Close, a sophomore from Hoover, Ala., batted .435 with 10 hits and 14 RBI to lead the Flames to a 4-1 record last week, including a series sweep over League foe VMI. The first baseman posted multiple hits and multiple RBI in four of the five games he played, including three hits, six RBI and a grand slam against Old Dominion on April 24. He highlighted the series against VMI with a pair of hits, four RBI and double in game one of the double-header on April 27. He finished the week with two doubles, two home runs and a stolen base in the five-game span. The honor marks his first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

Campbell entered exam week after a 2-0 week, winning its fifth and sixth games in a row. The Camels posted 10-0 and 10-7 victories over North Carolina Central and UNC Greensboro, pushing their record against in-state competition to 14-3 this season. **MATT MARKSBERRY** struck out a career-best 13 for No. 29 Campbell in a combined one-hit shutout of North Carolina Central Tuesday night at Jim Perry Stadium. Marksberry allowed just one hit in seven shutout innings, that coming with two away in the fifth after the redshirt junior fanned the Eagles' first two batters of the frame. He faced the minimum through 3 2/3, when an error extended the inning, and walked five in the game. His 13 strikeouts were one shy of the school record. **BLAKE BOYCE**'s pinch hit grand slam in the bottom of the eighth lifted Campbell over visiting UNCG 10-7 on Wednesday. Boyce, a senior from Virginia Beach, Va., pinch hit after the Spartans intentionally walked **MICHAEL DELUCIA** to load the bases with one out in the eighth. On a 1-0 pitch, Boyce belted the round tripper to left off of UNCG's Dylan Hathcock, the first home run of the senior's career, to put the Camels ahead 10-7. Boyce also came up with a bottom of the ninth RBI double last Friday in the VMI series opener, lifting the Camels to a 2-1 win.

The Bucs fell into a 7-1 hole early, before nearly climbing all the way out with four runs and moving the tying run into scoring position in the sixth to cut the lead to 7-5... **JOHN FAIRCLOTH** went 2-for-4 with two hits and two RBIs to lead the Bucs... CSU eads into a key Big South series next weekend at Winthrop. CSU is 7-2 in Big South play at home, but 0-6 on the road... Junior lefthander **TORY SCHROFF** is 5-2 for the Bucs and has won all three of his home starts in Big South play... Sophomore **BOBBY ISON** has started every game for the Bucs in centerfield and leads the team with a .364 average... Coastal Carolina has played 8 of its last 11 on the road with the only home games being a weekend series with conference foe Radford ... CCU is 6-5 over the span ... While CCU returns home to host Charlotte Tuesday, Coastal hits the road to play at Georgia Tech for three games this weekend ... **RYAN CONNOLLY** has been named to the Mid-Season Watch List for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year. Connolly pitched twice this past weekend. In 3.1 innings, he recorded a save and 0.00 ERA. He allowed two hits with zero walks and six strikeouts. Over his last 13 appearances, Connolly has allowed just one earned run (3 total) for a 0.33 ERA, going 3-1 with seven saves, eight walks and 26 strikeouts.. The game he lost, at VMI, was also the game he allowed an earned run to blow a save, but the game was lost on a dropped by fly ball. Since then, Connolly has pitched in seven games, going 2-0 with four saves. In 18.0 scoreless innings, he has a 0.00 ERA, with eight hits allowed, five walks and 18 Ks ... Coastal Carolina second baseman **JAKE KANE**, shortstop **NICK OBERG** and centerfielder **JACOB MAY** are CCU's most productive players as of late. Kane is riding a seven-game hit streak, batting .381 (8-for-21 over the span. Over his last 16 games, Kane is batting .333 (17-for-51) but more importantly has not made an error in his last 80 chances, including a game which he tied a CCU record with nine assists at Winthrop. Oberg has the team's best current reached base streak at 14 games. He has a hit in 12 of those games, including a current streak of 10 straight. He is batting .364 (12-for-33) during his 10-game hit streak and .326 (15-for-46) of his 14-game reached base streak.

