Brown averaged 21.5 points per game and shot 70 percent from the field against two nationally-ranked squads last week. The guard/forward got her week started with 23 points on 8-of-10 from the field, 6-of-7 from the line and one from downtown against No. 24 Texas A&M on Nov. 20. She also chipped in four rebounds and one helper against the Aggies. Three days later at No. 3 Baylor, Brown connected on 62 percent of shots from the field and added two from three-point range and two from the line to finish with 20 points against the defending National Champions. In the post, Brown pulled down five rebounds, to go along with a pair of steals and two assists in the contest. The honor marks her first Player of the Week nod this season.

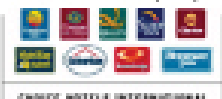

## BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

## NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. **FRED APPLIN** is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. **DeUNNA HENDRIX** is running the panthers, while **KEVIN COOK** has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

## IT'S ABOUT TO GET REAL

The Big South Women's Basketball Conference Slate opens up this week with Charleston Southern at Presbyterian College on Nov. 28. On Dec. 1, Campbell travels to UNC Asheville, while Liberty renews its rivalry at Radford. **CAMPBELL**

Campbell went 1-2 in a tough week that saw the Lady Camels defeat Mount St. Mary's 54-48 on the road...The first major test came at the ECU Pirate Thanksgiving Invitational, where **TONISHA BAKER** was named all-tournament, but Campbell fell to Appalachian State, 69-54 and host East Carolina, 74-54...The Lady Camels had a lead in the second half against the Mountaineers, 49-48 with 10:21, and later tied it at 54 with 7:50 remaining before App scored the final 15 points of the contest...ECU opened with a 21-4 run and cruised to the victory...Junior **ASHLEY JAMES** recorded a career-best four assists against the Mountaineers and pulled down seven offensive rebounds...Campbell was out-rebounded by just two, 38-40, against a much taller App St. team and won the rebounding battle against ECU, 33-32...The Lady Camels went 21-of-24 from the free throw line at ECU and made the first 13 during the contest.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern went 1-1 on the week, improving to 3-1 in the Fred Applin era as the Lady Bucs fell to N.C. State while topping Paine at home on Saturday... **DJ FOWLER** and **LAKEITHA ALSTON** nearly had double-doubles against the Lions as Fowler had 10 points - nine steals, while Alston had 15 points - nine rebounds... Alston led the Lady Bucs in scoring in both contests on the week with 19 points against NC State and 15 against Paine in averaging 17.0 points per game...The Lady Bucs open conference play on Wednesday against Presbyterian before playing their second ACC opponent in the season next weekend as CSU takes on Wake Forest.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina finished the week with a 2-1 record, picking up home wins against Columbia (SC) and Southern Virginia before falling on the road at IPFW ... With its two home wins the Chants improved to 4-0 at The HTC Center this season ... **SHATIA COLE** led Coastal in scoring, averaging 15.3 points per game ... The sophomore tied her career-high with 22 points against Columbia ... **AJ JORDAN** (13.3), **ANGELICA HENRY** (12.7) and **ALEX PUCKETT** (10.0) also averaged double-figure outputs on the week ... Freshmen **RESSA BORKOVICH** and **MEGAN PITTMAN** along with walk-on sophomore **CORINNE HOLLAND** each recorded their first career points during the week ... Coastal opens conference play at Gardner-Webb on Saturday, Dec. 1.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Despite the Thanksgiving holiday, the Runnin' Bulldogs continued on with its 2012-13 season, going 1-1 over its two non-conference games during the break. GWU remained winless on the road and fell to 0-2 in away contests this season with a 84-43 loss at Appalachian State on Tuesday night, November 20th. GWU bounced back to snap its losing streak at two games with a 76-41 rout of Asbury University on Saturday night, November 24th. GWU, who was plagued by 34 turnovers in the loss at Appalachian State, shot over 49 percent and dished out 22 assists overall in the blowout win of Asbury. With the win, GWU improves to 4-0 at home on the year and matches its win total of all of last season. GWU, who out rebounded the Eagles of Asbury 51-33, are undefeated (4-0) this season when posting more rebounds than its opponents. In the win, GWU held Asbury to 20.4 percent shooting (11-of-54) for the game and outscored the Eagles 61-14 in points in the paint. GWU will not set its sights on Big South Conference play, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will look to remain unbeaten at home on the year with a home conference opener on Saturday, December 1st, at 3 p.m. versus Coastal Carolina.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point wrapped up a tough road trip with a loss at Xavier ... **CHEYENNE PARKER** led all players with 20 points and 13 rebounds in the loss ... The Panthers returned home to beat Bluefield College ... Four Panthers scored in double digits led by Lindsay Puckett with a season-high 15 ... Parker posted her fourth double-double in five games with 13 points and 17 rebounds ... Parker moved in to seventh place on HPU's all-time rebounding list with 712 rebounds ... She passed Arlene King who collected 710 rebounds from 1990-93 ... Parker's needs 33 rebounds to move in to sixth on the list ... Shamia Brown (2008-12) is currently sixth with 745 rebounds ... High Point hosts UAB on Tuesday before hitting the road for over a month ... The Panthers will not play another home game until Jan. 3 against Charleston Southern.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty went 0-2 on its Thanksgiving week Texas trip, dropping contests to a pair of nationally ranked teams, Texas A&M and Baylor ... The Lady Flames became just the ninth NCAA Division I women's basketball team ever to play each of the last two seasons' national champions in back-to-back games ... Liberty had held 58 straight opponents below 50 percent field goal shooting before both Texas A&M and Baylor made at least half of their shots ... The 92 points Baylor scored against Liberty were the most the Lady Flames have allowed in a game since Dec. 20, 2001, when Duke posted a 95-53 win over Liberty ... **DEVON BROWN** led all players in scoring in both games, totaling 23 points at Texas A&M and 20 at Baylor ... Brown became the fifth Liberty player and the 19th Big South Conference player ever to score 1,500 career points, finishing the week with 1,525 points for her career ... This week, Liberty will seek its 11th straight home win (vs. UNCG on Tuesday) and will try for its 12th victory in its last 13 Big South openers (at Radford on Saturday).

**LONGWOOD**

The Lancers are 1-4 so far this season. The squad dropped a 75-67 in its only game last week at Coppin State University on Nov. 20. Through five games, LU is led by senior **CHELSEA COWARD** with 18.0 points per game and 11.4 rebounds per game. Classmate **CRYSTAL SMITH** is second on the team with 12.6 points per game, followed by freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** with 11.4 points per game. Freshman **KHALILAH ALI** is second on the team with 5.4 rebounds per game. As a team, the Lancers are shooting 36% (111-311) from the field, including 29% (40-137) from beyond the arc, and 67% (51-76) from the foul line.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

Presbyterian College went 2-1 last week, topping Southern Wesleyan on Monday (62-50) and North Carolina Central on Saturday (49-37) while dropping a home contest to South Carolina State (55-60) on Wednesday... Senior center **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** scored her 1,000th career point on Saturday with six against NC Central. Pietrowski becomes the first women's basketball Blue Hose in the Division I era to hit the millennium mark and the first since Rebecca Wessinger last accomplished the feat on November 23, 2005. The Blue Hose will play host team Eastern Kentucky on Friday night before taking on either Jackson State or Marshall on Saturday.
