Medina hit .571 in the three games against the Highlanders with five RBI and four runs scored. Medina went 3-4 on Friday with two RBI, a run scored and a triple. He then went 3-6 with an RBI and Run scored as well as a stolen base on Saturday and went 2-4, including a double, with two RBI and two runs scored on Sunday. Medina drove in the winning runs in the series finale on Sunday with a bases-loaded single in the ninth. The honor marks his first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

CAMPBELL

The Camels posted 1-0 and 5-2 wins to take its series over Longwood over the weekend after the Lancers took game one of the series 3-2 Friday night. Campbell improved to 31-7 on the season and 11-4 in Big South play. **HEATH BOWERS** (7-0) and **HECTOR CEDANO** (7-2) became the 10th and 11th pitchers in Campbell history to record at least seven wins in a single season with their wins on Saturday, tying the pair for fourth on the school single season list. **RYAN THOMPSON** posted his seventh save of the season in the rubber match. Heath Bowers registered a complete game shutout Saturday in Campbell's 1-0 Big South win over Longwood. The sophomore improved to 7-0 on the season with his first career complete game shutout, allowing seven hits with eight strikeouts and two walks. His eight K's on Saturday marked a career high. Over his last 34 2/3 innings, spread over five starts, Bowers has allowed just one earned run. The streak includes 28 strikeouts, six walks and only one extra base hit. The complete game shutout was the first by the Camels this season. Campbell has won in each of Bowers' nine starts this season. Campbell senior center fielder **BEN MCQUOWN** set the Campbell single season stolen bases record this week, and eyes the school career record with 17 regular season games remaining. McQuown came into the week tied for the single season record with 35, knotted by **BRANDON SCOTT**'s 2008 mark. The senior outfielder owns 65 steals in just two seasons, transferring to Campbell after two seasons at Lower Columbia Community College. **BRANDON SCOTT** also owns the career mark with 80. **NIC CARTER** is second on the career list with 72. McQuown's 38 steals this season leads the nation. The Camels were winners of six in a row before falling on Wednesday.

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers turned in a 3-1 week with a midweek win at USC Upstate, 9-3, for their first road win of the year and series-win over VMI with a trio of quality starts on the weekend. The Bucs had a team ERA of 2.68 with 34 strikeouts on the week. Seniors **RYAN GUNTHER** and **KEVIN BURAN** each picked up wins over the Keydets. Gunther won a 6-4 decision on Saturday with a CSU season-high 10 strikeouts, while Buran held VMI down with 9 Ks in a 7-4 win on Sunday. Coastal Carolina has won nine straight (Citadel twice, sweep of Liberty, Coll of Charleston and sweep of Winthrop) ... The streak is Coastal's best since winning nine straight early in the 2012 season (Mar. 11-25) ... Coastal has not won 10 straight since the 2010 season when Coastal won 17 straight ... Ironically, the 10th win in that stretch was a 12-4 win at #21 North Carolina, who CCU plays Tuesday in hopes of getting its 10th straight win... Coastal Carolina started the week by completing its series with Liberty ... Coastal won 12-1 Monday to sweep the Flames and run its win streak over Liberty to 20 straight while improving to 56-28 all-time over the Flames... Coastal ended the week by sweeping Winthrop on the road ... The Chants are now 73-47 all-time versus the Eagles... 


