McClanahan, a junior from Oak Ridge, Tenn., averaged 25.0 points per game and shot 44 percent from the floor to lead the Eagles to a pair of Big South wins last week. She got her week started with 28 points on 45 percent shooting, to go along with eight boards, three assists and a steal in Winthrop's win over Longwood on Feb. 21. Two days later against Radford, the guard notched 22 points and finished the game with six assists, four rebounds and three steals. The honor marks her second Big South Player of the Week selection this season.

**BIG SOUTH PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE**

Winthrop University junior guard **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been voted the 2012-13 Big South Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's Head Coaches and media panel. McClanahan is the reigning Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She led the Conference in scoring with 21.1 points and 7.2 assists last season, becoming just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in both categories. McClanahan was the first Big South player to average 20.0 points in a season since 2006-07, as well the first to average 7.0 helpers since 1987-88. In addition, she was just the second player in the Big South record books to average 20.0 points and 7.0 assists in the same season. McClanahan was the first Winthrop player to lead the Big South in scoring, and had a League-best 19 20-point games in 2011-12 -- including four games with at least 30 points. In League games she averaged 21.8 points. She also tallied six double-doubles and set the Big South single-season assist record with 224. McClanahan, who grabbed 4.7 rebounds and averaged 2.0 steals per game last year, became the first player in school history to eclipse 1,000 career points prior to her junior season. With the 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Women's Basketball Championship only a week away, the Big South teams are beginning to position themselves for the tournament. Liberty, Presbyterian College, Campbell and Winthrop have each secured first-round byes for the championship. Gardner-Webb, Charleston Southern and UNC Asheville will play in the first round. The fifth seed, and final bye into the quarterfinals is still up for grabs as High Point, Radford, Coastal and Longwood are still mathematically eligible... Also, Liberty has clinched at least a share of the 2013 Big South Women's Basketball Championship. A Lady Flames win in either of its last two games (Coastal Carolina, Feb 28 and Charleston Southern, March 2) would give the Lady Flames the Championship outright and No. 1 seed.

**DOUBLE-TROUBLE**

**CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point and **KELLI RILES** are currently in elite company they are just two of 37 players in the country averaging a double-double. Parker is posting 18.0 points per outing, while ripping down 13.3 rebounds per game. Against Longwood on Feb. 7, Parker exploded for 34 points and 20 rebounds. Riles currently has 10.9 points and 10.0 rebounds per game.

**ENJOYING THE VIEW**

**CHEYENNE PARKER** of High Point is currently ranked No. 3 in the nation with 13.3 rebounds per game, while her 4.48 blocked shots per game are good for No. 1 nationally. She is also ranked or No. 2 nationally with 22 double-doubles.

**YOU DON'T WANT NUNN**

Winthrop's **SHAQUILLA NUNN** is establishing herself as one of the top Freshmen in the Big South Conference this season. On Nov. 20 she posted the top Freshman performance this season as she turned in a triple-double of 10 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against the Mississippi State. She has been named the League's Freshman of the Week four times this season. Her 10 blocks tied the Big South single-game record.

**BLOCK PARTY**

Led by Parker's 4.48 rejections per game, the High Point Panthers currently lead the nation with 7.9 blocked shots per game... For her career, Parker has 317 rejections to rank No. 1 All-Time in the Big South Conference. Parker also has 121 blocks this season, tying her own Big South single-season record

**SCORE'N**

The Big South has three student-athletes with 30 point games this season ... Liberty's **DEVON BROWN** put in 32 points in the win over Winthrop, while **CHEYENNE PARKER** notched 31 points in High Point's win over Mercer and put in a Big South season-high 34 points in HPU's win over Longwood. **CRYSTAL SMITH** of Longwood chipped in 32 points vs. Gardner-Webb and posted 32 in Longwood's win over Campbell.

**NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE**

The Big South has four new head coaches on the sidelines this season. **FRED APPLIN** is the new coach at Charleston Southern, while **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** take over at UNC Asheville. High Point and Winthrop also have new leaders in place with the promotion of assistant coaches. **DeUNNA HENDRIX** is running the Panthers, while **KEVIN COOK** has the reigns of the Eagles' program. All of them have picked up their first wins at their respective schools early in the season.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME**

**MARIAH PIETROWSKI** became the first Presbyterian College women's basketball player in the Division I to score 1,000 points in her career. The milestone came against North Carolina Central on Nov. 24. She also grabbed her 500th career rebound against Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 30 to become the first player in the Division I era to tally 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in a career.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 2)**

The Liberty Lady Flames achieved a first as they picked up their first-ever win at James Madison on Dec. 4. The Dukes had won 87 of their previous 100 games in their home gym prior to the Lady Flames knocking them off.

