Baker, a senior from High Point, N.C., was named to the UNF Holiday Classic All-Tournament team after guiding the Lady Camels to the tournament title. The guard poured in a season-high 22 points and was one off a double-double with a season-best nine rebounds in a 66-53 win against Jacksonville State on Dec. 14. The next day, she totaled 17 points and six boards in the Lady Camels, 77-72, victory over UMES. Baker shot .593 from the field, going 16-for-27 in the two-game span and drilled three 3-point field goals in each game. Baker also contributed eight assists and five steals during the two contests.

Parker, a junior from Queens, N.Y., put in 22 points and ripped down 21 rebounds to lead the Panthers to a win over USC Upstate on Dec. 16. She connected on 47 percent of her shots from the field against the Spartans and added six blocks, five steals and one assist.

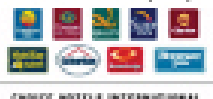

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. BALLERS

The Big South Conference currently has two players ranked in the Top 5 in the national individual stats. **CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 with 14.4 rebounds per game and is also No. 2 with eight double-doubles. Her 4.0 blocked shots per game is good for No. 2 nationally ... Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has been shooting the lights out from downtown and is No. 1 in Division I with 4.0 triples per game.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's **SHAQUILLA NUNN** is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State to rank No. 1 in the nation. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. **FRED APPLIN** is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. **DeUNNA HENDRIX** is running the panthers, while **KEVIN COOK** has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first last week as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted four 20-point games this season, to go along with two games with 10-more-assists. She is the only player in the Big South with two 20-point, 10 assist games.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading four players with consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in nine games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. CAMPBELL

Campbell is off to its best start, 8-2, since the 1991-92 season (8-2) after it claimed the UNF Holiday Classic by defeating UMES (77-72) and Jacksonville St. (66-53)... **TONISHA BAKER** and **KIERA GAINES** were named to the UNF Holiday Classic All-Tournament Team...Gaines posted a career-high 20 points for the Lady Camels against the Lady Hawks and contributed 8 points, 8 boards and 9 steals against Jacksonville State...Baker posted a season-high 22 points and 9 rebounds against Jacksonville State, while contributing 17 points and 6 boards against UMES...Head coach **WANDA WATKINS** now has 484 career victories and has entered the top-50 in wins amongst active coaches from all division (I,II,III)...Watkins is currently ranked 25th among active DI coaches...The 8-2 start is tied for the second-best in the Division I era with the 1991-92 squad, while an 11-2 start in 1987-88 is the best... Campbell plays its final home contest of 2012 on Thursday against Elon, before a test at ACC-foe Wake Forest on Dec. 29.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 0-1 this past week, falling to S.C. State in their first home loss of the 2012-2013 season...For the third game in a row, the Lady Bucs scored 57 points in the loss, having fallen to Presbyterian (58-57), Wake Forest (77-57) and S.C. State (73-57)... **LAKETHA ALSTON** entered the top 10 in CSU's all-time scoring ranks in the loss to the Lady Bulldogs, finishing with 10 points to surpass Joy Galloway in the rankings with 1,134 points...Alston is currently 26 points away from moving into ninth place in the scoring ranks... **ERIN BRATCHER** scored a season-high 17 points in the loss to S.C. State... Charleston Southern continues to be one of the top free throw shooting teams in the country, converting 10-of-12 attempts from the charity stripe this past week to put the season-rate at 80.6% as a team... CSU finishes up their pre-Christmas scheduling at home this week taking on Trinity Baptist on Monday and Western Carolina on Wednesday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina posted a 1-1 record on the week with a 70-43 win over Converse and a 75-49 loss to No. 19 North Carolina ... North Carolina became the first nationally-ranked team to play in the HTC Center ... The Chants' win over Converse saw **ANGELICA HENRY** (24 pts) **SHATIA COLE** (16 pts) and **KATELYN CONNOR** (15 pts) each score in double figures ... Henry's 24-point performance was a career-high and the most by a Chanticleer in a game since Sydnei Moss scored 25 against Liberty in the quarterfinal round of the 2011 Big South Tournament ... After starting the season with three straight home wins, the Runnin' Bulldogs have dropped its last three contests, all of which have come at home in Paul Porter Arena. GWU used a 19-2 run in the second half against the Davidson Wildcats, yet ran out of time in the end in a 59-56 home loss to the Southern Conference Preseason favorites last week. She needs six to reach fifth place currently held by Ethel White who collected 793 rebounds from 1976-79 ... Redshirt-sophomore **STACIA ROBERTSON** added 23 points and eight rebounds in the win ... Junior **TAYLER TREMBLAY** had 14 points and three assists ... The Panthers open Big South play on Tuesday at Winthrop ... HPU has won the last five meetings with the Eagles ... It is the fifth game of a seven-game road stretch for High Point.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 1-1 in a pair of home games last week ... The Lady Flames' 60-56 loss to North Carolina A&T on Saturday snapped the team's five-game winning streak and 13-game home winning streak ... The 13-game home streak equaled the fourth-longest in program history ... The Lady Flames will now attempt to avoid their first back-to-back home losses since Nov. 14 and Dec. 7, 2008 ... Liberty went 7-3 in its first 10 games of the season for its best 10-game start since the 2009-10 Lady Flames also opened the year at 7-3 ... **EMILY FRAZIER** dished out a career-high nine assists on Saturday versus North Carolina A&T, which was the most by a Lady Flame since Jan. 9, 2010 ... That day, **AMBER MAYS** finished with 10 assists against Winthrop ... **TOLU OMOTOLA** needs 21 rebounds to become the 23rd Lady Flame ever to pull down 500 career boards.

