Brown shot 58 percent from the floor and averaged 23 points per game to lead the Lady Flames to a 3-0 record over Christmas break, including a win over League foe Winthrop. The guard/forward highlighted the break with 32 points, eight rebounds and two assists in the 90-57 win over the Eagles on Dec. 29. Against Virginia Union on Dec. 17, Brown put in 22 points on 63 percent from the floor, to go along with six boards and a pair of steals. Three days later at Virginia Commonwealth, she connected on 60 percent from the field and posted three helpers, two rebounds and two steals. The honor is her third Big South Player of the Week selection this season.

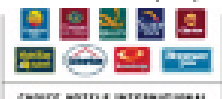

Brown, a guard from Richmond, Va., put in 18 points on 86 percent shooting, to go along with 10 rebounds, seven steals and two assists to lead the Lancers to their first-ever Big South win as they downed Radford on Dec. 29. She averaged double-digits in all three contests she played in during the break as she posted 14 points against Arizona on Dec. 20 and followed with 20 points against Arizona State on Dec. 22. In the three-game span, Brown shot 60 percent from the floor, ripped down 19 rebounds, came away with 10 steals and dished out seven assists. The honor is Longwood's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Freshman of the Week plaudit.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. RADICAL RANKINGS

The Big South Conference has had four squads receive attention on the National Mid-Major Poll at CollegeInsider.com. Liberty, High Point, Winthrop and Campbell have either been ranked or recieved votes in the poll this season.

BALLERS

The Big South Conference currently has two players ranked in the Top 5 in the national individual stats. **CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 with 14.2 rebounds per game and is also No. 2 with 11 double-doubles. Her 4.15 blocked shots per game is good for No. 2 nationally ... Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has been shooting the lights out from downtown and is No. 2 in Division I with 3.73 triples per game.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's **SHAQUILLA NUNN** is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State to rank No. 2 in the nation. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.15 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.0 blocked shots per game.

SCORE'N

During the Christmas break a pair of Big South student-athletes posted 30-plus point games... Liberty's **DEVON BROWN** put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while **CHEYENNE PARKER** notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. **FRED APPLIN** is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. **DeUNNA HENDRIX** is running the panthers, while **KEVIN COOK** has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

DEQU\$A

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted five 20-point games this season, to go along with two games with 10-more-assists. She is the only player in the Big South with two 20-point, 10 assist games.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 12 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went winless in its three games from Dec. 17 - Jan. 2 ... The Chanticleers are on a season long four game losing skid ... The Chants played back-to-back days on Dec. 18 and 19, falling at **South Carolina State**, 55-78, on the 18th and dropping a 58-69 decision against **North Florida** on Dec. 19 at the 2012 **Carolinas Challenge** ... **Coastal** returned to Big South play on Dec. 29 at **Presbyterian College**, falling 30-50 ... **ALEX PUCKETT** led the Chanticleers over the three-game stretch as she averaged 12.3 points per game and set her career-high with 14 points against **North Florida** ... **Puckett** also tied her career-high with a pair of made 3-pointers at **South Carolina State** ... **KATELYN CONNOR** was **Coastal's** top rebounder over the stretch, grabbing 24 total boards (12 offensive and 12 defensive) ... The Chants continue league play this week, kicking off the New Year at **Campbell** on Jan. 3 and hosting **Lowcountry** rival **Charleston Southern** on Jan. 5.

GARDNER-WEBB

The **Runnin' Bulldogs** have won three straight contests heading into play this week and are doing it on the defensive end and on the glass. This week, **GWU** will be looking for some pay-back against the **Longwood Lancers**, as the **Lancers** defeated **GWU** 70-62 back on December 9th in **Paul Porter Arena**, as well as returning to the **Millis Center** to take on the **High Point Panthers** in the two teams' first meeting of two this season.

HIGH POINT

The **High Point University women's basketball team** improved to 7-6 overall and 1-1 in Big South play with wins at **Mercer** and **UNC Asheville** over the holiday break. Junior **CHEYENNE PARKER** is averaging 22.7 points and 13.3 rebounds per game over the last three games including a career-high 31 points at **Mercer**. The win at **UNC Asheville** was **HPU's** eighth straight win over the **Bulldogs**. It wrapped up a seven-game road trip for the **Panthers** that lasted the entire month of December. **HPU** finally returns to the **Millis Center** this weekend.

LIBERTY

Liberty has won four straight road games and three consecutive contests overall ... On Dec. 17, the Lady Flames posted a 95-39 home win over **Virginia Union**, marking **Liberty's** largest margin of victory (56 points) since a 99-42 home win over **Charleston Southern** on Feb. 18, 2008 ... The **Virginia Union** contest was played in front of 3,230 fans on **Liberty's** inaugural Best Field Trip Ever Day ... It was **Liberty's** largest home crowd since 3,387 fans attended a win over **Coastal Carolina** on Feb. 20, 2010 ... **EMILY FRAZIER** dished out a career-high 12 assists during the Dec. 20 victory at **VCU**, marking the most assists by a Lady Flame since Dec. 2, 1997, when **SARAH WILKERSON** tallied a dozen assists at **Hampton** ...
