In doubleheader against USC Upstate, she was 1-for-4 with a double, seven putouts, one walk and two fielding assists. In the 9-5 win over Morehead State, Baker went 3-for-3 with two home runs, five RBI, two runs scored and two walks. She concluded her weekend going 1-for-4 with a RBI single and five putouts in the 4-2 win over UNC Wilmington. This marks Baker's first Player of the Week nod this season.

CAMPBELL

Campbell posted a 2-1 record last week to improve to 8-3 overall ... The 8-2 start tied the 1994 team for the best 10-game beginning to a season in program history ... Sophomore ERICKA NESBITT snapped a 20-game hit streak that dated back to last season against Bowling Green, but extended her reached-base streak to 21-straight contests ... The Camels have four starters with .400 or better batting avg.: Nesbitt (.441), COURTNEY KLINGER (.419), STEPHANIE JONES (.412) and SARAH FORGACS (.400) ... As a team, Campbell has posted a .332 batting avg. and .584 slugging and .434 on-base pct ... The team has blasted 16 home runs ... BRITTANY ARNN (1-0) and OLIVIA SCARBOROUGH (3-1) each notched relief victories during the week ... Campbell plays N.C. Central in a doubleheader before flying to Hawaii for five games.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern saw a weekend washed away by rain and power outages at the College of Charleston Cougar Invitational as the Bucs went 1-1 with a win over Wagner, while falling to South Carolina ... Sophomore pitcher JENNIFER GILES took the mound and the decision in both games, recording her first win of the season over the Seahawks on Friday, before falling on Sunday to the Gamecocks ... STEPHANIE SBARDELLA, MARCI CHRISTIAN and MELANIE STICKNEY all homered this weekend ... Stickney's and Sbardella's were their second HR's of the season ... Charleston Southern's bats exploded in the bottom of the fifth inning against Wagner as the Bucs sent 10 batters to the plate with TREA STEELE capping off the frame with a walk-off double to the fence in centerfield to defeat the Seahawks on the first day of the College of Charleston Cougar Classic ... Giles picked up the win, scattering four hits while striking out five in the win ... In Saturday's action, an eight-run top of the fourth helped the first two runs of the contest for the Bucsaneers with a game-tying two-run blast to straightaway centerfield, while Sbardella went deep with her second home run of the season to left field in the third inning for the Bucs on the final day of the CofC Cougar Classic ... In Sunday's final contest against host CofC, electrical failure in the outfield lights caused both sets to fail, and in the interest of player safety, the game was called and will be rescheduled at a later date, with both teams starting over from scratch ... CSU hosts the Buccaneer Invitational this weekend, with Tennessee, Valparaiso and UNC Wilmington coming to town from March 1-3.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won its first four home games of the season last week, notching 10-2 and 7-2 wins over Rhode Island and 5-1 and 5-3 victories over Loyola Chicago ... The Chanticleers homered in all four games, while totaling seven as a team ... They now have 14 home runs in 14 games this season ... KIANA QUOLAS is currently on a six-game hitting streak, going 9 for 23 at the plate during that time. In the four games this week, Quolas went 7 for 16 with two home runs, one double, one triple nine RBIs and four runs scored. She also notched a complete-game win in the circle, allowing just five hits against Loyola Chicago. She now has 30 strikeouts and just six walks on the season ... KORY HAYDEN hit three home runs in the four games last week, including two in a game against Rhode Island, the first multi-homer game of her career ... ASHLEY BAGWELL went 3-0 in the circle with two complete-game wins and another victory in relief. She allowing a total of seven hits in 16.2 innings, while striking out 22 batters, including 10 against Rhode Island.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs posted their first two wins of the season last week, as GWU went 2-2 overall with wins over Morehead State and UNC Wilmington ... Gardner-Webb bounced back from an 8-0 first game loss and a 5-2 game two loss in a doubleheader with the USC Upstate Spartans on Wednesday afternoon to defeat Morehead State 9-5 and UNC Wilmington 4-2 on Sunday at the weather shortened Seahawk Classic in Wilmington, N.C. ... GWU picked up home runs from MORGAN BAKER and SAMAN-THA MEENAGHAN over the four game stretch, as Baker led the way with six RBI and a slugging percentage of 1.091 overall ... Sophomore outfielder KELLIE BERES led GWU with eight hits, as she was 8-for-13 with an average of .615 overall ... Newcomer ASHLEY RHYNE registered her first win and first save as a Runnin' Bulldog, as she earned the save in the win over Morehead State and a complete game win against UNC Wilmington ... GWU will return to action next week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will compete at the War Eagle Classic hosted by Auburn University on March 1-3rd in Auburn, Alabama.

LONGWOOD

Longwood swept a doubleheader against St. Francis on Feb. 21 and went 3-1 to win its annual Adidas Spring Classic Tournament on Feb. 23-24 to improve to 7-1 on the new season ... KAITE SHINROCK currently leads the Lancers with a .478 batting average (11-23), while MEGAN BALTZELL is hitting .474 (9-19) ... Shinrock leads the squad with four multiple-hit games, while Baltzell and EMILY MURPHY have three apiece ... BROOKE SHORT is in the midst of a six-game hitting streak and also leads the team in the circle with a 4-0 record.

LIBERTY

Liberty (3-6) posted a 2-3 record at the East Carolina Pirate Invitational, opening with a 9-8, eight-inning win against Fairfield and closing with a 5-4 win over the host ECU Pirates ... Liberty hit .301 as a team while in Greenville, hitting five doubles, one triple and five homers ... Against Fairfield, HOLLY SEIZ hit a three-run triple in her second career at bat ... Seiz went on to bat .389 with five RBIs for the weekend ... GRACE NORDAN hit a walk-off, two-run homer in the eighth inning to give Liberty the 9-8 win over Fairfield ... On Sunday against East Carolina, Seiz and Sammi Shivock hit consecutive homers in the first inning ... Pitcher ANNAH JO BRITTINGHAM and the Liberty defense held off the Pirates' late surge, and the Lady Flames claimed a 5-4 win, Liberty's first over ECU since 2004 ... In addition to Shivock, Seiz and Nordan, HANNA NICHOLS and KELBY ALLEN also homered this weekend ... Liberty competes against Hampton on Tuesday in the Lady Flames' earliest home opener in program history ... The Lady Flames will then travel to play against East Tennessee State on Wednesday, concluding a stretch of nine games in six days.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

A team that likes to get on the board early, 34 of the team's 78 runs have come in the first two innings so far this season ... Just 12 games into the season, the Blue Hose are almost halfway to the 155 RBI from all of last season ... They have 70 so far ... PC already has 11 home runs, just 12 shy of last season's 23 ... Five players are batting well over the .300, compared to just one from last year.
