Smith, a senior from Richmond, Va., averaged 27.5 points per game and dished out 14 assists to lead the Lancers to a 2-0 Big South record last week. The guard got her week started with 32 points, including 12-of-12 from the line as Longwood defeated Gardner-Webb on Jan. 3. She also dished out five assists, ripped down six boards and came away with two steals in the win. Two days later against Winthrop, Smith narrowly missed a triple-double as she posted 23 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists in the win over the Eagles. The honor marks Longwood's first-ever Big South Player of the Week nod.

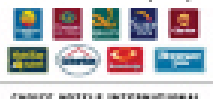

## BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. ## OFF TO A GREAT START

Presbyterian College is off to its best start since joining the Big South Conference. The Blue Hose are currently 4-0. Longwood has started its first-ever season in the Big South Conference in fine form as it is currently 3-0. The Blue Hose and the Lancers are the only undefeated teams in Conference play.

## RADICAL RANKINGS

The Big South Conference has had four squads receive attention on the National Mid-Major Poll at Col-legeInsider.com. Liberty, High Point, Winthrop and Campbell have either been ranked or recieved votes in the poll this season.

## ENJOYING THE VIEW

The Big South Conference currently has two players ranked in the Top 5 in the national individual stats. **CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point is currently ranked No. 1 with 13.9 rebounds per game. Her 4.15 blocked shots per game is good for No. 2 nationally to go along with a No. 2 national ranking with 11 double-doubles. ... Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has been shooting the lights out from downtown and is No. 2 in Division I with 3.43 triples per game.

## YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's **SHAQUILLA NUNN** is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

## BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.33 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.5 blocked shots per game.

## SCORE'N

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's **DEVON BROWN** put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while **CHEYENNE PARKER** notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer. **CRYSTAL SMITH** of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb.

## NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. **FRED APPLIN** is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. **DeUNNA HENDRIX** is running the Panthers, while **KEVIN COOK** has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME**

**MARIAH PIETROWSKI** became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)**

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)**

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

**DEQUESA**

**DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted five 20-point games this season, to go along with three games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with two 20-point, 10 assist games.

**QUEENS OF THE CAROM**

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with six consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 13 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16. Parker is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

Head Coach Wanda Watkins secured her 250th combined conference win in the Division I era, registering a 157-161 mark in the A-Sun and 93-34 record in the Big South... She has 488 in her career with the milestone 500th victory on the horizon... Campbell has a 10-4 overall and 2-1 league mark... The Lady Camels defeated Coastal Carolina, 64-64, on Jan. 3 as **KIERA GAINES** paced the team with 11 points and all five starters had at least eight points with every player dressing earning playing time... Campbell shot 38.7 from the field, but was out-rebounded for just the fourth time this year, 48-36... In the first half against Presbyterian, Campbell dictated the flow and cruised to a 40-19 halftime lead by shooting 53.3 percent from the field and a 6-of-10 performance from three-point range... The Blue Hose relentless defense took over in the second half as their offense put on a show by shooting 70.6 percent from the floor and tied the contest at 56 just before the final horn of regulation, which was aided by a scoreless stretch of the final 6:30 by the Lady Camels... After two treys from **MONIQUE SPRY** provided Campbell with a lead in the overtime period, Presbyterian scored the final seven points to secure the 68-62 OT win... Gaines led the Lady Camels with 14 points, including a career-best three made shots from behind the three-point arc and Spry added 12... Campbell nailed 11 three-point field goals, the most in a game since setting a Gore Arena record with 13 against UNC Asheville on 1/2/12.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern went 0-3 on the week, finishing up the 2012 schedule with a loss at home to College of Charleston, and fell twice in conference play on the road with losses to High Point and Coastal Carolina... **LAKEITHA ALSTON** continued moving up in the rankings, sitting seventh overall in the CSU scoring ranks with 1,205 career points... Alston recorded CSU's first double-double of the season on Saturday against Coastal Carolina with 17 points and 12 rebounds in the loss to the Chants... Senior guard **SHAY JONES** continued her incredible stretch from the free throw line to open the season, converting 18 of 20 attempts from the stripe this week and leads the Big South hitting 89.8% of her free throw shots this season... Charleston Southern continues BSC play this week, hosting Liberty and Longwood.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina went 1-1 on the week with a loss at Campbell (54-64) and a home win over Lowcountry rival Charleston Southern (64-56) ... The victory over Charleston Southern snapped Coastal's five-game losing streak and evened the team at 7-7 on the season and 2-2 in conference play ... **AJ JORDAN** led the Chanticleers in the scoring column in each game, finishing with 13 at Campbell and a career-high 21 against Charleston Southern ... **ALEXX PUCKETT** and **KATELYN CONNOR** also averaged double digits on the week as both finished with 10.5 points per game ... The Chants are now 6-1 at The HTC Center this season with its lone loss coming at the hands of then 19th-ranked North Carolina ... Coastal stays at home this week as High Point and Liberty come to Conway on Thursday and Saturday, respectively.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