**FIRST TIME IS A GREAT TIME (PART 3)**

The Longwood Lancers wasted no time picking up the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Conference win. In its first League game, Longwood defeated Radford 57-40 for its first Conference win since joining the League this season.

**MILLIS CENTER (NORTH)**

With High Point's win over Liberty on Jan. 17 at the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back to back games on the road at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1993-94 and 1996-97 seasons.

**DEQUESA**

**DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** has been crucial for Winthrop this season. She has posted a League-best 14 20-point games this season, to go along with four games with 10-more-assists. McClanahan put in a triple double vs. William & Mary as she finished with 14 points, 15 rebounds and 12 assists. She is the only player in the Big South with multiple 20-point, 10 assist games as she has three this season.

**QUEENS OF THE CAROM**

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** is leading nine players with seven consecutive 10-rebound performances this season. Parker has posted 10-or-more boards in 23 games this season. She pulled down a season-high 21 rebounds on Dec. 16 ... **KELLI RILES** and **TAYLOR CALVERT** have also been busy on the glass ... Parker, Riles and Calvert are the the only players in the Big South this season with games of 20-or-more rebounds. Calvert ripped down 21 rebounds against Troy, while Riles came away with 20 boards against Wofford.

The Lady Camels are locked into the No. 4/5 matchup with one game left at High Point on Thursday and will play Mar. 8 at 2 p.m. in the Big South Championships... Junior forward **ROSLYN PRESLEY** came off the bench for Campbell at Charleston Southern and posted a career-day with 20 points and 11 rebounds for first-career double-double... Campbell won the battle of the boards 48-29, the largest margin in a Big South game for the squad... At Presbyterian, the Lady Camels were held to 33.9 pct. from the floor and were not in sync on offense, while the Blue Hose converted at a 46.8 pct. rate... Free throws also plagued Campbell, who went just 7-of-16 from the line and could have made it a one-possession contest late... The Lady Camels totaled 25 steals on the week and have forced at least 20 turnovers in nine-straight games... Head coach **WANDA WATKINS** notched her 497th-career victory against the Lady Bucs... Campbell will be seeking its first 20-win season since the 2000-01 season and the seventh in program history..

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern went 0-2 at home in their final home stand of the 2012-13 season, falling in overtime to Coastal Carolina and Campbell to end the season... Charleston Southern falls to 8-17, 3-13 in Big South Conference play on the year... **LAKEITHA ALSTON** broached the 1,400+ career point mark against Coastal Carolina, and currently has scored 1,427 career points on the season, 16 points away from fourth place in the CSU record books... The Lady Bucs opened up the week at home on Thursday against Coastal Carolina... With 3.2 seconds remaining and CSU clinging to a 62-59 lead following a 13-0 run, the Lady Bucs had to inbound the ball following a tipped in-bounds pass going off Coastal Carolina... Angelica Henry, however, intercepted the CSU entry pass, taking it down the court and connecting on the game-tying three-pointer as the clock expired, sending the teams into the overtime period... Alston recorded her second double-double of the season against the Chanticleers in the loss, finishing with 21 points and 13 rebounds, while **DJ FOWLER** added 17 points and eight rebounds of her own... **SHAY JONES** and **ERIN BRATCHER** were also in double-digits with 14 points apiece, with Jones finishing the contest with eight rebounds and five steals from the floor... On Saturday, Campbell used a 12-2 run late in the first half and scored the first six points in the second half in seizing control of the game as the Camels held off Charleston Southern on Saturday afternoon inside the Buc Dome, 65-55... When the action began, the Buccaneers again relied on their seniors on the court as Alston led the way with 16 points and six rebounds, while Jones finished in double-digits again with 10 points, connecting on two three-pointers in the loss... Bratcher, courtesy of her five three-pointers rounded out the Lady Bucs in double-digits on the afternoon with 15 points, while Fowler filled the statistics sheet with nine points, eight assists, seven rebounds and five steals in playing all 40 minutes on the floor

