BIG SOUTH SENDS RECORD FOUR TEAMS TO POSTSEASON

For the first time in Big South history, four men's basketball teams are playing in the postseason in the same year. **LIBERTY** received the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN** is making the Conference's fourth NIT appearance. **GARDNER-WEBB** and **HIGH POINT** have accepted invitations to participate in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT), marking the third time the Big South will play in that event. It is the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has multiple men's basketball teams playing in the postseason.

LIBERTY GRABS BIG SOUTH'S NCAA AUTO BID FOR FIRST TIME IN NINE YEARS

Big South champion Liberty is making its third-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, tied for the second-most in Big South history. The Flames also went to the Big Dance in 1994 and 2004. It is Liberty's first postseason appearance since 2009 when the Flames went 1-1 in the CIT.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN IN POSTSEASON FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 1997

South Division champion Charleston Southern will make its first postseason appearance in 16 years as the Buccaneers will represent the Big South in the NIT. CSU secured the overall No. 1 seed in the Big South Championship and the League's automatic berth to the NIT. It will be the Buccaneers' second postseason appearance as Big South members and first since the 1997 NCAA Tournament.

GARDNER-WEBB, HIGH POINT IN POSTSEASON FOR FIRST TIME AS DIVISION I MEMBERS

Gardner-Webb's and High Point's upcoming appearance in the CIT will be the first postseason appearance for both schools at the Division I level. The Runnin' Bulldogs' last postseason appearance came in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2000, which was the program's final season at that level. The Panthers' last postseason berth was in the 1997 NCAA Division II Tournament.

THEY'VE GOT THE HATS!!

According to STATS, Inc., Liberty is the fourth team since 1996-97 to have started the season 0-8 or worse and make the NCAA Tournament. The others are Arkansas-Pine Bluff (0-11 in 2009-10), Mississippi Valley State (0-8 in 2007-08) and Florida A&M (0-10 in 1998-99). Meanwhile, Liberty is just the second team in history to make the NCAA Tournament with 20+ losses. The other was Coppin State in 2007-08 (16-20 entering tourney).

FANNING THE FLAMES

Liberty will set the Big South single-season record for most games played when the Flames play their NCAA Tournament game on Tuesday. It will be the squad's 36th contest of the year, breaking the previous League record of 35 -- first set by Liberty in 2008-09 and matched by Coastal Carolina in 2009-10.

LIBERTY CAPTURES 2013 BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE IN UNPRECEDENTED FASHION

The Liberty Flames are the first team in Big South history to win the Conference Tournament championship out of the first round following their amazing 4-0 run last week. Officially the No. 5 seed in the North Division, the Flames would have been the No. 10 seed in a traditional top-to-bottom bracket. Liberty opened with a 78-61 victory over No. 4 South seed and host Coastal Carolina (No. 5 overall), followed by a one-point win over No. 1 North seed High Point (No. 2 overall). The Flames then defeated No. 2 South seed Gardner-Webb (No. 3 overall), 65-62 and knocked off No. 1 South seed and overall No. 1 Charleston Southern by nine points in the title game. Liberty was the third team to reach the Championship game from the first round.

HIGH POINT WINS NORTH DIVISION

High Point was the outright North Division champion and the No. 1 North Seed in the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship. The Panthers went 12-4 in Conference games -- its most League wins since joining the Big South, and captured their first-ever Big South regular-season men's basketball crown.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN CLAIMS SOUTH DIVISION

Charleston Southern won the South Division title with its 12-4 Conference mark -- the Buccaneers' first Big South regular-season title since 1986-87. While High Point and CSU both finished 12-4 in League play, the Buccaneers were declared the overall No. 1 seed based on winning the regular-season head-to-head meeting with the Panthers.

20/20 VISION

Gardner-Webb is the Big South's lone 20-win team this season, as the Runnin' Bulldogs have won 21 games thus far. It is GWU's most wins since achieving full Division I membership in 2002-03. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern is sitting at 19 wins, and a victory in the first round of the NIT would give the Buccaneers their first 20-win season since 1986-87.

BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Liberty is 0-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Flames are making their third trip to the Big Dance, tied for second-most in Big South history.

