His biggest game of the series came in game three on May 5 as he robbed Georgia Tech's Daniel Palka of a two-run homer as he found the wall, leaped and brought the ball back in the bottom of the first. In the second inning, the center-fielder posted a two-run home run to give Coastal Carolina the momentum. He finished game three with a pair of hits and three RBI. He also had two hits in game one, including a double. May is currently riding a career-high 14-game hitting streak. The honor marks his second Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

#30 CAMPBELL

No. 30 Campbell picked up a 2-1 series win on the road at High Point after the exam break, moving to 10-2 on the road in conference play. The Camels improved to 39-9 overall on the year, needed just one more victory to secure the program's second ever, and second straight, 40-win season. Campbell has gathered 80 wins over the past two seasons, a program record. The Campbell pitching staff owned a season best series ERA of 0.69 for the weekend, allowing only two earned runs in three games while striking out 20 Panthers. **RYAN THOMPSON** picked up a relief win and a save in the series win. Thompson picked up the win in three innings of relief on Saturday, moving to 6-0 on the season with a pair of hits, two strikeouts and two walks. On Sunday, Thompson came back to earn his eighth save, going three more innings after picking up the win Saturday night. The junior righty did not allow a baserunner, striking out one. He needed just 22 pitches. His six scoreless innings extended a streak to 20 2/3 innings without a run allowed, dating back to April 5 (11 appearances). The streak is his second of the season of 20 2/3 without an earned run charged, which dated from Feb. 19 to March 20 (10 appearances). For the season, Thompson is 6-0 with eight saves and a 0.81 ERA. **MICHAEL FELTON** hit .545 for the week and extended his hitting streak to seven games to help No. 29 Campbell win its Big South series at High Point. Felton has 16 hits over his last seven games, hitting .593 with seven RBI and seven runs scored. **BEN MCQUOWN** stole his 44th base of the year on Sunday, and still leads the nation.

Coastal Carolina entered last weekend having a 4-14 all-time record versus Georgia Tech. However, with two wins this past weekend, Coastal has won four of the last seven. Also, with the wins over the nationally-ranked opponents, Coastal improves to 35-64 versus teams ranked among the nation's top 30 (bases on available records)... Coastal Carolina's next four games will be at home and those will be Coastal's final four home games of 2013. CCU hosts UNC Asheville May 10-12 and UNC Wilmington May 14... Coastal will host UNC Asheville for three games this weekend. Coastal is 66-16 all-time versus the Bulldogs. The two teams did not meet in 2012 and the Bulldogs come to Conway with a two-game win streak over the Chanticleers, taking 2-of-3 from CCU in Asheville in 2011... After playing UNCW on Tuesday May 14, Coastal will conclude the regular season May 16-18 at Charleston Southern. **JUSTIN CREEL**, who owns a career GPA of 4.0, was named Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District this past week. That win also improved Gardner-Webb to 3-4 on the season in extra innings games ... Gardner-Webb led East Carolina 7-3 after seven innings on Tuesday night, but saw the Pirates rally late to win 9-7 in 12 innings ... On Saturday vs. North Carolina Central, Gardner-Webb's pitching staff struck out 32 batters in 20.0 innings of work, walked just five and surrendered only eight hits (seven singles) ... The Highlanders dropped a 4-3 midweek decision to No. 25 Virginia Tech for their only loss. **CHRIS COIA** moved from his normal defensive position in center field to replace injured All-Big South shortstop **JEFF KEMP** batted .462 and scored four runs in helping the Highlanders with a road sweep over Longwood. Drove in five runs and stole two bases as well. **JEFF MAXWELL** appeared in 3 of Radford's 4 games on the week earning two Big South saves in the opening two games at Longwood. Pitched 3.2 innings on Saturday after earning the save on Friday night. On the week, he struck out 7 and did not issue a walk in 8.0 innings pitched. He worked 2.2 innings of scoreless relief against the No. 25 team in the nation, Virginia Tech, on Tuesday. In Friday's series opener vs. the Lancers, inherited two runners in the eighth with one out. He got the Highlanders out of the jam and finished the game in the ninth. **PATRICK MARSHALL**, who replaced Kemp in the offensive lineup, drove in a career high five runs in the Longwood opener. He also drove in the winning run on Sunday in extra innings. **TYLER COSTELLO** (5-3) and **MICHAEL BOYLE** (5-2) each recorded their fifth victories of the season to match Dylan Nelson for the most wins on the season. **JOSH GARDINER** extended his hitting streak to 10 games. UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville had last week off, but the week before last the Bulldogs took on non-conference foe Wofford on Wednesday before splitting their Big South series with Gardner-Webb. The series finale was canceled due to inclement weather in the Boiling Springs, N.C., area on Sunday on Monday. The Bulldogs are now 15-30 on the year, with a 3-14 mark in the Big South. Asheville is also 9-13 at home, 4-15 on the road and 2-2 at neutral sites. Catcher **IAN GRAHAM** was named the NABC National Hitter of the Week as well as the Big South Player of the Week for the week of April 10 for his efforts for the Blue & White. Asheville is now fifth in the league in batting, with a team mark of .278. Asheville is also 11th in team fielding and 12th in team pitching. Senior **TODD JOYNER** is now 12th in the league in batting with a mark of .328. The Bulldogs next game will be on May 8, when they take on ETSU in Johnson City, Tenn. The game will mark the second time the two teams will play this season, with the Bucs handing the Bulldogs their most lopsided loss of the season, a 20-9 win at Greenwood Field on March 13.

