Smith, a senior from Richmond, Va., averaged 26.0 points per game to lead her squad to a 2-0 Big South record last week. The guard got her week started with her second 30-point game of the season as she poured in 32 points in the win over Campbell on Jan. 17. She also posted seven boards, five assists and three steals in the win. She followed that performance with 20 points, eight boards, one assist and a pair of steals in the win over Coastal Carolina on Jan. 19. In the two-game span, Smith connected on 10-of-13 from downtown for a 77 percent clip. The honor is her second Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

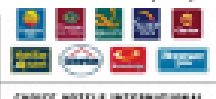

Nunn, a center from Fayetteville, Ga. averaged a double-double of 11 points and 13.5 rebounds per game to push the Eagles to a pair of Big South wins last week. Against Charleston Southern on Jan. 17, Nunn put in 12 points on 57 percent from the floor, to go along with 10 rebounds, a block and a steal. Two days later against Presbyterian College, Nunn connected on 80 percent from the floor to finish with 10 points. She also pulled down a season-best 17 rebounds and turned away seven Blue Hose shots. She shot 67 percent from the floor in the two-game span to earn her third Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. BCS BUSTERS

The Big South Conference has picked up a couple wins over BCS Conference schools during the 2012-13 season. Presbyterian College got the ball rolling with a win over Clemson of the ACC on Nov. 11. Winthrop followed suit with a win over Mississippi State out of the SEC on Nov. 20. Below is a look at the wins.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes averaging double-doubles this season. CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently posting 17.9 points and 13.2 rebounds per game, while KELLI RILES of UNC Asheville averages 10.2 ppg and 10.4 rebounds per game. The pair are in elite company as only 37 student-athletes nationwide are averaging a double-double this season.

ENJOYING THE VIEW

CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 with 13.2 rebounds per game, while her 4.28 blocked shots per game are good for No. 1 nationally. She is also ranked No. 2 nationally with 14 double-doubles.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's SHAQUILLA NUNN is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week three times this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.29 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.5 blocked shots per game.

SCORE'N

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's DEVON BROWN put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while CHEYENNE PARKER notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer. CRYSTAL SMITH of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb and posted 32 in Longwood's win over Campbell. Smith is the only player in the Big South with two 30-point games.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. FRED APPLIN is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. DeUNNA HENDRIX is running the Panthers, while KEVIN COOK has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

MILLIS CENTER (NORTH)

With High Point's win over Liberty on Jan. 17 at the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back to back games on the road at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1993-94 and 1996-97 seasons.

DEQUESHA

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted a League-best nine 20-point games this season, to go along with four games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with multiple 20-point, 10 assist games as she has three this season.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with six consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 15 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

