#### CAMPBELL

Campbell finished with a 39-21 mark, the third-most victories in school history, guided by Big South Coach of the Year DREW PETERSON, who earned his third honor in 12 seasons (A-Sun - 2x) ... The Camels had five all-conference selections, tying the program record (1994/2012) - First Team - 1B RAVEN LEE, SS ERICKA NESBITT, OF STEPHANIE JONES; Second/Freshman Team - C COURTNEY KLINGLER, P COURTNEY ROBERTS ... Lee was honored on the Big South Championship all-tournament team after going 6-for-9 with 5 RBI, one homer and three walks ... Lee ended the campaign second on the Camels single-season charts with 70 RBI (two behind Amanda Littlejohn - 2008) and 18 homers (two behind Courtney Quinn - 2008) ... Lee will also rank inside the top 6 in the Big South single-season charts in both categories ... The .300 batting average for the Camels was the second-best in the history of the program with a .324 mark back in 1993 being better ... Campbell swiped a total of 118 bases, leading the conference (T-6th on the single-season list) and setting a new school-record ... Other team numbers that fall in the top 10 of the Big South charts are homers (68 - 5th), RBI (298 - 5th), Hits (482 - 10th), Runs (T6th - 322), Saves (T-4th - 6) ... Roberts (20-7) became the fourth Camel to reach 20 wins and second freshman to accomplish the feat ... Klingler hit the most homers as a freshman (13) and was named Big South Freshman of the Year (second-consecutive season the Camels were acknowledged with that award - Jones - 2012) ... Campbell returns its entire team next minus the contributions from seniors RF SARAH FORGACS and P BRITTANY ARNN.

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern picked up wins over No. 9 Presbyterian and No. 1 Coastal Carolina to open up the 2013 Big South Conference Softball Championships, before falling on Friday with back-to-back losses to No. 5 Winthrop and No. 3 Longwood to see their season end ... CSU finishes with a record of 15-40, 6-17 in Big South Conference play ... JENNIFER GILES set a new career high with 11 strikeouts in the CSU win over Presbyterian, and picked up her second shutout win of the season in the Bucs 2-0 victory over Coastal Carolina.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina finished the 2013 season with a 37-22 record, posting the fifth-most victories in school history ... MORGAN NOAD and JESSIE WINANS were named to the Big South All-Tournament team ... Noad went 7 for 16 during the tournament with two home runs, one double, three RBIs and three runs ... Winans went 4 for 13 with two homers and a team-high four RBIs. She also had 16 assists and nine putouts defensively without an error ... The Chanticleers hit a school-record 70 home runs during the year, with KORY HAYDEN and Noad sharing the team-lead with 15 ... Hayden had a team-best 41 RBIs, while Noad totaled 39 ... CACIA PIERRE finished as the team's leader in average at .358, along with 36 RBIs ... BRI CHIUSANO had 29 stolen bases without being caught and scored a team-high 47 runs ... KIANA QUOLAS finished with a 1.94 ERA and a 22-10 record. She and ASHLEY BAGWELL each recorded 151 strikeouts. Pierre and JAZMIN DAIGLE.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

For the first time in the Runnin' Bulldogs' five year history in the Big South Conference, GWU bowed out of the Big South Softball Championship postseason tournament without recording a win, suffering a 4-3loss to No. 2 Campbell and then a 4-2 loss to No. 3 Longwood to go 0-2 at the tournament ... GWU finished the season at 13-31 overall and 8-16 in the Big South conference, finishing in a tie for sixth-place overall with the Liberty Lady Flames ... Despite the disappointing record, GWU had two players named to the All-Conference teams in SAMANTHA MEENAGHAN and MORGAN BAKER, while sophomore shortstop SAVANNAH BURNS was named the 2013 Big South Softball Scholar-Athlete of the Year and received a spot on the Big South All-Academic Team ... Meenaghan, who earned Big South First-Team All-Conference honors for the third straight season, finished the year ranked third in the Big South with a .427 battingaverage and eighth in hits with 67 ... Baker, who was tabbed as a Second-Team All-Conference honoree, finished tied for ninth in the conference with a team-high 39 RBI on the season ... Sophomore KELLIE BERES joined Meenaghan on the College Sports Madness 2013 Big South All-Conference Teams, as Beres, who posted a League high 18 sacrifice bunts on the season, was named to the Madness All-Big South Second-Team, while Meenaghan earned First-Team All-Conferencerecognition.

#### LIBERTY

The Liberty softball team opened up the 2013 Big South Softball Championship with a 5-3 win over No. 3 seed Longwood, with the Lady Flames hitting three homers and getting strong pitching from CHANDLER BALL ... Liberty was the only team to beat Longwood during the conference tournament ... The Lady Flames then fell to the top two seeds in the tournament on Friday, 4-3 to No. 2 Campbell and 2-1 to No. 1 Coastal Carolina ... 20th-year head coach PAUL WETMORE led the Lady Flames for the last time on Friday, ending a successful career that saw him build the Lady Flames into a five-time conference champion (two postseason, three regular-season), while posting 547 victories as the winningest coach in Liberty athletics history ... Ball pitched 18 1/3 innings on the week, holding opponents to a .238 batting average while striking out 14 and posting a 2.67 ERA ... The Lady Flames hit five home runs during the tournament, with homers accounting for six out of Liberty's nine runs scored ... JILL STEPHENS recorded a base hit during both her first career at bat, and in her last collegiate at bat ... KATIE ZAVODNY was named Big South All-Conference first team, as she set or tied four program records on the season ... KASSIDY MCCOY was named to the inaugural Big South All-Freshman team, while MEGAN ROBINSON was tabbed to the Big South All-Academic Team ... SAMMI SHIVOCK is now tied for eighth in program history with 23 career home runs and 94 RBIs, and is 10th with 100 runs scored ... Zavodny, with 79 career stolen bases, is one shy of tying the program record, while CHANDLER BALL is 10th in Liberty history with 201 career strikeouts.

