Parker, a junior from Queens, N.Y., averaged 24.0 points and 20.0 rebounds per game to lead the Panthers to a pair of Big South wins last week. The center got her week started with a Big South season-high 34 points, as well as 20 boards as the Panthers downed Longwood on Feb. 7. She connected on 74 percent of her shots from the field against the Lancers and added two blocks, one steal and one assist. Two days later at Radford, Parker ripped down 20 rebounds and poured in 14 points, to go along with five rejections, a pair of assists and one steal. The honor marks her second Big South Player of the Week plaudit this season.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. The Big South Conference has picked up a couple wins over BCS Conference schools during the 2012-13 season. Presbyterian College got the ball rolling with a win over Clemson of the ACC on Nov. 11. DOUBLE-TROUBLE

CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently in elite company as she is just one of 36 players in the country averaging a double-double. She is posting 18.0 points per outing, while ripping down 13.5 rebounds per game. Against Longwood on Feb. 7, Parker exploded for 34 points and 20 rebounds.

ENJOYING THE VIEW

CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 in the nation with 13.5 rebounds per game, while her 4.43 blocked shots per game are good for No. 1 nationally. She is also ranked No. 2 nationally with 19 double-doubles.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's SHAQUILLA NUNN is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week three times this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.43 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.8 blocked shots per game... For her career, Parker has 298 rejections and is closing in on the Big South record of 306, held by former Panther Mackenzie Maier.

SCORE'N

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's DEVON BROWN put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while CHEYENNE PARKER notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer and put in a Big South season-high 34 points in HPU's win over Longwood. CRYSTAL SMITH of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb and posted 32 in Longwood's win over Campbell.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. FRED APPLIN is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. DeUNNA HENDRIX is running the Panthers, while KEVIN COOK has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

MILLIS CENTER (NORTH)

With High Point's win over Liberty on Jan. 17 at the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back to back games on the road at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1993-94 and 1996-97 seasons.

DEQUESHA

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted a League-best 11 20-point games this season, to go along with four games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with multiple 20-point, 10 assist games as she has three this season.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with six consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 20 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

She then blocked Gentry Manley's game-tying layup attempt on the ensuing possession and grabbed the rebound to secure the victory ... Coastal returns to The HTC Center for its final two regular season home games of the season starting on Thursday against Presbyterian College followed by Gardner-Webb on Saturday.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs bid for four straight wins came up short last week, as GWU split its two home contests with a win over Presbyterian and a loss to Charleston Southern. In the 55-38 win over PC on Thursday night, GWU held the Lady Blue Hose to only three made field goals over the final 20 minutes of play en route to the double digit win. Without sharpshooter **JASMINE DALE**, who missed the game due to an injury, GWU, who usually shoots over 35 percent from behind the three-point line on the season struggled to find its offense outside the paint in the loss. GWU will look to rebound this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will hit the road to take on Campbell on Thursday night, February 14th, at 7 p.m., before taking on Coastal Carolina on Saturday night, February 16th, at 4 p.m. in Conway, S.C.

HIGH POINT

High Point picked up two road wins this week, at Longwood and Radford ... Junior **CHEYENNE PARKER** had double-doubles in both games including 34 points and 20 rebounds at Longwood ... Her 34 points were two shy of HPU's Div. I single-game record of 36 set by **ERIN REYNOLDS** last year against Pittsburgh ... She now has 1,079 career points and 954 career rebounds ... She also has 198 career blocks, eight away from tying the Big South career record, held by former HPU player Mackenzie Maier ... Sophomore **LEXI PATTERSON** had a career-high 11 points at Longwood which she topped with 13 points at Radford in front of her hometown crowd ... The Panthers had four players in double-figure scoring in both games.

