McClanahan posted three 20-point games and shot 54 percent from the floor to lead the Eagles to a 2-1 record last week, including a pair of Big South wins. The Big South Preseason Player of the Year got her week started with 21 points on 77 percent from the floor to go along with five rebounds, two steals and two assists against South Carolina State on Jan. 8. Two days later against UNC Asheville, the guard put in 23 points, including a perfect 10-of-10 from the charity stripe. She also chipped in five rebounds, five helpers, a pair of blocks and two steals in the win over the Bulldogs. McClanahan closed her week out with 23 points, seven rebounds, seven assists and four steals in the 60-55 win over Gardner-Webb on Jan. 12. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week plaudit this season.

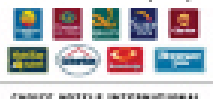

Rininger, a red-shirt freshman from Canton, Ohio, played an important role in Liberty's 2-0 road trip to Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina last week. The forward/center got things going with a team-high 14 points on 70 percent shooting to go along with a team-best 10 rebounds against Charleston Southern on Jan. 10. She also posted five blocked shots in the win, becoming the first Liberty player to post five rejections in a game since 2005. Two days later against Coastal Carolina, Rininger stayed hot as she connected on 71 percent from the floor to finish with 10 points, six rebounds, two blocks and one assist. The honor marks her second Big South Freshman of the Week selection this season.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. BCS BUSTERS

The Big South Conference has picked up a couple win over BCS Conference schools during the 2012-13 season. Presbyterian College got the ball rolling with a win over Clemson off the ACC on Nov. 11. Winthrop followed suit with a win over Mississippi State out of the SEC on Nov. 20. Below is a look at the wins.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

High Point's CHEYENNE PARKER is averaging 18.3 points and 13.6 rebounds per game. She is the only player in the Big South and one of just 36 nationwide averaging a double-double this season.

RADICAL RANKINGS

The Big South Conference has had four squads receive attention on the National Mid-Major Poll at CollegeInsider.com. Liberty, High Point, Winthrop and Campbell have either been ranked or recieved votes in the poll this season.

ENJOYING THE VIEW

The Big South Conference currently has two players ranked in the Top 5 in the national individual stats. CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 with 13.6 rebounds per game, while her 4.29 blocked shots per game is good for No. 1 nationally. She is also ranked No. 2 nationally with 14 double-doubles.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's SHAQUILLA NUNN is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week twice this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.29 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.5 blocked shots per game.

SCORE'N

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's DEVON BROWN put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while CHEYENNE PARKER notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer. CRYSTAL SMITH of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. FRED APPLIN is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. DeUNNA HENDRIX is running the Panthers, while KEVIN COOK has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

DEQUESHA

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted a League-best eight 20-point games this season, to go along with three games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with two 20-point, 10 assist games.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with six consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 15 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

