Klinger belted three home runs in five games to help Campbell to a 5-0 record last week. She finished the week .429 (6-for-14) with a 1.214 slugging percentage, .500 on-base percentage, seven RBI and six runs. The catcher opened her week going 1-for-5 with a home run, two runs, one RBI and one walk in the doubleheader against Charlotte. In a Big South series against Gardner-Webb, Klinger capped off Campbell's five-run inning with a three-run homer to help push the Camels past Gardner-Webb in game 1. In game 2, she blasted another home run and scored two runs. In the series finale, Klinger notched two-doubles while recording two RBI and one run. Klinger is the first freshman to earn the Player of the Week honor this season.

#### CAMPBELL

Campbell notched a mid-week sweep of Charlotte, 6-5, 3-1, before beginning Big South play by taking all three games from Gardner-Webb, 6-5, 11-3 (5), 9-1 (5) ... The Camels jumped on their opponents early this week by scoring 12 runs in the first inning, but used 18 runs in the fifth to seal victories, including two-run rule wins against the Bulldogs ... Sophomore ERICKA NESBITT notched two walk-off hits against the Bulldogs, a grand slam in game two and a two-RBI single in the finale ... Campbell found its offensive fire power with eight home runs including three hit by Klingler ... The pitching staff went 5-0 on the week with a 2.03 ERA with 18 strikeouts in 31 innings pitched ... Senior BRITTANY ARNN and freshman COURTNEY ROBERTS both posted 2-0 marks, while sophomore JULIA CALLICUTT picked up a victory and save ... Campbell welcomes South Carolina on Tuesday night before playing a three-game set at Coastal Carolina.

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern went 1-6 this week, opening with a 9-6 victory over Bethune-Cookman, before falling to Appalachian State, Mississippi State and Longwood to close out the week ... The Buccaneers were led on the week by the powerful bats of MARCI CHRISTIAN and LINZY ROTHER, as the duo combined to hit seven home runs this week, while STEPHANIE SBARDELLA chipped in two of her own ... JANA MATTHEWS became CSU's all-time home run leader in the first game on Saturday against Longwood, connecting on her 28th career home run, passing former teammate MEGAN LOMBARD (2009-12) in the record books ... Rother drilled four home runs this week, connecting on her first two of the season against Bethune-Cookman, including the walk-off three-run blast to win the game, and added dingers against both App State and Longwood ... The Buccaneers take a much needed break this week before hosting Winthrop next weekend in a three-game series at the CSU Softball Field.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina was off last week and now begins Big South Conference play with three-game series' against Longwood and Campbell over a five-day span ... The Chanticleers travel to Longwood for a doubleheader on Tuesday and a single game on Wednesday before returning home to host Campbell on Friday and Saturday.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

One big inning in each of GWU's three games last week ended up costing the Runnin' Bulldogs the contests, as GWU went 0-3 last week with all three losses coming in Blg South Conference play at Campbell in Buies Creek, N.C. ... GWU had a lead or was tied with the Fighting Camels in all three games over the weekend, yet gave up multiple runs in the bottom of the fifth in each contest to lose all three to the home standing Camels and fall to 0-3 on the year in conference action ... GWU suffered a 6-5 loss in game on on Friday, as MORGAN BAKER's five RBI game was erased by a five-run fifth by the Fighting Camels in the win ... In the second game of the doubleheader, GWU allowed seven runs on three home runs to the Camels in the bottom of the fifth to drop that contest, 11-3 ... On Saturday, in the third and final game of the weekend conference series, GWU took a 2-2 game into the bottom of the fifth where Campbell posted a six spot in the inning to earn the 9-1 win ... Baker was 5-for-9 (.556) for the week with a home run, a triple, a double, a walk and five RBI, while SAMANTHA MEENAGHAN was 6-of-10 (.600) with an RBI, two runs scored and a stolen base ... Two other players in TAYLAR PRIDGEN and KELLIE BERES hit over .300 for the week, however, GWU allowed Campbell to hit .386 overall and outscored GWU 26-9 for the three-game span.