LIBERTY

Liberty won its only game last week, posting a 97-56 win at Longwood on Saturday to take sole possession of first place in the Big South standings at 10-2 ... The Lady Flames have now won five straight games overall, eight straight contests against Longwood, eight straight games against in-state opponents and nine straight road tilts ... Liberty's 97 points were a season high, and the Lady Flames have now scored 90 or more points five times this year ... This is the first time Liberty has ever posted five 90-point games during a single season ... Liberty's next victory will be No. 600 in program history ... The Lady Flames are 599-437 overall, and this is the team's 39th season ... Head coach **CAREY GREEN** has coached 100 games in February during his 14 seasons at Liberty and is 92-8 in those contests ... During Saturday's game, **TOLU OMOTOLA** became the 10th Lady Flame ever to total 600 career rebounds ... **DEVON BROWN** enters this week with 1,841 career points, leaving her five shy of passing **KATIE FEENSTRA** for third place in program history and seventh place in Big South annals.

LONGWOOD

Longwood University dropped two Big South Conference games at home last week. The squad fell, 79-72, against visiting High Point University on February 7 before suffering a 97-56 setback against Liberty University on Feb. 9. Longwood's nine wins so far this year marks the program's most victories since the 2009-10 season. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 37% (541-1473) from the field, including 29% (154-536) from three-point territory, and 69% (314-456) from the free throw line. Senior **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who has led the team in scoring seven times and surpassed 1,000 career points against High Point, paces the squad with 14.8 points per game. Classmate **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has nine double-doubles so far, is second on the team with 14.4 points per game. Coward leads the team with 8.0 rebounds per game, as well. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 13.5 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, Feb. 14 when it hosts to league opponent Radford University for a 7 p.m. tilt.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose dropped their only game last week, a 55-38 defeat at Gardner-Webb... **KARLEE TAYLOR** led the team with 11 points and played all 40 minutes, the first member of the Blue Hose to go the distance this season... PC's next league win would give the team nine for the season, setting a new program high in Big South wins... **DRIA DAVID** dished out her 300th career assist on Thursday... **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** passed Cameron Cook (2002-06) for seventh place in program history with her 589th career rebound... The Blue Hose have alternated wins and losses for the past eight games and have not lost two games in a row dating back a pair of defeats against Eastern Kentucky and Marshall on November 30 and December 1... PC will look to get back on track with repeat wins over Coastal Carolina (February 14) and Charleston Southern (February 16) this week.

RADFORD

Despite senior guard **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** becoming the 20th member of the 1,000-point club at Radford, the Highlanders dropped home contests to Campbell (52-66) and High Point (57-65) last week to fall to 12-10 on the season. Currently on a three-game slide, RU will look to get back on the winning track when the squad faces its in-state Big South foes Longwood (Feb. 14) and Liberty (Feb. 16) this week.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with a 54-48 setback to Charleston Southern on Thursday followed by a 50-46 loss to Coastal Carolina on Saturday. Asheville has now dropped 15 games in a row. Asheville has now lost 24 Big South Conference games in a row, with the Bulldogs last victory coming against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012. In the game against Radford on Jan. 3, senior forward **KELLI RILES** became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in rebounds in the NCAA Division era, pulling down 10 rebounds to reach 899 for her career, passing former Bulldog great Wendy Beecher (894). The all-time record at UNC Asheville is 2,200 boards, recorded by Sheila Ford from 1980-84, when the Bulldogs were an NAIA institution. Riles now has 989 for her career, moving into fifth place in Big South history for rebounds. She passed former Liberty great Megan Frazee, who had 951 in her career. She is 23 rebounds behind fourth place, currently held by Radford's Karen Bowles (1,012). Riles also has 980 points in her career, 20 away from 1,000. The Bulldogs have now lost 26 consecutive road games. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. The Bulldogs will be on the road for their next two games, playing at High Point on Thursday and then Campbell on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Winthrop's eight-game winning streak was snapped and its chance of setting a record for most consecutive victories in the program's history went down the drain in a 84-69 home loss to hot-shooting Campbell. The Camels gained revenge for a 23-point loss Winthrop handed them on Jan. 26. **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** tied her season-high in scoring with 27 points on 10 of 21 FG shooting and **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** scored 15 points (all in the first half).