Campbell moved to 12-4 overall and 4-1 in the Big South with a weekly sweep of Gardner-Webb, 59-49, and High Point, 79-76....**TONISHA BAKER** posted a season-high 24 points against High Point as for the first time this season four Lady Camels hit double-figures - **ROSLYN PRESLEY** (18), **KIERA GAINES** (14) and **ZENA LOVETTE** (12)...Lovette and Gaines were the primary scoring threats at Gardner-Webb with 13 points each....The Lady Camels forced a season-high 28 turnovers at GWU, leading to 25 points...Baker moved into 7th on the Lady Camels career charts vs. High Point and now has 1,288 points passing **RHONDA MUELLER** (1978-82) at 1,276...Baker also posted her 300th career assist against Gardner-Webb and became the eighth player to hit that mark with Associate Head Coach **MARY WEISS** in seventh at 342 assists...Head Coach **WANDA WATKINS** has 490 career victories and the count down to 500 is now at 10....Campbell ranked seventh nationally (1/11 report) with 3FG% at .390, 19th in steals at 12.6 and 23rd in assists at 16.6, but bumped up its season average in each category vs. High Point.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern fell in both games this week at home as the Lady Bucs are in the midst of a five game losing streak...CSU fell at home on Thursday to Liberty despite 20 points by **LAKEITHA ALSTON** as the Lady Flames took control of the game early...CSU was held without a made field goal for the final 11:42 in the game as the Lady Bucs fell 92-33...A balanced scoring attack paced CSU against Longwood in weekend action as all nine Lady Bucs players found the basket in the game, led by Alston's second double-double in three games as the senior forward scored 11 points and added 12 rebounds in the 67-52 loss to the Lancers...**DJ FOWLER** added nine points in the loss as CSU battled back into the game from the free throw line, making 18-of-26 attempts...CSU continues Big South Conference play this weekend with trips to Winthrop and Radford.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 0-2 on the week falling at home to High Point (54-70) and Liberty (48-76) ... Head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** missed both games last week with an illness ... **AJ JORDAN** led Coastal in scoring on the week, notching 11 vs. High Point and 13 vs. Liberty ... The games marked the ninth and 10th time this season the sophomore has reached the 10-point plateau ... Redshirt freshman **DJ HUNTER** scored a career-high nine points against Liberty ... Coastal's shooting struggles continued on the week as both High Point and Liberty held the Chants to less than 35 percent from the field ... Coastal will spend the upcoming week in Virginia, playing Radford on Thursday and Longwood on Saturday ... The Chants split the season series with Radford last year and have not played Longwood since the 1985-86 season.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs are in the middle of its worst losing streak of the year, as GWU has lost five straight contest, with all five coming in Big South Conference play. The Runnin' Bulldogs, who played five games over a 10-day period over the last two weeks, went 0-3 last week with all three losses coming at home in Paul Porter Arena. In each loss, the Runnin' Bulldogs were in the contest late, yet could not finish the game out strong. Over the three losses, GWU was outscored 48-26 over the final five minutes of play and combined to commit 11 turnovers, while only forcing its opponents into two combined. Despite the losses, GWU had a number of big performances from **CATRINA GREEN** (21 points, 16 rebounds and five blocks versus Winthrop) **JESSICA HEILIG** (11 points versus Campbell and nine boards against Radford) and **OLIVIA PARKER** (13 rebounds and three steals versus Campbell). Junior sharp shooter **JASMINE DALE** continued her record streak of consecutive games with at least one made three-pointer, as she drained one in each of the three contests last week to push her streak up to 10 straight games with a trey. GWU will have a much needed break this week before hitting the road to take on UNC Asheville at 2 p.m. on Saturday afternoon.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 1-1 for the week with a win at Coastal Carolina and a loss at Campbell ... The Panthers have played 12 of their 17 games this season on the road and are 6-6 away from the Mills Center ... Junior **CHEYENNE PARKER** continues her record-setting season ... She averaged 18 points and 12 rebounds along with four blocks per game for the week ... She is 25 points from eclipsing 1,000 career points, and has 875 career rebounds, which is fifth all-time at High Point ... Redshirt-sophomore **LINDSAY PUCKETT** set a career-high with 25 points at Campbell ... **STACIA ROBERTSON** has scored in double-digits in each of the last five games.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 2-0 on its annual trip to Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina, scoring its most points ever (168) on the two-game South Carolina swing ... The Lady Flames posted a 59-point win (92-33) at Charleston Southern on Thursday, marking the team's largest margin of victory ever in a Big South contest ... Liberty held its opponents without a point for a total of 18:02, spanning the two games, including the last 11:09 at CSU and the first 6:53 at Coastal Carolina ... The Lady Flames have now won 39 straight games against Coastal Carolina and head coach **CAREY GREEN** is 31-0 coaching against his alma mater ... Liberty has also notched six straight road victories ... **ASHLEY RININGER** blocked five shots at Charleston Southern, marking the first five-block game by a Lady Flame since Feb. 28, 2005, when **KATIE FEENSTRA** turned away six Winthrop shots ... **DEVON BROWN** has climbed to fourth place in program history and ninth place in Big South annals with 1,752 career points ... Liberty has not trailed during its current three-game winning streak and has won the trio of games by an average of 37.7 ppg.

