CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JUANNE BLOUNT • RB • R-Junior
 Gardner-Webb • Wingate, N.C.

Blount rushed 28 times for a career-high 162 yards and a pair of touchdowns -- giving GWU its first win over Furman and first victory over a SoCon team since 2009. Blount had 20 carries for 120 yards and both scores in the second half, with each of his touchdowns in the third quarter that rallied Gardner-Webb back from a 21-7 deficit. Seven of Blount's carries went for first downs, and five went for 10 yards or more. His 29-yard scamper with just over 10 minutes remaining was the key play in Gardner-Webb's game-winning drive -- getting GWU down inside the Furman 30. The Runnin' Bulldogs scored four plays later and never trailed again. After Gardner-Webb got the ball back with 1:48 left, Blount raced off right tackle and outran the Paladin defense, gaining 41 yards down to the Furman one to ice the game.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CALVIN BRYANT • LB • Senior
 Charleston Southern • Jacksonville, Fla.

Bryant led the Bucs to a 32-29 win over The Citadel with a team-high 12 tackles (seven solo and five assisted), as well as 1.5 TFL, one forced fumble and one pass break-up. He made three stops on third down plays to force fourth down situations, while another two of his tackles went for no gain. With CSU clinging to a three-point lead, Bryant recorded three tackles during The Citadel's final two drives in helping the Bucs turn away the Bulldogs both times in CSU territory. For his efforts, Bryant has been named National Co-Defensive Player of the Week by *The Sports Network*.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LaDARIUS HAWTHORNE • DB • Senior

With South Carolina State looking to increase its lead to 11 points midway through the third quarter, Hawthorne came off the right edge and blocked a 39-yard field goal attempt that was scooped up by Quinn Backus and returned 56 yards for a touchdown. Coastal would convert a two-point PAT to tie the game at 20-20, and Hawthorne's play swung the momentum to the Chanticleers.

BIG SOUTH CLAIMS THREE SEASON-OPENING FCS WINS FOR FIRST TIME

The Big South's three season-opening FCS victories on Saturday were the most for the League in the Conference's record book. The most FCS opponents the Big South played in a season-opening weekend was five in 2012 (out of seven games), followed by four in 2002 (out of four games), 2008 (out of seven games) and this year (out of six contests). The Big South is now 33-37 in season openers since 2002, but 17 of those 37 losses have been against FBS members.

FOR OPENERS

Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb were victorious in their respective season openers this past Saturday. The Chanticleers won their third consecutive season opener and sixth in their 11-year history. The Buccaneers claimed their first season-opening win since the 2010 season, while the Runnin' Bulldogs won their season opener for the second time in three seasons.

MORE ON THE 1-0 TEAMS

As mentioned above, Coastal Carolina is 1-0 for the third-straight year and sixth time in the history of the program. The Chants are looking for their third consecutive 2-0 start this week. Charleston Southern last started 2-0 in 2006 when the Bucs opened 9-0. Gardner-Webb has not been 2-0 since the 2010 campaign.

BIG SOUTH'S NEWEST COACHES SCORE DEBUT WINS

New Charleston Southern head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** and Gardner-Webb head coach **CARROLL McCRAY** were both victorious in their coaching debuts this past Saturday. Chadwell and McCray join Coastal Carolina's **JOE MOGLIA** (2012) and VMI's **SPARKY WOODS** (2008) among the current Big South coaches who won their coaching debut in the Conference. The last time two new head coaches won their first game in the Big South was in 2006 -- Liberty's **DANNY ROCCO** and VMI's **JIM REID**.

HOME SWEET HOME

A Big South-record tying five season-openers were played on the road this past Saturday, and those five teams (Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Liberty, Presbyterian and VMI) will play their home opener this weekend. Below is a look at the five teams' last home-opening win and current home opening streaks.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 86. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb has not been shutout in its last 56 games, followed by Coastal Carolina (17). Furthermore, Liberty is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 30, tied for the third-longest streak in Big South history. That record is 45 games, established by the Flames from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

BIG SOUTH'S STREAK OF NATIONALLY-RANKED PROGRAMS CONTINUES

With Coastal Carolina ranked No. 22 in this week's FCS Coaches poll and No. 24 in *The Sports Network* ranking, the Big South has had a football squad ranked for 22 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

BUCS' BIG WIN

Charleston Southern won at The Citadel, 32-29, in its season-opener for the squad's first FCS road win since Nov. 7, 2009 -- ending an 11-game losing streak in such contests. In addition, the Buccaneers' 32 points were their most in a season-opener since scoring 41 against North Greenville in 2010 -- which was **JAMEY CHADWELL**'s second season leading the Crusaders. It was also the Bucs' most points scored against a non-Conference FCS foe since Oct. 3, 2009 when CSU defeated Savannah State, 47-10.