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina defeated Charleston Southern 77-72 in overtime in its lone game of the week ... The win was the Chanticleers' second straight overtime victory and sixth win in its last seven games ... The Chants improved 13-13 on the season and 8-8 in Big South play ... Coastal's eight conference wins are the most for the program since finishing the 2008-09 season with and 8-8 league mark ... Katelyn Connor led the Chants at Charleston Southern with a career-high 22 points on 9-of-19 from the field and a perfect 4-of-4 from the free-throw line ... **ANGELICA HENRY** scored 18 points in the win, including the game-tying 3-pointer as time expired ... **KAYLA COOK** tied her career-high with 17 points, while Savannah Pippin corralled a career-high 13 boards ... Henry leads Coastal with 11.4 points per game and has scored in double figures in three straight games, and seven of the Chants' last 10 ... Coastal returns to the road for its final regular season games of the year traveling to Liberty for a 7 p.m. tipoff on Thursday, Feb. 28 before concluding their regular season at High Point on Saturday, March 2.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

The Runnin' Bulldogs snapped its four-game losing streak overall and a four-game losing streak to the High Point Panthers with its 1-1 split this past week. In the program's 1,000th game played on Thursday night, February 21st, the Runnin' Bulldogs forced High Point into a season-high 36 turnovers in a 65-57 home win over the Panthers. GWU recorded 20 steals as a team in the win, which ranks as the third most by a GWU team in a single game in the program's Division I history. In the win, a trio of players in **LANA DORAN**, **JESSICA HEILIG** and **MAY-HANA DUNOVANT** all had double digit points, highlighted by Doran's career-high 15 points. In the Runnin' Bulldogs regular season home finale on Saturday afternoon, GWU outscored the Liberty Lady Flames in the second half, but could not overcome its season-low 13 points in the first half in the 55-40 home loss. GWU held League leading Liberty to a season-low 27.7 percent shooting for the contest and its second lowest point total of the year with their 55 points. However, the Runnin' Bulldogs shot a season-low 21.7 percent and scored a season-low 40 points in the loss. Gardner-Webb will wrap up its regular season slate with road games at Winthrop and Radford this week.

**CHEYENNE PARKER** become the first player in HPU's Div. I era to record 1,000 career points and rebounds ... She has 1,150 points and 1,003 rebounds ... Two HPU players reached the milestone before the Panthers Div. I era, Andrea Blanchard and Angie Green ... Parker also has 121 blocks this season, tying her own Big South single-season record ... High Point will finish the season at home with games against Campbell and Coastal Carolina.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty's victories at UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb enabled the Lady Flames to set a program record for longest road winning streak, at 11 games ... Liberty has not lost a road contest since Nov. 23 at Baylor ... The Lady Flames finished 9-0 in Big South road games this season and have now won a season-best nine straight games overall ... Liberty has clinched at least a share of its 14th Big South regular-season title in the last 16 seasons ... **DEVON BROWN** passed **MEGAN FRAZEE** on the all-time scoring list last week ... Brown now ranks No. 2 in program history and No. 5 in Big South annals with 1,891 career points ... She needs three more points to pass Campbell alum Tammy Brown for fourth place in conference history ... On Thursday, the Lady Flames will be in search of their 40th straight win in the head-to-head series versus Coastal Carolina ... If Liberty wins both of its games this week, the Lady Flames would tie the Big South record for most conference victories in a single season with 16 ... Liberty set the record last season, going 16-2 ... The Lady Flames need a win over Coastal Carolina on Thursday to wrap up a 7-0 February ... Liberty is 96-8 in February under head coach **CAREY GREEN**.