LONGWOOD

Longwood University earned its second straight road victory in a non-conference contest on December 15 against Bucknell University to improve to 3-6 overall. The Lancers took the lead for good early in the second half en route to the 60-52 win. LU had a season-low 10 turnovers in the decision. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** has added to the offensive effort with 8.9 points per game, while freshman **KHALILAH ALI** averages 5.8 points per game and 5.6 rebounds per game. Freshman **RAVEN WILLIAMS**, who earned her first career start at Bucknell, is averaging 5.8 points per game, as well.

PRESBYTERIAN

Five seniors enter Monday's game closing in on 100 career games played. **CHELSEA PARKER** stands at 98 games while **SHONDA BURNSIDE** and **DRIA DAVID** each boast 97, **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** sits four from the century mark at 96 while Devin Fothergill has played in 95. Kristen Stevens holds the Division I era record with 116 and 16 games remain after PC takes on UCF... The Blue Hose take a break for the holidays and return to action on December 29, where PC will host Coastal Carolina in a Big South Conference matchup at 2 p.m.

RADFORD

RU split its two contests for the week, defeating Norfolk State before falling to Clemson. Behind **VICTORIA HAMILTON**'s double-double (10 points and 11 rebounds), Radford secured a 73-50 decision over Norfolk State in non-conference women's basketball action Thursday night inside the Dedmon Center. Hamilton's double-double marked the first of the season for a Highlander and is the fourth of her career. The senior was one of four double-figure scorers for RU. Ashley Buckhannon paced the offensive attack with 17 points on 6-of-12 shooting. The Wytheville, Va. native drained four trifectas Thursday to move into sole possession of third place in 3-pointers made in Radford women's basketball history. Her career total has risen to 124, two ahead of Kelli Tull (122 / 1996-2000). Freshman **AISHA FOY** continued her stellar play with 13 points on 5-of-10 shooting, while **JORDYNN GAYMON** contributed 11 points via a 4-of-8 clip. In the final game of the week, Clemson hit 51 percent of its shots and was able to answer each comeback attempt by Radford in the second half to defeat the Highlanders, 74-55, in non-conference women's basketball action Sunday evening inside Littlejohn Coliseum. Ayana Avery was the lone Highlander in double figures with 11 points on 3-of-11 shooting. Hamilton, **DIANI MASON** and Gaymon added eight points apiece, while Hamilton reeled in a team-best 10 boards. Connecting on a season-best 26-of-51 (51 percent) from the hardwood, Clemson did most of its damage in the paint. The Lady Tigers outscored the visitors, 38-20, in this category. However, the Highlanders managed to win the rebounding battle (42-41), which led to an 18-7 edge in second-chance points. Both squads struggled keeping possession, combining for 54 turnovers. The Lady Tigers forced Radford into a season-high 27 miscues, which were cashed in for 35 points.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-1 on the week, with a 71-62 setback against Kennesaw State on Thursday evening. The Bulldogs (2-8) lost to Kennesaw State at home on Thursday night, 71-62. The Owls built an 18-point lead before Asheville made a frantic comeback but fell just short. **SHONESE JONES** led the Bulldogs with 22 points, while Kelli Riles added 13 points and 19 rebounds. Jones has scored in double figures in four straight games and scored at least 21 points in three of those contests. Her scoring average for those four games is 20.5. **KELLI RILES** has 866 career rebounds and is in fourth place on Asheville's career list. She needs just 23 rebounds to move past Kim Duncan into third place. Riles has grabbed at least 10 rebounds in five different contests this season. The Bulldogs have out-rebounded their last three opponents. Asheville has made 25 three-pointers in the last four games for a 6.25 per game average. This is the Bulldogs first game in the state of Florida since playing in the Gator Invitational at the University of Florida in December, 2007. Asheville lost to Alabama A&M and Holy Cross in the tournament. Ironically, Bulldog coach Brenda Mock Kirkpatrick was an assistant at Florida during that tournament.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is riding a two-game win streak heading into Big South Conference play against High Point on Tuesday night. **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** connected on 7 three-pointers and tied a season-high with 23 points to lead the Eagles past NC Central on the road (63-44). Choibekova entered last week ranked third nationally for 3-pointers made per game (3.69) and could move up to No. 1 in this week's NCAA statistics. She led the nation in that category last year, with her 23-point performance at NCCU, Choibekova has taken over as the team scoring leader with her 16.9 average. When the Eagles outrebound or tie their opponents on the glass, they are 5-0 this season. The High Point game will pit two of the nation's top blocked shot artists facing one another in HPU's Cheyenne Parker and WU's **SCHAQUILLA NUNN**. Both players were ranked in the NCAA top 10 in blocked shots last week.