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history through last season:

MARSHALL PLAN

Liberty junior and Big South Tournament MVP **DAVON MARSHALL** made a Big South Tournament record 17 three-point field goals and was 17-of-24 (=70.8 percent) from beyond the arc in the Conference Tournament. Marshall now has 101 three-pointers on the season and needs one to tie the Liberty school record of 102 that was established by **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09. Marshall's next three-point bucket will also push him into the Big South's single-season Top 10 as well.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern sophomore guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 13 times in their young career (eight times this season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 12-1 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 13 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

HOLTMANN NAMED FINALIST FOR HUGH DURHAM AWARD

Gardner-Webb head coach and Big South Coach of the Year **CHRIS HOLTMANN** is one of 21 finalists for the 2013 Hugh Durham Award as the nation's top Mid-Major coach. He is the Big South's first finalist since 2010-11 and sixth overall. The 2013 award will be presented at the Final Four in April. Former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** won the award in 2006-07.

SANDERS ON CUSP OF ENTERING BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** needs eight points to become the fourth Big South player this season and 117th in League history to reach 1,000 career points. The League had five active 1,000-point scorers on the court this season. Below is a look at those five players and their all-time ranking:

SAND SCULPTURE

In his last 12 games, Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** has averaged 19.1 points, 4.9 rebounds and 5.0 assists in leading the Flames to an 8-4 record in that span -- including the Big South Conference Tournament championship. He is 70-of-154 from the field (=45.5) and 76-of-92 from the free throw line (=82.6) with five 20-point games. Prior to the 12-game spurt, Sanders was averaging 11.6 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.7 assists.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT RECAP

As mentioned previously, Liberty was the first team to win the Big South Championship coming out of the first round, and was technically the second No. 5 seed to win the title in Tournament history, joining UNC Asheville in 2003. However, Liberty's overall seeding would have been No. 10, so the Flames receive the nod as the lowest seed ever to win the Conference championship. The 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship also had two overtime games -- the most since a record three in 2003, and featured the first true neutral site title game since '03 as well. The No. 1 overall seed also reached the Championship game for the 10th-straight year. Meanwhile, teams that led at halftime were 10-1 in the Tournament (No. 2 North seed VMI lost to CSU in the Semifinals despite a five-point lead at the break).

KESSENS SETS BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT SINGLE-GAME SCORING RECORD

Longwood freshman **MICHAEL KESSENS** scored 36 points in the Lancers' quarterfinal loss against VMI, breaking the Big South Tournament record for most points in a game. The previous record was 35 points, first set by Liberty's **JAMAAL BENNETT** in the 1999 Quarterfinals against UNC Asheville and later tied by Radford's **KENNY THOMAS** in the 2009 Semifinals against the Bulldogs.

CROSSOVER DRIBBLE

The North Division finished 7-4 against South Division teams in the 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship, which included the Conference Championship trophy. During the regular-season, the South Division "won" the first season of the Big South's crossover divisional games in men's basketball, as the South teams finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division. The host teams won a combined 22 games, with the South Division squads finishing 13-5 at home while going 9-9 on North Division home courts. Both Charleston Southern and UNC Asheville went 6-0 against the North Division in the regular-season.

OKOYE RECEIVES ALL-DISTRICT HONORS FROM USBWA

VMI forward and Big South Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** has been named to the USBWA's All-District III team. He is the first Big South player to receive this honor since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10.

Liberty junior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,227 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 992 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

LITTLE BIG MAN

Charleston Southern 5-8 sophomore guard **SAAH NIMLEY** recorded back-to-back 20-point, 10-rebound games for the Buccaneers Jan. 26-30, and posted his third such effort Feb. 13 at Winthrop with 24 points and 10 boards. He tallied a 20-point, 10-assist game earlier this season against The Citadel on Dec. 4 and a second one against Radford on Jan. 5 (20-11). He is the first Big South player since VMI's **TRAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 to post a 20-point/10-rebound and 20-point/10-assist game in the same season. Nimley enters the postseason with six double-doubles this season.