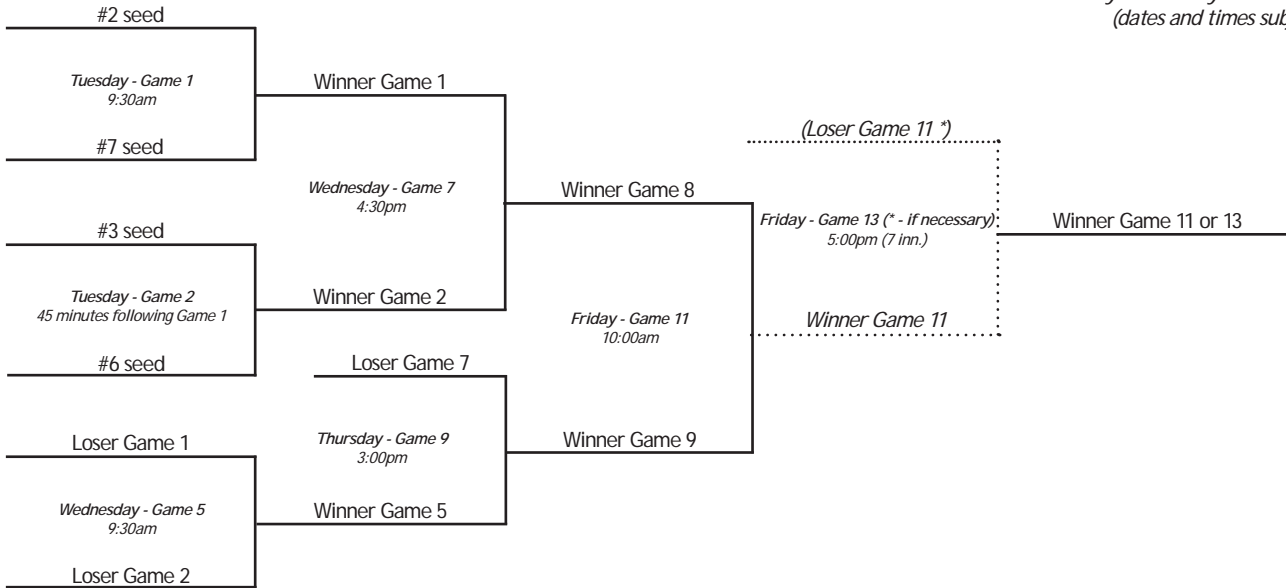

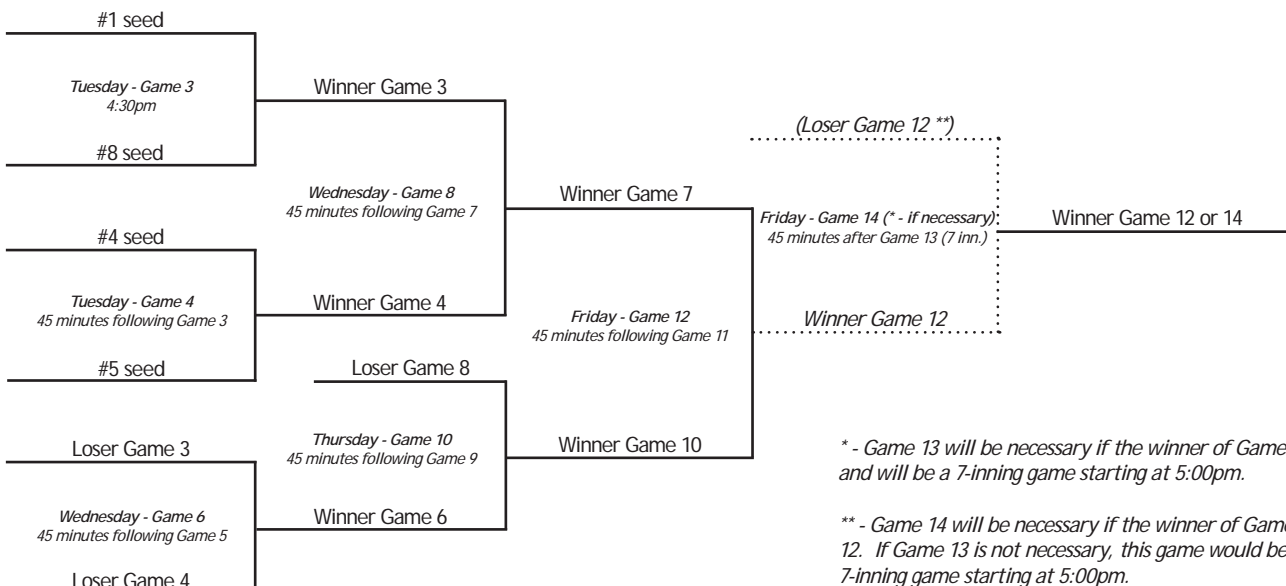
