BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. The Big South Conference has picked up a couple wins over BCS Conference schools during the 2012-13 season. Presbyterian College got the ball rolling with a win over Clemson of the ACC on Nov. 11. DOUBLE-TROUBLE

CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently in elite company as she is just one of 36 players in the country averaging a double-double. She is posting 17.6 points per outing, while ripping down 13.6 rebounds per game. Against Longwood on Feb. 7, Parker exploded for 34 points and 20 rebounds.

ENJOYING THE VIEW

CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently ranked No. 3 in the nation with 13.6 rebounds per game, while her 4.52 blocked shots per game are good for No. 1 nationally. She is also ranked tied for No. 1 nationally with 21 double-doubles.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's SHAQUILLA NUNN is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week three times this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.43 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 8.0 blocked shots per game... For her career, Parker has 309 rejections to rank No. 1 All-Time in the Big South Conference.

SCORE'N

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's DEVON BROWN put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while CHEYENNE PARKER notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer and put in a Big South season-high 34 points in HPU's win over Longwood. CRYSTAL SMITH of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb and posted 32 in Longwood's win over Campbell.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. FRED APPLIN is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. DeUNNA HENDRIX is running the Panthers, while KEVIN COOK has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

MILLIS CENTER (NORTH)

With High Point's win over Liberty on Jan. 17 at the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back to back games on the road at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1993-94 and 1996-97 seasons.

DEQUESHA

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted a League-best 12 20-point games this season, to go along with four games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with multiple 20-point, 10 assist games as she has three this season.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with seven consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 22 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

Campbell has forced at least 20 turnovers in seven-straight games, including a season-high 29 in back-to-back games at Winthrop and against Gardner-Webb... The Lady Camels were efficient in transition against the Bulldogs in forcing 20 turnovers that led directly to 29 points... Baker surpassed associate head coach **MARY WEIS** in assists with 342 for seven on the program's all-time charts... Campbell begins a three-game road trip against Presbyterian, Charleston Southern and High Point to close out the regular season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern fell in their only contest this past week, losing to visiting Presbyterian College in their annual Play 4 Kay contest inside the Buc Dome... CSU drops to 8-15, 3-11 in Big South play on the season with the loss, snapping a two-game winning streak in conference action... **LAKEITHA ALSTON** broached a career record on Saturday against the Blue Hose, pulling down her 600th career rebound in the loss... Presbyterian used a 10-0 run at the beginning of the second half, holding off the Lady Bucs late as Charleston Southern fell, 79-61... Alston led the Lady Bucs with 23 points, narrowly missing out on her fourth double-double of the season with nine rebounds and tied a career-high with three made three-pointers in the game in leading the CSU offense... **ANICIA DOTSON** also connected on three treys in finishing with 14 points, while **SHAY JONES** scored 10 points off the bench, all in the second half, for the Bucs... CSU remains at home for their final two games of the regular season in the Buc Dome this week, welcoming Coastal Carolina on Thursday evening, and Campbell on Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina split its final two regular season home games last week, falling 54-65 to Presbyterian College before rebounding with a 70-67 overtime win against Gardner-Webb ... Coastal finishes its home slate with a 10-5 record ... Coastal has won five of its last six games with four of those victories featuring double digit second-half comebacks ... The Chanticleers overcame a 17-point second-half deficit against Gardner-Webb to send the game into OT ... Coastal has overcome a pair of 17-point second half deficits against Big South opponents this season (vs. Longwood on 1/31) ... The overtime victory was the first in Coastal Carolina history, according to the record books that reflects back to the 1985-86 season ... Coastal overcame a 10-point GWU halftime lead, marking the first time in program history a victory was produced after trailing by double digits at halftime ... **ANGELICA HENRY** averaged 21.5 points per game on the week and scored a career-high 27 points in the victory over Gardner-Webb ... Henry now ranks as Coastal's leading scorer at 11.2 points per game ... **SHATIA COLE** and **KATELYN CONNOR** also averaged in double figures on the week at 11.0 and 10.0, respectively ... The Chants play once in the coming week, traveling to long time Lowcountry rival Charleston Southern for a 5 p.m. tipoff on Thursday.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs struggled with its offensive consistency in each of its two games last week, as GWU fell at Campbell 65-46 and at Coastal Carolina 70-67 in overtime. GWU coughed up the ball 29 times and was 0-of-4 from behind the three-point line for the game in the double digit loss to the Fighting Camels on Thursday night. Gardner-Webb got off to a sluggish start, falling behind by double digit points early in the first half in the 65-46 road loss. The Runnin' Bulldogs losing streak would be extended to three-games on Saturday afternoon, as GWU saw a double digit second half lead evaporate over the final eight minutes of the contest, as Coastal Carolina sent the game into overtime and eventually defeated GWU 70-67. GWU had a trio of players in **MAYHANA DUNOVANT**, **JESSICA HEILIG** and **OLIVIA PARKER** all score in double figures, as the Runnin' Bulldogs also hit seven three-point field goals as a team in the loss. With the overtime loss, GWU falls to 0-2 this season in overtime contests. Gardner-Webb will wrap up its 2012-13 home slate this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will host High Point on Thursday night at 7 p.m. and then Liberty on Saturday afternoon at 3 p.m. GWU's home contest on Thursday night, February 21st, will be the program's 1,000th game of its 37-year history.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 1-1 on the week with a win over UNC Asheville and a loss to Winthrop ... Junior **CHEYENNE PARKER** had eight blocks in the Winthrop game to become the Big South and HPU career blocks leader with 309 career blocks ... She passed former Panther Mackenzie Maier for the all-time record ... Parker is 18 rebounds away from 1,000 for her career ... She will become the first player in HPU's Div. I era to record 1,000 career points and rebounds ... Sophomore **LEXI PATTERSON** has scored in double figures in each of the last four games.