HEIR APPARENTS

Charleston Southern's sophomore backcourt of **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** are arguably the Big South's top guard tandem. Both earned a spot on the 2012-13 All-Conference Team and All-Tournament Team, and have led CSU to its first postseason berth since 1997. Nimley averages 15.7 points while Harper is close behind at 15.2 points. The duo's efforts are reminiscent of UNC Asheville's All-Conference guard duo of **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** -- and perhaps slightly ahead. Dickey/Primm combined for 1,365 points during their freshman and sophomore seasons with no postseason appearances. Nimley/Harper have combined for 1,733 points thus far with an upcoming NIT game. However, Dickey/Primm combined for 2,102 points and two NCAA Tournament berths during their junior and senior seasons. Stay tuned.

TRIPLE THREAT

Charleston Southern senior **JEREMY SEXTON** is 26th all-time in Big South history with 207 career 3-point field goals. He eclipsed the 200 mark on Feb. 16 at UNC Asheville, becoming the 31st player in Big South history to achieve the milestone. He is the fourth Buccaneer on the list, joining **JAMARCO WARREN** (337 from 2007-11), **BRETT LARRICK** (234 from 1993-97) and **CHRIS MOORE** (206 from 2004-08).

7-UP

Charleston Southern's 7-0 Big South start was its best since opening the 1986-87 League season 10-0 and marked the program's second-ever 7-0 opening. It is the third-straight season that a Big South member opened League play at least 7-0 (12th all-time), and the Buccaneers are the fourth League member with at least two 7-0 starts to the Conference season.

BUCCANEERS GRAB A REPEAT OF BIG SOUTH HISTORY

Charleston Southern's South Division title marks the 12th time in League history that a team starting at least 7-0 in Big South games went on to win or share the regular-season crown.

STAN'S THE ONLY MAN

Big South Player of the Year **STAN OKOYE** of VMI is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 career points (2,146), 900 career rebounds (962) and 100 career blocked shots (103). Okoye is the second player in League annals with 2,000 points and 900 boards, joining High Point's **ARIZONA REID**. Reid had 2,069 points and 1,013 rebounds in his career from 2004-08.

GRAB AND GO

Big South Player of the Year and VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** led the Big South with 21.5 points and 9.4 rebounds, becoming just the fifth player in League history to lead the Conference in scoring and rebounding in the same year. The last to do it was Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10. Okoye is also just the fourth different player in the League record books to average at least 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in the same season.

LEADING MINUTE MAN

Presbyterian College senior **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** finished his career as the Big South's all-time leader for career minutes played with 4,542 after breaking the mark of 4,178 on Feb. 2 at High Point. He surpassed the record that was first established by Liberty's **ANTHONY SMITH** (2005-09). Mutakabbir averaged 1,135.5 minutes played per season, and his League-leading 37.25 average minutes played per game this year marked his fourth-straight campaign leading the Big South in the category.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-freshman and Big South Freshman of the Year **JOHN BROWN** is just the second freshman in League history to be named First-Team All-Conference, joining Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** (1989-90). Brown, who is out for the rest of the year with a broken foot, is fourth in the Big South with 16.4 points per game and tied for the third-most 20-point contests with 12. He was the 6th-highest scoring freshman in the nation as of March 17, and his per game clip is the highest for a Big South frosh since **SETH CURRY** averaged 20.2 points for Liberty in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Brown's League ranking is the highest for a freshman since Curry finished second among the Conference's scoring leaders in '08-09.

2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** finished his career fourth on the Big South's all-time scoring list with 2,146 career points. He became the eighth player in Big South history to score 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Feb. 19 against High Point, and is the third Keydet on the Big South's 2,000-point list, which is detailed below:

LAW OF GRAVITY

High Point redshirt-senior **COREY LAW**, who is tied for 26th all-time in Big South history with 684 rebounds, is the 2013 "Dark Horse Dunker" winner and will participate in the Denny's Slam Dunk Competition at the State Farm College Slam Dunk & 3-Point Championships in Atlanta April 4 at 7 p.m. ET on ESPN. Law, who was selected for his "dynamic combination of power and elevation," is the Big South's second Slam Dunk representative in three years. UNC Asheville's **JOHN WILLIAMS** competed in 2011 and finished as the Runner-Up.