HEY YOU... I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU

The Big South will see a familiar face across the sideline this season, as VMI, Gardner-Webb (Sept. 14) and Liberty (Sept. 21) will go head-to-head against the Richmond Spiders and former Liberty head coach **DANNY ROCCO**. Rocco spent six seasons in the Big South as the Flames' leader from 2006-11, and directed his teams to a 26-5 Conference record and 47-20 overall mark. He is now 3-0 against the Big South while at UR.

COMINGS...

The Big South Conference will welcome **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014. The Hawks will get an early taste of League play as they will travel to Liberty this Saturday. The Big South is 2-0 against Monmouth, with Coastal Carolina earning both wins (2008 and 2009).

... AND GOINGS

The Big South bid farewell to Stony Brook following the 2012 campaign, as the Seawolves ended their associate membership after five years to join the CAA. Meanwhile, VMI is playing its final campaign in the Big South this season, as the Keydets are rejoining the Southern Conference next fall.

ANOTHER FAMILIAR FOE

Furman is opening the 2013 season against the Big South, playing its first three games against the Conference. The Big South has won four times against the Paladins since starting football in 2002 -- Coastal Carolina (this week's opponent) has three victories and Gardner-Webb claimed the fourth this past weekend. Meanwhile, start-up program Charlotte will face four Big South members during its inaugural 2013 season.

CLAMP DOWN DEFENSE

Gardner-Webb held Furman to just 43 offensive plays and 213 yards of offense in Saturday's season-opener. It was GWU's fewest plays allowed since becoming Big South football members in 2002, and the fewest yards allowed since holding Southern Virginia to 91 offensive yards on Oct. 24, 2009. Furman's 213 yards were the fewest gained by a Division I opponent (FBS or FCS) since the Runnin' Bulldogs held Georgia Tech to 199 offensive yards on Oct. 11, 2008.

RETURN ON INVESTMENT

Coastal Carolina has rushed for more than 200 yards in eight of its last nine games, dating back to last season. As a program, Coastal is now 46-5 (=.902) when rushing for at least 200 yards in a game.

MASTRO OF THE UNIVERSE

Coastal Carolina senior **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is the Big South's all-time leader for punt returns (64) and punt return yards (547). He is the third player in Big South history with at least 100 combined kickoff/punt returns in a career, as he is third all-time with 111 (47 KR, 64 PR). He needs 17 returns to break the Conference record of 127, which is held by former VMI standout **TIM MAYPRAY**. Maypray returned 98 kickoffs and 29 punts in his career from 2006-09. Meanwhile, Mastromatteo is the only player in the Conference record books with two punt returns of at least 80 yards.

MEMBERS ONLY

Presbyterian College junior LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** needs three tackles to become the 38th player in Big South history with 200 in a career. He has tallied 104 solo stops and assisted on 93 tackles during his time in Clinton. Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is 20 hits away from the 200-tackle milestone.

PRESS ON

Gardner-Webb senior DE **PRESTON PEMASA** is now eighth in Big South history with 13.5 quarterback sacks. He is also tied for third in the Conference record books with 36.0 career tackles-for-loss. Pemasa needs 2.5 TFL to move into second in League history and 4.0 sacks to move into second in that category. Former Gardner-Webb All-American **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is the Big South's all-time leader in both categories with 53.5 TFL and 20.5 sacks.

