Two days later against Radford, the forward poured in 20 points, pulled down six rebounds and came away with three steals, a block and an assist. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

Brown had a career week this week, as she helped lead the Runnin' Bulldogs to a 1-1 record in League play. In the road loss to Presbyterian on Jan. 24, Brown led GWU with 14 points, then a career-high, on 5-of-8 shooting (62.5 percent) from the floor and 4-of-6 (66.7 percent) from the free throw line. She also hauled in a team-high eight rebounds, and recorded three steals and two blocks on the defensive end. Two days later at Charleston Southern, she exceeded those stats, as she poured in a new career-high 22 points, on 10-of-15 shooting (66.7 percent) and was a perfect 2-of-2 from the charity stripe. She led GWU's defensive effort, as she recorded six steals and also hauled in three rebounds in 39 minutes of play. The honor marks her first Big South Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

## BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. ## DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes averaging double-doubles this season. CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently posting 17.5 points and 13.0 rebounds per game, while KELLI RILES of UNC Asheville averages 10.8 ppg and 10.7 rebounds per game. The pair are in elite company as only 37 student-athletes nationwide are averaging a double-double this season.

## ENJOYING THE VIEW

CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 in the nation with 13.0 rebounds per game, while her 4.45 blocked shots per game are good for No. 1 nationally. She is also ranked No. 2 nationally with 16 double-doubles.

## YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's SHAQUILLA NUNN is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week three times this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

## BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.45 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.8 blocked shots per game.

## SCORE'N

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's DEVON BROWN put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while CHEYENNE PARKER notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer. CRYSTAL SMITH of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb and posted 32 in Longwood's win over Campbell. Smith is the only player in the Big South with two 30-point games.

## NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. FRED APPLIN is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. DeUNNA HENDRIX is running the Panthers, while KEVIN COOK has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME**

**MARIAH PIETROWSKI** became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)**

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)**

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

**MILLIS CENTER (NORTH)**

With High Point's win over Liberty on Jan. 17 at the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back to back games on the road at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1993-94 and 1996-97 seasons.

**DEQUESHA**

**DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted a League-best 10 20-point games this season, to go along with four games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with multiple 20-point, 10 assist games as she has three this season.

**QUEENS OF THE CAROM**

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with six consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 17 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

Campbell stands at 5-4 in the Big South following a 1-1 week that included an overtime victory over Radford, 83-77...The Lady Camels were topped by Winthrop, 76-53...**ASHLEY JAMES** and **KIERA GAINES** each posted a double-double for Campbell against the Highlanders...Gaines registered a career-high 26 points and 14 rebounds, while James totaled a personal-best 20 points and 11 boards...They became the third and fourth players to hit 20 points in a game for the Lady Camels joining **TONISHA BAKER** and **MONIQUE SPRY**... Radford sent the contest to overtime as Da'Na Spencer-Edwards hit a jumper with 14 seconds left... Campbell secured a win following a made jumper by Spry from inside the three-point arc and a defensive stop, while making 10-of-11 free throw to close out the contest... The Lady Camels hung tough with Winthrop all afternoon, but was unable to make a run late... Winthrop extended its advantage to 17 with six minutes left to cruise to the win... Campbell was held with just one made three-point field goal for the second time in a three-game stretch... The Lady Camels host Liberty on Thursday at 7 p.m. before facing Longwood on Saturday at 1 p.m. on ESPN3

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern went 1-1 this past week, winning their first Big South Conference game of the season against Asheville, before falling in a tough contest on Saturday against Gardner-Webb... The Lady Bucs improved to 6-12 overall on the season, 1-8 in Big South play... On Thursday evening, CSU seized control of the game early and held off a late UNC Asheville charge inside the Buc Dome in the 73-59 win... CSU built a 21 point lead in the second half and **ERIN BRATCHER** connected on a late three-pointer to end a Bulldogs' run to seal the victory... **DJ FOWLER** recorded her first 20 point game on the season in the win, while **LAKEITHA ALSTON** added 18 points and six rebounds in head coach Fred Applin's first Big South coaching victory... On Saturday against Gardner-Webb, Alston moved into fifth place in the CSU career scoring ranks with a game-high 26 points against the visiting Runnin' Bulldogs, but a late surge by GWU led the visitors to the 59-55 win... CSU used a 15-4 run to take a 26-22 halftime lead inside the Buc Dome... A 22-8 Gardner-Webb run in the second half gave the Runnin' Bulldogs a lead they would not relinquish in the win... Alston moved past Keena Wicker (1,292 points, 2002-07) to move into fifth place all-time and finished the contest with 1,303 points.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina went 1-1 on the week, falling 52-76 to Winthrop and defeating UNC Asheville 73-62 ... Coastal's win over Asheville broke a five-game losing skid and gave the Chanticleers a 29-28 lead in the all-time series ... Each of Coastal's starters scored in double figures against Asheville, marking the first time that feat had been achieved since Jan. 3, 2009, also against UNC Asheville ... **ANGELICA HENRY** and **SHATIA COLE** co-led Coastal in scoring for the week with 13.0 points per game ... Henry turned in a stellar 19-point, 7-rebound effort to lead Coastal over the Bulldogs ... Head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** missed both games last week with an illness ... The Chants close out their current four-game home stand this week as hosts to Longwood on Thursday and Radford on Saturday.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

