Brown, a redshirt-senior from Waynesboro, Va., averaged 19.5 points per game and shot 44 percent from the field to lead the Lady Flames to a pair of wins last week, including their first-ever road win at James Madison. She got her week started with 22 points on 43 percent from the floor, a perfect 9-of-9 from the line and one from downtown in the win over the Dukes on Dec. 4. She also chipped in six rebounds and two assists against JMU. Four days later against UNC Wilmington, Brown stayed hot as she finished with 17 points, three helpers, four rebounds and a steal in the win. The honor marks her second Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

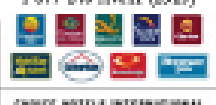

Foy shot 63 percent from the floor and posted 9.0 points per game to help the Highlanders to a 1-1 record last week. Against No. 21 North Carolina on Dec. 5, Foy was inserted into the lineup when Radford made its 14-2 rally to cut UNC's lead to 11 with under seven minutes to play. During that span, she contributed two points, two steals and an assist to give the Highlanders a chance to pull off the upset. Three days later in the win over William & Mary, poured in a personal-best 16 points on 4-of-6 shooting from 3-point land to go along with a 4-for-4 performance from the charity stripe. She added two rebounds and a steal in just 14 minutes of action. The honor is her first Big South Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

## BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. ## BALLERS

The Big South Conference currently has two players ranked in the Top 5 in the national individual stats. **CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 with 13.7 rebounds per game and is also No. 3 with seven double-doubles. Her 3.78 blocked shots per game is good for No. 4 nationally ... Winthrop's **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** has been shooting the lights out from downtown and is No. 4 in Division I with 3.63 triples per game.

## YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's **SHAQUILLA NUNN** is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State to rank No. 1 in the nation. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

## NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. **FRED APPLIN** is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. **DeUNNA HENDRIX** is running the panthers, while **KEVIN COOK** has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME**

**MARIAH PIETROWSKI** became the first women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)**

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first last week as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

**DEQU\$A**

**DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted four 20-point games this season, to go along with two games with 10-more-assists. She is the only player in the Big South with two 20-point, 10 assist games.

**QUEENS OF THE CAROM**

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading four players with consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in six games this season. **CAMPBELL**

The Lady Camels are 6-2 on the season after opening Big South play with a 73-56 victory over UNC Asheville and taking an Education Day matinee, 84-54 against Columbia (S.C.) College...An announced attendance of 2,905, second largest crowd at Gore Arena/John W. Pope, Jr. Convocation Center saw Campbell on Education Day as area fifth-grade students were on campus... Campbell has been led offensively by **TONISHA BAKER**, who has been the team's leading scorer in six games, including the past five, averaging 13.5 points per game... Baker is the Campbell leader in seven offensive categories... **KIERA GAINES** came close to a triple-double against the Fighting Koalas with 11 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists... Campbell has been tough on the boards and has out-rebounding seven of eight opponents for a margin of +10.5... Gaines paces the squad with 7.1, while **ASHLEY JAMES** (6.0) and Baker (5.3) follow behind... Team has been the emphasis for the Lady Camels as the squad is averaging 25 points from its bench and twice all players dressed have scored... The Lady Camels are off for 11 days before departing for Jacksonville, Fla. for the North Florida Hampton Inn Oceanside Holiday Tournament, where they will face Maryland-Eastern Shore and Jacksonville State on Dec. 14-15.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern took a week off from exams and returns to the court this week as the Lady Bucs take on S.C. State on Wednesday evening inside the Buc Dome. S.C. State has the 13-5 all-time record over CSU in their past meetings. The Bucs are led on the season by **LAKEITHA ALSTON**'s 15.5 points and 5.2 rebounds as CSU begins a three-game homestand before Christmas featuring games against S.C. State this week, and contests against Trinity Baptist and Western Carolina next week.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina was off last week for the Fall examination period ... The Chanticleers play a pair of games in the coming week, hosting Converse on Thursday and 21st-ranked North Carolina on Sunday ... Coastal is off to a 5-2 start through the first quarter of its season, including a 1-0 record in Big South play ... **AJ JORDAN** (13.0 ppg) leads a trio of Chanticleers averaging double figures in the scoring column ... Junior center **KATELYN CONNOR** has developed into Coastal's premier post player, averaging a team-high 6.8 boards per game while scoring 8.2 points per contest.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

The Runnin' Bulldogs have dropped two straight contests, both of which came at home to conference foes. GWU shot over 60 percent in the first half and was 7-of-9 from downtown before the break, yet struggled to find its offense and committed 15 turnovers in the second half to fall to Longwood 70-62 in a non-conference match up. **JASMINE DALE** poured in a game-high 20 points, however, the Lancers had three players in double figures for the game. Despite outscoring Longwood 33-18 in points in the paint and 10-7 in second chance points, GWU was doomed by its 24 turnovers as it led to 20 Longwood points. Coupled with the miscues, Longwood hauled in 19 offensive rebounds to give them 16 more shot attempts than the Runnin' Bulldogs for the contest. With the loss, GWU falls to 0-4 on the year when scoring less than 64 points in the game. GWU will look to right the ship this Thursday night, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will host Davidson at 7 p.m. in Paul Porter Arena.