CAMPBELL

Campbell fell to 4-3 in the league following road losses to Longwood, 77-75, and Liberty, 65-58. **TONISHA BAKER** has posted back-to-back-to-back 20 point outings, starting with 24 points vs. High Point followed by 20 points at Longwood and 21 at Liberty. The Lady Camels fell to the Lancers on a layup by Smith with 2 seconds remaining in the game as Baker's desperation three fell just short. **MONIQUE SPRY** tallied 20 points along with Baker vs. Longwood, becoming the first 20-point duo for the Lady Camels since Baker (30) and Lauren Yesh (20) against USC Upstate on Feb. 26, 2011. Baker during the week became the 13th Lady Camel with 600 rebounds and also eclipsed 1,300 career points. She has additionally registered at least 100 field goals in each of her four seasons at Campbell, only the fifth player in school history to accomplish that feat. Head coach **WANDA WATKINS** has 490 career victories, and is approaching the 500-win milestone. The Lady Camels continue a tough nine-game stretch by opening a four-game homestand with Radford and Winthrop.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs fell in both Big South Conference games this week, suffering losses on the road to both Winthrop and Radford as CSU drops to 0-7 in BSC action in the 2012-2013 season. On Thursday inside the Winthrop Coliseum, Charleston Southern cut a 20 point deficit down to five points early in the second half using a 21-4 run sparked by a barrage of three-pointers by **ERIN BRATCHER**, **DJ FOWLER** and **ANICIA DOTSON** to put the score at 50-45 with 13:48 to play in the game. The lead remained at five as **SHAY JONES** answered a **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** jumper with one of her own, but Winthrop followed with the next five points in going on a 29-9 run to close out the home victory. Bratcher hit five three-pointers in the victory, leading four Lady Bucs in double-digits with 17 points in the loss. CSU held the lead at the end of the first half inside the Dedmon Center on Saturday afternoon, using a 13-5 run as **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** drove in for the layup to give CSU the 27-24 halftime lead. Radford used a 12-2 run in the second half to build a double-digit lead as the Highlanders held off the Lady Bucs despite a game-high 17 points by Jones in the win. CSU returns home this week hosting UNC Asheville on Thursday evening and Gardner-Webb on Saturday afternoon.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 0-2 on the week, falling at Radford (56-68) and at Longwood (63-77). Head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** missed both games both games due to illness. The Chanticleers are in the midst of a four-game losing streak with each coming against a conference opponent. **ANGELICA HENRY** averaged 14 points per game - 13 at Radford and 15 at Longwood - to lead Coastal in scoring on the week. **ALEX PUCKETT** led Coastal against Radford with a career-high 16 points. Puckett has re-established her career-high on four occasions this season. **AJ JORDAN** posted her third career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds at Longwood. The double-double was Coastal's fifth of the season compared to only four during the 2011-12 season. The Chants returns home, where they are 6-3 on the season, for a four-game stand starting on Thursday against Winthrop. Coastal will host UNC Asheville at 4 p.m. on Saturday on ESPN3.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs recorded its first conference win of the season last week, as GWU used its defense to defeat UNC Asheville 58-45 in Kimmel Arena on Saturday afternoon. GWU, who snapped a season-high five-game losing streak with the win, got 16 points and five blocks from Jessica Heilig and 13 points and seven steals from **CANDACE BROWN**. As a team, the Runnin' Bulldogs recorded 15 steals and seven blocks and held Asheville to only nine made field goals on 27.3 percent shooting for the game. Junior sharp shooter **JASMINE DALE** continued her hot hand from downtown, as she made a three-pointer late in the first half to extend her streak to 11-straight games with at least one trey. GWU will remain on the road this week to take on PC on Thursday night, January 24th, at 7 p.m. and Charleston Southern on Saturday afternoon, January 26th, at 2 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point beat Liberty, 71-63, at the Vines Center on Thursday. High Point is the first Big South team to defeat Liberty at the Vines Center in back-to-back years since UNC Greensboro posted four straight wins at the Vines Center between 1993-94 and 1996-97. Junior point guard **TAYLER TREMBLAY** led all players with 11 rebounds, while also scoring 16 points. Junior **CHEYENNE PARKER** is nearing 1,000 career points, needing just 14 more points. She is also closing in on 1,000 rebounds with 881 career boards. Graduate student **KENDRA WALLACE** is also getting close to 1,000 career points. She had 845 in three seasons at USC Upstate and now has 126 at HPU for 971 career points. The Panthers return home this week for two games. HPU has played just five of its 18 games this season at the Millis Center, posting a 4-1 record at home.

LIBERTY

Liberty bounced back from a 71-63 home loss to High Point on Thursday to defeat Campbell 65-58 on Saturday. The Lady Flames have still not lost back-to-back conference games since Feb. 20 and 22, 1997. Liberty, which is ranked No. 2 nationally in rebound margin (+17.1), has outrebounded 15 straight opponents, including a +27 margin against Campbell. The Lady Flames have played better on the road than at home in recent weeks, as they are 6-0 in their last six road games but only 3-3 in their last six home contests. During the High Point game, **DEVON BROWN** became the seventh Lady Flame to grab 700 career rebounds. Brown finished the week with 711 career boards. Liberty, which has faced Longwood 28 times as a non-conference opponent, will play its first-ever conference game against the Lancers, Saturday at 5 p.m. at the Vines Center.

