Omotola averaged a double-double with 14.5 points per game and 11.5 rebounds per game in Liberty's two wins last week, including a win over Conference foe Radford. The forward/center got her week started with 21 points on 83 percent shooting, to go along with 10 rebounds, two assists, three blocks and a steal in the win over UNC Greensboro on Nov. 27. Four days later at Radford, she pulled down a career-best 13 boards, posted eight points, two assists and two blocks in the win over the Highlanders. With 43 ticks left in the contest, Omotola connected on the game-winning bucket and followed with a blocked shot on the ensuing Radford possession to seal the League-opening win for the Lady Flames.

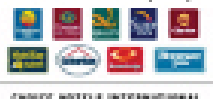

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. On Nov. 20 she added top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State to rank No. 1 in the nation. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. **FRED APPLIN** is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. **DeUNNA HENDRIX** is running the panthers, while **KEVIN COOK** has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading four players with consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in six games this season. She pulled down a season-high 17 rebounds on Nov. 25 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass as they are the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. After playing its Education Day game on Dec. 3, Campbell will take some time off before playing its next game ... The Fighting Camels' next contest is slated for Dec. 14 in the Jacksonville Tournament.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern suffered their first conference loss of the season in going 0-2 this past week in falling to Presbyterian and Wake Forest...The pair of losses drops the Lady Bucs to 3-3 on the season...CSU is currently 2-0 at home on the year, but their record falls to 0-3 when the Lady Bucs play on an opponent's court... **LAKEITHA ALSTON** continues her early stretch of dominance on the court adding 39 points over the two games this past week with a season-high 25 coming in the 58-57 loss to the Blue Hose...CSU went a combined 82.1% from the free throw line this week as a team, hitting 17 of 21 attempts from the charity stripe against the Blue Hose and 15 of 18 against Wake Forest to improve their season total to 80.2% on the year...The Lady Bucs will be off for the next 10 days before coming back on December 12th to host S.C. State inside the Buc Dome.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won its Big South opener by a score of 65-62 at Gardner-Webb in its only action of the week ... The win marked the first for Coastal at Paul Porter Arena since the 2008-09 season and the first conference road victory since March 4, 2011 at Charleston Southern ... The Chants have now won back-to-back conference season openers, improving their all-time record to 13-14 in Big South lid lifters ... **ALEX PUCKETT**, **KATELYN CONNOR**, **AJ JORDAN** and **SHATIA COLE** each scored in double figures, marking the second time this season four Chanticleers have reached 10-plus points in the same game ... Connor finished with her first career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds ... Through seven games the Chants have recorded three double-doubles compared to only four throughout the entire 2011-12 season ... Coastal will take the next 12 days off for the Fall exam period before returning to action on Dec. 13 as hosts to Converse

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs suffered a tough 65-62 home loss last Saturday afternoon to fall to 4-1 at home on the season and 0-1 to start Big South Conference play. In the loss, GWU's first home loss of the season and second straight to the Chanticleers, the Runnin' Bulldogs kept the Chanticleers within reach, trailing for most of the contest by six points or less. However, Coastal Carolina had an answer for every GWU run, holding the lead for over the final 25 minutes of the contest in the three-point win. For the second straight game sophomore guard **MAYHANA DUNOVANT** led GWU in scoring with 15 points, while also posting a team-high four assists and three steals. Junior center **CATRINA GREEN** registered her fifth double-double of the season with 14 points and 13 rebounds, while **JESSICA HEILIG** added 11 points of her own in the loss. GWU will have a week off before returning to the floor to host Longwood in a non-conference game on Sunday, December 9th, at 3 p.m. in Paul Porter Arena.

HIGH POINT

HPU won the Navy Classic with wins over Monmouth and Navy ... Junior **TAYLER TREMBLAY** was named the Navy Classic MVP and redshirt-sophomore **LINDSAY PUCKETT** was named to the All-Tournament Team ... Puckett averaged 15.5 points and five rebounds in the tournament, scoring a career-high 21 points in the win over Monmouth ... Tremblay tied her season-high with eight assists in the win over Monmouth and followed it up with a season-high 17 points, five assists and two steals in the win over Navy to clinch the tournament ... Tremblay played 39 minutes in each of the Navy Classic games ... **CHEYENNE PARKER** had 14 rebounds in the win over Navy to give her 754 for her career and move her in to sixth place all-time at HPU, she started the season in 11th place

LIBERTY

Liberty defeated UNCG 76-56 on Nov. 27, improving to 3-0 at home this season ... The Lady Flames have now won 11 straight home games, dating back to last season ... Liberty then picked up its first road win of 2012-13 Dec. 1 at Radford, by a 67-65 count ... The Lady Flames have opened Big South play with a victory 12 times in the last 13 seasons ... **TOLU OMOTOLA** enjoyed a big week, recording her second career double-double (21 points, 10 rebounds) against UNCG ... Omotola then scored the game-winning basket with 43.1 seconds left against Radford and pulled down a career-high 13 rebounds against the Highlanders ... After averaging 22.0 ppg during Liberty's two wins last week, **DEVON BROWN** has now scored 1,569 career points ... She needs 22 points to pass Shamia Brown (High Point) and become one of the Big South's top 15 all-time scorers ... This week, Liberty will play two CAA opponents in James Madison (Tuesday) and UNC Wilmington (Saturday) ... The Lady Flames will be in search of their first-ever win at the JMU Convocation Center, while they will match up with UNC Wilmington for the first time in program history.