**HIGH POINT**

**CHEYENNE PARKER** had 20 points and 12 rebounds in HPU's loss at Davidson ... It was her seventh double-double in nine games this season ... She now has 766 career rebounds, working her way up to sixth place all-time ... Next ahead of her is Ethel White who collected 793 rebounds from 1976-79 ... The Panthers are return to action on Sunday Dec. 16 at USC Upstate ... It is game four of a seven-game road trip spanning the entire month of December ...

**LIBERTY**

Liberty ran its winning streak to four with a pair of victories over CAA foes last week ... The Lady Flames' 60-48 triumph at James Madison on Dec. 4 was the team's first-ever win at JMU ... Liberty then equaled the most three-pointers it had ever hit at the Vines Center (11) and held UNCW to eight second-half points in an 84-34 win over the Seahawks on Dec. 8 ... It was the first time the Lady Flames have defeated an NCAA Division I opponent by 50 points since a 99-42 triumph over Charleston Southern on Feb. 18, 2008 ... Liberty has now won 12 consecutive home games, dating back to last season ... The Lady Flames just missed the program single-game free throw shooting record against James Madison, shooting 18-of-20 from the line ... She currently ranks 13th in conference history with 1,608 career points ... If Liberty defeats Bluefield State on Thursday, the Lady Flames will be off to their best 10-game start (7-3) since the 2008-09 squad also started out 7-3.

**LONGWOOD**

Longwood University defeated Gardner-Webb University, 70-62, in a non-conference contest on December 9 to improve to 2-6 overall. The victory snapped a five-game skid and was the Lancers' first road win of the season. As a team, LU is shooting 36% (172-484) from the field, including 31% (64-207) from three-point territory, and 66% (88-208) from the free throw line. Senior **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has four double-doubles so far, paces Longwood with 15.9 points per game and 9.8 rebounds per game. Classmate **CRYSTAL SMITH** is second on the team with 14.0 points per game. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** has added to the offensive effort with 9.6 points per game and freshman **KHALILAH ALI** follows with 6.6 points per game and 6.4 rebounds per game. Freshman **RAVEN WILLIAMS**, who posted career highs of four three-pointers, four rebounds and 14 points at Gardner-Webb, is averaging 6.0 points per game.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

The Blue Hose will then head to NC State for a Saturday afternoon contest and wrap up non-conference play on Monday night at UCF in Orlando, Fla... **DRIA DAVID** became the program's Division I-era leader in minutes played in the team's 11/30 contest against Eastern Kentucky. She enters the week with 2,804 minutes logged in her career.

**RADFORD**

Highlanders split their two games this past week as No. 21 North Carolina defeated RU (64-44), but bounced back with a 72-55 decision over William & Mary inside the Dedmon Center to snap a three-game skid. After falling behind by 23 against the Tar Heels, Radford embarked on a 14-2 surge to get to within 11, but that was as close as the Highlanders could get. Despite committing 31 turnovers, the hosts connected on 42 percent of their shots and held a decisive advantage on the boards (52-27). Against the Tribe, Radford used a 13-3 run midway through the opening stanza to seize the lead it would never relinquish. Stout defense was the theme for the Highlanders as W&M became the fifth Radford opponent to be held under 40-percent shooting this season. RU possessed an overwhelming advantage in bench points (39-6) and rebounds (44-31).

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 1-1 on the week, with a 54-52 setback to USC Upstate on Monday evening followed by a 70-48 victory over Columbia College (S.C.) on Saturday. The Bulldogs are now 2-7 on the season, with a 0-1 mark in the Big South. Asheville is also 2-4 at home and 0-3 on the road. The Bulldogs led most of the game against Upstate on Monday evening, but the Spartans were able to gain a 52-46 advantage with just over a minute to go. The Bulldogs tied the game at 52-52 with 13 seconds to go in the game, but Asheville committed a foul that sent a Spartan to the free throw line. Down 54-52 with 5 seconds remaining **SHONESE JONES** dribbled the ball up the court and got off a 3-point attempt as time expired, but the shot fell just short. The Bulldogs have only one more contest before the holiday break, as they host Kennesaw State on Thursday evening at Kimmel Arena. This is a rematch from a game last season, an 83-79 victory for the Owls in Kennesaw, Ga. **KELLI RILES** has 847 career rebounds, good for fourth place all-time on Asheville's career rebounds list. She needs 42 rebounds to move into third place past Kim Duncan (888) and 57 to move past Wendy Beecher (894) into second place. When she moves past Beecher, Kelli will become the school's Division I leader in rebounding. Sheila Ford holds the top spot with 2,200 rebounds. Riles grabbed 15 rebounds at USC Upstate Monday night and has collected at least 10 rebounds in four different games this season. Her 10.6 per game mark is second best in the Big South.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop took a break from final exams to host St. Augustine's and came away with a 83-74 win to even its record at 4-4. The game was just the second home contest for the Eagles after six straight road games. Winthrop pulled off a rarity with three players achieving double-doubles in the game. Freshman center **SCHAQUIL-LA NUNN** scored 12 points and grabbed a game-high 13 rebounds; senior **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** scored 17 points and pulled down 11 rebounds; and junior **DEQUE-SHA MCCLANAHAN** scored 21 points and dished out 10 assists. She moved into 9th place on the Winthrop career scoring list with 1,174, and her 10 assists moves her into third place on the career list with 388. With Choibekova and **SAMIYA WRIGHT** combining to connect on 9 three balls, Winthrop shot 12 of 25 from behind the arc. The game was the first ever between the two schools.