The Runnin' Bulldogs split its two games last week, as GWU suffered a 57-48 road loss at Presbyterian on Thursday night, before bouncing back to record a 59-55 road win at Charleston Southern on Saturday. The Big South win on Saturday was the Runnin' Bulldogs second conference win this season, both of which have come on the road, which matches GWU's conference wins from all of the 2011-12 season. The win was GWU head coach **RICK REEVES'** 398th career win, pushing him closer to number 400 overall. The Runnin' Bulldogs were led by freshman guard **CANDACE BROWN**, as she recorded a career-high in each of the two contests last week, scoring 14 at PC and 22 in the win at CSU. GWU had three players post double digit points in the win versus the Lady Bucs.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point split a pair of Big South home games, beating Longwood and falling to Radford ... Junior **CHEYENNE PARKER** became the 16th player in HPU history to record 1,000 career points ... She now has 1,014 points and 902 career rebounds ... She is also closing in on the Big South record for blocks with 185 career rejections ... The league record is held by former HPU forward **MACKENZIE MAIER** (306) ... Redshirt-sophomore **STACIA ROBERTSON** has scored in double digits for the last eight games, including a career-high 28 points in the win over Longwood ... She is averaging 15.2 points per game in league play.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty's 91-58 home victory over Longwood on Jan. 26 enabled the Lady Flames to move back into a first-place tie in the Big South standings, with a 7-2 conference mark at the halfway point of the 18-game conference slate ... It was Liberty's 29th all-time meeting with Longwood but the first as conference foes ... The Lady Flames have scored 90 or more points four times this season ... The last time Liberty had four 90-point games in a single season was 1986-87, when the Lady Flames also reached 90 on four occasions ... **EMILY FRAZIER** totaled a career-high 13 assists against Longwood, which was the most assists by a Lady Flame since Kristi Mercer had 13 against UNG on Feb. 16, 1989 ... **DEVON BROWN** scored a game-high 21 points versus the Lancers, moving to within five points of becoming the fourth player in program history and the ninth player in Big South annals to tally 1,800 career points ... Liberty will play its next three games on the road, looking to extend a six-game road winning streak ... The Lady Flames have not lost away from the Vines Center since Nov. 23 at Baylor ... The visiting team has won the last five contests between Liberty and High Point, who the Lady Flames will face on Saturday.

**LONGWOOD**

Longwood University dropped a pair of Big South Conference road decisions last week. The team fell at High Point, 83-66, on Jan. 24 before falling at Liberty, 91-58, on Jan. 26. Longwood's nine wins so far this year marks the program's most victories since the 2009-10 season. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 37% (459-1243) from the field, including 30% (133-448) from three-point territory, and 69% (258-374) from the free throw line. Senior **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who has led the team in scoring seven times, paces the squad with 16.4 points per game. Classmate **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has eight double-doubles so far, is second on the team with 15.5 points per game. Coward leads the team with 8.4 rebounds per game, as well. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 13.1 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, January 31 when it travels to league opponent Coastal Carolina University for a 7 p.m. tilt.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

PC won its only game last week, a 57-48 home victory over Gardner-Webb on Thursday night. The result moved PC to 7-2 in the Big South Conference, tying the Blue Hose with Winthrop and Liberty for the best league record. PC will look for revenge on Thursday when the squad hosts Winthrop, aiming to make up for a 78-50 loss in Rock Hill on January 19... **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** scored a season-high 23 points in Thursday's win. The Blue Hose also blocked nine shots, setting a new Division I-era school single game record... **DRIA DAVID**'s 11 made free throws on Thursday also tied a Division I-era single game school record. David enters the week one assist shy of breaking into the top 10 in program history, with 291... **SHONDA BURNSIDE** turned in a season-high four blocks, tying her with Tonya Kelley (1994-98) for the sixth-most in program history... After Thursday's home matchup against Winthrop, PC welcomes UNC Asheville on Saturday afternoon.

