After defeating Appalachian State 11-6 in Thomasville, N.C. on Wednesday night, Campbell came away with two bottom of the ninth wins to open the VMI series. On Saturday, **MICHAEL FELTON** gave Campbell a walk-off win for the second straight day, driving in the winning run with a base hit in the bottom of the ninth, defeating VMI 4-3 to clinch the series. The Camels took Friday's opener 2-1 over the Keydets on **BLAKE BOYCE**'s game ending RBI double in the bottom of the ninth. **HECTOR CEDANO** struck out a career-high nine to lead Campbell in an 8-1 win, completing a Big South series sweep over VMI Sunday at Jim Perry Stadium. Cedano, a junior lefthander from Miami, Fla., fanned nine, walked three, and allowed a run on just four hits in eight innings, improving to 8-2 on the season. Cedano's eight wins is the fourth most in CU single season history. The Miami, Fla. native's nine strikeouts marks a career best and the most by a Camel this season. **MICHAEL DELUCIA** blasted two home runs and drove in six in a Campbell win over Appalachian State to highlight a week where the senior catcher batted .357. DeLucia blasted a three-run homer in the first and a two-run shot in the fifth, both to left, in Campbell's 11-6 win over Appalachian State in Thomasville, N.C. The senior came into the night without a career home run in his two seasons as a Camel. The catcher also drove in a run in the third with a single through the right side, pushing his total to six. In all, DeLucia went 3-for-3 with six RBI, also reaching in the seventh after being hit by a pitch. His six RBI tied a season-best for a Camel this season (fourth time), while becoming the first this season to belt multiple home runs in a game. His nine total bases were also a Camel high for the year. DeLucia owns a team-high 15 two-out RBI for the season. During the week, **BRENT GRAHAM** also posted his team-leading ninth and 10th bunt hits of the season.

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers pieced together a 3-1 week to climb back into the race in the South Division of the conference standings...CSU opened the week with an 11-5 win over Savannah State, before taking two out of three from Presbyterian on the weekend...The Bucs also debuted their new baseball lights, briefly on Friday before storms set in and then for a full game on Saturday night...CSU's **TORY SCHROFF** recorded the final 25 outs on Saturday to finish off Friday's continued game in impressive fashion, shutting out PC in a 1-0 win. The junior held the Blue Hose to six hits and two walks, while striking out six in CSU's first shutout of the season...The Bucs also won the series finale on Sunday as **RYAN GUNTHER** worked seven strong innings and the Bucs piled up 12 hits to take a 5-2 win and the series...PC took a Saturday night decision, 8-4...The Bucs are now 7-2 in Big South play at home and 15-8 overall at CSU Ballpark this season...Centerfielder **BOBBY ISON** had a big week, batting .526 (10-for-19) with three doubles, a triple, and two steals. RADFORD

