CAMPBELL

Campbell finished the regular season with a 37-19 overall and 18-6 Big South record, second place in the league standings ... The Camels were unable to finish off a potential regular season championship by taking 2-of-3 from Longwood ... Freshman catcher **COURTNEY KLINGLER** ended game one, an ESPN3 broadcast, with a bang on a walk-off two-run homer as the Camels won, 7-6 ... Campbell had the bases loaded with no out in the B7 in game two, down 5-3, but only scored two to tie it as Longwood eventually took the contest in nine innings, 6-5 ... Klingler paced the Camels attack on the weekend with a 6-of-11 performance at the plate and eight RBI ... A program record with 115 stolen bases have already been set by the squad, surpassing the total of 108 in 1995 ... Big South single-season individual charts: Homers (**RAVEN LEE** - 7th - 17), RBI (**RAVEN LEE** - 4th - 65) ... Big South single-season team charts: Homers (5th - 65), Runs scored (10th - 307), Stolen Bases (8th - 115) ... Campbell opens the Big South Championships on Thursday at 5 p.m. against No. 7 Gardner-Webb.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 2-0 on the week in picking up a pair of victories over Presbyterian, but Sunday's series finale was cancelled due to rain, leaving the Bucs and Blue Hose looking ahead to a Big South Championships' first round game on Thursday morning ... CSU took both games of the doubleheader on Saturday afternoon against Presbyterian as the Bucs used the long ball in the first game behind three home runs between **MARCI CHRISTIAN** and **NATALIE YONAN**, while **LINZY ROTHER** connected on a three-run blast to pace a strong pitching performance in leading the Bucs to 7-6 and 7-5 victories over the Blue Hose ... In the first game, Charleston Southern led off the first, third and fourth innings with solo home runs in support of sophomore right-hander **JENNIFER GILES** as the Buccaneers took the first game of the doubleheader against Presbyterian College on Saturday afternoon, topping the Blue Hose, 7-6 ... In the second game, Rother pitched five solid innings on the mound and connected on a three-run home run in the top of the first inning to pace the Buccaneers to the Saturday sweep over Presbyterian, topping the Blue Hose, 7-5, in the nightcap ... CSU and PC open up the tournament on Thursday morning in an elimination game, with the winner advancing to take on top-seed Coastal Carolina.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina captured the 2013 regular-season championship, its first since 2006 and seventh overall, to lead all Big South schools ... The Chanticleers also earned the No. 1 seed for this week's Big South Tournament ... Coastal will take on either Presbyterian or Charleston Southern in its first game on Thursday ... The Chants won their last seven conference games to overtake Campbell for first place ... CCU finished the regular first in the conference in pitching, posting the top ERA as well as the most strikeouts and lowest opponents' batting average ... Individually, **KIANA QUOLAS** led the league in ERA, wins, shutouts and opponents' batting average and ranked second in strikeouts, behind teammate **ASHLEY BAGWELL**.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs had the week off due to exams and now set its sights on the 2013 Big South Softball Championship presented by Musco Sports Lighting this Thursday through Sunday, May 9-12th in Rock Hill, S.C. ... GWU drew the No. 7 seed after finishing the season tied with Liberty in sixth-place overall at 8-16 in conference play ... Liberty held the tiebreaker over the Runnin' Bulldogs with their 2-1 series win in Lynchburg, Va. back on April 12-13th ... GWU has won nine of its final 13 games, including wins over Radford, Charleston Southern, Liberty and Presbyterian ... Over the last 15 games, GWU has outscored its opponents 78 to 64 and has outhit its foes .313 to .268 during that span ... The pitching has been strong for the Runnin' Bulldogs to close out the regular season, as the duo of **ASHLEY RHYNE** and **JESSICA CHILDERS** combined for nine wins and helped to hold its opponents to an average less than .250 overall ... GWU will look to have another strong showing in the Big South Softball Championship this year, as the Runnin' Bulldogs have been only one win away from reaching the championship game in each of the last two years.

LIBERTY

Liberty (19-35, 8-16 Big South) enters the Big South Softball Championship as the No. 6 seed for the second year in a row, and will take on conference newcomer Longwood in the first round ... **SAMMI SHIVOCK** was named to the Capital One Academic All-District III team on Thursday, becoming the first Lady Flame since 2007 to be named All-District ... The Lady Flames closed out their 2013 regular-season schedule with a pair of setbacks to Virginia Tech on Tuesday, despite being three outs away from winning game two ... **KATIE ZAVODNY** stole her program-record 41st base of the season on Tuesday, and needs two more steals to break Stacy Radulovich's (1996-99) Liberty career record of 80 ... Shivock now ranks ninth all-time at Liberty with 93 career RBIs, and is currently in a tie for ninth in home runs (22), and is 10th in runs scored (98) ... **CHANDLER BALL** is ranked 10th in program history with 187 career strikeouts ... The Lady Flames will play in the 2013 Big South Softball Championship, held at Winthrop's Terry Field ... Liberty has experienced much success in conference tournament play in Rock Hill, S.C., winning its two Big South championships there (2002, 2011) while finishing as runner-up in 1998 and 2008 when the tournament was hosted by Winthrop.