#### LONGWOOD

Longwood currently owns a school-record 41-18 overall mark ... The team defeated Winthrop University, 10-2, in five innings to win its first-ever Big South title in its first year of competition in the league, as well as an automatic NCAA Tournament bid ... The Lancers will square off against regional host, No. 7 University of Tennessee, on Friday, May 17 beginning at 6 p.m. ... Longwood dropped its first Big South Tournament game against No. 6 Liberty, but when undefeated the rest of the way, eliminating No. 7 Gardner-Webb, No. 9 Charleston Southern and No. 2 Campbell to reach the title game ... Sophomore pitcher LIBBY MORRIS was named the Tournament MVP, while senior BROOKE SHORT, and sophomores KORI NISHITOMI and MEGAN BALTZELL earned All-Tournament honors, as well ... Nishitomi leads the Lancers with a .446 batting average ... Senior BROOKE SHORT is second on the team with a .430 average, while sophomore Baltzell, who paces the team with 30 home runs, has a team-high 78 RBI along with a .420 batting average ... Nishitomi leads the team with 28 multiple-hit games, while Baltzell has 23 ... Morris leads the squad in the circle with a 21-8 record.

#### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Four players averaged over a .300 in batting average with JILL MCLEAN leading the way with a .333 ... ERIN RUFF finished with a .325, while CAT TARVIN posted a .316 ... TERA POWELL rounded out the group with her .314 ... PC liked to share the wealth in RBI with all but one starter collecting at least 14 ... Four recorded at least 30 with KERSTEN LEGACKI and SHELBY PETIK leading the way with 35. Ruff had 32, while Tarvin had 31 ... With a teamleading 11 home runs this season, Petik finished 111th in the nation. As a team, the Blue Hose have 45 home runs, or almost one a game (0.85), to put them in the top 75 in the country ... With the extra-inning win over Western Carolina April 24, the Blue Hose equaled last year's mark of 20 wins. The 22 wins was the second most in PC Division I history and was just six from tying the mark of 28 set in 2011 ... PC was 15-0 when leading after the fourth inning, 13-1 after the fifth and 14-1 after the sixth. The Blue Hose were 9- 2 when flawless defensively, but 5-12 when committing one error and 8-17 when committing at least two. The Blue Hose were 17-9 when it got on the board first but just 5-22 when the opponents took the first lead ... Offensively, PC has made tremendous strides since last season. The Blue Hose eclipsed the home run total from 2012 by 22, 45-23 and had 63 more RBI, 218-155. PC surpassed the doubles mark, 70-36 and had 43 more hits, 384-341. Overall, batting average was better as well, .270-.247, as well as slugging pct., .423 - .336.

#### **RADFORD**

Radford concluded its season at the Big South Tournament, falling to host Winthrop and top-seeded Coastal Carolina ... The Highlanders young squad gained plenty of experience throughout the season and will be a veteren group entering their second seasons in 2014 ... Freshman BECKY MANTEL broke the single season hit-by-pitch record (20) after being plunked two more times over the weekend. She also posted the fifth best on base percentage (.467) in program history and is tied for third in career hit by pitches ... Freshman EMILY NAEGELE hit her 10th home run against Winthrop and finished the season tied with junior JESSIE HUTCHEN for the team lead. It was also the second best HR total by a RU rookie, one shy of the mark held by Vicki Madden ... Freshman pitcher RACHAEL WALTERS earned first-team all-conference honors, earning the ninth straight first-team pitcher nod for the Highlanders ... That trio and CASEY BURNS were selected to the all-freshman squad ... In addition, senior outfielder MORGAN EYE, a second-team all-conference selection, registered her career-best 8th outfield assist against Coastal. Her helper was the 20th for Radford's trio of Eye, RYNDEE RUCH (5) and Mantel (7), the most since 19 in 2007 ... As a team, the Highlanders posted top 10 offensive numbers in the record books; hit by pitch (36/2nd), walks (133/4th), home runs (45/5th), slugging (.403/5th), OBP (.336/7th), runs (227/9th)

#### WINTHROP

Eagles made a run to the Championship game from the 5th seed as it finished the tournament with a 3-2 mark after falling to Longwood 10-2 on Sunday ... It was the fourth time Winthrop had been seeded fifth and second time its made the championship game as that seed. It was the seventh time in school history the Eagles have been runner-up in the conference tournament. It was also the school's 12th appearance in the championship game, which is tied for the most in league history ... The team's three tournament wins gave head coach MARK COOKE 47 for his career, which is just one away from the conference record held by Coastal Carolina's JESS DANNELLY. Cooke has been at the helm of 10 of Winthrop's 12 title game appearances ... Senior CHELSEY SCHOENFELDT finished as the school's all-time home run leader with 33 in her career and finished her single-season record for home runs at 17. She came within one RBI of the school's single-season mark of 60. She actually had 60 RBI, but during a three-run home run against Liberty on Apr. 19, a base running mistake cost Schoenfeldt an RBI and it ended up being a two-run home run as one of the runners was ruled out ... MCKENZI CORN finished with a .408 batting average, becoming the sixth different player in school history to bat .400 or better in a season. Her average is the 7th best in school history for a season.