**RADFORD**

Despite five players in double figures, Radford women's basketball could not overcome a 55-32 rebounding disadvantage as Campbell clawed out an 83-77 Big South overtime victory over the Highlanders inside Gore Arena Thursday night. With the loss, Radford's win streak ended at five games. The Lady Camels' victory also snapped a five-game losing streak in the all-time series with RU. For the first time since Feb. 10, 2010, the Highlanders had five double-digit scorers. **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** led the way with 14 points on 7-of-13 shooting, including the deuce to force overtime with 14 seconds remaining in regulation. **AYANA AVERY** and **DIANI MASON** chipped in 13 points apiece, while **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** and **VICTORIA HAMILTON** charted 10 points each. Buckhannon also contributed a game-high six steals, while Sarah Tabb hauled in a team-best eight boards. Radford connected on 43.1 percent from the floor and was sharp from the charity stripe (84.2 percent). After grabbing its first double-figure lead in the second half, the Radford women's basketball team had to fend off a furious High Point comeback that allowed the Panthers to reclaim the lead, but the Highlanders held on for the crucial 64-55 Big South victory Saturday evening at the Millis Center. For the second straight outing, Erwin Spencer led the Highlanders with 17 points on 5-of-11 shooting to go along with a 7-for-10 performance from the charity stripe. Avery played phenomenal in front of her home crowd, torching the nets for 10 points, which included two critical 3-pointers in response to High Point's second-half surge. **ASHIA HOLMES** was credited with a career-high-tying four assists. Coming in as the third-best team in the Big South in rebounding (43.8), High Point was held to just 37 (tied for the fourth-fewest this season) while RU hauled in 40. **JORDYNN GAYMON** led the way in the rebounding department for the Highlanders with eight.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with a 73-59 setback to Charleston Southern on Thursday before falling to Coastal Carolina on Saturday, 73-62. Asheville has now dropped 11 games in a row. Asheville has now lost 20 Big South Conference games in a row, with the Bulldogs last victory coming against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012. In the game against Radford on Jan. 3, senior forward **KELLI RILES** became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in rebounds in the NCAA Division era, pulling down 10 rebounds to reach 899 for her career, passing former Bulldog great Wendy Beecher (894). The all-time record at UNC Asheville is 2,200 boards, recorded by Sheila Ford from 1980-84, when the Bulldogs were an NAIA institution. Riles now has 965 for her career, moving into fifth place in Big South history for rebounds. She passed former Liberty great Megan Frazee, who had 951 in her career. She is 47 rebounds behind fourth place, currently held by Radford's Karen Bowles (1,012). The Bulldogs have now lost 24 consecutive road games. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. The Bulldogs will be on the road for their next two games, playing at Gardner-Webb on Thursday evening followed by a trip to Presbyterian on Saturday.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop established a new school record for most consecutive Big South wins with six straight with road victories over Coastal Carolina and Campbell. The Eagles are now two wins away from equaling the longest winning streak for all games in school history of eight set back in 1983-84. Winthrop's last four wins have all come by margins of 20 or more points. The Eagles got outstanding performances from **DEQUESA MCCLANAHAN**, **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA**, **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** in last week's two wins. McClanahan averaged 20.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 4 assists and connected on 54 percent from the floor (14-26). She scored 25 in the win at Campbell. In her last six games, McClanahan is averaging 23.5 points, 6 rebounds and 6.3 assists. Choibekova averaged 18 point, 5.5 rebounds and connected on 10 three-pointers. She equaled her season-high with 23 points at Coastal as she went 6 of 8 from long distance. Kilpatrick averaged 13.5 points, 6 rebounds and 3.5 assists while Calvert averaged 8 points and 7 rebounds. The Eagles connected on 50 percent from the floor (30-60) against Campbell. The Eagles are 13-0 this year when they hold their opponent to 40 percent or lower field goal shooting.
