Omotola, a redshirt senior from Houston, Texas, averaged 16.0 points per game on 57 percent shooting to lead the Lady Flames to a pair of Big South wins last week. The forward/center got her week started with 10 points as she connected on 71 percent from the floor to lead Liberty to the win over Campbell on Jan. 31. She also chipped in seven rebounds, three blocks and a steal against the Fighting Camels. Two days later against High Point, Omotola recorded 22 points, 12 rebounds, three steals and a block as the Lady Flames defeated High Point, 67-59. The honor marks her third Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

In the win over Presbyterian College on Jan. 31, Kilpatrick notched 12 points on 57 percent from the floor, 2-of-2 from long range and two from the line. She also came away with five steals and three assists to go along with two boards against the Blue Hose. She followed that effort with 16 points on 71 percent shooting, as well as five rebounds, two steals and two helpers in the win over Charleston Southern on Feb. 2. The honor marks her first Big South Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Winthrop University junior guard DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. BCS BUSTERS

The Big South Conference has picked up a couple wins over BCS Conference schools during the 2012-13 season. Presbyterian College got the ball rolling with a win over Clemson of the ACC on Nov. 11. Winthrop followed suit with a win over Mississippi State out of the SEC on Nov. 20. Below is a look at the wins.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

The Big South has two student-athletes averaging double-doubles this season. CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently posting 17.5 points and 13.0 rebounds per game, while KELLI RILES of UNC Asheville averages 10.8 ppg and 10.7 rebounds per game. The pair are in elite company as only 37 student-athletes nationwide are averaging a double-double this season.

ENJOYING THE VIEW

CHEYENNE PARKER of High Point is currently ranked No. 2 in the nation with 12.9 rebounds per game, while her 4.52 blocked shots per game are good for No. 1 nationally. She is also ranked No. 2 nationally with 17 double-doubles.

YOU DON'T WANT NUNN

Winthrop's SHAQUILLA NUNN is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week three times this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

BLOCK PARTY

Led by Parker's 4.45 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 8.0 blocked shots per game... For her career, Parker has 291 rejections and is closing in on the Big South record of 306, held by former Panther Mackenzie Maier.

SCORE'N

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's DEVON BROWN put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while CHEYENNE PARKER notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer. CRYSTAL SMITH of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb and posted 32 in Longwood's win over Campbell. Smith is the only player in the Big South with two 30-point games.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. FRED APPLIN is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. DeUNNA HENDRIX is running the Panthers, while KEVIN COOK has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME

MARIAH PIETROWSKI became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

MILLIS CENTER (NORTH)

With High Point's win over Liberty on Jan. 17 at the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back to back games on the road at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1993-94 and 1996-97 seasons.

DEQUESHA

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted a League-best 10 20-point games this season, to go along with four games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with multiple 20-point, 10 assist games as she has three this season.

QUEENS OF THE CAROM

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with six consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 18 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs extended its winning streak to two games and completed the regular season series sweep of UNC Asheville with a 73-47 home win last week. GWU's win handed Head Coach **RICK REEVES** his 399th career win, making him just one short of career win number 400 heading into play this week. In last week's conference win over Asheville, GWU forced the Bulldogs into 22 turnovers and out-rebounded Asheville 41-24. Behind **JASMINE DALE's** four three-pointers, the Runnin' Bulldogs were 10-of-21 (47.6 percent) from downtown for the game, including a perfect 6-of-6 in the second half. GWU still ranks first in the conference and in the top-20 in field goal percentage defense, as the Runnin' Bulldogs are holding its opponents to only 33.8 percent shooting on the season, and also ranks second in the League in 3-pt field goal defense by holding their foes to a shooting percentage of 27.1 percent from behind the arc on the year. GWU is also second in the League in 3-point shooting (35.7 percent), rebounding margin (+7.5) and blocked shots (4.7) per game. Gardner-Webb, who has three out of its last five games will look to continue to add to its recent success in conference play this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will host Presbyterian on Thursday night at 7 p.m. and Charleston Southern on Saturday at 4:30 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point split the season series with Liberty after a 67-59 loss on Saturday ... **CHEY-ENNE PARKER** recorded her 17th double-double of the season with 17 points and 12 rebounds in the game ... She now has 914 career rebounds, closing in on becoming the fifth player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds ... She also has 291 blocks, closing in on Mackenzie Maier's 306 career blocks which is both the HPU and Big South records.