OCHO-QUATRO

VMI QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** has connected on four pass plays of at least 80 yards in his career -- the only QB in the Conference record books with more than two. Kordenbrock hooked-up with RB **JABARI TURNER** last season on an 81-yard swing pass catch and run Nov. 10 against The Citadel. It was the longest pass reception by a running back in Big South history. Two weeks earlier on Oct. 27, Kordenbrock had an 80-yard touchdown pass play with WR **JAMES ROGERS** at Gardner-Webb.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 IN 2013

The Big South Conference will televise nine football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season and a total of 22 games will be televised this year. Overall, the Big South will appear on television every week of the season for the second consecutive campaign, including a "Game of the Week" on ESPN3. The "Game of the Week" package includes two non-Conference broadcasts for the first time and begins Sept. 14 when Gardner-Webb hosts Richmond. The first League game will be Oct. 12 with the Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina contest.

BIG TALLY FOR TALIAFERRO

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** rushed for 157 yards at South Carolina State, the highest single-game rushing total by a Chanticleer since **TOMMY FRASER** rushed for 157 yards against Presbyterian on Nov. 14, 2009. It was just the ninth time a CCU rusher had surpassed 150 rushing yards in a game in school history.

KORDENBROCK IS A LOCK TO FINISH HIGH ON BIG SOUTH'S PASSING LISTS

VMI senior QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** is quickly climbing the Big South's career passing record charts. He entered the season ninth all-time with 430 completions and sixth with 813 attempts, and is now eighth with 448 completions and fourth with 845 throws. He moved into the top 10 in career passing yards this past weekend and is 10th in that category with 4,658. Kordenbrock is 52 completions shy of becoming the fourth Big South QB with 500, is 155 attempts away from becoming the third to attempt 1,000 passes in a career, and needs 342 yards to become the 10th member of the 5,000-passing yard club. Just six players in League history have thrown for more than 6,000 yards.

BACKUS ACHIEVES RARE FEAT

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** become the second Chanticleer and sixth player in Big South history to return a blocked field goal for a touchdown when he accomplished the feat this past Saturday at South Carolina State. Below is the list of the Big South's all-time blocked field goals returned for TDs:

EYES ON HAZEL

Coastal Carolina senior WR and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **MATT HAZEL** is the Big South's active career leader with 118 receptions (T-17th in League history), 1,600 receiving yards (20th) and 19 touchdowns (tied for 7th). He has also been named to the 2014 Senior Bowl Watch List as well as the South Carolina Football Hall of Fame College Player of the Year Award Watch List.

FOGG ALERT

Liberty redshirt-senior **KEVIN FOGG** is tied as the Big South's all-time leader for most kickoff return touchdowns with three. Coupled with his one career punt return score, Fogg is second in League history with four kick return TDs. He needs one to tie the all-time mark of five, set by former Liberty WR **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (3 KR, 2 PR) from 2005-08.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

Coastal Carolina and Liberty will meet this season in Lynchburg on Oct. 19 for the 11th time. The series is tied at 5-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship eight times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2012 as well as 2010.

FB-YES

The Big South will play five games against FBS opponents this season, and has recorded three FBS wins since the 2010 campaign -- including two victories in 2010. That year, the Big South was the only FCS AQ Conference with two FBS wins.

* Charleston Southern meets Shorter for the second time on Saturday. The Buccaneers lead the series, 1-0, after winning the first meeting last season, a 23-20 road victory.

* The Bucs own a four-game home winning streak, dating back to last season.

* In the win over The Citadel, Charleston Southern rallied from a 16-0 deficit behind two passing TDs from **MALCOLM DIXON** and two rushing TDs from **ZACH FRAZIER** for the 32-29 victory.

* Dixon threw TD passes on back-to-back offensive snaps for the Bucs (64 yards to **KEVIN GLEARS** and 19 yards to **DONTE SUMPTER**) as the Bucs scored 14 quick points.

* **CAMERON MITCHELL's** 29-yard field goal, his first career attempt, was the deciding score with just over six minutes to play.

* CSU started three freshmen offensive lineman in the win over The Citadel. The win is the Bucs' first over a SoCon opponent since 2006 and second against The Citadel, now 2-5 all-time against the Bulldogs.

* RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** led the Buccaneers with 92 rushing yards on 22 attempts at The Citadel, with a long of 24. DB **ELJAH LEE** averaged 20.5 yards on two punt returns and also returned a kickoff 28 yards.

* New head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL**, the third head coach in school history, is the first Buccaneer head coach to win his debut.
