BRAD CHILDRESS**, who also had 172 dishes in the 1988-89 campaign. Freeman is just 11 assists shy of moving into 6th-place on the school's career list. He has 283 career dishes in 58 games (4.9 per outing) ... **MARVELLE HARRIS** is three blocks away from moving into 5th-place in school history.

## HIGH POINT PANTHERS

The Panthers' Big South North Division Championship is HPU's first Big South title of any kind in men's basketball ... High Point's seven-game winning streak from Jan. 30 to Feb. 19 was the team's longest since an eight-game winning streak from Dec. 22, 2006 to Jan. 22, 2007 ... HPU is 12-4 since Dec. 29 ... High Point's win at VMI last Tuesday was the Panthers' first win at Cameron Hall since the 2007-08 season.

## LIBERTY FLAMES

Against Longwood, **DAVON MARSHALL** finished with a career-high 31 points, including 29 in the second half, marking the first time a Liberty player has scored 30 points or more since **KYLE OHMAN** recorded 39 in a 76-67 win over High Point on Feb. 20, 2010 ... **JR CORONADO** grabbed a career-high 18 rebounds against Austin Peay, setting a Vines Center record for most rebounds in a single game ... Marshall's trio of three-point field goals against Austin Peay gives him 77 on the season. The junior is now fourth all-time in program history for most three-point field goals in a single season. Marshall needs eight more treys to surpass **ANTHONY SMITH** (84 in 2007-08) for the No. 3 spot ... **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** is averaging 20.8 ppg in the last six games and needs 12 points to reach 900 for his Liberty career.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

**TRISTAN CAREY's** 40-point effort last week against Liberty is the fifth-highest, single-game scoring total in the 37-year history of the program, and the most points scored in a game since 2000-01 (41) ... His eight three-pointers against the Flames are the third-highest total in the history of the program, only behind the school-record nine three-pointers made in a game by two different players ... Carey led the Lancers at Tennessee-Martin with his game-high 23 points, including four three-pointers. He has scored 94 points in his last three games, an average of 31.3 per game, while making 31-of-57 field goals (54%), including 16-of-33 three-pointers (48%) and 16-of-21 free throws (76%) ... **KYLE ZIEGLER** added career-highs of 14 points and seven rebounds before fouling out at UTM. **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** had 10 points and tied his career-high with a game-high 11 assists for this third double-double.

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford lost back-to-back overtime games last week ... The Highlanders can still claim the No. 2 seed in the North with two wins this week coupled by two losses by Campbell and VMI.

## VMI KEYDETS

VMI's game at Liberty on Tuesday, Feb. 26 will be VMI's fifth contest over an 11-day span ... VMI's six-game losing skid is its longest since a 12-game streak from Jan. 18, 2005 to Feb. 23, 2006 ... Junior point guard **RODNEY GLASGOW** has missed VMI's last three games with a groin pull ... **STAN OKOYE** last week became the fifth VMI player to surpass the 2,000 point mark in Keydet history. Okoye stands eight rebounds away from becoming the second all-time leading rebounder at VMI and moving past **BILL RALPH** (1952-54) and is 24 points away from the fourth spot on the all-time scoring list held by **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2006-09) ... **D.J. COVINGTON** scored 18 points in just 20 minutes against Marist Saturday night and hit his first career three-pointer. He has averaged 19 points and 58% from the floor his last six games ... Freshman guard **TIM MARSHALL** started his first collegiate game for shooting guard **BRIAN BROWN**, who was slowed by illness. Brown played seven minutes off the bench.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

Junior forward **ALLIE FULLAH** had a career-high in the opening nine minutes against PC last week and finished with 13 points in the win over the Blue Hose. The Bucs raced to a 21-7 lead and led throughout in the win ... CSU found its shooting touch on Thursday night against VMI for its third-straight Big South win. The Bucs buried 14-of-25 three-point attempts to top the Keydets. Senior **MATHIANG MUO** knocked down 7-of-8 triples, one off the Big South record for percentage in a game, to lead the way. He had 23 points, while **ARLON HARPER** added 21 and **JEREMY SEXTON** added 19 ... CSU dropped its final game of the week in Lawrenceville, N.J., falling to Rider, 61-54. The Bucs had an 18-6 edge in offensive rebounds and +5 in turnover margin, but was just 4-of-19 from behind the arc,

## COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chanticleers went 1-1 last week with a one-point victory at home over UNC Asheville and a 10-point loss on the road at Western Carolina ... Coastal was led by senior **ANTHONY RAFFA**, who averaged 20.5 points and 3.0 steals per game. Raffa had 22 points in the win over Asheville and 19 in the loss to WCU ... The Chants are now 11-3 at home this season and just 2-10 on the road ... **KIERRE GREENWOOD** recently became the winningest four-year player in Coastal Carolina basketball history as he was part of his 88th win in a Coastal uniform Tuesday night against Asheville. CCU's record with Greenwood on the roster is 88-38.

## GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb was at its best defensively last week, posting a 2-0 record and holding its opponents to an average of 52.0 ppg in the two games ... GWU allowed just 37.5 percent shooting for the week overall and only a 26.8 percent effort from long range ... GWU also forced an average of 16 turnovers per game in the pair of victories ... The team's 18 wins are the most in a season since 2004-05, the same year Gardner-Webb won the Atlantic Sun Conference regular-season crown (18-12) and advanced to the league's tournament title game before losing to Central Florida ... During its current 5-game win streak, Gardner-Webb is limiting opponents to just 60.0 ppg and have made more free throws (108) than its five opponents have attempted (95) during the stretch -- shooting a solid 75.0 percent from the stripe ... Nearly half (75) of the team's 182 rebounds during this span have come on the offensive end ... Gardner-Webb's RPI rose the No. 192 on Monday after its win over top-150 rated College of Charleston on Saturday.

## PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The 68-65 win over The Citadel this past Saturday snapped a 10-game losing streak against the Bulldogs and gave PC a 2-2 overall record in BracketBuster games ... **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** became the school's Division I scoring leader last week, surpassing **AL'ONZO COLEMAN's** record of 1,499 points ... At 1,524 points, Mutakabbir ranks eighth all-time ... The Blue Hose are ninth in the nation in free throw percentage (76.1). Mutakabbir is 35th in the NCAA in FT shooting with 86.2%.

## UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville lost two heartbreakers last week on last-second shots. Coastal Carolina edged the Bulldogs, 65-64 on Tuesday night on a shot with 5.9 seconds left and then Jacksonville State defeated Asheville on a tap-in as the buzzer sounded, giving the Gamecocks a 71-69 win. The Bulldogs played both games without second-leading scorer **KEITH HORNSBY**, who hurt his shoulder Monday in practice. However, sophomore guard **COREY LITTLEJOHN** stepped up and played very well in his place. He scored 12 points at CCU and then had a career-high 19 points and seven rebounds vs. Jacksonville State ... **JEREMY ATKINSON** almost willed the Bulldogs to a win on Saturday with 29 points ... Asheville finishes up the regular season with two League games, including a home game against PC on Wednesday and then a date at Winthrop on Saturday. The Bulldogs need two wins to seal their third-straight winning season.

## WINTHROP EAGLES

The Eagles are winless on the road in Conference play at 0-7 and have one last chance to pick up a road win on Wednesday at Coastal Carolina. In three of the team's last four road games, the Eagles have held double-figure leads and lost the game ... After losing starting forward/center **LARRY BROWN** two weeks ago, the Eagles suffered another blow with the loss of their starting guard and leading scorer **DERRICK HENRY** at the start of last week. In his absence, junior **JOAB JEROME** took over the role of the go-to-player and he averaged 14.5 points last week ... Winthrop had five players score in double-figures in its win over Southeastern Louisiana, the first time since Nov. 20, 2004 vs. Troy that Winthrop achieved the feat ... The win over Southeastern Louisiana was a big win in the history of the Winthrop program as it marked the 300th victory at the Winthrop Coliseum for the men's basketball team. The win over Southeastern Louisiana evened the Eagles to 4-4 all-time in BracketBuster contests.