LONGWOOD

Longwood improved to 36-17 overall and 16-8 in Big South games last week after the squad traveled to conference opponent Campbell University for a three game weekend series ... The Lancers split a doubleheader on Saturday, May 4, falling 7-6 in game one before defeating the Fighting Camels 6-5 in nine innings ... Longwood then earned a 7-2 decision in the rubber match on Sunday, May 5 ... The Lancers received the No. 3 seed for the 2013 Big South Conference Championship and will take on No. 6 Liberty University on May 9 at 7:30 p.m. ... Sophomore **KORI NISHITOMI** leads the Lancers with a .446 batting average ... Senior **BROOKE SHORT** is second on the team with a .433 average, while sophomore **MEGAN BALTZELL**, who paces the team with 26 home runs, has a team-high 71 RBI along with a .423 batting average ... Nishitomi leads the team with 25 multiple-hit games, while Short and Baltzell are tied with 21 apiece ... Short leads the squad in the circle with an 18-8 record.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Offensively, PC has made tremendous strides since last season ... The Blue Hose have already eclipsed the home run total from 2012 by 21, 44-23 and have 61 more RBI, 216-155 ... PC surpassed the doubles mark, 68-36 and have 39 more hits, 380-341 ... Overall batting average is better as well, .272 -.247, as well as slugging pct., .425 -.336 ... With the extra-inning win over Western Carolina April 24, the Blue Hose equalled last year's mark of 20 wins ... The 22 wins so far is the second most in PC Division I history and is just six from tying the mark of 28 set in 2011 ... PC is 15-0 when leading after the fourth inning, 13-1 after the fifth and 14-1 after the sixth ... The Blue Hose are 9-2 when flawless defensively, but 5-11 when committing one error and 8-17 when committing at least two ... PC is 17-9 when it gets on the board first but just 5-21 when the opponents take the first lead ... PC likes to share the wealth with all but one starter collecting at least 12 RBI ... Four have recorded at least 30 with **KERSTEN LEGACKI** and **SHELBY PETIK** leading the way with 35 ... **ERIN RUFF** has 32, while **CAT TARVIN** has 30 ... With a team-leading 11 home runs this season, Petik is 93rd in the nation ... As a team, the Blue Hose have 44 home runs, or almost one a game (0.84), to put them 65th in the country ...

RADFORD

Radford capped off the season with a three-game sweep against Winthrop ... The Highlanders won a pair of tight games on Saturday and went out with a bang on Sunday. In the finale, the Highlanders won 16-3, scoring the most runs since 2008 at Virginia (W, 16-4) and the most at home since 2002 against UMES (W, 20-0) ... It also marked the third highest run total at home in program history ... Senior **MORGAN EYE** hit a grand slam in her final home game, the second of the season and finished the weekend with two HR and eight RBI. Her four RBI matched a career high for the third time ... Freshman **EMILY NAEGELE** went 4-for-7 with two doubles, a triple, five RBI and three runs scored and posted a 1.143 slugging and .667 on base percentage in the series ... RU finished the season homering in 14 of their 17 home games and have hit 43 on the season which is the fifth highest single season total ... Radford will be facing Winthrop for the second straight season in the first round of the Big South Tournament ... RU is 5-10 against the Eagles in the tournament and 30-35 all-time.

WINTHROP

The Eagles ended the regular season suffering a tough 16-3 loss with a chance to finish fourth on the line, but the Eagles finished league play with a 12-12 mark and place fifth (after being picked to finish 8th in the preseason poll) ... It was the 4th time in league games the Eagles gave up 10 or more runs as the team sported a 4.16 ERA in league play, but the team ERA was 3.02 when subtracting the four games they allowed double-figure runs ... Highlighting the weekend was senior **CHELSEY SCHOENFELDT** who broke the career home run total with her 31st blast in the 7th inning of game one at Radford. Schoenfeldt had already broke the single-season record of 11 and now has pushed that record to 15. She's hit 29 of her 31 career home runs in the last three seasons. She is now ranked 3rd all-time in RBI with 133 and her 55 is 5 shy of the single-season record of 60 set by Jenny Scrymgeour in 2007. In single-season Top 10 at Winthrop, Schoenfeldt ranks 1st in home runs, third in RBI, 2nd in slugging percentage, and third in walks ... **MCKENZI CORN** is after the single-season record for doubles in a season as she now has 15 and is two shy of the record of 17 set by Christine Yon in 1995. Corn is also looking to become the sixth different player in school history to bat .400 or better as she finished the regular season with a .400 average. She's also been hit-by-a-pitch 12 times this season, which is the 2nd most by an Eagle in history (18) ... Schoenfeldt and senior **KATHRYN EBERLIN** were named to the Capital One Academic All-District 4 Teams this past week ... It was the first time either had been selected ... Eberlin in addition to her academic success has set career-highs in runs (20), hits (39), home runs (9) and RBI (37). Her 15 career home runs are tied for 10th all-time, her nine HR are tied for 5th best in a single-season and she's two RBI away from cracking the school's Top 10 single-season bests.