LONGWOOD

Longwood University picked up a pair of Big South Conference home wins last week. The team defeated Campbell, 77-75, with a last second layup from senior **CRYSTAL SMITH** on Jan. 17. The Lancers then mounted a second-half comeback to down Coastal Carolina, 77-63 on Jan. 19. Longwood's nine wins so far this year marks the program's most victories since the 2009-10 season. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 37% (414-1118) from the field, including 30% (122-414) from three-point territory, and 70% (235-336) from the free throw line. Smith, who has led the team in scoring seven times, paces the squad with 16.9 points per game. Classmate Chelsea Coward, who has eight double-doubles so far, is second on the team with 16.0 points per game. Coward leads the team with 9.0 rebounds per game, as well. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 12.3 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, January 24 when it travels to league opponent High Point University for a 7 p.m. tilt.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC split its two games last week, winning on the road at UNC Asheville (56-49) before falling to Winthrop on Saturday (50-78). PC's loss at Winthrop marks its first Big South Conference road loss this season, moving the team to 3-1 in that category and 6-2 in league play. **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** grabbed eight rebounds against the Eagles to move her into ninth place in program history, with 570 for her career. Thursday's win marks the fifth straight against UNC Asheville. Pietrowski tallied 12 points and a team-high 10 rebounds on Thursday against UNC Asheville, giving her fourth career double-double and her first since February 12, 2011, also against UNC Asheville. After not achieving the feat once last year, the Blue Hose have registered three double-doubles this season (**SHONDA BURNSIDE**, **DRIA DAVID** and Pietrowski). The Blue Hose host Gardner-Webb on Thursday at 7 p.m. before taking a weeklong break from competition.

RADFORD

For the fourth time this season, Radford women's basketball held its opponent to 50 points or less as the Highlanders claimed a 68-50 decision in Big South action inside the Dedmon Center on a snowy Thursday afternoon. **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** led four Highlanders in double figures with a game-high 22 on 7-of-15 shooting. Diani Mason and **VICTORIA HAMILTON** contributed 11 points each, while **SARAH TABB** chalked up 10 points and 10 rebounds to record her first double-double of the season and second of her career. Hamilton also dished out a career-high-tying six assists. Behind a season-best 52.8 percent clip from the hardwood and Radford's ferocious defense causing 28 Charleston Southern turnovers, the Highlanders gutted out a 71-60 Big South decision Saturday evening inside the Dedmon Center to up their win streak to five. **AYANA AVERY** chalked up 15 points to lead three double-figure scorers for Radford. Buckhannon and **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** dropped in 12 and 10 points, respectively, while Hamilton handed out a career-high-tying six assists for the second straight game. Buckhannon added six assists and four steals to her stat line. Erwin Spencer moved into sole possession of fifth place on the all-time career-scoring chart with 1,239. She passed Johnette Walker (1,238) with her performance Saturday.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with a 56-49 setback to Presbyterian on Thursday before falling to Gardner-Webb on Saturday, 58-45. Asheville has now dropped nine games in a row. The Bulldogs are now 2-16 on the season overall and 0-7 in Big South Conference play. Asheville has now lost 18 Big South Conference games in a row, with the Bulldogs last victory coming against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012. In the game against Radford on Jan. 3, senior forward **KELLI RILES** became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in rebounds in the NCAA Division era, pulling down 10 rebounds to reach 899 for her career, passing former Bulldog great Wendy Beecher (894). The all-time record at UNC Asheville is 2,200 boards, recorded by Sheila Ford from 1980-84, when the Bulldogs were an NAIA institution. Riles now has 939 for her career. The Bulldogs have now lost 22 consecutive road games. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. The Bulldogs will be on the road for their next four games, playing at Charleston Southern on Thursday evening followed by a trip to Coastal Carolina on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Winthrop extended its win streak to a season-best four in a row with double-digit home wins over Charleston Southern and Presbyterian. The Eagles got a combined four double-doubles from three different players. Freshman center **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** had back-to-back doubles to give her three in a row and nine on the season. She had a season-high 17 rebounds in the win over PC. Senior **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** tied a career-high in rebounds with 12 vs. CSU and junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** scored a season-high 25 points against PC. In the two wins, the Eagles shot a combined 61 of 122 for 50 percent. They connected on a season-high 53.4 percent vs. PC (31-58).