**LONGWOOD**

Longwood University split a pair of decisions last week, falling to Winthrop, 78-46, before ending its eight game skid at UNC Asheville with a 67-54 victory. The squad is currently 10-17 overall and 7-9 in conference action. Longwood's 10 wins so far this year marks the program's most victories since its first season playing Division I during the 2007-08 season. As a whole, Longwood is shooting 36% (596-1655) from the field, including 28% (168-600) from three-point territory, and 68% (349-515) from the free throw line. Senior **CRYSTAL SMITH**, who has led the team in scoring eight times and surpassed 1,000 career points against High Point, paces the squad with 14.7 points per game. Classmate **CHELSEA COWARD**, who has 10 double-doubles so far, is second on the team with 14.3 points per game. Coward leads the team with 8.2 rebounds per game, as well. Freshman **DAEISHA BROWN** rounds out the double-digit scorers for the Lancers with 12.7 points per game. Longwood will return to action on Thursday, Feb. 28 when it hosts league opponent Charleston Southern University for a 7 p.m. tilt.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

The Blue Hose won both of their games last week, knocking off Campbell on Thursday by a 62-51 margin before taking down High Point on ESPN3 on Saturday, 71-69... PC earned a first-round bye with the results... PC has won its last four games, one win shy of tying its longest streak of the season... Saturday's win marked its first-ever against High Point, snapping a 10-game all-time losing streak to the Panthers... PC has recorded 10 or more assists in 23 and boasts a 17-6 record when doing so. The Blue Hose also have a 15-3 record when scoring 50 or more points... PC has allowed opponents to shoot over 40 percent twice in the last nine games. High Point shot 40.7 percent, the first time PC has beaten an opponent that shoots over 40 percent this season... The Blue Hose end the season with a 9-3 home record and will take an 11-4 record in South Carolina into the postseason.

**RADFORD**

Despite receiving a combined 37 points from **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** and **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER**, Radford could not hold on to its lead down the stretch as Winthrop picked up a 67-62 victory Saturday afternoon in Big South women's basketball action inside Winthrop Coliseum. **JORDYNN GAYMON** connected on a jumper in the paint at the 10:31 mark to initiate a 16-4 surge, capped by a Buckhannon trey, to give Radford the 55-52 lead. However, the lead would not hold as the Eagles rallied in the late stages of the game to pull off the come-from-behind win. Buckhannon and Erwin Spencer dropped in 19 and 18 points, respectively, to lead RU in the scoring column. Buckhannon moved into 15th place on the all-time career-scoring chart with 1,081 points, passing Nan Milner and Karen Bowles. **VICTORIA HAMILTON** pulled down a team-best seven boards to claim sole possession of eighth place in career rebounding at Radford with 620 caroms. RU connected on seven 3-pointers in the game, the most since the squad hit nine against Norfolk State on Dec. 13. The Highlanders' defense kept them in it, however, forcing 10 steals which led to a 17-9 advantage in points off turnovers. Radford wraps up regular-season play next week with two home contests. First up is a battle with Presbyterian College on Thursday at 7:00 p.m. The Highlanders claimed a 49-31 triumph at PC on Jan. 12.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 0-2 on the week, with a 75-43 setback against Liberty on Thursday followed by a 67-54 loss to Longwood on Saturday. Asheville has now dropped 19 games in a row. UNC Asheville senior forward **KELLI RILES** reached 1,000 rebounds for her career against High Point on Feb. 14, before reaching 1,000 career points against Campbell on Feb. 16. She now has 1,026 points and 1,031 rebounds. Riles is now in fourth place in Big South history in rebounds, passing former Radford great Karen Bowles, who amassed 1,012 rebounds in her career. Asheville has now lost 28 Big South Conference games in a row, with the Bulldogs last victory coming against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012. The Bulldogs have not won a road game since Feb. 28, 2011, when the Blue & White earned a 66-61 victory over Winthrop at the Winthrop Coliseum. The Bulldogs will travel to Winthrop for their final regular season game of the season next Saturday.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop tied its school record for Big South regular season wins as the Eagles are now 12-4 after wins over Longwood and Radford. **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** continued her strong play as she scored 50 points in the two games, including 28 vs. Longwood and 22 vs. Radford. She has now scored in double figures in 26 games and had more than 20 14 times. The Eagles also got a big week from 6-3 freshman center **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** who averaged 14 points, 9.5 rebounds, and 4.5 blocked shots in the two games and connected on 13 of 17 FGs. Nunn recorded her 12th double-double of the year with 17 points and 11 rebounds against Radford. Freshman guard **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** averaged 10 points and had 5 steals. Winthrop put together a three-game winning streak without the services of second-leading scorer **DIANA CHOIBEKOVA** who suffered a sprained ankle in the Liberty game. Her status is day-to-day.