LIBERTY

Liberty posted home victories over Winthrop and Radford this past week, boosting its winning streak to a season-long seven games and reaching the 20-win mark for the sixth consecutive season ... The Lady Flames also opened up a two-game lead atop the Big South standings with four games remaining and clinched a bye into the quarterfinal round of the Big South Women's Basketball Championship ... This week, Liberty will have a chance to set a new program record for longest road winning streak when the Lady Flames travel to UNC Asheville (Thursday) and Gardner-Webb (Saturday) ... The Lady Flames have won nine consecutive road games and the existing program standard is 10 ... **DEVON BROWN** has scored 1,869 career points, which is good for third place in program history and sixth place in Big South history ... She needs 15 points to pass **MEGAN FRAZEE** as the second-leading all-time scorer at Liberty and the fifth-leading scorer in Big South annals ... **TOLU OMOTOLA** is creeping toward the 1,000-point mark in her third season as a Lady Flame ... She has scored in double figures in a career-best nine straight games, giving her 891 career tallies.

LONGWOOD

Longwood University, currently in the midst of a seven-game skid, lost its only game of the week at home to move to 9-16 overall and 6-8 in Big South Conference action. The squad fell, 60-46, against visiting Radford University on February 14. Longwood's nine wins so far this year marks the program's most victories since the 2009-10 season. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 36% (556-1529) from the field, including 28% (157-553) from three-point territory, and 68% (327-478) from the free throw line. Senior **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who has led the team in scoring seven times and surpassed 1,000 career points against High Point, paces the squad with 14.5 points per game. Classmate **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has 10 double-doubles so far, is second on the team with 14.3 points per game. Coward leads the team with 8.1 rebounds per game, as well. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 13.3 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, Feb. 21 when it travels to league opponent Winthrop University for a 7 p.m. tilt.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC won both of its games last week on the road against Coastal Carolina (65-54) and Charleston Southern (79-61), breaking an eight-game streak of alternating wins and losses dating back to a home loss to Radford on January 12... Saturday's win at Charleston Southern gives PC its 15th win, setting a new Division I era win total record for the program... PC's 79 points on Saturday marked a new season-high... The team scored 10 straight points from the free-throw line against Coastal Carolina and 14 against Charleston Southern... PC went 25-for-29 from the line against Charleston Southern, tying the most free throws made in the team's Division I history. The Blue Hose knocked down more free throws (25) than field goals (23)... **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** tallied her 1,200th career point and 600th career rebound in Saturday's win... **KARLEE TAYLOR** entered Saturday ranked fifth in the nation in three-point shooting and went five-for-five from distance against the Buccaneers... PC returns home for its final two home games of the season, hosting Campbell on Thursday at 7 p.m. and High Point on Saturday at 5 p.m. Saturday's game will be broadcast on ESPN3.

RADFORD

Radford split with its two in-state Big South foes last week, downing Longwood (60-46) before faltering at Liberty (69-60)... Ashley Buckhannon moved into 17th on the all-time scoring list at Radford with 1,062 points.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with a 49-35 setback to High Point on Thursday followed by a 64-39 loss to Campbell on Saturday. Asheville has now dropped 17 games in a row. UNC Asheville senior forward **KELLI RILES** reached 1,000 rebounds for her career against High Point on Thursday, before reaching 1,000 career points against Campbell on Saturday. She now has 1,004 points and 1,009 rebounds. Riles is now in fifth place in Big South history in rebounds, three rebounds behind former Radford great Karen Bowles, who amassed 1,1012 rebounds in her career. Asheville has now lost 26 Big South Conference games in a row, with the Bulldogs last victory coming against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. In the game against Radford on Jan. 3, senior forward Riles became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in rebounds in the NCAA Division era, pulling down 10 rebounds to reach 899 for her career, passing former Bulldog great Wendy Beecher (894). The all-time record at UNC Asheville is 2,200 boards, recorded by Sheila Ford from 1980-84, when the Bulldogs were an NAIA institution. The Bulldogs will be at home for their next two games, hosting Liberty on Thursday and then Longwood on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Freshman guard **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** scored a career-high 20 points and made four steals to lead Winthrop past High Point and a series sweep with a 67-62 road win. The Eagles were without senior **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA**, the team's second-leading scorer and the Big South leader in 3-point field goals made per game, who suffered an ankle sprain against Liberty two night before against Liberty. When she went out of the LU game, the Eagles held a 42-38 lead, but ended up losing 69-54. Junior point guard **DE-QUESHA MCCLANAHAN** scored 25 points against the Flames and averaged 22 points 6.5 assists in the two games last week.