A GAME OF MARGINS

With the completion of the 96-game Conference season, the home teams went 61-35 (.63.5 percent) -- the highest home winning percentage since the 2007-08 campaign when home teams won 66.1 percent of the League match-ups. Of the 96 games this year, 51 were decided by double figures by an average of 15.86 points, while the 45 games decided by less than 10 points were by an average of 4.89. Overall, the average margin of victory in the League season was 10.72 points.

GOING GREEN

Coastal Carolina senior guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD** finished his career 13th all-time in Big South history with 481 career assists. Greenwood, who became the 22nd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he eclipsed the milestone Dec. 13 against Toccoa Falls, is the third Chanticleer to make the Conference's all-time assist list, joining **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 from 1987-91) and **ALVIN GREEN** (411 from 2000-05).

THE D.J.'S

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** and VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** tied for the League-lead with 93 blocked shots -- the most in the Big South since UNC Asheville's **KENNY GEORGE** had 93 rejections in 2007-08. It is just the second time in Conference history that two players blocked at least 90 shots in the same year. The first was in 1994-95 when UMB's **PASCAL FLEURY** had 124 and Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** had 97. Cunningham and Covington had more blocks than five Big South teams this season, and their 93 are tied for fifth-most in a single-season in League annals.

DJC-I

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** is eighth all-time in Big South history with 180 career blocked shots and is 20 away from becoming the sixth player with 200. He is also 58th on the Big South's career rebounding list with 553. Already one of 10 players in League annals with 500 rebounds and 150 blocked shots, Cunningham is on pace to become the fifth player in Big South history with 600 rebounds and 200 blocks in 2013-14.

DJC-II

Big South 2012-13 Defensive Player of the Year **D.J. COVINGTON** of VMI is tied for ninth in Big South history with 166 career blocked shots. He enters 2013-14 needing 79 rebounds for 500 in his career, which would make him the 11th player in League history with 500 boards and 150 rejections.

TOPPING THE CHARTS

UNC Asheville sophomore **KEITH HORNSBY** remains second in the nation in free throw percentage with a 92.5 success rate as he made 99-of-107 attempts this season -- just 1.6 percentage points off the national leader. His percentage ties the Big South single-season record that was first established by Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND** in 1993-94. This season Hornsby had a school-record streak of 45 consecutive free throws made and another streak of 24.

BAUCOM'S BALLERS

With VMI's **STAN OKOYE** ranking fourth all-time in League history with 2,146 points, Keydet head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** owns the distinction of coaching four of the Big South's all-time Top 10 scorers. **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (2004-08) is the Conference's career leader with 2,556 points, and **CHAVIS HOLMES** (2005-09) is seventh with 2,065. **KEITH GABRIEL** (2008-12) is 10th with 1,925 career markers. In fact, VMI has the most representatives in the Top 10. High Point is second with two of the League's all-time Top 10 scorers.

OKOYE'S BRILLIANT FOUR-YEAR CAREER

VMI's **STAN OKOYE** is the only player in the Conference record books to rank among the Top 4 all-time in both scoring and rebounding, as he is fourth with 2,146 career points and 4th with 962 rebounds.

FIELD GENERAL

VMI senior **STAN OKOYE** ends his career fourth all-time in Big South history with 788 career field goals and ninth with 441 career free throws. He is just the third player in Big South history with 700 career field goals and 400 career free throws.

NO KNOCK ON WOOD

Longwood freshman guard **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** set a Big South freshman-record with 180 assists this year, surpassing the previous best of 175 set by UNC Asheville's **JEFF LIPPARD** in 1990-91. Woodhouse recorded a League-high five games with at least 10 assists, the most in the Big South since last season when Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** had eight. Woodhouse was the top assist man in Conference games with 7.38 per contest and finished third in overall games with 5.75.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Presbyterian College sophomore guard **ERIC WASHINGTON** finished as the League leader in assists per game with 6.54, the eighth-highest single-season assist average in League history. His per game average is 13th-best in the NCAA and his 157 helpers this season included 10 games with eight and four with 10. His 6.44 assist average in Conference games ranked second in the League.

DIME-ONDS IN THE ROUGH

Eight players have combined for 19 10-assist games this season, with Longwood's **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leading the way with five games. Last season, eight Big South players combined for 16 games with at least 10 assists, but just two players had more than one 10-assist performance. The last time the Big South had three players with at least three games with 10 helpers was before the 2004-05 season. The last time the Conference had 19 individual 10-assist games was also prior to the 2004-05 campaign.

