CAMPBELL

Campbell finished the Camel Stampede at 3-1 with wins over Northern Kentucky (6-4), Norfolk State (6-2) and Drexel (4-0) ... The lone defeat came to Morehead State (0-1) on an unearned run in the first ... Nesbitt ended a 29-game reached-base streak going back to last season against the Eagles ... She has compiled a .530 batting avg. with 35 hits so far this year, while reaching base at a .587 rate ... Campbell set a school-record with nine stolen bases against Norfolk State ... The Camels pitching was strong, allowing just 1.00 ERA with Roberts picking up two victories, Callicutt grabbing one and Scarborough notching the second save of her career ... Arnn and Roberts set season-highs with eight strikeouts against Morehead State and Drexel, respectively ... The Camels face Charlotte in a mid-week doubleheader on Wednesday before hosting Gardner-Webb in the first Big South series of the year on Friday (DH)/Saturday.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern struggled at the Long Beach State Mayfair Invitational, falling in all five games to this point, with losses to Cal State Fullerton, UC Santa Barbara, Idaho State, Long Beach State and #9 UCLA ... The Buccaneers wrap up the tournament today against Bethune-Cookman, with first pitch at 1 p.m. Eastern Time ... JANA MATTHEWS broke the CSU career RBI record against Idaho State on Sunday afternoon, driving in a two-RBI single to tie the game against the Bengals ... Matthews now has 115 career RBI, passing Megan Lombard's (2009-12) mark of 113 ... STEPHANIE SBARDELLA kept her on-base streak alive this week ... The junior third baseman has reached base in 14 consecutive games for the Buccaneers, including drawing a fifth inning walk to be the only Buc to reach base against UCLA ... CSU returns home after the Bethune-Cookman game for an 11 game home stand, taking on Appalachian State, Mississippi State and Longwood this weekend to open conference play.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 4-1 in its final tournament of the regular season, with all four victories coming by shutout ... Overall, the Chanticleers last seven wins have been shutouts ... KIANA QUOLAS notched two of the shutouts, giving her four individual shutouts in her last last seven starts. She had a streak of 37 consecutive scoreless innings, which ended against James Madison on Sunday. Quolas is 7-5 on the season with a 1.65 ERA and 63 strikeouts in 76.1 innings ... KORY HAYDEN put together an 11-game hitting streak before going 0 for 2 against Middle Tennessee State on Sunday. She hit .424 during that span with home runs in six of the games and now leads the Chants with nine on the season. Hayden also has a team-high 20 RBIs and is second on the squad with five doubles ... MORGAN NOAD hit a grand slam in Saturday's victory over Middle Tennessee, giving her three slams this season, all of them since March 1 ... CACIA PIERRE leads the team with a .365 average, while BRI CHIUSANO is second at .333 and leads Coastal with 26 hits and 16 runs ... As a team, the Chanticleers have totaled 26 home runs in 24 games this season.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs struggled last week by dropping four straight games to push its losing streak to a season-high six games ... GWU was hit by a big inning in its 10-3 loos to USC Upstate in game one of a twin bill on Thursday, then saw game two called early due to darkness with Upstate in front at 2-1 after six innings of play ... On Friday, GWU hit the road to take on the Charlotte 49ers who used a big inning in each game to sweep the Runnin' Bulldogs 7-3 and 10-2 ... GWU's Jordyn Arrowood had her hitting streak snapped at eight games after going hitless in the first game of the twin tilt versus the 49ers ... However, both JILL BLANK and KELLIE BERES continued their hot bats, as the freshman Blank was 5-of-8 with a run scored on the week, while Beres was 6-of-12 with a double and four runs scored ... Gardner-Webb will look to get back on the right track this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will open up conference play at Campbell in Buies Creek, N.C. on Friday & Saturday, March 15-16th.