LIBERTY

Liberty won games at Campbell and High Point last week, extending its road winning streak to eight ... The Lady Flames have not lost a road game since Nov. 23 at Baylor and are 6-0 in Big South road tilts this season ... Saturday's 67-59 victory at High Point came after the Lady Flames trailed by 15 points (38-23) at halftime ... Liberty had not overcome a 15-point deficit to win a game since Nov. 21, 2009, when the Lady Flames trailed Navy by 16 points before rallying to post a 55-43 win ... At 17-6, Liberty has clinched its 17th straight winning season ... Three more victories will give the Lady Flames their 15th 20-win season in the last 17 years ... With 1,828 career points, **DEVON BROWN** ranks fourth in program history and eighth in Big South history ... Brown needs 18 points to pass **KATIE FEENSTRA** on both lists ... **TOLU OMOTOLA** spearheaded the second-half comeback at High Point, posting 17 points and 9 rebounds after halftime ... The Lady Flames are now 35-4 all-time when Omotola scores in double figures ... Liberty has outrebounded 18 straight opponents and tops the nation in rebound margin at +17.6.

LONGWOOD

Longwood University lost two Big South Conference games on the road last week. Despite leading by 17 with 10 minutes to play, the team fell at Coastal Carolina University, 66-62, on January 31. The squad then fell at Campbell University, 62-51, on February 2. Longwood's nine wins so far this year marks the program's most victories since the 2009-10 season. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 37% (498-1350) from the field, including 29% (141-487) from three-point territory, and 69% (285-411) from the free throw line. Senior **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who has led the team in scoring seven times, paces the squad with 15.4 points per game. Classmate **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has nine double-doubles so far, is second on the team with 14.8 points per game. Coward leads the team with 8.5 rebounds per game, as well. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 13.2 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, Feb. 7 when it hosts to league opponent High Point University for a 7 p.m. tilt.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC split its two games last week, falling to Winthrop, 77-42, before dispatching UNC Asheville on Saturday, 71-40. The Blue Hose are 4-3 in their last seven games, alternating between wins and losses. Saturday's win gave the team its eighth League victory, tying last year's league win total for the most Big South victories in program history... Saturday saw several records fall and players move up the PC record books. **KARLEE TAYLOR** went 3-for-3 from beyond the three-point arc, setting a new PC Division I-era career record (since 2007-08) with 154 treys. The junior guard passed **AMANDA MILLS** (2008-11) mark of 153 and also moves to sole possession of third-place in program history... The Blue Hose shot 65.9 percent from the floor (29-for-44), setting a new Division I-era record for the program as well... **DRIA DAVID** cracked the top 10 in program assists with her 293rd helper while **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** tied for eighth-place in career rebounds, with 587.

RADFORD

Radford split its two-game road swing through the Palmetto State, defeating CSU (64-57) before suffering a 52-51 setback to Coastal Carolina... **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** dialed up a game-high 17 points to pass **AMANDA NEBY** for fourth place on the all-time career scoring chart... **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** enters Thursday's home contest against Campbell needing only one point to become the 20th member of the Radford women's basketball 1,000-point club.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with a 73-47 setback to Gardner-Webb on Thursday followed by a 71-40 loss to Presbyterian College on Saturday. Asheville has now dropped 13 games in a row. Asheville has now lost 22 Big South Conference games in a row, with the Bulldogs last victory coming against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012. In the game against Radford on Jan. 3, senior forward **KELLI RILES** became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in rebounds in the NCAA Division era, pulling down 10 rebounds to reach 899 for her career, passing former Bulldog great Wendy Beecher (894). The all-time record at UNC Asheville is 2,200 boards, recorded by Sheila Ford from 1980-84, when the Bulldogs were an NAIA institution. Riles now has 977 for her career, moving into fifth place in Big South history for rebounds. She passed former Liberty great Megan Frazee, who had 951 in her career. She is 35 rebounds behind fourth place, currently held by Radford's Karen Bowles (1,012). Riles also has 961 points in her career, 39 away from 1,000. The Bulldogs have now lost 26 consecutive road games. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. The Bulldogs will be at home for their next two games, hosting Charleston Southern on Thursday followed by a visit by Coastal Carolina on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Winthrop extended its winning streak to eight in a row to tie the school record which has stood for 29 years when the 1983-84 team last did it. The 35-point win over PC was the largest victory margin against a Big South opponent since the 2008 team defeated Charleston Southern 76-41 in the conference tournament. The eight-point win over CSU ended Winthrop's five-game streak of wins by at least 20 points. Freshman center **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** claimed her 10th double-double with a 16-point, 14-rebound performance against CSU. Senior **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** is only eight 3-pointers shy of 200 in her one-plus seasons as an Eagle. The school record is 263 set in four years by Tiffany Rodd (2005-2009). **DEQUESA MCCLANAHAN** has scored in double figures in 14 straight games. Freshman **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** has had four straight double figure scoring games.
