DEVON BROWN • G/F RSr. • Liberty Wayensboro, Va.

Brown shot 58 percent from the floor and averaged 23 points per game to lead the Lady Flames to a 3-0 record over Christmas break, including a win over League foe Winthrop. The guard/forward highlighted the break with 32 points, eight rebounds and two assists in the 90-57 win over the Eagles on Dec. 29. Against Virginia Union on Dec. 17, Brown put in 22 points on 63 percent from the floor, to go along with six boards and a pair of steals. Three days later at Virginia Commonwealth, she connected on 60 percent from the field and posted three helpers, two rebounds and two steals. The honor is her third Big South Player of the Week selection this season.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

DAEISHA BROWN • G Longwood Richmond, Va.

Brown, a guard from Richmond, Va., put in 18 points on 86 percent shooting, to go along with 10 rebounds, seven steals and two assists to lead the Lancers to their firstever Big South win as they downed Radford on Dec. 29. She averaged double-digits in all three contests she played in during the break as she posted 14 points against Arizona on Dec. 20 and followed with 20 points against Arizona State on Dec. 22. In the three-game span, Brown shot 60 percent from the floor, ripped down 19 rebounds, came away with 10 steals and dished out seven assists. The honor is Longwood's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Freshman of the Week plaudit.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. RADICAL RANKINGS

The Big South Conference has had four squads receive attention on the National Mid-Major Poll at Collegelnsider.com. Liberty, High Point, Winthrop and Campbell have either been ranked or recieved votes in the poll this season.

BALLERS

The Big South Conference currently has two players ranked in the Top 5 in the national individual stats. **CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 with 14.2 rebounds per game and is also No. 2 with 11 double-doubles. Her 4.15 blocked shots per game is good for No. 2 nationally ... Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has been shooting the lights out from downtown and is No. 2 in Division I with 3.73 triples per game.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's **SHAQUILLA NUNN** is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State to rank No. 2 in the nation. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.15 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.0 blocked shots per game.

SCORE'N

During the Christmas break a pair of Big South student-athletes posted 30-plus point games... Liberty's **DEVON BROWN** put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while **CHEYENNE PARKER** notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. FRED APPLIN is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. DeUNNA HENDRIX is running the panthers, while KEVIN COOK has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basket-ball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

DEQU\$A

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN as been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted five 20-point games this season, to go along with two games with 10-more-assists. She is the only player in the Big South with two 20-point, 10 assist games.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is leading nine players with consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 12 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... KELLI RILES and TAYLOR CALVERT have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

High Point's Cheyenne Parker has teamed up with two different teammates to have 20 point outings in the same game. Parker and ERIN REYNOLDS each had a 20-plus game against ETSU and Parker and STACIA ROBERTSON each went over the 20-point plateau against USC Upstate ... CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels started the season with a 9-3 mark, which is tied for the secondbest start in the program's Division I history (last occurring in 1990-91; only 1987-88 team was better at 11-3)...KIERA GAINES posted her second double-double of the campaign with 13 rebounds and 10 points in the win over Elon...Three players reached double-digits against the Phoenix - TONISHA BAKER (15), Gaines (10) and ZENA LOVETTE (17)...The trio of Baker (16), Gaines (14) and ASHLEY JAMES (12) hit double figures, while James also notched her second career double-double with 11 rebounds...Baker entered the Lady Camels top 10 in scoring following the Wake Forest game with 1,239 points passing Sara Moore (1997-01) at 1,238...Campbell out-rebounded the much-taller Demon Deacons 48-35, including a season-high 20 offensive rebounds...Campbell has registered more rebounds than its opponents on nine occasions...The Lady Camels were ranked 10th in the nation in 3FG% at 38.9 in the Dec. 16 rankings...Head Coach WANDA WAKINS has tallied 487 career victories as Campbell regimes Pig South play. victories as Campbell resumes Big South play.

Coastal Carolina went winless in its three games from Dec. 17 - Jan. 2 ... The Chanticleers are on a season long four game losing skid ... The Chants played back-to-back days on Dec. 18 and 19, falling at South Carolina State, 55-78, on the 18th and dropping a 58-69 decision against North Florida on Dec. 19 at the 2012 Carolinas Challenge ... Coastal returned to Big South play on Dec. 29 at Presbyterian College, falling 30-50 ... ALEXX PUCKETT led the Chanticleers over the three-game stretch as she averaged 12.3 points per game and set her career-high with 14 points against North Florida ... Puckett also tied her career-high with a pair of made 3-pointers at South Carolina State ...
