ZACK HAGAMAN - Jr - DH Charleston Southern Pawley's Island, S.C.

Hagaman, a junior from Pawley's Island, S.C., batted .471 with eight hits and nine RBI to lead the Buc caneers to a 3-1 record last week including a series sweep over Conference foe UNC Asheville. The designated hitter notched three doubles and three homers in the series with the Bulldogs to finish the weekend with a slugging percentage of 1.176. His biggest game of the week came in game one of the double header on March 30 as he notched four hits, four RBI, a pair of home runs and two doubles in the win over Asheville. The honor marks his first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

Lighton, a red-shirt freshman from Chesapeake, Va., notched a complete game shutout of Virginia Tech on March 26. The righthander struck out three batters scattered six hits and allowed no walks. He did not allow a single runner to reach second base until the eighth inning as he picked up the first complete game win of his career. The shutout win over Virginia Tech was the first VMI shutout of the Hokies since 1962. The award is his first Big South Pitcher of the Week plaudit this season.

CAMPBELL

Campbell posted its second win of the year over ACC member Duke on Tuesday before seeing its eight game winning streak come to an end Saturday against Radford. The streak was the Camels' second this season of eight or more games. The Camels posted an 11-3 win on Friday night over the visiting Highlanders, then dropped both games of a doubleheader Saturday, 5-2 and 3-2 to lose the series, 2-1, the team's first series loss of the year. It also marked the first time Campbell has lost consecutive games all season. With the win over Duke, CU is now 9-2 against in-state competition on the season. Campbell University officially dedicated Jim Perry Stadium prior to the Duke game, with a ceremony that included Jim and Daphne Perry and family, President Jerry Wallace, CU administration, staff, coaches and players. The ceremony concluded with a ribbon cutting. Jim Perry threw out the game's ceremonial first pitch.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern ended an eight-game losing streak with a 3-1 week and a series sweep of Asheville in Big South play on the weekend... The Bucs improved to 11-5 at home this season with three fast starts and three wins over the Bulldogs to move to 11-16 and 3-3 in Big South play. CSU also dropped a midweek game at Old Dominion, a game it led 3-0 heading to the bottom of the ninth before the Monarchs rallied... One the weekend, the Bucs scored 3-3-4 runs in each of their first inning at-bats and never trailed to UNCA. Designated hitter ZACK HAGAMAN was a big reason why the Bucs' offense exploded, he batted .571 (8-for-14) for the series with three home runs, three doubles, and nine RBIs. He had six combined RBIs in his first at-bat over the three games. He hit two home runs in Friday's 6-2 win, a game in which he went 4-for-4 with 12 total bases. Bobby Ison and ALEX TOMASOVICH also had big weekends for the Bucs. Both batted .545 (6-for-11) and reached base at a .643 clip. Tomasovich had a double and a solo home run to go with five runs scored. The Bucs also got three very effective starts on the weekend. Seniors RYAN GUNTHER (3-3) and KEVIN BURAN (1-5) each pitched eight innings and struck out six in wins over the Bulldogs. Buran took a shutout into the eighth, scattering five hits and walking two. TORY SCHROFF (4-1) won Saturday's opener, pitching effectively with a big, early lead. He struck out six with no walks in 5.1 innings of work. The Bucs travel to South Carolina on Tuesday for a 7 p.m. first pitch before traveling to Gardner-Webb in a weekend series which opens on Friday.

Coastal took two of three at VMI. However, by losing the backend of Saturday's doubleheader, Coastal had its win streak over the Keydets snapped at 18 games, dating back to April 27, 2008. Coastal is now 29-5 all-time versus VMI... Coastal Carolina will play a home-and-home series versus The Citadel in the midweek, traveling to Charleston Tuesday and hosting the Bulldogs Wednesday. The Chanticleers own a 41-31 advantage in the all-time series, winning 10 of the last 12... While Coastal had its 18-game win streak snapped over VMI, Coastal will but another win streak on the line this weekend, hosting Liberty for a three-game set. Coastal has won each of the last 17 games versus the Flames, dating back to May 24, 2008 in the Big South Tournament. (Coastal would turn around that day and beat Liberty to win the 2008 Big South Championship and start the win streak.) The Chants have won four games over the Flames in each of the last four years, sweeping the regular-season series and getting a win over Liberty in the Big South Tournament... High Point went 2-2 last week, picking up a home win over Elon and winning the first game of its three-game series at William & Mary. The Panthers shutout Elon for just the second time since joining Div. I on Tuesday. Senior WILLIE MEDINA finished 3-4 in the game with one RBI and two runs scored. Eight different High Point batters recorded an RBI in the game. Senior RYAN RETZ started on the mound for the Panthers and earned his third win of the season after pitching five innings of shutout baseball. The High Point bullpen combined to throw four scoreless innings in relief, allowing just one hit and one walk while striking out eight. High Point picked up its fourth-straight win in the series opener at William & Mary, winning 7-5 in extra innings. It was the junior's second game this season with three or more hits ... Saturday in game two of a doubleheader with Longwood, RHP TREY LAMBERT pitched seven perfect innings in moving his record to 5-1 on the year. Lambert faced the minimum of 21 batters through seven frames in Liberty's 8-1 win, before being reached by the Lancers for their only run of the contest in the eighth ... 1B DANNY GRAUER provided Lambert plenty of support in the contest, going 4-for-4 with two doubles and four RBIs. Radford went 2-1 on the week with a doubleheader Saturday sweep and a Big South series victory at then #27 Campbell. In the final two games, the Highlander pitching staff held the #4 hitting team in the nation over 60 points under its average (.274). The Camels were #1 in the country in stolen bases and were just 2-4 in SB attempts in the series. JOSH GARDINER extended his current hitting streak to 10 games. He now has 11 multi-hit games on the season. Gardiner has reached base in 15 straight games. JEFF KEMP batted .400 and slugged .800 in series win at Campbell. Fielded at .938 and involved in 5 double plays, including a DP in each of Saturday's games in the 9th inning to secure road victories over nationally-ranked Campbell. Hit his 6th home run of the season. Posted a .538 on-base average. He has reached base in 17 straight games. Alexander Lee and Josh Reavis both currently have 7 game hitting streaks. ZACH WOOLCOCK only had 2 hits in the series, but one was a two-run double that helped win the first game of Saturday's DH, and the second was his first home run of the season that gave RU a 1-0 lead in the nightcap. MICHAEL BOYLE gave up only 2 hits and held Campbell to .133 batting average, which is 100 points below its team average. The Camels were ranked #4 in the country in batting average. Left the game with a 2-0 lead in the sixth. Held the #1 team in the country in stolen bases to 0-1 in SB attempts. Struck out 5 and walked 3. When KEITH FRITZ was forced out of game 3 of the series after facing only 2 batters after taking a line drive off his pitching hand, the Highlanders used 7 pitchers in the 3-2 victory. Ryan Meisinger earned his first career win, and Michael Costello posted his 5th save of the season.