LONGWOOD

Longwood University split a pair of Big South Conference road decisions last week. The team fell, 71-62, at Presbyterian College on January 10 before defeating Charleston Southern, 67-52, on January 12. The squad's margin of victory at CSU was its largest all season. The Lancers' seven wins so far this season ties the program's total number of wins from last season. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 36% (361-996) from the field, including 30% (111-376) from three-point territory, and 69% (198-286) from the free throw line. Senior **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has seven double-doubles so far, leads the team with 16.3 points and 9.1 rebounds per game. Classmate **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who has led the squad in scoring six times this season, is second on the team with 15.6 points per game. Classmate. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 11.9 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, January 17 when it hosts league opponent Campbell University for a 7 p.m. tilt.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College split its two Big South Conference games at home this weekend, knocking off Longwood by a 71-62 margin before falling to Radford, 49-31. Saturday's loss to the Highlanders snaps PC's five game winning streak, the longest in the team's Division I history and the longest since the 2005-06 season. PC's five-game Big South winning streak comes to an end as well, also a Division I-era best... **DRIA DAVID** scored a career-high 22 points and 13 rebounds on Thursday against Longwood, notching her fourth career double-double and the team's second this season... After shooting a season-high 55.1 percent (27-for-49) on Thursday night, the Blue Hose shot a season-low 21.1 percent (8-for-38)... PC entered last week ranked 101 in the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), higher than any other Big South Conference team. The Blue Hose ended the 2011-12 season in the 118 spot.

RADFORD

Radford women's basketball pushed its win streak to three following a road sweep of Gardner-Webb and Presbyterian College. For the fifth time in the series, Radford and Gardner-Webb battled into overtime before the Highlanders reigned victorious by outlasting the Runnin' Bulldogs, 72-69, Thursday night inside Paul Porter Arena. Since Dec. 12, 2004, extra time has been needed in five out of the 11 meetings between the two squads, including four out of the previous six encounters. GWU was unbeaten in overtime contests against Radford until Thursday. Leading the way was **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON**, who finished the night with game-highs of 20 points and five assists. Tying her career-high of 16 points was **SARAH TABB**, who knocked down 5-of-7 from the floor and 6-of-7 from the charity stripe. Ironically, the other 16-point outing Tabb had came against the Runnin' Bulldogs last season in Boiling Springs. **AYANA AVERY** rounded out three double-figure scorers for the Highlanders with 13 points, including a critical 3-pointer late in regulation to keep RU's hopes of a comeback victory alive. **VICTORIA HAMILTON** reeled in a game-high 11 boards to go along with nine points, while **JORDYNN GAYMON** filled up the stat sheet with nine rebounds and eight points. Presbyterian College entered Saturday's matchup second in the Big South in scoring defense, but it was Radford's defense rising to the occasion as the Highlanders handed PC its first setback in league play, 49-31, inside the Templeton Center. Hamilton notched a season-high 16 points on 6-of-10 shooting to spearhead the Highlanders' offensive attack. The senior from the U.S. Virgin Islands narrowly missed a double-double, pulling down a game-high nine rebounds. Buckhannon dished out a game-high four assists and was credited with a career-high-tying six steals.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-1 on the week, with a 65-59 loss to Winthrop at home in the Kimmel Arena on Thursday evening. The Bulldogs led by six points with just over seven minutes remaining in the game, but the Eagles finished the game on a 23-9 run to earn the victory. The Bulldogs are now 2-14 on the season overall and 0-5 in Big South Conference play. Asheville is also 2-7 at home, 0-6 on the road and 0-1 in neutral site games. Asheville has now lost 16 Big South Conference games in a row, with the Bulldogs last victory coming against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012. In the game against Radford on Jan. 3, senior forward **KELLI RILES** became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in rebounds in the NCAA Division era, pulling down 10 rebounds to reach 899 for her career, passing former Bulldog great Wendy Beecher (894). The all-time record at UNC Asheville is 2,200 boards, recorded by Sheila Ford from 1980-84, when the Bulldogs were an NAIA institution. Riles now has 911 for her career. The Bulldogs have now lost 22 consecutive road games. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. The Bulldogs will host Presbyterian College on Thursday evening before hosting Gardner-Webb on Saturday at Kimmel Arena this week.

WINTHROP

Winthrop won two Big South games on the road in which they lost the lead in the second half only to come back in the final minutes to win. **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** scored 23 points in both wins and also had 21 in the non-conference loss at South Carolina State. Freshman **SCHAQUILLA NUNN**, who missed the SC State and UNC Asheville games with a groin pull, claimed her 6th double-double of the season with 12 points and 14 rebounds against Gardner-Webb. Sophomore forward **TAYLOR CALVERT** had the best overall game of her career in the win over Asheville as she scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed 17 rebounds while connecting on 9 of 11 field goals. McClanahan has taken over fifth place on the Winthrop career scoring list. She now has 1,343 points in two-plus seasons.
