Graham, a senior from Marietta, Ga., extended his streak of reaching base to 32 games, while batting .524 in five starts last week. He recorded four multi-hit games, including a two home run game against Charlotte on April 6. For the week he went 11-for-21, with nine RBI and five runs scored. The catcher recorded two homers and two doubles, with three walks and one sacrifice fly. He posted a slugging percentage of .907, and an on-base percentage of .577 from the leadoff spot. Against mountain rival Western Carolina on April 3, Graham tied a career-high five RBI against the Catamounts. The honor marks his first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

Campbell posted its third 5-0 week of the season with a Big South series sweep on the road at Presbyterian to go along with a pair of midweek wins. After a 10-2 win at N.C. A&T on Tuesday, Campbell picked up its first shutout of the season with an 8-0 win over visiting Old Dominion on Wednesday night. The Camels picked up another first on Friday at Presbyterian, their first extra inning win of the year, 7-1 in 11 innings... **HEATH BOWERS** was the starter in two of Campbell's five wins this week, running his consecutive innings streak without an earned run to 24. The sophomore righthander pitched 13 innings with one run on eight hits, eight strikeouts and three walks, adding a 0.69 ERA for the week... **DAVID OLSON** clubbed Campbell to its third 5-0 week of the season, posting two home runs, three multi-hit games, five RBI, seven runs and a win on the mound to cap it off... The Camels return to Jim Perry Stadium next week, hosting five games in Buies Creek. The week begins with North Carolina A&T on Tuesday, followed by Savannah State on Wednesday. Campbell will host new Big South rival Longwood over the weekend

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU is 11-20 and 3-6 in Big South Conference play following a week which included a tough 9-5 loss at South Carolina and weekend series at Gardner-Webb which featured close losses on Saturday and Sunday... The Bucs outhit the No. 11 Gamecocks in a midweek loss as five Bucs all had two hits, led by **DREW WOODALL** who hit a solo home run and scored twice... **CHASE SHELTON** led the Bucs' attack on the weekend going 5-for-11 against the Runnin' Bulldogs..GWU overcame two early leads on Saturday and Sunday to take a 4-2 win on Saturday and a 3-2 win on Sunday. The Bucs had the tying run thrown out at the plate in the ninth of Sunday to end the weekend...CSU had 12 hits on Saturday, but managed only two runs. The Bucs' **TORY SCROFF** had the best out of the weekend, who struck out a CSU season-high nine on Saturday, allowing three earned runs in the loss. **BOBBY ISON** and **ALEX TOMASOVICH** are the only Bucs to have started all 31 games. COASTAL CAROLINA

Including two wins in the series so far, Coastal has won each of the last 19 games versus the Flames, dating back to May 24, 2008 in the Big South Tournament. (Coastal would turn around that day and beat Liberty to win the 2008 Big South Championship and start the win streak.) The Chants have won four games over the Flames in each of the last four years, sweeping the regular-season series and getting a win over Liberty in the Big South Tournament... With wins over Liberty in the first two games of the series on Saturday and Sunday, Coastal has won its fourth conference series in four tries this season and has won nine straight three-game conference series dating back to the end of 2011. (Note: CCU split a two-game set with Winthrop as a game was rained out last season.) Over his last 14 games, **TED BLACKMAN** has batted .447 (21-for-47) to raise his season batting average 123 points to a team-best .323 ... More specifically, he has raised his average 96 points over the last eight games, batting .556 (15-for-27)... **ALEX BUCCILLI** had two game-winning hits this past week ... He hit a sac fly in the seventh at The Citadel to give CCU a 3-2 win ... Saturday, he broke a 1-1 tie in the eighth with a two-run double ... He has raised his batting average 42 points to a season-high .281 over the past five games, batting .444 (8-for-18) over the span with five RBI