#### LIBERTY

The Liberty softball team (11-11) went 3-3 this past week, ending the weekend on a three-game winning streak with victories over Temple, Maine and Dartmouth at the USF Spring Invitational ... On Saturday, Liberty defeated Temple and Maine, winning both games on the final pitch .... The Lady Flames downed Temple, 6-5, in eight innings, with GRACE NORDAN drawing a bases-load walk for the winning run ... Liberty then scored four runs in the bottom of the seventh to beat Maine, 4-3 ... In Liberty's most recent game, the Lady Flames recorded a season-high 15 hits, including eight for extra bases, in a 10-4 win over Dartmouth ... KATIE ZAVODNY, the conference leader with 23 stolen bases, is on a career-best 14-game hitting streak at present. Her 14-game hitting streak is the longest by a Lady Flame since ASHLEY BENSINGER's 15-game hitting streak in 2011 ... During its current three-game winning streak, Liberty is hitting .294 while averaging nearly seven runs per contest, while the pitching staff's ERA is 3.18 ... AMBER DONOVAN is hitting .435 with nine RBIs over Liberty's last 10 games, while Zavodny is batting .400 and MEGAN ROBINSON .375 during that span ... The Lady Flames open up the conference schedule against Radford for the fourth season in a row, Wednesday at Radford ... Liberty is 7-12 all-time in conference openers, with its last conference-opening win coming versus Birmingham-Southern in 2008.

#### LONGWOOD

Longwood went 3-2 last week to improve to 19-7 so far this season ... The Lancers dropped a doubleheader at in-state opponent the University of Virginia on March 14 before sweeping a three-game series at Big South foe Charleston Southern University on March 16-17 ... Sophomore MEGAN BALTZELL currently leads the Lancers with a .459 batting average and is second with 33 RBI, while senior BROOKE SHORT and freshman EMILY MURPHY are tied for first on the squad with 34 RBI apiece ... Nishitomi, who is in the midst of a 17-game hit streak, leads the team with 13 multiple-hit games, while Baltzell has 12. Short leads the squad in the circle with a 11-3 record.

#### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

In just 26 games, the Blue Hose are only 29 RBI from surpassing last year's total of 155 and just two home runs away from tying the 23 from 2012 ... PC opens Blg South play this weekend as the Blue Hose travel to Liberty for a three-game series starting Friday ... PC is 3-4 in league-opening series since the 2009 season, the first year the team was eligible for the Big South tournament.

#### **RADFORD**

Radford posted a 4-2 week, which included a 4-1 mark at the City of Clearwater Invitational ... The Highlanders' bats came alive down in Florida as they batted .394, raising their average from .184 to .239 ... In three of its games, Radford recorded 13-plus hits, matching a season-high with 14 against Quinnipiac... Their eight-run third against LIU-Brooklyn was the biggest inning this year ... They also went to work on the base path, stealing 20 bases, matching the school record of eight on two occasions against Quinnipiac and Rhode Island ... Senior MORGAN EYE, who stole six on the weekend, tied a single-game mark with three against the Rams ... Freshman BECKY MANTEL hit her first collegiate home run against LIU-Brooklyn and has reached base safely in eight straight contests and 10 of last 11 games ... Junior JESSIE HUTCHEN slugged 1.000 (3 doubles, triple, 2 HR) and knocked in eight runs ... In the circle, senior JACKIE JENKINS picked up her first two wins of the season, while freshman ALLIE REID earned her first collegiate win with a complete-game effort against Rhode Island ... The Highlanders begin defense of their four straight regular season Big South titles when they host Liberty in a single game on Wednesday.

#### WINTHROP

The Eagles are in the middle of a road stretch of eight straight games on the road as it started at #6 Tennessee on Tuesday ... The Eagles head to Appalachian State this Wednesday for a doubleheader before getting back to league play on the weekend with a three-game series at Charleston Southern to wrap-up the road trip ... At that point Winthrop will welcome PC for a three-game series at home before embarking on another road stretch of four games ... That will make 12-of-15 games on the road ... KRISTY NOBLE had a rough start to her sophomore season at the plate, getting just 4 hits in first 38 at-bats, but since the second game of the doubleheader with Longwood on Mar. 5, Noble has been on a tear by going 13-for-28 nine runs and an on-base percentage of .571. The average during that time span has gone from .103 to .254. She has two hits in five of her last seven games ... Senior CHELSEY SCHOENFELDT drove in three on the week and now has 107 in her career which moved her into 7th on Winthrop's all-time list. She also connected on her 23rd career home run this week and is now tied for 3rd all-time in school history (seven back of the record). She has seven home runs on the year, which ties her single-season best which she set as a sophomore and repeated as a junior. She's also just five RBI for setting a new single-season best.