The Highlanders finished the week 2-2 with a series victory at Coastal Carolina. It was the first series win against the Chanticleers since 2002 and snapped their streak of 12 straight series victories in conference play. The Highlanders had not won a series on the road vs. CCU since 1997, and the win on Saturday broke a 12-game road losing streak to the Chanticleers... The opener of the series, which CCU won 1-0 in 15 innings, was the second longest game in Radford baseball history (2008, L 3-2 vs. VMI in 16 inn.). It was the longest game in school history to go as a scoreless tie (14.2 innings)... **MITCHELL MACKETH** stood out for the Highlanders on the mound. 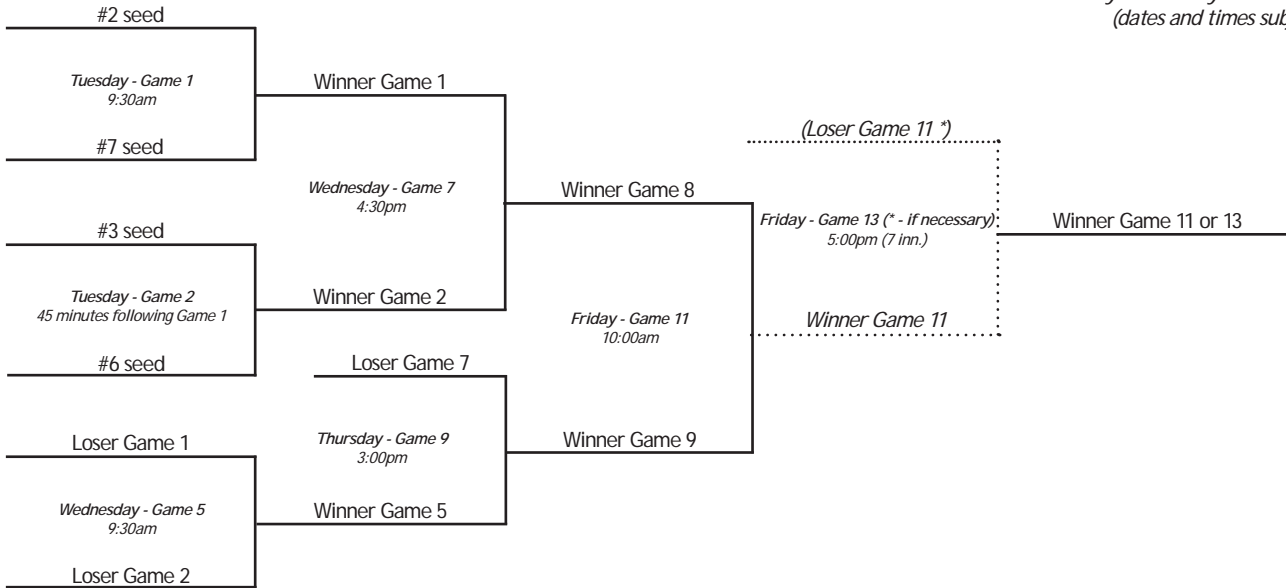

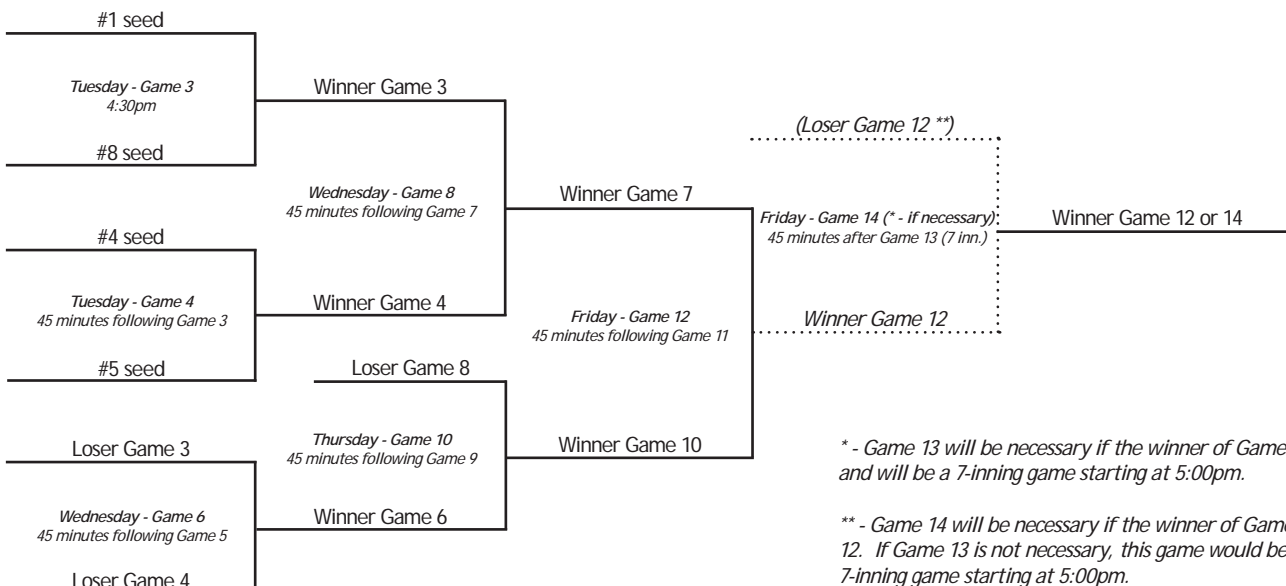