Defensively, he robbed an ETSU player of a home run reaching over the left field fence and making a catch. As a team, the Highlanders batted an impressive .309 on the week. 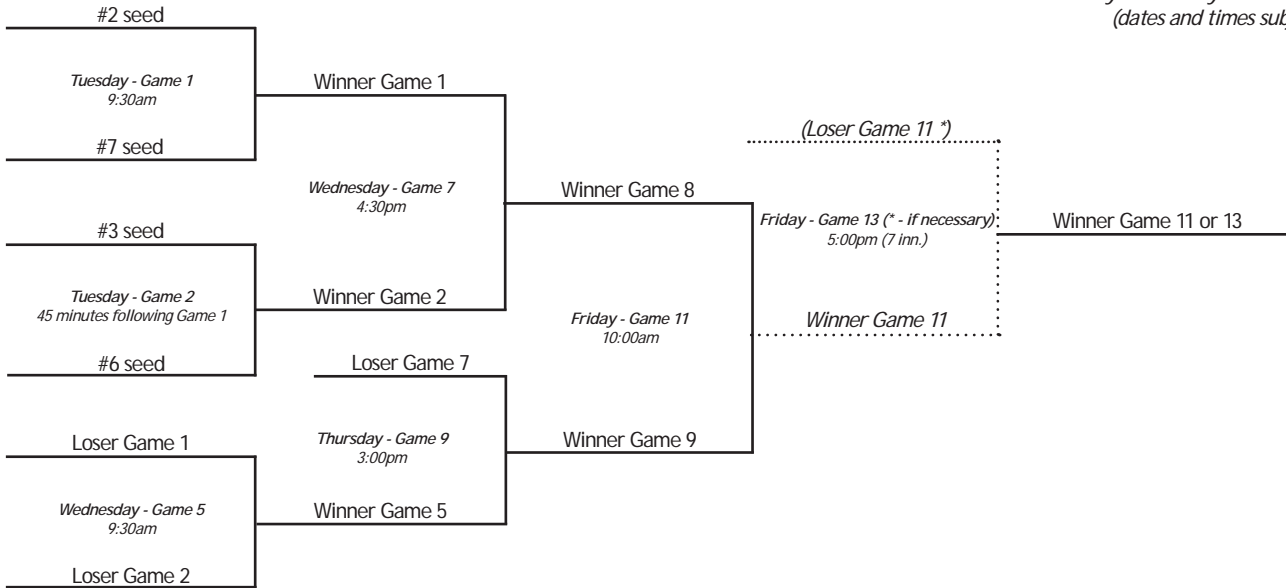

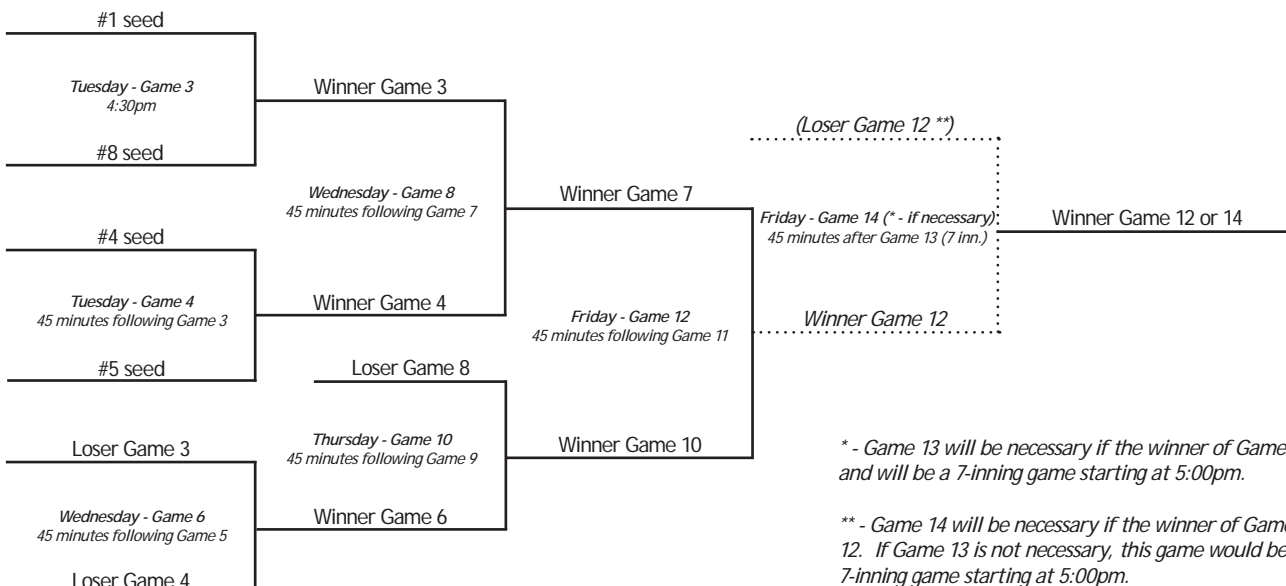
