CAMPBELL

Campbell won its opening Big South series on the road at Gardner-Webb and picked up its first season sweep of East Carolina since 1985 this week. ELIJAH TRAIL's seventh inning two-out bases clearing double put Campbell ahead and reliever RYAN THOMPSON pitched two shutout innings to seal an 8-6 victory over visiting East Carolina Wednesday night at Jim Perry Stadium. The win was number 300 for Camel head coach GREG GOFF, who is in his sixth season at the helm of the CU program. The Camels then took to the road to open Big South play, picking up a 7-1 to open the Gardner-Webb series. BEN MCQUOWN and MICHAEL FELTON both picked up two hits and scored twice while RYAN MATTES picked up his fourth win of the year. LOGAN SELF earned the three inning save, allowing a hit with a walk and a strikeout. It marked the Camels' sixth milti-inning save this season, including Thompson's on Wednesday night against ECU. In Sunday's rubber match, down 9-0 after the third, Campbell rallied to defeat Gardner-Webb 11-10 and take the Big South weekend series at JH Moss Stadium. The Camels have won 57 games over the last two seasons with 36 games remaining on the 2013 schedule. Campbell won a school record 41 games in 2012 and are off to a 16-3 start this year. The 2000 and 2001 Campbell teams combined to win 64 games, the most in school history in back to back seasons.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers fell to 8-13 overall and 0-3 in Big South play after a week which included loses at home to Ohio State (6-3) and a road-loss to Clemson (3-1), in which the Bucs outhit both of their opponents. CSU also dropped its weekend series at Liberty. Despite the losses, the BUcs had some outstanding pitching performances. Freshman ANDREW TOMASOVICH limited Clemson to three earned runs and four hits in 8.0 innings of work. He struck out five against the Tigers. Junior TORY SCHROFF held Liberty to four hits and two earned runs with four strikeouts in a 3-1 loss to Liberty on Sunday. CSU also got an impressive midweek effort from BOBBY ISON, who went 7-for-9 with three doubles in games against Ohio State and Clemson. The Bucs return to non-conference action with a midweek game against UNC Wilmington on Wednesday and a three-game weekend series against The Citadel. Saturday's game against The Citadel is at CSU Ballpark at 2 p.m., Friday and Sunday's game are at Riley Park.

COASTAL CAROLINA

RYAN CONNOLLY, who had a save in three appearances last week, now has 116 career appearances. Coastal's Byron Binda (2002-05) currently owns both the CCU and Big South records for appearances with 117. Connolly set a CCU and Big South record in 2010 with 40 appearances in earning Freshman All-American honors. Connolly led the Big South in appearances in 2011 with 32 and tied teammate AARON BURKE for the Big South lead in appearances with 35 appearances in 2012... Connolly has appeared in nine games this season and has three saves and two tough-luck losses. He has a 2.70 ERA and, in 20.0 innings, has 15 strikeouts, four walks and allowed nine hits for an opponent batting average of .130... After a slow start to the season, Coastal's bats are heating up. Over the past 10 games, the Chants' batting average has gone from .207 to .257. The Chants batted .308 two weeks again and .309 this past week. During Coastal's current streak, winning six of its last eight, Coastal had four games with double-digit hits, including 17 doubles... For the second consecutive outing, BEN SMITH posted a 0.00 ERA in getting his second consecutive win. Saturday versus Michigan, the sophomore pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits and four walks. The previous week, Smith was named Big South Pitcher of the Week as he pitched 6.1 scoreless innings, allowing four hits and two walks with nine strikeouts.

HPU baseball went 2-2 on the week, falling at No. 1 North Carolina by a score of 7-2 during the week before returning home and winning a series, 2-1, over Central Connecticut State. High Point won each of the first two games against CCSU, beating the Blue Devils by scores of 6-2 on Friday and 10-2 on Saturday. Senior JACOB NEWBERRY pitched eight innings and struck out a career-high 10 batters on Friday and Redshirt-junior lefthander SEAN TOWNSLEY earned his third win of the season with six innings of work on Saturday. HPU's bullpen pitched well all week, surrendering just two runs over 13-1/3 innings of work. Senior WILLIE MEDINA recorded a hit in each game this week and hit .389 overall. Medina led HPU on the week with two doubles and four runs scored while also picking up three RBI.

Both Grauer's and Aanderud's home runs were their first of the year ... RHP BROOKS ROY picked up his third win of the season, Saturday. UNC Asheville went 2-3 on the week, defeating Wofford on Tuesday evening before falling to ETSU on Wednesday. The Bulldogs then dropped 2-of-3 to Longwood in the Big South opening series for both squads. Asheville is now 8-13 on the season overall, with a 1-2 mark in conference play. The Bulldogs are also 5-4 at home, 1-7 in road games and 2-2 at neutral sites. Asheville is now sixth in the league in team batting and 12th in team pitching. The Bulldogs are currently being led in batting average by ROBERT MCINTOSH and IAN GRAHAM. Both are posting a .345 mark. Newcomer KYLE TOWLES leads the team in hits with 25 while senior TODD JOYNER is one behind at 24. McIntosh still leads the team in RBI with 12 despite missing the past five games due to injury. Only four Bulldogs (HUNTER BRYANT, Joyner, Phillip Treadway, Towles) have played in all of Asheville's 21 games this season. Bryant, Joyner and Towles are the only three to have started every game for the Blue & White.