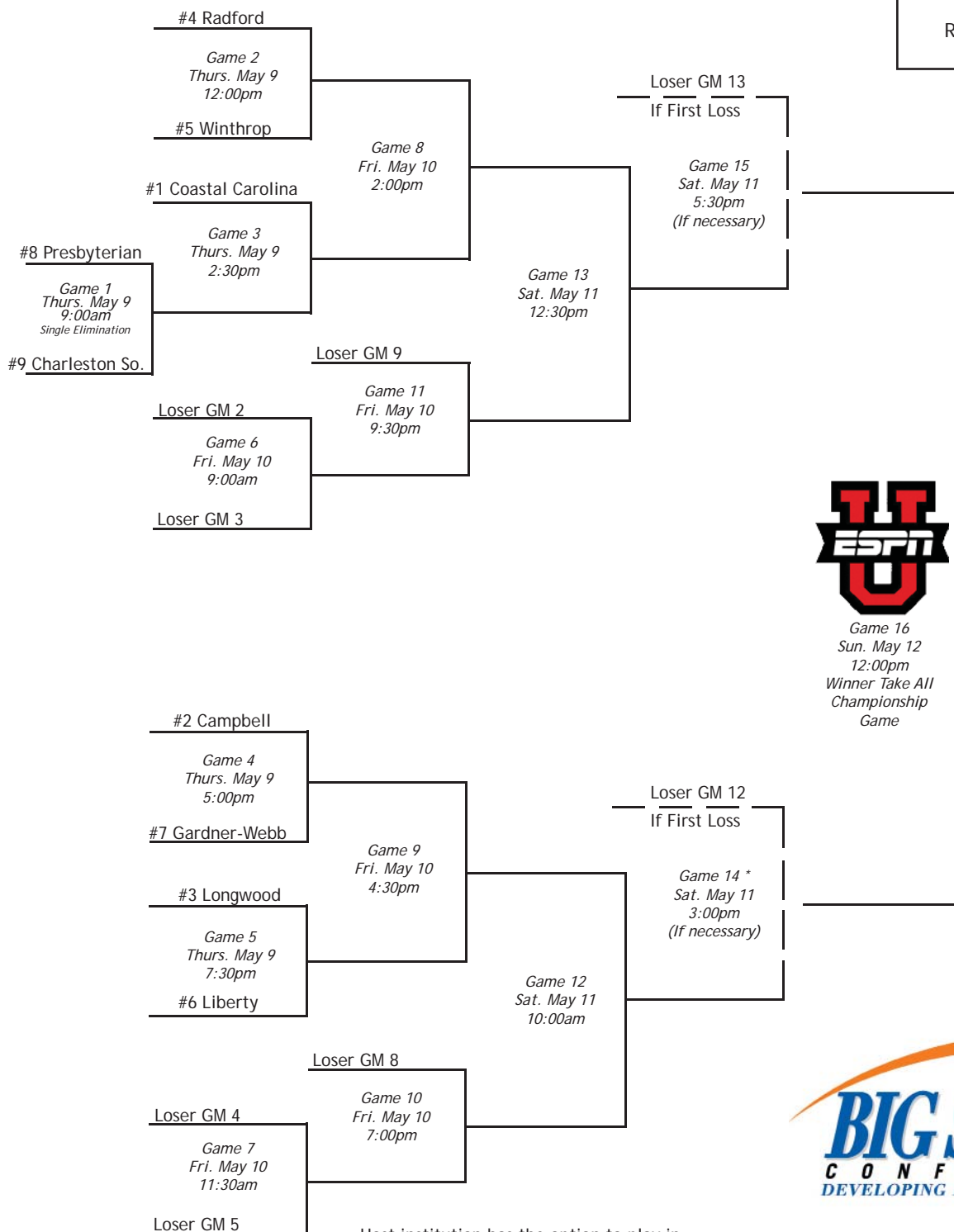