The Runnin' Bulldogs entered the week on a three-game winning streak, yet saw that come to an end with two losses, both of which came on the road in conference play. GWU ran out to an 18-point lead over Longwood midway through the first half, but saw the lead evaporate early in the second half as the Lancers defeated the Runnin' Bulldogs 87-75, for the second time this season. GWU struggled in its loss to High Point on Saturday afternoon, as the Runnin' Bulldogs had its worst shooting performance of the season, shooting only 22.8 percent overall from the field. GWU will open up the three-game home stand with Campbell at 7 p.m. on Monday night and will then welcome Radford to Boiling Springs, N.C. for a midweek game at 7 p.m. on Thursday night. GWU's home stand and week will conclude with a 3 p.m. showdown with Winthrop on Saturday afternoon.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point went 2-0 for the week with two double-digit wins over Big South opponents ... The Panthers topped Charleston Southern 71-54 on Thursday ... Junior **CHEYENNE PARKER** led all scorers with 25 points and eight rebounds while redshirt-sophomore **STACIA ROBERTSON** added 18 points on 8-of-10 shooting ... The Panthers extend their win streak to four games with a 64-42 win over Gardner-Webb on Saturday ... Four Panthers scored in double-digits led by Parker with 16 points and 16 rebounds for her 12th double-double of the season ... **KENDRA WALLACE** and **LINDSAY PUCKETT** each had 16 points and Robertson added 12 ... The Panthers had 13 blocks in the game to bring their NCAA leading average to 10.3 per game.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty dropped its Big South home opener for the third consecutive year with a 51-49 loss to Presbyterian College on Thursday ... It was the Lady Flames' first-ever loss to the Blue Hose, after Liberty had won the teams' first nine head-to-head meetings ... Liberty then responded with its 12th consecutive victory over UNC Asheville on Saturday, a 75-49 win ... The Lady Flames have not lost back-to-back Big South games since Feb. 20 and 22, 1997 ... **DEVON BROWN** continues to climb the Big South career scoring list, as she currently ranks 11th in conference history with 1,725 career points ... In just 2.5 years as a Lady Flame, **TOLU OMOTOLA** has become the program's 20th-leading all-time rebounder with 530 career boards ... This week, Liberty will try to extend a couple of streaks ... The Lady Flames have won four straight road games and have posted 38 consecutive victories over Coastal Carolina.

**LONGWOOD**

Longwood University went undefeated at home last week, picking up two Big South Conference wins to improve to 6-8 overall and 3-0 in league play. The team defeated Gardner-Webb, 87-75, for the second time this season on Jan. 3 in its first home contest since Nov. 17. The Lancers then earned a 79-74 decision against Winthrop on Jan. 5. The squad's current three-game win streak is the longest for the program since 2007-08, when LU closed the year with five straight victories. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 36% (311-870) from the field, including 29% (99-342) from three-point territory, and 69% (181-262) from the free throw line. Senior **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who has led the team in scoring six times this season, leads the team with 15.8 points per game. Classmate **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has six double-doubles so far, is second with 15.6 points, and paces LU with 8.9 rebounds per game. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 11.9 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, January 10 when it travels to league opponent Presbyterian College for a 7 p.m. tilt.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