UNC Asheville went 2-3 on the week, splitting a home and home series with mountain rival Western Carolina before going 1-2 against Charlotte on the weekend in a three-game series. Catcher **IAN GRAHAM** continues his impressive play from the leadoff spot, having reached base in all 30 games he has played in this season, and 32 games dating back to last season. Currently **TOMMY HOUMARD** leads the team in RBI with 23 and doubles with 10 on the year. **DEAN ROLAND** picked up his first win of the season on Saturday, tossing six strong innings against Charlotte. Roland is now 1-6 on the year. **BILLY CREIGHTON** picked up his first save of the season, tossing three shutout innings against Charlotte on Saturday. Creighton was also credited with the loss in the Bulldogs' extra inning setback to the 49ers on Sunday, allowing two runs in the bottom of the 11th. The Blue & White will host Appalachian State on Tuesday evening at McCormick Field before traveling to Wofford on Wednesday. 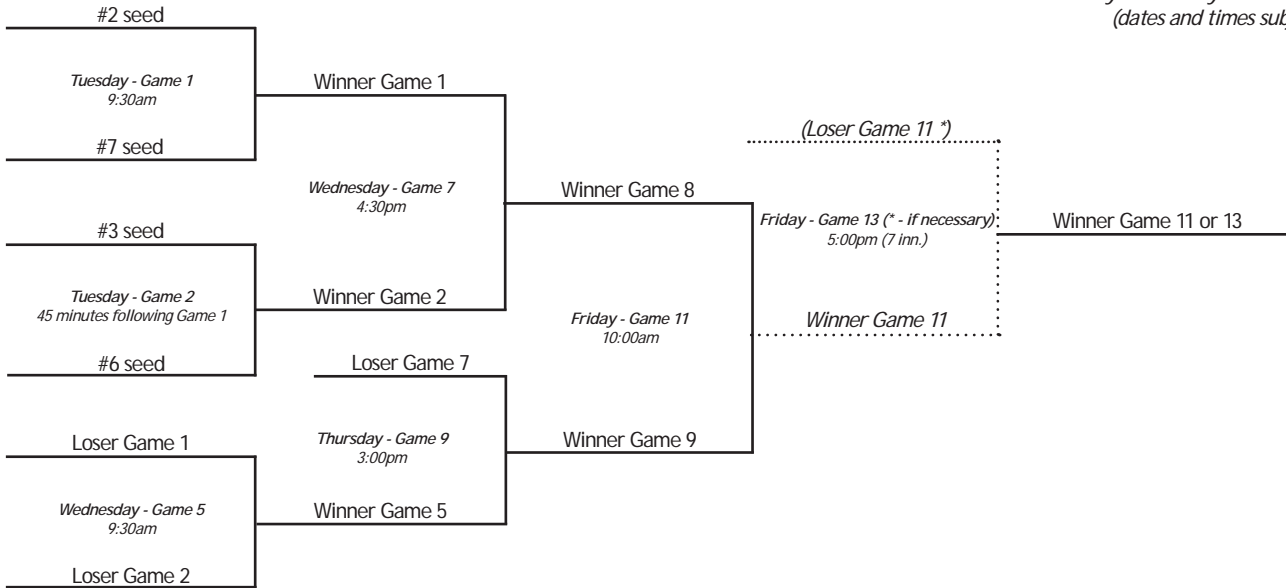

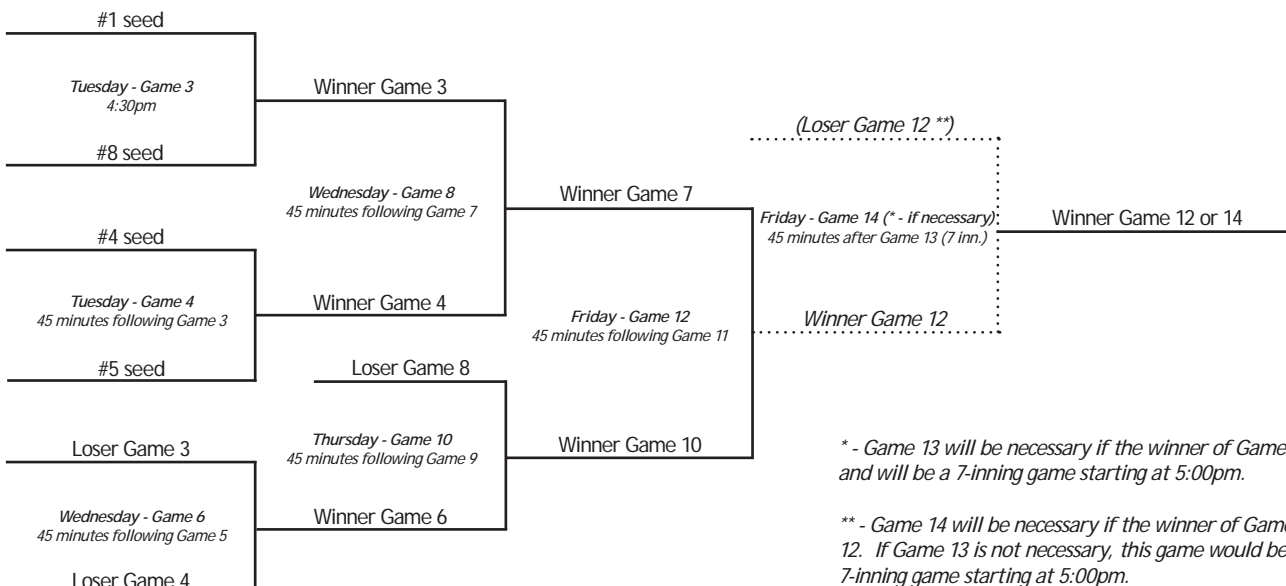
