#28 CAMPBELL

The Camels will head into the Big South Championship with the No. 1 seed for the second time in program history, with the only other coming in 1986. Campbell, who claimed the Big South's North Division crown with Saturday's win, earned a divisional championship for the first time since 1987. For the second straight week, **RYAN THOMPSON** earned a win and a save in a pivotal Big South series. Thompson, now 7-0 with a 0.72 ERA and nine saves, one shy of the school record, picked up the five-inning win in relief in Friday's 13 inning thriller, surrendering only three hits, striking out five and walking two after entering the game in the ninth. The Turner, Ore. native then pitched the eighth and ninth on Sunday to close it out for the Camels. Thompson earned his ninth save, allowing a pair of hits with two punchouts and a walk in two innings. His seven scoreless innings extended a streak to 27 2/3 innings without a run allowed, dating back to April 5 (13 appearances). The streak is his second of the season of more than 20, going 20 2/3 without an earned run charged, which dated from Feb. 19 to March 20 (10 appearances). **DAVID OLSON** hit .357 while pitching 4 2/3 innings of no-hit ball with two saves in three appearances. For the season, Olson hits .357 with 39 runs and 32 RBI, adding eight doubles and two home runs. On the mound, the senior is 3-0 with three saves in 26 1/3 innings pitched, adding a 1.71 ERA. **BEN MCQUOWN** stole his 45th base of the year on Sunday, and still leads the nation.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers went 3-2 on the week and picked up a Big South series win with a pair of wins at Radford on the weekend...CSU is now 21-29 overall and 10-11 in conference play...The Bucs rallied from an early 6-3 deficit to pound out 18 hits in a 13-7 win over Radford on Sunday. CSU also held on for an 8-7 win in the series-opener on Saturday to win the series...Junior **ZACK HAGAMAN** hit a three-run home run and Stephen Leopard tossed 4.1 shutout innings out of the bullpen in a 13-7 win on Sunday. The Bucs had 18 hits, their most in a Big South game this season, in the win...Sophomore **BOBBY ISON** was 3-for-3 with two sacrifices to carry the Bucs in the series opener. Junior shortstop **ALEX TOMASOVICH** was 1-for-3 with two walks and two runs scored to help the Bucs. Closer **AUSTIN WEEKLEY** notched his eighth save in the win to remain among the Big South leaders in the category...Radford won game two of the series, rallying from a 3-2 deficit to win 8-3...Reliever **STEPHEN LEOPARD** worked 6.2 shutout innings and struck out five on the week...Ison, who entered the weekend as the toughest player in the country to strikeout (1 every 29 at-bats) batted .455 for the week (10-for-22) with two doubles and a triple. He also scored six times and had an on-base percentage of .478. He was 7-for-14 on the weekend against Radford...Sophomore **CHASE SHELTON** batted .435 for the week (10-for-23) with his first home run of the season and six RBIs. Shelton was 4-for-4 in the Bucs' 8-3 win over Savannah State on Tuesday. The Bucs also dropped a Wednesday affair at home to USC Upstate, 8-7.

#30 COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal used timely hitting and strong pitching to sweep UNC Asheville, improving to 69-16 all-time versus the Bulldogs... Coastal has won five straight, thanks to winning the last two at Georgia Tech and sweeping UNCA, and has won seven of its last 10... With a 3-2, 11-inning win Saturday over UNCA, Coastal improved to 14-5 in one-run games this season and 5-2 in extra-inning games. This is a dramatic improvement from the previous two years as CCU was just 16-18 in one-run games (6-11 in 2011 and 10-7 in 2012) while being just 1-13 in extra-innings games (0-6 in 2011 and 1-7 in 2012)... Coastal Carolina has clinched the Big South South Division title... Coastal will close the regular season for the second consecutive with a three-game set at Charleston Southern. Coastal owns a 67-27 advantage in the all-time series, has won five straight in the series, won 16 of the last 17 and won 27 of the last 30.