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

For the second consecutive year, the Big South recorded wins over the ACC, BIG EAST and SEC in the same season, marking the third time overall (1993-94 was the first). The Big South has collected an SEC victory six out of the last seven seasons, an ACC win five out of the last six years, and a BIG EAST win five out of the last nine seasons. The Big South has two BIG EAST wins in 2012-13.

THE NEW 40

Longwood junior guard **TRISTAN CAREY** scored a school Division I record 40 points vs. Liberty on Feb. 19 with a school Division I record eight three-pointers in the contest. It is the highest single-game scoring output in the Big South this season, and it occurred almost a year to the day since the Conference's previous 40 point game -- Feb. 22, 2012. That night, **NICK BARBOUR** poured in 44 points at home against Campbell.

TURN OF THE CENTURY

Longwood defeated Liberty 102-101 on Feb. 19, marking the first Big South game since Jan. 2, 2010 in which both squads scored 100 points in the same contest. Liberty was involved in that game as well, as the Flames defeated VMI, 110-102. The combined 203 points for Longwood-Liberty were the most combined points in a Big South game since Feb. 13, 2010 when UNC Asheville (114) and VMI (97) combined for 211. Meanwhile, Liberty scored 100 points in a Big South game for the fifth time, but it was the Flames' first loss when reaching the century mark in points.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

Campbell senior **DARREN WHITE** was selected to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-America Team as a Third-Team selection. He is the Big South's first CoSIDA Academic All-American since Gardner-Webb's **AARON LINN** in 2008-09, and the eighth such honoree in League history.

HE'S SEXTON AND HE KNOWS IT

Charleston Southern senior guard **JEREMY SEXTON** set a Big South single-game record for highest three-point percentage in a Conference game after going 8-of-9 (=88.9 percent) from beyond the arc Jan. 19 against High Point. The record, based on a minimum 7 made 3FG, was previously 77.8 percent. In fact, Charleston Southern now has four of the top five individual single-game three-point field goal percentage in a Big South game following Sexton's performance.

PERFECTO MUNDO

Presbyterian College went a perfect 16-of-16 from the free throw line Jan. 26 at Longwood, the third time a Big South member has recorded a 100.0 free throw percentage in a game when making at least 16 from the charity stripe -- and the second time in a Conference game. UNC Asheville holds the all-time mark of 24-of-24 against High Point on Feb. 18, 2000, while Liberty was a perfect 18-of-18 from the line against Hampton on Dec. 17, 2011.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

The Big South is in jeopardy of not having a member ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 for the first time since 2004, as the League's streak of eight consecutive seasons with a team rated among the Top 25 could end this season. The Big South has had six programs receive votes in this year's weekly ranking, which are detailed below:

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (256) and Big South victories (154). Having completed his 20th year as a collegiate head coach, Biedenbach is 285-309 in his career, while his record in 17 seasons as the Bulldogs' leader is 256-258.

MORE ON COACHING WINS...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is VMI's all-time winningest coach with 118 wins, breaking the previous school record of 116 on March 2. On Jan. 16, Baucum collected his 150th career win as a collegiate head coach with the Keydets' 76-57 win over Campbell. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** became the 11th head coach in League history with 100 wins at a Conference member as he reached the milestone with the Buccaneers' 79-75 win at Liberty on Jan. 26.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 113. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 647 Division I wins and is tied for 33rd all-time in Division I victories. VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is sixth in League history with 118 career wins, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is eighth with 113 career victories. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is tied for 10th all-time with 107.

TWO SCHOOLS ANNOUNCE COACHING CHANGES FOLLOWING BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT

Campbell announced on Monday, March 11 that head coach **ROBBIE LAING** would not return as head coach of the Camels. Laing was 114-185 in 10 years at the helm of the Campbell program, including 30-35 (18-16 Big South) in two seasons in the Big South Conference. On Thursday, March 14, Longwood announced that head coach **MIKE GILLIAN** resigned his post after 10 years leading the Lancers. He was 93-214 during his time in Farmville, including 8-25 (4-12 Big South) in his lone season in the Big South. Both schools have begun national searches for new coaches.