LONGWOOD

Longwood University dropped a pair of decisions on the road last week to move to 1-6 overall. The squad, currently in the midst of a five-game skid, is still looking for its first road win of the season. The Lancers fell to Pittsburgh, 86-60, on Nov. 26 before losing to Virginia Tech, 73-58, on Dec. 1. As a team, LU is shooting 36% (153-422) from the field, including 31% (55-180) from three-point territory, and 66% (70-106) from the free throw line. Senior **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has four double-doubles so far, paces Longwood with 16.6 points per game and 10.1 rebounds per game. Classmate **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who notched a career-high five three-pointers en route to a season-high 26 points at VT, is second on the team with 13.7 points per game. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** has added to the offensive effort with 9.7 points per game and freshman **KHALILAH ALI** follows with 6.6 points per game and 6.4 rebounds per game.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC picked up a win in its Big South Conference opener against Charleston Southern on Wednesday (58-57) before dropping both games of the Eastern Kentucky Comfort Suites Invitational in Richmond, Ky., to host EKV (43-61) and Marshall (51-59)... **KARLEE TAYLOR** was named to the Invitational's All-Tournament Team for averaging 12 points and 3.0 assists per game... **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Friday. Already the Division I career leader in rebounds, she becomes the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. She now stands 61 boards shy of tying for ninth place in program history... **DRIA DAVID** also moved into sole possession of ninth place in career steals, currently at 188... The Blue Hose take a break for exams before returning to action by hosting their annual Education Day game against Brevard on Tuesday, December 11.

RADFORD

For the second straight game, a late rally by the opposing side caused the Radford women's basketball team to fall as Liberty escaped the Dedmon Center with a 67-65 Big South nail-biting victory Saturday evening. **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** led the Highlanders (3-3, 0-1 Big South) with a season-high 21 points on 9-of-18 shooting. She now is tied for seventh with Corrie Fertitta on the all-time career scoring chart with 1,215 points. **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** (9), **SARAH TABB** (8) and **AYANA AVERY** (8) also neared double-digit scoring for RU. The Highlanders went to its bench to score 21 points, compared to just 12 from Liberty's reserves. Radford's grueling stretch of games continues with a road trip to Chapel Hill, N.C., Wednesday, Dec. 5. The non-conference clash between the Highlanders and the Tar Heels tips at 7:00 p.m. from Carmichael Arena and marks as the second of three ACC foes RU will face on its schedule this season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, falling to South Florida out of the Big East Conference and dropping their Big South Conference opener to Campbell. The Bulldogs will have two games this week, taking on USC Upstate on Monday evening on the road before taking on Columbia College at Kimmel Arena on Saturday afternoon. Asheville's game against USF marked the first time a Big East school has played at Kimmel Arena. The Bulldogs' last game against a Big East school came during the 2010-11 season, a 75-46 setback at Marquette. With four rebounds against UNC Chapel Hill on 11/25 senior **KELLI RILES** reached 800 boards for her career. She now sits at 823, good for fourth place all-time on Asheville's career rebounds list. She needs 68 rebounds to move into third place past Kim Duncan (888) and 73 to move past Wendy Beecher (894) into second place. When she moves past Beecher, Kelli will become the school's Division I leader in rebounding. Sheila Ford holds the top spot with 2,200 rebounds. USC Upstate is coached by former Asheville assistant coach Tammy George. Tammy was an assistant for the Bulldog program in the 2002-03 season. The Bulldogs hope to break an 18-game road losing streak tonight. Sophomore guard **SHONESE JONES** scored a season-high 21 points against Campbell on Saturday. She has now scored 20 points or more in 12 different games during her career. Sophomore guard **JEANNIE BUCKNER** leads Asheville in assists with 16 and is tied for the team leading 3-pointers made with nine. She has 12 field goals on the season with nine being from long-range. Bucker grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds vs. Campbell on Saturday. Senior forward **GENTRY MANLEY** has scored in double figures in three of the last four games.

WINTHROP

Winthrop defeated College of Charleston for just the second time in the 28-game series as the Eagles claimed a 63-61 road win that was clinched by two free throws by Dequesha McClanahan with 17 seconds left in the game. Freshman Center **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** had her second double-double of the season to go along with one triple-double as she scored 12 points and grabbed a season-high 16 rebounds against CoFC. Sophomore forward **TAYLOR CALVERT** claimed her second career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds in the loss at Bradley. McClanahan had her double-figure scoring streak snapped at 19 games over the past two seasons as she was held to 8 by Bradley.