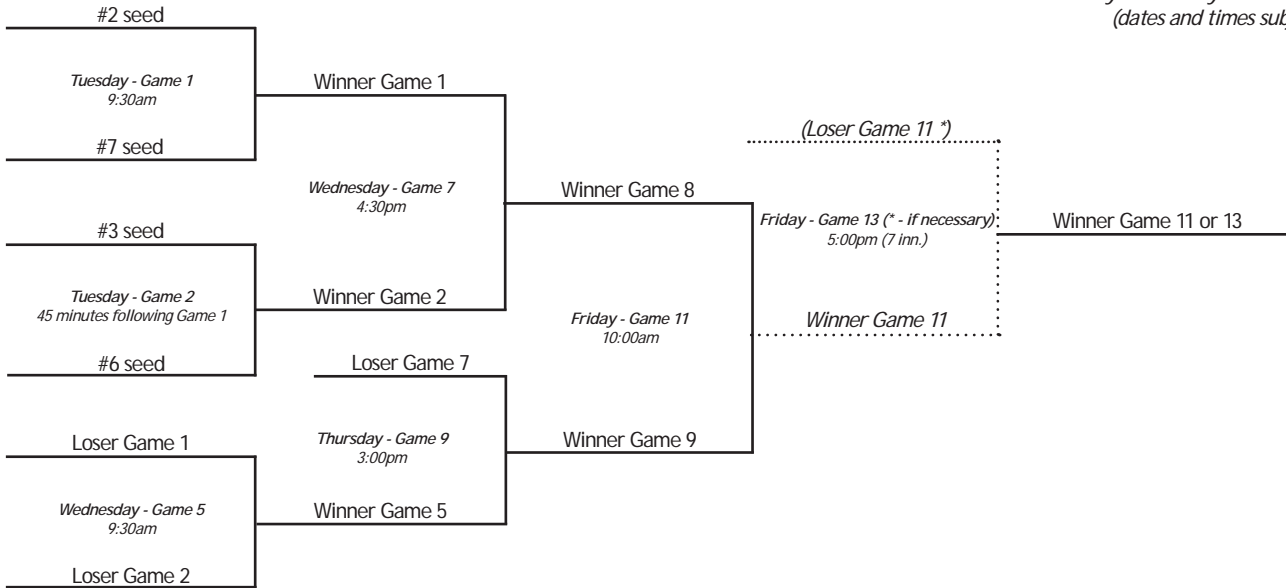

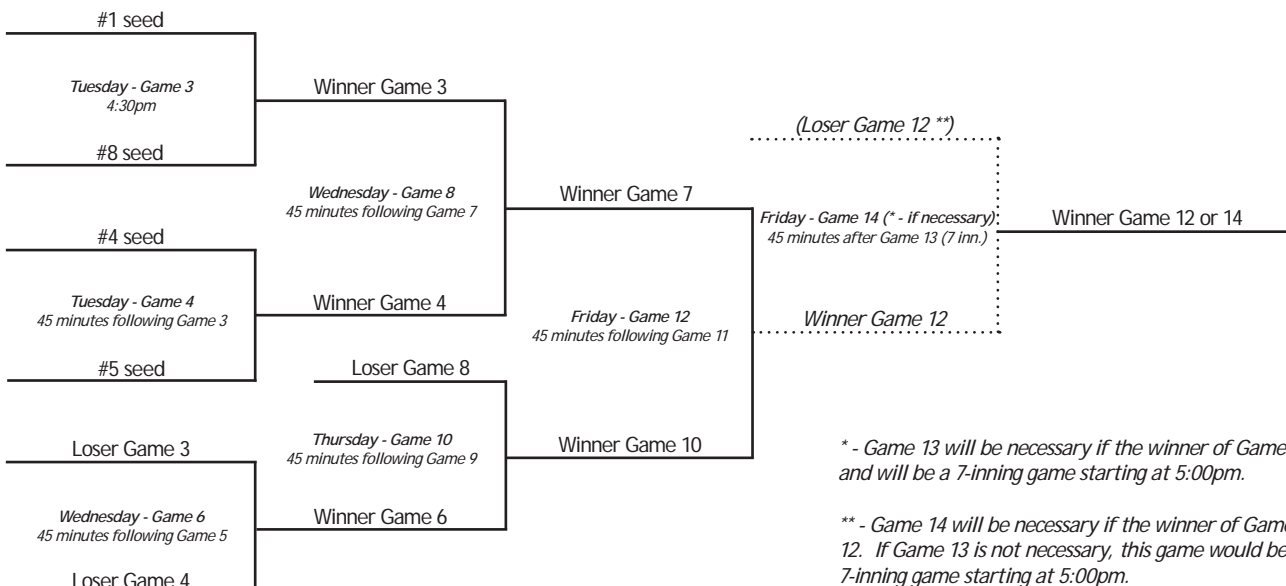
