CAMPBELL

Campbell completed its second 5-0 week of the season and improved to 21-3 overall, 5-1 in Big South play, with sweeps against Rider and at UNC Asheville. The Camels have posted three comeback wins over the last two weeks, including two in Big South play to begin the conference season 5-1. Campbell found itself facing another comeback effort in game one of the Camels' March 23 doubleheader at UNC Asheville, falling behind 8-2 after the fifth. The comeback began in the sixth with MICHAEL FELTON's two-run double with the bases loaded. CU posted four more runs in the inning, knotting the game at eight-all. The Camels took the lead in the seventh as Felton's RBI groundout scored BEN MCQUOWN. Campbell finished the game with a 12-8 win. Campbell preseason All-American Michael Felton, who hit .424 as a junior last season, has pulled his 2013 clip up to .309 after a slow start. The senior has hit .372 (16-43) over his last 11 games with six multi-hit games, compared to four in his first 13 contests. Felton has 15 RBI over that span, adding three doubles and a home run. He has also scored nine runs while Campbell has gone 10-1. Felton started the season 2-for-17 (.118) and climbed over .300 for the first time on March 15 after going 2-for-5 in Campbell's 7-1 game one win at Gardner-Webb, hist third-straight multi-hit game. Since going 0-for-3 in his first start as a Camel, junior outfielder CLAYTON BROWN has hit .500 (28-for-56) in 18 starts. Brown has also hit .490 in the month of March. The Seattle, Wash. native has spent the majority of that time batting the nine hole (15 game), hitting .489 in that position. Brown is hitting .467 on the season with 11 RBI and 13 runs scored.

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers went 1-1 in yet another rain-drenched week. The Bucs lost at UNC Wilmington, 10-3, then dropped a Friday game at The Citadel, 6-4. CSU's Saturday and Sunday contests against the Bulldogs were washed away by heavy rains in the Charleston area will have not been rescheduled. The Bucs were their own worst enemy against UNCW. CSU committed six errors and starter ANDREW TOMASOVICH took the loss despite one earned run against the Seahawks. KEVIN HICKEY and ZACK HAGAMAN each had two hits. CSU's rallied from a 3-0 deficit to tie the game in the sixth against The Citadel, but a couple of clutch hits late lifted the Bulldogs to the win. CSU left 11 on base in the game, including the tying run in the ninth. Bobby Ison leads the Bucs with a .333 average among everyday players. He was 3-for-4 against The Citadel and had eight put outs, including a couple of highlight-reel catches. The Bucs missed out on weekend starts from TORY SCHROFF and KEVIN BURAN due to the rain. Schroff remains 3-1 with a team-low 2.45 ERA. CSU plays a lone midweek game at Old Dominion on Tuesday evening, before hosting Asheville on Friday at 2p.m. in its Big South home opener.
