CAMPBELL

The Camels moved to 13-2 on the season, sweeping Fairleigh Dickinson with a combined 40-9 score in three games. BEN MCQUOWN leads the nation with 24 stolen bases and is yet to be caught on the season. That number already stands 10th on the CU single-season list with 40 left to play on the Camels' schedule. He stands 10 shy of Brandon Scott's single-season record of 35 (2008). McQuown stole 27 bases last season, good for fifth on the single-season list. Campbell skipper GREG GOFF won his 299th career game as a collegiate head coach on Saturday with the sweep of Fairleigh Dickinson. He has won 147 games since taking the helm at Campbell.

The Buccaneers capped off a 3-2 week with a series win against Siena on the weekend. CSU moved to 8-8 on the year and caps a six-game home stand with Ohio State on Tuesday at 2 p.m. The Bucs open s-ix game road trip on Wednesday with a mid-week game at Clemson before traveling to Liberty for their Big South opener on Friday. Leftfielder JOHN FAIRCLOTH saw his season-high 11-game hit streak come to an end this week. Third baseman JAREN SUSTAR is chasing Faircloth for season-high honors with a current 8-game streak and is batting .500 (15-for-30) over the last 8 games. COASTAL CAROLINA

With a win Sunday versus Ohio State, Chanticleer skipper GARY GILMORE won his 700th game as Coastal Carolina head coach to become the 23rd active coach in NCAA Division I to notch 700 wins at one school. Gilmore is now 700-350 in his 18th year (1996-present) at his alma mater. Overall, Gilmore is in his 24th year as a college coach and owns a 956-452-2 record. Gilmore began his head coaching career at USC Aiken and was 256-102-2 in six years (1990-95) there... Coastal Carolina entered the weekend with a 4-8 record. It marked Coastal's worst start to a season since beginning the 2006 season 4-12. Also, Coastal entered the weekend on a four-game losing streak, marking the program's first four-game losing streak since the 2009 season. CCU lost two at High Point (April 18-19) and later lost games at #20 Clemson and versus College of Charleston... After a slow start to the season, Coastal's bats are showing life. The Chants entered the week with a .207 team batting average. The Chants batted .308 this past week, including a .323 batting average in three weekend wins. Coastal is now batting .241.

Liberty had won its first seven games in the new Liberty Baseball Stadium ... Liberty's win streak tied the Division I school record for consecutive victories. The mark has been reached during seven other seasons. The school's all-time record for consecutive wins is 15 set by the 1976 Flames ... On Sunday, the Flames snapped another streak, a three-game losing skid, with an 11-8 win at Georgia ... In Liberty's win over Georgia, the Flames belted out a season-high 16 hits. LF NICK LACIK, 2B BRYAN ANDERUD and #B DALTON SYPE each had three hits in the contest. Lacik also had three RBIs ... RHP TREY LAMBERT ran his record to 3-0 on the year in the win at Georgia. Lambert pitched seven scoreless, before allowing runs in the eighth. Until giving up a run in the eighth inning, Lambert had not allowed a run for 14 consecutive innings ...