Liberty (8-8) went 3-1 at the NCCU Eagle Challenge, downing the host Eagles three times and falling to UNC Wilmington ... The Lady Flames ended the weekend with a 16-3, five-inning win over N.C. Central, setting season highs in hits, runs, RBIs and doubles ... Liberty's 16 runs on Sunday marked the team's highest scoring output since a 16-3 win over Hampton, April 19, 2011 ... AMBER DONOVAN went 4-for-4 with two doubles, three runs scored and a career-high five RBIs in game two Sunday against NCCU, while KATIE HAN had four runs scored against the Eagles ... For the weekend, Donovan hit 5-for-7 (.714) with seven RBIs, two doubles, one homer and four RBIs ... MEGAN ROBINSON hit 6-for-10 on the weekend with seven runs scored, registering two hits in three consecutvie games ... KATIE ZAVODNY stole four bases during the tournament, giving her 17 steals this season and moving her into third place all-time at Liberty with 55 career stolen bases ... The Lady Flames' pitching staff recorded a 2.42 ERA on the weekend, with KENZIE FRIESEN picking up her first two career wins and CHANDLER BALL pitching a complete-game four-hitter ... The Lady Flames have recorded separate streaks of 16 2/3 and 14 innings without allowing an earned run this season ... Liberty next plays at 2012 NCAA Regional participant UCF on Wednesday, before competing in the USF Spring Invitational on the weekend in Clearwater, Fla. ... The Lady Flames will meet USF on Friday, and the Bulls appeared in the 2012 Women's College World Series.

LONGWOOD

Longwood went 7-1 last week to improve to 16-5 so far this season ... The Lancers won two out of three games in its first-ever Big South series at Winthrop before going an undefeated 5-0 at the George Mason Invitational over the weekend ... Sophomore MEGAN BALTZELL currently leads the Lancers with a .492 batting average and 30 RBI, while senior BROOKE SHORT is hitting .483 with 29 RBI. Baltzell leads the squad with 10 multiple-hit games, while sophomore Short and sophomore KORI NISHITOMI have eight apiece ... Short leads the squad in the circle with a 10-2 record.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose went 2-2 in weekend action, including 2-1 at the N.C Central Tournament held in Durham, N.C. ... Three players are batting over .300 wiht ERIN RUFF leading the charge with a .383 batting average ... Six players are already in double-figures in RBI with SHELBY PETIK's 19 pacign the Blue Hose ... The Blue Hose are home this weekend for just the second time this season as they host East Tennessee State Thursday and Towson on Saturday.

RADFORD

Radford went 1-4 at the Miken Maryland Invitational picking up its lone win over the host Terrapins, 4-3 ... Junior JESSIE HUTCHENS knocked in the game-winning run with a double in the top of the seventh ... Freshman HAY-LEY TABORA recorded her first collegiate hit earlier in the contest ... With an outfield assist against Maryland, BECKY MANTEL has three outfield assists, all coming on plays at the plate.

WINTHROP

Winthrop was 5-3 on the week and ended up allowing 40 runs in the three-game conference series opener with Longwood. Winthrop lost game 3 17-5 and it was the first time since March 18, 2004 when the Eagles allowed 15 or more runs in a league contest ... That day Winthrop lost 15-5 to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi ... Winthrop bounced back to go 4-1 the remainder of the week after losing the series to Longwood and the only loss came to #24 Georgia ... Several players had good weeks offensively but none more than senior CHELSEY SCHOENFELDT ... She batted .435 and had a six-game hitting streak come to an end in the only game she didn't collect at least one RBI (vs. North Carolina A&T on Mar. 9) ... She had accounted for nine runs, two doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI with a 1.043 slugging percentage. Her three-run home run against #24 Georgia was the 150th career hit of her career. Just last week she raised her batting average 57 points ... Junior MCKENZI CORN had a very good week as well as she hit a three-run home run against Longwood in the sixth inning to help Winthrop to a 12-10 win and then capped off the week with her first career walk-off home run with a solo shot against Harvard in a 5-4 win. She batted .522 on the week with 10 runs scored, three doubles, two home runs and six RBI. She raised her batting average on the week by 50 points and is now batting a team-best .431. She also has 16 runs scored through 22 games as her season-best came in 2012 with 20 runs in 54 games ... Senior TEJA DURANTE hit the first two home runs of her career over the weekend as she hit a two-run shot against Delaware State and North Carolina A&T ... After two seasons with low power production, Winthrop seems to have found its pop again as the Eagles have 23 home runs through 22 games ... The team had 26 total in 2012 and just 21 in 2011 ... Sophomore pitcher SUTTON WATSON was 2-3 on the week, but recorded her second complete game shutout of the season/career against Kent State as she allowed just three hits. She is now 8-6 on the year and is leading the staff in several categories.