PC (9-6) enters the week with a 4-0 record in Big South Conference play for the first time following a 51-49 win at Liberty on Thursday and a 68-62 victory at Campbell on Saturday... The Blue Hose topped Liberty for the first time in 10 all-time meetings by holding the Flames to a season-low 28.1 shooting percentage (16-for-57), the first time the Flames have fallen below the 30 percent threshold this season... PC next rallied from a 21-point halftime deficit on Saturday to force overtime and top the Campbell Camels. The Blue Hose shot 70.6 percent (12-for-17) in the second half to outscore the home side 37-16 in the period and 12-6 in overtime. Dria David hit the game-tying FT with 1.6 seconds left and scored eight straight points in OT... **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** scored 17 points against Liberty and 20 against Campbell... The team's four-game league winning streak matches last year for the longest Big South winning streak in program history... **DRIA DAVID**, Pietrowski and **SHONA BURNSIDE** all played their 100th career games last week... The Blue Hose have rallied from halftime deficits in three of the last four games (UCF, Liberty and Campbell) to win after starting the season 0-6 in that category... In the second halves of PC's last four games, opponents are shooting 19.4 percent (25-for-111).

**RADFORD**

Radford utilized strong bench play and fended off a second-half comeback by UNC Asheville to prevail, 66-54, in Big South women's basketball action Jan. 3 inside the Dedmon Center. Ayana Avery and Ashley Buckhannon poured in double-figure efforts for the Highlanders with 14 and 11 points, respectively. **DIANI MASON** and **SARAH TABB** contributed nine points each. Kelli Riles knocked down 7-of-9 from the hardwood, in addition to a 6-for-6 performance from the charity stripe, on her way to game highs in points (20) and rebounds (10) for the Bulldogs. Riles became Asheville's all-time Division I leader in rebounding during the contest and now has 899 for her career. Shonese Jones and Brittany Gwyn registered 19 and 11 points, respectively, to round out three Bulldogs in double-figure scoring. The visitors finished with a 42.9-percent rate (18-of-42), while the Highlanders connected on 40.7 percent of their attempts (24-of-59). The Bulldogs also won the battle on the glass, 35-33. However, Radford got major contributions from the reserves as the squad outscored UNCA's bench, 38-15. The Highlanders also made a living in the paint, outscoring their opponent 34-20. Radford remains unbeaten at 5-0 when winning this category. Radford hits the road for its next two outings. First up is a Jan. 10 matchup at Gardner-Webb. Tipoff between the Highlanders and the Runnin' Bulldogs is set for 7:00 p.m. inside Paul Porter Arena.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, falling to Big South foes Radford and Liberty on the road. The Bulldogs dropped a 66-54 decision to Radford on Thursday, before falling to Liberty 75-49. In the game against the Highlanders senior forward **KELLI RILES** became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in rebounds in the NCAA Division era, pulling down 10 rebounds to reach 899 for her career, passing former Bulldog great Wendy Beecher (894). The all-time record at UNC Asheville is 2,200 boards, recorded by Sheila Ford from 1980-84, when the Bulldogs were an NAIA institution. Riles now has 900 for her career. The Bulldogs are now 2-13 on the season overall and 0-4 in Big South Conference play. Asheville is also 2-6 at home, 0-6 on the road and 0-1 in neutral site games. With the two losses on the road this week, the Bulldogs have now lost 22 consecutive road games. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. The Bulldogs have only one game this week, a home match against Big South foe Winthrop on Thursday evening at Kimmel Arena. The Eagles have won two in a row against Asheville.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop got a triple-double performance from **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** in the William & Mary game as she scored 14 points, dished out a season-high 12 assists, and grabbed a career-high 15 rebounds. She has tied Tammy Jones for 6th place on the Winthrop career scoring list with 1,276 points. **ASHLEY PORTER**, a 6-2 freshman center, who had scored 10 points in 77 total minutes in the first 13 games of the season, had 19 points and grabbed 9 rebounds against Longwood. She went 8 of 9 from the floor and was 3 for 3 from the foul line. **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** had her 8th double figure rebounding game of the season as she tied her season-high with 16 boards against Longwood.
